No. 12 MIZZOU (6-1, 0-1) at ARKANSAS (9-0, 1-0)

STORYLINES

- Mizzou snapped a 7-game winning streak, its longest streak in the Cuonzo Martin era and longest since 2013-14, with its loss to No. 7 Tennessee on Wednesday night. Dec. 30 is the latest on the calendar Mizzou suffered its first loss in a season since Marcus Denmon and company led the 2011-12 team to a historic 30-5 campaign.
- The Tigers head to Fayetteville for the 52nd all-time meeting between Arkansas and Mizzou. The Tigers have faced the Razorbacks more than any SEC opponent, meeting 36 times before Mizzou became an official member of the Southeastern Conference.
- Mizzou has won three of the last five matchups with Arkansas, but the two squads tend to hold serve at home. Mizzou has won four straight in the series in Columbia and Arkansas has won six consecutive in Fayetteville. Mizzou is looking for its first win in Fayetteville since Jan. 28, 2014 and just its second win at Arkansas since 1991.
- Junior Xavier Pinson has a knack for big performances vs. Arkansas, racking up 58 combined points in four career games against the Razorbacks, including 19.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in the two meetings last season.
- During nonconference play, Mizzou knocked off both No. 21 Oregon and No. 6 Illinois, and had five wins over teams in KenPom's Top 125 (Liberty, Wichita State, Bradley). The last time a Mizzou team racked up at least two Top 25 wins & a true road victory during nonconference play came during the 2011-12 campaign.
- Mizzou is one of 11 teams nationally with a pair of wins over ranked opponents already.
- After its historic start, Mizzou checked in at No. 12 in the AP Top 25 poll on Dec. 28, its highest ranking since Jan. 7, 2013 (No. 10). When Mizzou cracked the Top 25 on Dec. 14, it marked the first time the Tigers had been ranked during the Martin era and the first time since the 2013-14 campaign. Mizzou was ranked as high as No. 7 during the 2012-13 campaign.
- Before the loss to Tennessee, Mizzou had collected its 17th 7-0 start in program history. Mizzou finished December 5-1 and improved to 20-3 in December during the Cuonzo Martin era.
- A key to Mizzou's early success has been experience. Martin's squad features one of the most experienced rosters in all of college basketball, returning 88.13 percent of its scoring from a season ago, which ranks third among all Power 5 conference teams, trailing only Texas and UCLA.
- The returners are responsible for 99.4 percent of Mizzou's points through three games. Seven Tigers are averaging 16 minutes or more thru four games, with six contributing at least 6.5 points on the young season.
- Mizzou's veteran squad has been good recently under Martin in bounce-back games, going 4-1 in its last five games coming off a loss.
- With freshman center 7-foot-3 Jordan Wilmore joining the squad, Mizzou enters the season with an average height of 6-foot-6. That makes the Tigers the SEC's tallest team in 2020-21 and the ninth-tallest team nationally.

• The Tigers are being recognized nationally for a hot start. Thus far, Martin was named National Coach of the Week, Mizzou was named National Team of the Week and Mark Smith and Dru Smith earned back-to-back SEC Player of the Week awards. The squad nabbed two straight SEC weekly honors for the first time since Feb. 2018.

THE BIG FELLA

- Senior **Jeremiah Tilmon** returns for a fourth season in Columbia after testing the NBA Draft waters over the summer. The seasoned big man has made 79 starts, played in 88 games and netted 781 points as a Tiger.
- Tilmon secured his seventh career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Bradley. He made the game-winning 3-point play with 1.0 second left, converting a tough bucket and draining a free throw to push the Tigers to a 1-point win. It was the first game-winning bucket of his career, including high school and childhood.
- Through seven games, Tilmon leads Mizzou in rebounding (7.3) and field goal percentage (.568). His rebounding average is a career-high thus far.
- He launched the 2020-21 campaign with a career-high 12 boards and eight points on 4-of-5 shooting vs. Oral Roberts. Tilmon then dominated the paint vs. No. 21 Oregon, scoring 11 points and snagging nine boards. He tallied eight points and nine boards vs. Liberty. He's grabbed 6+ boards in seven of the last eight games, averaging 7.5 in that span.
- Tilmon's 7.3 rebounds per game ranks eighth in the SEC. In his 15 career games with at least eight rebounds, Mizzou is 13-2.
- He chipped in nine points on 3-of-5 shooting vs. No. 7 Tennessee and recorded his 81st career block. With 81 career swats, he moved into sole possession of 10th all-time in program history, surpassing Ricardo Ratliffe on the blocks list. He's recorded at least one in 16 of his last 22 games.
- Tilmon is one of the nation's most efficient scorers, shooting 56.0 percent for his career, which ranks fourth all-time at Mizzou and 29th nationally among all active players. He shot 58.9 percent a season ago from the floor.

