POSTGAME NOTES: MISSOURI 50, ARKANSAS 48

PREGAME NOTES

- The Razorbacks wore white helmets, white jerseys and white pants.
- Arkansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half.
- Arkansas' captains were Myron Cunningham, Feleipe Franks, Grant Morgan and Jonathan Marshall. Cunningham was the Razorback's coin toss representative.
- Weather 46 degrees, sunny, no wind.

GENERAL NOTES

- Saturday marked the 12th all-time meeting between Arkansas and Missouri. Missouri improved to 9-3 in the all-time series.
- Today's starters: Offense KJ Jefferson (OB), Myron Cunningham (LT), Brady Latham (LG), Ricky Stromberg (C), Ty Clary (RG), Dalton Wagner (RT), Trelon Smith (RB), Mike Woods (WR), Treylon Burks (WR), Trey Knox (WR), Blake Kern (TE). Defense - Isaiah Nichols (DE), Jonathan Marshall (DT), Eric Gregory (DE), Bumper Pool (LB), Grant Morgan (LB), Hayden Henry (LB), Greg Brooks Jr. (NB), Joe Foucha (S), Myles Slusher (S), Montaric Brown (CB), Hudson Clark (CB).
- QB KJ Jefferson made his first start of the season, and second of his career.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Set a season-high in points and scored 40+ points for the first time against an SEC opponent since 2017 against Missouri.
- The Razorbacks registered a season-high 566 total yards and 292 rushing yards.
- Arkansas scored 27 points in the first half, it's the Hogs' highest scoring opening half this year.
- Arkansas had a 150 yard rusher and receiver in a game for the first time since 2015 against Texas A&M.
- The Razorbacks scored a TD on four consecutive drives, its longest streak of the season.
- Rushed for 200+ yards for the third time this year
- Scored its first TD of the day on a 12-play, 75-yard drive with a KJ Jefferson 2-yard TD pass to TE Blake Kern.
- Tied the game at 13 in the second quarter on a 68-yard TD pass from to Treylon Burks. It was Arkansas' 10th catch of 50+ yards as a team.
- 8-yard TD run by RB Trelon Smith tied the game at 20 with 3:39 to go in the second guarter, he has scored a rushing TD in three straight games.
- QB KJ Jefferson ran for a 1-yard TD on a sneak with 20 seconds left in the first half, giving Arkansas a 27-20 lead.
- Smith scored his second rushing TD of the game on a 15-yard run in the third quarter.
- Smith found the end zone for the third time on a 16-yard run.
- Arkansas scored its last TD on a 14-yard pass to Mike Woods with 43 seconds left and Woods scored a two-point conversion to take a 48-47 lead.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Registered 5.0 tackles for loss, including 1.0 sack with four passes broken up.
- Led by DB Hudson Clark's career-high 10 tackles.
- DL Julius Coates accounted for Arkansas' sack in the first quarter.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

• P Reid Bauer punted five times for 207 yards, averaging 41.4 yards per punt with two downed inside the 20-yard line.

PLAYER NOTES

WR Treylon Burks

- Registered 10 receptions for a career-high 206 receiving yards with a TD. Also ran three times for 14 yards.
- Scored his seventh receiving TD of the season seventh of his career on a career-long scoring play 68-yard catch in the second quarter, tying the game at 13. It was his fifth grab of 40+ yards this season.
- First Razorback to have 200+ receiving yards since Jarius Wright in 2011 against Texas A&M (281).
- Recorded his sixth game of 90+ receiving yards this year.
- Registered his fourth 100+ yard receiving game of the season, became the first Hog receiving with four 100+ yard games in a year since Cobi Hamilton in 2012.
- Totaled the most receiving yards by a Razorback in the all-time series against Missouri.

QB KJ Jefferson

- Completed 18-of-33 passes for 274 yards, three touchdowns and no interceptions. Jefferson also ran for a TD.
- Threw his first career TD pass in the first quarter, finding TE Blake Kern for a 2-yard reception.
- Found WR Treylon Burks for a 68-yard score, Arkansas' second longest scoring reception of the year.
- Completed a 14-yard pass to WR Mike Woods for a score with 43 seconds left in the fourth quarter and hit him again for a two-point conversion.
- First Arkansas QB to throw for two or more TDs while rushing for at least one TD in SEC play since Austin Allen in 2017 against Missouri.
- First Arkansas QB to throw for at least 300 yards while throwing for at least three touchdowns and running for one since Ryan Mallet it 2010 against ULM (400 yds, 3 pass TD, 1 rush TD).



TE Blake Kern

• Made his second TD grab of the season - second of his career - on a 2-yard reception in the first quarter.

RB Trelon Smith

- Ran for 100+ yards for the second time this year and set career-highs with 172 rushing yards on 26 carries and three rushing TDs.
- Scored a rushing TD in his third straight game, finding the end zone in the second quarter, tying the game at 20.
- Found the end zone for the second time on a 15-yard rush in the third quarter, giving Arkansas a 10-point lead.
- Scored for the third time on a 16-yard rush in the fourth quarter, giving Arkansas a 14-point lead.
- First Arkansas back to rush for three TDs in a game since Rawleigh Williams in 2016 vs. Mississippi State.
- Ran for the most yards by a Razorback against Missouri in the all-time series.

WR Mike Woods

- Made two catches for 23 yards, a touchdown and a two-point conversion.
- Scored a TD for the third consecutive game with a 14-yard grab in the fourth quarter and scored on the follwing two-point conversion.

CB Hudson Clark

• Registered a team-high 10 tackles with his first career tackle for loss.

DE Julius Coates

• Registered a sack for a loss of 13 yards in the first half, while also forcing a fumble.

BS Joe Foucha

• Totaled five tackles with 1.0 tackles for loss and two pass breakups.

LB Grant Morgan

• Made seven tackles, including five solo tackles with a tackle for loss.
