## GAME 18

No. 10 MIZZOU (13-4, 6-4) vs. ARKANSAS (15-5, 7-4)

### STORYLINES

- Head coach Cuonzo Martin enters Saturday's matchup with Arkansas just one win shy of 250 career wins.
- Saturday is Mizzou's sixth annual #RallyForRhyhan game, benefiting pediatric cancer research. Mizzou is 5-0 all-time in Rally For Rhyhan games. The game started to help raise money for Rhyhan Loos, the daughter of former Mizzou assistant coach and now Assistant AD for Major Gifts, Brad Loos. Rhyhan was battling pediatric cancer at the time it started. Since its inception, Rhyhan has beaten cancer and is in remission! Coach Martin, the Loos family & Mizzou have chosen to continue the game and raise money for all children fighting pediatric cancer.
- In Mizzou's Jan. 2 victory over Arkansas, the Tigers earned just their second win in Fayetteville since 1991.
- Mizzou and Arkansas meet for the 53rd time in their program histories. The Tigers have faced the Razorbacks more than any more than any SEC opponent, meeting 36 times before Mizzou became an official member of the SEC.
- Mizzou has won four of the last six matchups with Arkansas. The Tigers are looking for their fifth consecutive win over the Razorbacks at Mizzou Arena.
- A win on Saturday would give Mizzou a regular season sweep of the Razorbacks for the first time since 2013-14 and just the second time in program history.
- The Tigers enter Saturday on the heels of a loss at Ole Miss. Mizzou hasn't lost back-to-back games all season and hasn't done so since Feb. 29 and March 4 of the 2019-20 campaign.
- Mizzou is one of eight teams nationally with five Quad 1 victories. Mizzou has three wins over Top 10 teams (No. 10 Alabama, No. 6 Tennessee, No. 6 Illinois) in the same season for the first time since 2011-12. The Tigers boast four ranked wins and four true road victories, and all four of their losses have come against Quad 1 opponents.
- From December of 2013 until Cuonzo Martin's first year at the helm, Mizzou hadn't beaten a ranked opponent in more than 1,500 days. Mizzou has four alone this season and the Tigers are 8-6 against ranked teams under Martin.
- Mizzou checks in at No. 10 in the AP Top 25 poll. That's the highest since Dec. 24, 2012, the highest ranking for any SEC team currently and gives Mizzou nine consecutive weeks in the Top 25 (the 14th-longest streak nationally).
- Mizzou is 5-0 in games decided by five or fewer points this season.
- Mizzou handed Alabama its first SEC loss of the season last Saturday and is now responsible for the Crimson Tide's last two league losses, including the 2019-20 season finale. In those two games, Alabama shot 30.4 percent and 33.3 percent, respectively - the two worst shooting performances of the Nate Oats era.
- After scoring 26 points vs. Kentucky, 16 against Alabama and 17 at Ole Miss, redshirt senior **Dru Smith** is on a tear, having reached double figures in nine consecutive games - the longest streak by a Tiger since Jordan Geist in 2018-19. A 10th consecutive game would mark the most since Kassius Robertson's 10-game streak in 2017-18. Dru's averaging 16.7 points per game in that span and earned his third SEC Player of the Week honor this season, the most by a Tiger in a campaign since Utah Jazz star Jordan Clarkson in 2013.
- In its 13 wins, Mizzou has averaged 76.8 points, while shooting 46.7 percent from the field.