SMITH & SMITH: SEC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- Mizzou captured back-to-back SEC Player of the Week awards on Dec. 7 and Dec. 14 with senior guard Mark Smith getting the honor after lighting up Oregon and Wichita State and redshirt senior Dru Smith receiving the recognition after captaining Mizzou's wins over Liberty and Illinois. Before the two-week sweep, Mizzou hadn't had a Tiger win the award since Jeremiah Tilmon took it home on Dec. 24, 2018.
- Mark and Dru are responsible for 57 percent of Mizzou's made 3s, 37 percent of its scoring and 32 percent of its minutes played. At least one of them has scored in double digits in six of the last seven games during the win streak.
- Mark led Mizzou to a pair of wins over No. 21 Oregon at a neutral site and Wichita State on the road, averaging 17 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists while ripping the nets to the tune of 52.6 percent shooting from the field, 45.4 percent shooting from 3-point range and a perfect 9-of-9 clip at the foul line. Mark led the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage as a sophomore, and shot 37 percent from beyond the arc as a junior.
- Mark has made three or more 3-point buckets in 23 of his 50 appearances in a Mizzou uniform with the Tigers posting a 15-8 record in those games. Mark ranks third in the league in 3-point shooting, making 43.8 percent of his attempts. He is key to Mizzou's success. The Tigers went 8-3 when he reached double figures last season and are 4-0 this season.
- Dru Smith, a Preseason second-team All-SEC selection by both the league's coaches and the media, is one of the nation's best defenders. He's swiping 2.0 steals per game. He took a pair of charges and forced a steal in the final minutes vs. No. 6 Illinois, locking down Preseason All-American Ayo Dosunmu to seal the win.
- Dru has scored in double digits in five of seven games this season. He opened the campaign by stuffing the stat sheet vs. ORU with 16 points, six assists, five rebounds and four steals, shooting 5-of-9 from the field, then followed with three steals, 11 points, four boards and four assists in a team-high 31 minutes vs. No. 21 Oregon. Dru posted 14 points, four assists and two dimes at Wichita State. He added 14 points vs. Liberty and a team-high 18 points vs. Illinois.
- The redshirt senior point guard finished his first season as a Tiger in 2019-20 with 393 points, 131 boards, 121 assists and 64 steals. The last two SEC players to reach those marks in each category in the same campaign: Ben Simmons and John Wall. He became just the second SEC player since 1992 to average 12.7 points, 3.9 assists, 2.1 steals and 4.2 rebounds alongside Georgia's Kato Davis in 1995-96. His 64 steals led the SEC, ranked 20th nationally and sixth-best in a single-season at Mizzou. Dru's 2.1 steals per game clip currently ranks second all-time at Mizzou, trailing only Stefhon Hannah's 2.2.
- In his 88-game career, Dru has only gone two games without recording an assist, (Dec. 3, 2016), giving him a dime in 79 of the last 80 games. He's posted 49 multi-assist outings in his last 52 games. Dru has started 59-straight games including all 37 of his Mizzou career. Dru's 87.5 percent clip from the free throw line ranks 10th nationally among all active players.

X-FACTOR

- An electric playmaker, **Xavier Pinson** has averaged 17.4 points over his last 12 games while producing 10 double-figure scoring games in that span, four of which have been 20-point or better efforts after a 22-point outburst vs. No. 21 Oregon. Pinson erupted for 19 second-half points and finished with four rebounds and three dimes against the Ducks.
- Pinson's 162 career assists rank fifth among active SEC players. He grabbed a season-high seven boards vs. Liberty and leads all Mizzou guards with 25 for the season.
- Pinson's ability to attack the rim has led to a team-best 35 trips to the foul line, where he's made 80 percent of his attempts.
- Pinson enters his third season on campus after withdrawing his name from the NBA Draft pool at the end of the summer. The athletic guard averaged 11.1 points, 2.8 assists and 2.8 boards in 24 minutes as a sophomore. He launched the season with 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting vs. Oral Roberts, to go along with four assists. He's reached the 17-point mark eight times in his last 14 games, with Mizzou going 7-1 in those contests.
- To close the season in 2019-20, he scored 170 points in nine outings, including four 20+ point efforts, and at least 15 points in six of his final seven games. Mizzou closed the season 6-3 when Pinson was its leading scorer.

