ATM's

The ATM machine is located in the north lobby of Barnhill Arena.

CAMERA POLICY

Point-and-shoot cameras are permitted inside the arena. However, professional camera equipment, camera bags or camera lenses exceeding 6" in length, monopods, tripods and video cameras are prohibited inside the arena. For the safety of all competitors **NO flash photography is permitted in the arena.** No personal video or camera equipment will be stored at the arena for pick up post-event.

Any capture of images, still or motion, for the purposes of advertising, promotions, trade or resale by patrons is prohibited. The recording of events and the public distribution without prior written permission is a violation of Southeastern Conference and University of Arkansas policies.

CONCESSIONS

There are concession stands located on both sides of the arena. No outside food or beverage is permitted inside the Arena.

COVID-19 Safety Measures

In consultation with the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH), Razorback Athletics has implemented a number of measures to make your meet day experience as healthy and safe as possible including:

- Reduced capacity inside Barnhill Arena, based upon current state Phase II social distancing standards.
- All event staff and employees will wear face coverings at all times.
- All guests will be required to wear face coverings (over the nose and mouth) from the time they get in line to enter the arena until the time of exiting.
- Lines will be queued following social distance guidelines with 6-foot distancing markers placed throughout the venue and strictly enforced.
- Contactless transactions will be introduced for concessions and merchandise purchases.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be added throughout Barnhill Arena to supplement restroom use.
- Extensive cleaning and sanitation efforts including deep cleaning prior to meets and disinfecting of high frequency touchpoints throughout the event.

DIRECTIONS TO BARNHILL ARENA

The University of Arkansas campus is accessed from Interstate 49 at three major exits: 60 (Razorback Road), 62 (Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.) and 63 (Wedington Road). The core athletic facilities (except for Baum Baseball Stadium and the Tyson Indoor Track Center) are located between Razorback Road on the west and Stadium Drive on the east and Maple Street on the North and Martin Luther King Blvd. on the South.

DISABILITY SEATING

For information on ADA seating call the Razorback Ticket Office at 479-575-5151 (local calls), 1-800-982-HOGS (4647). ADA seating is available on the south side of the competition floor in front of sections N & O. Those with tickets to these seats will need to enter the facility on the south side of the arena.



ENTRY and ARENA SEATING

To create and protect the competition bubble for teams and coaches there will be no north/south movement inside the arena. Entering on the proper side of the arena is extremely important! **If sitting in sections A – E, fans must enter on the north side of the arena. For fans sitting in sections K-W, enter through the south side of the arena.** Access to all seats within the arena will require climbing stairs, if you are unable to do so please contact the ticket office prior to noon on Friday for re-seating options. Please check your mobile tickets once they arrive to determine your entry location. *As a reminder: Please do not move to open seats, as the assigned seats are socially distanced and ADH approved.*

EVACUATION

In case of evacuation, instructions will be given over the public address system. Event staff will assist in directing fans to the appropriate exits.

FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

The NCAA, SEC and UA have assigned a high priority to assuring athletic events are conducted in a safe and enjoyable atmosphere which promotes good sportsmanship by spectators, student-athletes and coaches. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants, officials, those around you, and event management in a positive manner and treating others with courtesy and respect.

FIRST AID/EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE

EMS personnel are available in the arena. They are in the southwest corner of the arena under section P. An event staff member will be happy to assist you in accessing emergency personnel if needed.

EVENT POLICIES

Rowdy, threatening, unsafe or inappropriate conduct including profane, racial, sexist, abusive or intimidating comments or actions, fighting, smoking, drunkenness and throwing of any object in the arena will not be tolerated and can result in ejection, arrest and/or loss of ticket privileges. The UA reserves the right to remove the ticket holder from the premises if, in the sole discretion of security personnel, the ticket holder's conduct endangers or disrupts the environment. Everyone must have a ticket, regardless of age, to enter the arena. Per SEC rules, no re-entry is permitted at any door. All permissible bags will be searched at the door upon entering Barnhill Arena (please refer to the prohibited items list for types of non-permissible bags).

DOORS OPEN

Public doors open one hour (60 minutes) prior to the start of competition. The player pass gate, located at the lower south entrance opens 90 minutes prior to competition.

LOST CHILDREN

Parents/guardians with a lost child should contact the nearest event staff member for assistance.

LOST & FOUND

PARKING

PUBLIC PARKING

Public parking is very limited on campus prior to 5 p.m. on weekdays. However, parking is free in most lots after 5 p.m. Free parking is available in lot #44 north of Donald W. Reynolds Razorback Stadium on the corner of Maple and Stadium Drive and in all lots west of Razorback Road.