## DYNAMIC POINT GUARD DUO

- After **Xavier Pinson** and **Dru Smith** scored 36 points and 10 points, respectively, vs. TCU, and followed with 14 points and 26 points vs. Kentucky, Mizzou improved to 7-1 this season when both players score in double figures.
- Dru, a Preseason second-team All-SEC selection by both the league's coaches and the media, is one of the nation's best defenders. He's leading the SEC during league play for the second consecutive campaign with 2.0 steals per game and his 2.1 steals per game over his time as a Tiger ranks second all-time at Mizzou. He is a three-time SEC Player of the Week after earning the award on Feb. 8 after adding 16 points and a season-high eight rebounds vs. No. 10 Alabama.
- His nine-game double-figure scoring streak, after posting 17 points on a career-high five 3-pointers at Ole Miss, is the longest since Jordan Geist's nine-game streak during the 2018-19 season. A 10th straight game Saturday would be the longest since Kassius Robertson scored 10+ in 10 straight games in 2017-18. Mizzou is 7-0 this season when he dishes at least four assists. He's the only Tiger with an assist in every game.
- Dru exploded for a season-high 26 points, helped by 12-of-14 free throws, vs. Kentucky. He finished with 26 points, seven rebounds, and five assists vs. the Wildcats, the first Tiger to reach all those numbers in the same game since DeMarre Carroll posted 31 points, nine boards and five dimes vs. Iowa State in 2009.
- Dru surpassed the 1,000-career point plateau with a season-best 21 points at Auburn. Dru leads Mizzou during 2020-21 with 14 double-figure scoring games. Since Feb. 8, 2020, Dru has scored in double figures in 21 of the last 26 games. Mizzou is 18-8 in that stretch which includes just four games against non-Power Conference teams.
- Dru tallied 16 points, six boards, six assists and four steals in one of the best all-around performances of his Tiger career at Texas A&M. He is the only Tiger in the last decade to hit all those marks in the same game. Dru followed with 16 on just six shots vs. South Carolina on Jan. 18. Only Dru, Jordan Geist, Keith Shamburger, Alex Oriakhi and Kim English have done that in a Mizzou uniform in the last decade. He chipped in 18 points and had zero turnovers at No. 6 Tennessee.
- In SEC play, Dru ranks sixth in free throw percentage (.853), first in steals (2.0) and 13th in scoring (15.2).
- The redshirt senior point guard finished his first season as a Tiger in 2019-20 with 393 points, 131 boards, 121 assists and 64 steals. The last two SEC players to reach those marks in each category in the same campaign: Ben Simmons and John Wall.
- In his 98-game career, Dru has only gone one game without recording an assist (Dec. 3, 2016), giving him a dime in 89 of the last 90 games. He's posted 88 multi-assist outings in his last 92 games. Dru has started 70-straight games including all 48 of his Mizzou career. Dru's 87.7 percent clip from the free throw line ranks 19th nationally among all active players.
- An electric playmaker, **Xavier Pinson** has averaged 15.7 points over his last 24 games while producing 17 double-figure scoring games in that span, seven of which have been 20-point or better efforts, after a career-high 36 points vs. TCU, a 22-point outburst vs. No. 21 Oregon, 23 points at Arkansas and 27 points at No. 6 Tennessee. The 27 points marked the most scored by an individual player against Tennessee all season. He scored his 23 points at Arkansas on just 11 field goal attempts, just the 10th different Tiger to do so in a game since 2010.
- Mizzou is 9-2 when Pinson scores in double figures and 10-2 when he dishes 2+ assists. In Mizzou's wins, Pinson is averaging 15.3 points and 3.1 assists.
- Pinson became just the 26th player nationally to score 36+ in a game this season. It's the most by any SEC player in 2020-21 and the most by any Tiger since Thomas Gardner dropped 40 on Kansas, on Jan. 16, 2006. Pinson hit a Mizzou Arena record-tying eight 3-pointers en route to the 36 points, including the game-tying three at the end of regulation. Pinson and Tilmon became the third SEC duo over the last 25 seasons with 30 points in the same game, joining Maxwell Evans and Saben Lee (Vanderbilt) in 2020 vs. LSU and Jodie Meeks and Patrick Patterson (Kentucky) in 2008 vs. Tennessee State.
- Pinson's ability to attack the rim, get fouled and convert at the foul line has been a weapon for Mizzou. Pinson has made 81 trips to the foul line, 19 more than any other Tiger guard. He's made 81.5 percent of his attempts this season. Pinson made 12-of-15 free throws at Arkansas, the most in a game by a Tiger this season. When Pinson has earned 10+ trips to the free throw line in a game in his career, Mizzou is 6-0.

