STORYLINE

After spending the first week of the season on the road, the Lipscomb men's basketball continues its journey on Saturday with a trip to SEC country where the Bisons and Hogs will meet in BWA.

Lipscomb's only win against an SEC opponent came Dec. 29, 2016 when the Bisons went into Missouri and left with an 81-76 victory. They are 0-3 in SEC games since. The Bisons traveled to Auburn last season (L 86-59).

STARTING NOTES

- Lipscomb is in its 90th season of basketball.
- It was 265 days between games for the Bisons after they walked off the court in the ASUN Conference Final in Lynchburg last season.
- Lipscomb returns 10 letter winners and three of its primary starters from a squad that finished 16-16 overall and 9-7 in ASUN play. That team finished the year in stride, winning eight of its final 10 games to climb to third in the league standings.
- Lennie Acuff enters his 2nd season at the helm of the program and his 31st overall as a head coach. His 16 wins last season were the most by a first-year head coach in Lipscomb's Division I era.
- The Bisons have played in three straight conference championship games (2018-20) and were tabbed as the league's preseason favorite by the ASUN head coaches and the media.
- Among those returning is junior center Ahsan Asadullah (18.6 points, 10.1 rebounds, 3.9 assists), who was a First Team All-Conference and NABC All-District selection. He was named the ASUN Preseason Player of the Year earlier this month, becoming the second Bison in the last three seasons to earn the distinction.

HEAD COACH: LENNIE ACUFF



Lennie Acuff was named the 19th head men's basketball coach at Lipscomb University on April 23, 2019.

With a 30-year storied coaching career, Acuff has established himself a proven winner and one of the best teachers in the game.

To make things tough for Acuff, who was already entering his first coaching job at the Division I level, the Bisons had seven players, more than 7,700 career points and 3,000 career rebounds walk out the door prior to his arrival in 2019-20. Not only did he have to work eight first-year players into the roster, but there were only two guys on the team who had ever started a game.

But for a coach with more than 550 wins over his career, Acuff was ready for the challenge. He continued to tell anyone who would listen that 2019-20 would be a

"jumping on point" for the program. Glancing back on his first D-I campaign, it sure looks like he was right. He pushed his team to its fullest potential and put the Bisons back in the ASUN Conference championship game for a third straight season.

He guided Lipscomb to a 16-16 overall record and coached a team picked fifth in the preseason to a third-place finish in the league (9-7) after winning eight of the final 10 games. The 16 wins were the most by a first-year head coach in Lipscomb's Division I era.

Acuff's creative game planning and offensive sets brought forth a different style of play Lipscomb fans had come accustomed to over the last few seasons. It enabled sophomore big man Ahsan Asadullah to post a season line that had only been accomplished once in Division I since 1992-93, averaging 18.6 ppg, 10.1 rpg and 3.9 apg. Former LSU star and current Philadelphia 76er point guard Ben Simmons was the only other player to achieve those numbers in 2015-16.

For his efforts, Asadullah was named First Team All-ASUN and First Team All-District by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

The Bisons opened the Acuff era in convincing fashion with a 104-55 victory over Rhodes College inside Allen Arena on Nov. 5, 2019. It was the most points by a Lipscomb team since 2008.

Growing pains set in after that game, and the Bisons lost their next four games – three of which were two-possession contests. Back-to-back road wins at Navy (65-61) and Tennessee Tech (78-65) put the team back on track heading into Thanksgiving break. Road games at #23 Xavier, Belmont, Vermont and #8 Auburn helped prepare the Bisons for the conference season, where they went on the road and held off a pesky new-look Stetson squad 66-63 to give Acuff his first ASUN victory on January 2.

At the midway point of ASUN play, after an 85-73 win over then co-leader North Florida, the Bisons were 8-13 and sat in eighth place in the league standings. They then opened the month of February with a disappointing loss to Stetson and dropped to 3-6 in conference games. That game would end up being a turning point for the team.

Behind Asadullah, the Bisons reeled off six straight wins and finished the second half of league play 7-1, including a 77-71 win over regular season champion Liberty in the home finale, to enter postseason play as hot as any team in the ASUN.

The day he was snubbed for conference Player of the Year, Asadullah carried Lipscomb to a 68-63 victory over FGCU in the first round of the ASUN tournament after scoring a career-high 40 points and grabbing 14 rebounds. It was the most points ever scored by a Bison inside Allen Arena.

Playing in the program's sixth-straight conference semifinal, the Bisons went on the road and came away with a 73-71 upset win over No. 2 North Florida as senior Andrew Fleming sunk the game-winning floater with 3.1 seconds on the clock to send Lipscomb to the championship game. Asadullah scored 27 points and pulled down a career-high 19 rebounds in the win.