RESERVED PARKING

Certain parking lots are reserved on event days (see map below). Parking passes for Gymnastics meets at Barnhill Arena are available through the Razorback Foundation Priority Plan. For information about the Razorback Foundation, Inc., please go to www.razorbackfoundation.net.



ADA PARKING Disability parking with a state-issued hang tag is available in Lots #45, #59, #67 and the Meadow Street Parking Garage. These lots are located adjacent to Barnhill Arena. Please display your ADA parking hangtag to the parking attendant for access to any one of these lots.

RE-ENTRY POLICY

Once a guest leaves the arena, they will not be permitted back inside. This is a University of Arkansas and Southeastern Conference Policy and applies to every ticket holder. Guests should plan accordingly and bring everything they need to the arena upon initial entry.

RIDESHARE

The rideshare drop off and pick-up location is on Meadow Street in front of the Jones Student-Athlete Success Center.

SMOKING/TOBACCO FREE

The University of Arkansas campus is tobacco free. This means no cigarettes, e-cigarettes, pipes, cigars, dip or chew may be used anywhere on campus. Additionally, this includes no exiting the arena for tobacco use outside the stadium.

WILL CALL

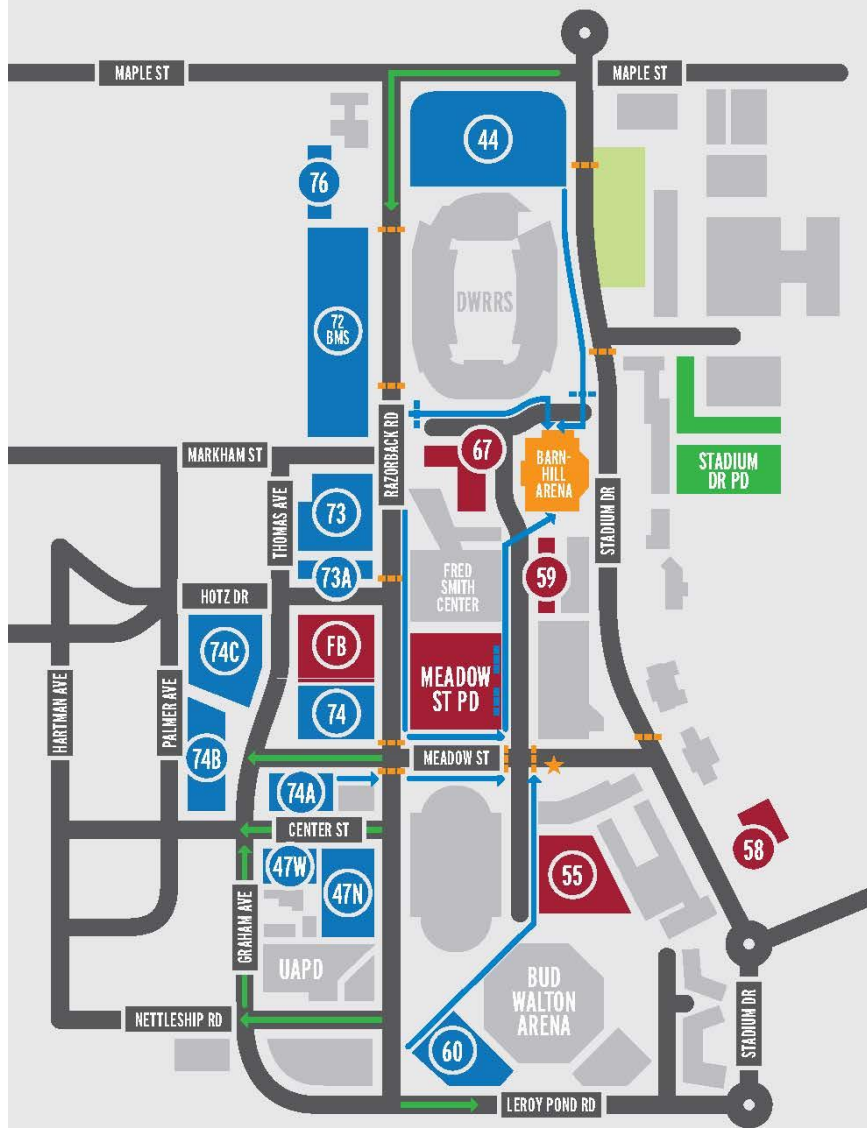