## JEREMIAH TILMON: THE BEST BIG IN THE SEC

- Senior **Jeremiah Tilmon, Jr.**, has solidified himself as arguably the SEC's best center and one of nation's toughest matchups in the paint. During league play, he leads all SEC players in field goal percentage with a scalding .627 clip, leads all SEC centers in scoring at 13.6 PPG, ranks fourth in rebounds (7.5) and fifth in blocked shots (1.9).
- Defensively, Tilmon is a menace. Over the last eight games he has 21 blocks (2.8 per game), with 2+ blocks six times. The last Tiger to post multiple blocks in five straight games was Laurence Bowers, who did so in seven straight games during the 2010-11 campaign. Tilmon had a career-high six blocks at Auburn, the most by a Tiger since Ricardo Ratliffe on Jan. 22, 2011 vs. Iowa State. Tilmon is just the third Tiger since 2010 with six blocks in a single game.
- Offensively, Tilmon's career 57.4 percent clip is on pace for fourth all-time at Mizzou and his 62.7 percent clip this season ranks 10th in a single campaign in program history. The record is held by Ratliffe, who shot 69.3 percent in 2011-12.
- Tilmon returned for a fourth season in Columbia after testing the NBA Draft waters over the summer. The seasoned big man has made 91 starts, played in 98 games and netted 941 points as a Tiger. Tilmon had scored 16+ points just eight times in three seasons before this year. He did so five times in January.
- Tilmon put together a ridiculous performance vs. TCU on Jan. 30 in which he racked up a career-high 33 points on 13-of-16 shooting, 11 rebounds and three blocks. The 13 field goal makes marked the most by a Tiger since Michael Dixon's 13 field goals vs. William & Mary on Dec. 18, 2011. Tilmon is one of two players nationally this season with at least 33 points, 11 boards and three blocks in a single game alongside Kent State's Danny Pippen.
- Tilmon entered his senior campaign with six career double-doubles. He has six in the past 12 games after a 14-point, 10-rebound, three-block performance at Texas A&M, a 19-point, 10-rebound, three-block outing vs. South Carolina and a 21-point, 10-rebound, six-block output at Auburn. He is one of four players nationally with at least 21 points, 10 boards and six blocks in a game this season, and the only one in that group who also had multiple steals.
- Tilmon ranks eighth all-time in program history with 102 blocks.
- Tilmon went 8-for-11 vs. South Carolina. He added a career-best three steals during the dominant outing, becoming just the fourth Tiger with 18 points, three steals and three blocks in a game (Steve Stipanovich, Doug Smith twice & Ricky Frazier).
- Tilmon's six double-doubles is a career-high for him in a season, matching the most by a Tiger in a campaign since Jonathan Williams III had six double-doubles in 2014-15.
- Tilmon's team-best 7.8 rebounds per game clip ranks third in the SEC for all games and is the highest by a Tiger since Alex Oriakhi in 2012-13 (8.4). In his 22 career games with at least eight rebounds, Mizzou is 19-3. Mizzou is 12-2 this season when Tilmon grabs 5+ rebounds and 6-1 when he grabs 10+ boards.
- He's on pace to become the first Mizzou player in more than 30 years to shoot at least 54 percent in all four seasons.
- When Jeremiah scores at least 13 points, Mizzou is 19-6 in his career. When he reaches 16 points, Mizzou is 12-1.