Three days later, in a game no one expected Lipscomb to be in, the Bisons battled top-seeded Liberty on national television and in front of a record-breaking crowd for the ASUN crown. A 19-point first-half deficit ended up being too much to overcome for Lipscomb and when the final horn sounded, it was the Flames who had taken a 73-57 victory.

Many might have worried where the program would go after a two-year run that saw 52 wins, its first NCAA Tournament appearance and a charge to the NIT championship game. But if 2019-20 is a glimpse of where Acuff has this program headed, you better jump on and buckle up.

Prior to arriving in Nashville, Acuff spent the previous 22 seasons at the helm of the University of Alabama in Huntsville, where he built the Chargers program into a national power with a 437-214 overall record.

Under Acuff, UAH won eight regular season and three Gulf South Conference tournament championships and earned 11 trips to the NCAA-DII tournament, including two trips to the Elite Eight after winning the NCAA-DII South Regional in 2011 and 2012.

BYE-SUNS

We are the “BYE-SONS” at Lipscomb. Don’t confuse us with North Dakota State where they are pronounced the “BYE-ZIN”. Act like you are from the South.

The most commonly accepted plural of ‘bison’ is bison, but at Lipscomb we are the Bisons. The unabridged Oxford English dictionary includes Bisons as a proper usage.

WE ARE THE ASUN CONFERENCE

When referring to our conference, please use “ASUN Conference” or “ASUN”.

Refrain from using “Atlantic Sun Conference”. The league underwent a rebranding in April of 2016 which dropped the usage of “Atlantic Sun.”

DAT BOY FERG

Grad transfer Romeo Ferguson was exceptional for the Bisons throughout the Tulane Classic. He recorded team-highs in points in both games and was named the ASUN Newcomer of the Week on Monday for his efforts.

The Burlington, North Carolina native averaged 16.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.0 steal per game as Lipscomb went 1-1. Ferguson match the team-high in points for the third game in a row at Cincinnati with 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting.

He is currently leading the team in scoring at 15.0 ppg and his 5.3 rpg is second most. He’s shooting 47.1 percent from the field, 42.9 percent from deep and 83.3 percent at the free throw line.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Bisons have been good on the road in ASUN Conference play the last few years.

They were just 5-5 in league road contests last season and 28-12 in their last 40. The Bisons led the country in 2019-20 with 14 road wins. (14-4)

USE ‘EM UP

According to KenPom.com, Asadullah had the 4th highest usage rate in the country at 36.1% in 2019-20. He trailed only Marquette’s Markus Howard (38.0), UNCG’s Isaiah Miller (37.6) and ECU’s Jomaru Brown (36.9).

70 OR LESS

Lipscomb was 10-4 when holding opponents to 70 points or less last season. The defeats came on the road at Duquesne (58-36), at FGCU (68-61) and at Liberty (67-60) before falling to Stetson (55-53) at home.

Dating back to 2016-17, the Bisons are 42-8 in their last 50 games when limiting foes to 70 points or less.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Ahsan Asadullah was one of the most improved players in the country last season, racking up 15 double-doubles. Ten of those came in the last 13 games, all against ASUN opponents.

SOPHOMORE LEAP?

KJ Johnson put together one of the best freshman seasons in the Bisons Division I history in 2019-20. He finished 19 points shy of matching Josh Williams’ (2013-14) total of 377 in 29 games. His 13.0 ppg average is also tops for a Lipscomb freshman.

Johnson totaled 358 in 32 games. His 11.2 ppg average was also second behind Williams in the NCAA era for a freshman.

#KAREEMAWARD

Asadullah is one of just 20 players in the nation named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced the esteemed list on Friday.

8TH TO 3RD

After losing more than 7,700 career points, six of the top seven scorers and their head coach from 2018-19’s NIT runner-up team, it took some time to put it all together.

At the midway point of the conference schedule in 2019-20, the Bisons were 8-13 overall and 3-5 in league play and sitting in 8th place in the ASUN standings. The 85-73 win over Co-champ North Florida in Nashville on Jan. 25 started a strong finish to the season where they won 9 of the last 11 games and climbed to 3rd in the conference.

Three of those wins came against No. 1 Liberty and (2x) No. 2 UNF. The Bisons were the only team in the ASUN to defeat both of the league co-champions.

ROMEO-O-ROMEO

The 6-foot-5 guard transferred to Nashville in the offseason as a graduate student from Belmont Abbey College in North Carolina, where he was a First Team All-Conference selection and was named Defensive Player of the Year in the Conference Carolinas. He also earned Second Team NABC All-District honors.