MIZZOU MADE IN THE NBA

- In June of 2018, Michael Porter, Jr., was selected 14th overall by the Denver Nuggets, becoming the Tigers' first NBA First-Round selection since DeMarre Carroll was taken 27th overall in 2009. Porter, Jr., was Mizzou's highest NBA Draft pick since Keyon Dooling was selected 10th by the Orlando Magic in 2000.
- Jordan Clarkson is averaging 14.8 points per game over his career, the highest average of any former Mizzou player. Clarkson put up 15.6 points per game in 2019-20 with the Utah Jazz. Former All-SEC forward Jontay Porter, who played for Cuonzo Martin, recently inked a 3-year, 6-million dollar deal with the Memphis Grizzlies, giving Mizzou three NBA pros.



BALANCED & DEEP

- Mizzou's veteran roster features three players with 700+ career points (Dru Smith, Jeremiah Tilmon and Drew Buggs) and five with 500+ career points (Smith, Tilmon, Buggs, Xavier Pinson and Mark Smith). Mizzou's 12-man roster features nine players with at least junior eligibility standing and one of the remaining three players entering his third season on campus in Parker Braun, making Mizzou the SEC's oldest team.
- Mizzou's returning core is responsible for 99.4 percent of Mizzou's points through seven games. Seven Tigers are averaging 16 minutes or more, with six contributing at least 6.5 points. Mizzou's veteran defense has been stifling as well, limiting opponents to just 26.4 percent shooting from beyond the arc, which leads the SEC.
- The Tigers were +16 on glass vs. Liberty, their largest rebound margin since a +17 advantage against Arkansas Feb. 8, 2020. Mizzou is 22-7 in Martin-era when holding a rebound advantage of +10 or more; including 10-2 over the last two seasons (2-0 in 2020-21, 8-2 in 2019-20). Illinois entered the Dec. 12 matchup second nationally in rebound margin at +22. Mizzou outrebounded the Illini by nine en route to its upset win.
- Mizzou has made at least one 3-point field goal in a school-record 417-consecutive games since an 0-for-10 effort at Kansas, Feb. 4, 2008. In fact, the Tigers have hit at least one trifecta in 944 of their last 946 outings (at KU in 2008, vs. Southern Cal in 1995), a run that started with their 1991 Big 8 Tournament championship win over Nebraska, and in 1,098 of 1,108 all-time games played since the 3-point shot was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- Over their last 14 games dating back to a 53.8 percent effort at the foul line in a four-point loss at No. 25 LSU a year ago, the Tigers have connected on 243-of-319 of their free throws since then. After shooting a school-record 78 percent from the charity stripe last season, Mizzou is shooting 72.7 percent this season. Mizzou made its first 16 free throws vs. Illinois.
- Coach Martin also bolstered his backcourt in the offseason with the addition of Hawaii transfer Drew Buggs, who set the Rainbow Warriors' all-time career assists record with 437 dimes. Buggs dished a season-high five assists with just one turnover vs. Liberty. He has multiple assists in three of six appearances. He came to Mizzou largely because he wants to coach for a living after college, and thought there was no one better to learn from than Cuonzo Martin. Martin said of Buggs "I wouldn't be surprised if he is someone's coach some day."

EMBRACING THE SIXTH MAN ROLE

- After starting 52 games through his first two campaigns, head coach Cuonzo Martin has asked junior **Javon Pickett** to come off the bench this season. Pickett, well-known for his relentless work ethic, has responded by becoming Mizzou's fifth-leading scorer with 7.4 points per game.
- Pickett trails only Tilmon on the team in field goal percentage, making 51.2 percent of his attempts, including a 20-for-33 effort from 2-point range. He finished with 14 points, on 6-of-8 shooting, vs. No. 6 Illinois. In three career games vs. the Illini, he's 3-0 while averaging 15.7 points and 5.0 rebounds and shooting 68.9 percent (20-of-29 FGs).
- Thru seven games, Pickett has produced three double-figure scoring efforts. Pickett had 11 points in 20 minutes vs. ORU in the season-opener, then netted 13 in 21 minutes against No. 21 Oregon before the season-high 14 points vs. Illinois. Mizzou is 10-1 over the last two seasons when Pickett scores in double figures.
- Fifth-year senior Mitchell Smith has also embraced coming off the bench, playing the fifth-most minutes on the team. He's chipping in 5.1 points and 5.7 rebounds (the third-most on the squad). Smith is the energy guy, who brings the emotion and has the ability to guard all five positions at 6-foot-10.
- Off the bench, Smith has grabbed at least six rebounds in four straight games and at least four boards in six straight games - the longest streak of his career.
- Smith grabbed a season-high nine rebounds and tallied a career-high three blocks in another steady performance vs. Bradley to help Mizzou claim the victory.