He averaged 17.9 points, a team-high 7.3 rebounds and a league-best 4.7 assists on 54.9 percent shooting. He pulled down seven double-doubles and netted 11 double-digit scoring games, including a career high 29 points against King University last January.

Led Belmont Abbey to its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 after earning an at-large bid as the No. 8 seed in the Southeast Regional just days before the basketball world was shut down in March.

Ferguson finished top-10 in the Conference Carolinas in 12 different statistical categories last season: total assists (1st – 141), assists per game (1st – 4.7), total minutes (2nd – 1023), minutes per game (2nd – 34.1), defensive rebounds (2nd – 184), field goals made (3rd – 201/366), total rebounds (3rd – 220), scoring (4th – 17.9), total points (5th – 537), rebounds per game (5th – 7.3), three-point percentage (7th – 45.1) and field goal percentage (9th – 54.9).

SUPER MURRIO

Lipscomb inked two high school standouts during the early signing period last November.

A legend in the state of Alabama, Murr attended Lindsay Lane Christian Academy where he led the national high school ranks in scoring back-to-back seasons, producing 44.3 as a senior and 45.1 as a junior.

He scored 56 in his career finale in the AH-SAA State Playoffs. He closed the books on his storied six-year varsity career with 5,716 total points; making him the all-time leader in Alabama history and No. 2 all-time nationally, according to the NFHS record book. Only four players in high school basketball history ever eclipsed the 5K mark.

Also set a reported national record with 1,226 career free throws made. Produced 23 career games of 40+ points and five of 50+. He averaged 31.6 ppg over his career in 181 games. His father played college basketball at Tennessee Temple University.

WILL PRUITT

Will Pruitt prepped just 30 minutes east of campus in Mount Juliet, Tenn. Finished as a Mr. Tennessee Basketball finalist and a First Team All-State selection as a senior, averaging 21.3 ppg, 6.7 rpg and 5.2 apg. Upped that from 15.2 ppg, 5.1 rpg and 1.5 spg as a junior.

Led the Bears to three straight District 9-AAA Championships; the first championships in school history.

Asadullah is one of just eight players from mid-major schools on the watch list.

Last season, he joined former No. 1 pick in the NBA Draft – Ben Simmons – as the only two players in NCAA Division I since 1992-93 to average a season line of 18.6 points, 10.1 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game.

RELOADING

In the 2nd season since losing a nation-leading 8,883 career points at the end of 2018-19, the Bisons are well ahead of schedule just 34 games into the Acuff era.

Lipscomb has just hold-over four players on its current roster that played under Casey Alexander (Belmont) that season. They accounted for just 14.3% of the offense, or 440 of the 3,076 total points scored. Below is a chart that shows those players with their total points and ppg over the last 3 seasons.

NIT RUNNER-UP

In 2019-20 and a year after its first NCAA Tournament berth, Lipscomb became the first ASUN squad to reach the NIT Final and just the second men's basketball program in conference history to play for a national postseason title (Mercer, CIT, 2012).

The Bisons defeated Davidson, UNC Greensboro, North Carolina State and Wichita State, all on the road, before succumbing to Texas in the final.

HISTORY LESSON

Lipscomb University was established in 1891 by David Lipscomb and James A. Harding as the Nashville Bible School. Nearly 30 years later, the school was renamed David Lipscomb College after Lipscomb passed away.

In 1988, Lipscomb became known as David Lipscomb University, but in 1994, the "David" was legally dropped. The school joined the NCAA as a full member in 2004-05. Lipscomb is affiliated with the Churches of Christ.

LET'S SCORE 4000+ POINTS

The top two all-time leading scorers in college basketball history (NCAA or NAIA) belong to the Lipscomb Bisons.

John Pierce is college basketball's all-time leading scorer with 4,230 career points and current Lipscomb AD Philip Hutcheson, who concluded his career as the nation's all-time leading scorer, ranks second alltime with 4,106 career points.

The NCAA record for career points is held by LSU's "Pistol" Pete Maravich, who totaled 3,667 points.

WINNING

Lipscomb has earned 89 victories since the start of 2016-17 season. During that stretch, the Bisons racked up three straight 20-win campaigns. Those victories are the second-most in the ASUN in that span, trailing only Liberty's 105, and are the most in the program's D-I history during a four-year span.

MR. JONES

Greg Jones enters the matchup second on the team in scoring (14.0 ppg), third in assists (3.0 apg) and fourth in rebounding (3.0 rpg). He matched Ferguson on Wednesday with a team-high 12 points. The junior has scored in double figures in three straight games for just the second time in his career. He leads the Bisons and ranks 32nd in Division I with 10 made threes on the year.