DEEP ROTATION

- A key to Mizzou's success has been experience. Martin's squad features one of the most experienced rosters in all of college basketball, returning 88.13 percent of its scoring from a season ago, which ranks third among all Power 5 conference teams, trailing only Texas and UCLA. The returners are responsible for 98.0 percent of Mizzou's points through 17 games. Seven Tigers are averaging 19.5 minutes or more thru 17 games, with six contributing at least 6.8 points and four posting at least 10.1 points on the season. Four different Tigers have led Mizzou in scoring in a game this season.
- The roster features five players with 700+ career points (Dru, Jeremiah, Drew, Mark and Xavier) and six with 500+ career points (Smith, Tilmon, Buggs, Xavier Pinson, Mark Smith and Javon Pickett). Mizzou's 12-man roster features 10 players with at least junior (or redshirt sophomore) eligibility standing, making Mizzou the SEC's oldest team.
- Mizzou also has three players in Drew Buggs, Dru Smith and Xavier Pinson who have 200+ career assists.
- The Tigers also boast three players in the league's Top 11 in free throw percentage (Pinson, Dru Smith and Mark Smith).
- Sophomore Kobe Brown - the youngest rotation player Mizzou has - turned 21 on New Year's Day. Brown has been outstanding of late, grabbing a career-high 13 rebounds vs. TCU. That's the most rebounds by a Tiger this season and the most since Jontay Porter grabbed 13 at Ole Miss on Feb. 6, 2018. Brown ranks 17th in the SEC in rebounding with 5.8 boards per game in just 19.6 minutes per game. Kobe has 6+ rebounds in a game 15 times thus far during his career, and Mizzou is 11-4 in those games. Brown added 13 points and nine boards in 23 minutes vs. No. 10 Alabama. Mizzou is 3-0 this season when Brown scores in double figures and 9-1 when he grabs 6+ boards. Mizzou had four players with 8+ rebounds vs. Alabama, led by Brown. The last time the Tigers had four players with 8+ boards in the same game was 2004 vs. No. 21 UNLV.
- Coach Martin bolstered his backcourt in the offseason with the addition of Hawaii transfer Drew Buggs, who set the Rainbow Warriors' all-time career assists record with 437 dimes. Buggs dished a season-high five assists with just one turnover vs. Liberty and had four assists at Arkansas, becoming just the 16th active Division I player with 450+ assists. His 472 career assists rank 21st among all active players. Buggs scored a season-high six points in the Tigers' outing vs. South Carolina. His assist-to-turnover ratio is 3.6 (36 assists, 10 turnovers). Buggs has at least one assist in 15 of 17 games and 2+ dimes in 12 outings. Mizzou is 9-3 in those games.
- After starting 62 games through his first two campaigns, junior Javon Pickett made his first start of the season on Jan. 30 vs. TCU, scoring 11 points. Pickett, well-known for his relentless work ethic, has plays whatever role asked of him, becoming Mizzou's fifth-leading scorer with 7.5 points per game. Pickett trails only Tilmon on the team in field goal percentage, making 51.9 percent of his attempts, including a 46-for-83 (.556) effort from 2-point range. Since starting the campaign 1-for-11, he's made seven of his last 10 3-point attempts. He scored 10 points at Ole Miss & had 13 points at Auburn. Mizzou is 12-3 when he reaches double figures over the last two seasons. He finished with 14 points, on 6-of-8 shooting, vs. No. 6 Illinois. In three career games vs. the Illini, he's 3-0 while averaging 15.7 points and 5.0 rebounds and shooting 68.9 percent (20-of-29 FGs). Thru 16 games, Pickett has produced six double-figure scoring efforts. Pickett had 11 points in 20 minutes vs. ORU in the season-opener, then netted 13 in 21 minutes against No. 21 Oregon before the season-high 14 points vs. Illinois.
- Fifth-year senior Mitchell Smith has also embraced coming off the bench, playing the fifth-most minutes on the team. He's chipping in 4.2 points and 4.9 rebounds (the third-most on the squad). Smith is the energy guy, who brings the emotion and has the ability to guard all five positions at 6-foot-10. He posted a career-high 12 rebound performance vs. Kentucky. He is the third different Tiger to snag 12+ boards in game alongside Tilmon and Brown. Then he followed with a game-winning block vs. No. 10 Alabama and finished with six points, eight boards and two blocks. Mizzou is 8-1 when he grabs 5+ rebounds this season and 7-1 when he contributes 5+ points.

THE CUONZO MARTIN ERA

- In the previous three seasons before Cuonzo's arrival, Mizzou won 27 total games, 0 against ranked teams and 0 true road games. Seventeen games into his fourth season on campus, Martin has won 63 total games, eight against ranked opponents and racked up 13 true road wins. He is one win shy of 250 for his career.
- He and the Tigers are being recognized nationally this season. Thus far, Martin was named National Coach of the Week, Mizzou was named National Team of the Week and Mark Smith and Dru Smith have earned four combined SEC Player of the Week awards (Dru 3, Mark 1) The squad nabbed two straight SEC weekly honors for the first time since Feb. 2018.
- Cuonzo was of 10 coaches named to the NCAA's Midseason National Coach of the Year Watch List on Jan. 25.
- Cuonzo's squad hasn't lost two consecutive games since February of last season and hasn't lost a game decided by two possessions or less since last season.
- Mizzou improved to 27-0 in the Cuonzo Martin era when holding opponents to 59 or fewer points after limiting Texas A&M to a season-low 52 points on Jan. 16.
- Mizzou is continuing its reputation of tough, hard-nosed defense under Martin. Through 17 games, Mizzou opponents are making just 6.5 3-pointers per game the fewest among the 12 SEC teams that have played at least 17 games.
- Mizzou held Arkansas to season-lows for points scored (68) and field goal percentage (.268); the Tigers have held five opponents to a season-low point total (ORU, at Wichita State, Liberty, at Arkansas, at Texas A&M) and their defense has held the opponent to a season-low shooting from the floor four times (at WSU, Liberty, at Arkansas, Alabama).
- The Tigers have held their foe to 79 or fewer points in 21 of the last 24 games & in 43 of its last 48 overall. LSU (82), Alabama (88), Auburn (88), TCU (98) and Ole Miss (80) are the only teams to score more than 79 points against the Tigers in the last 48 games, and everyone but TCU did so on their home floors.
- Mizzou held Arkansas to its worst shooting game ever at Bud Walton Arena at 26.8 percent in the Tigers' 81-68 win on Jan. 2. It marked the worst shooting game for a Tiger opponent in a conference game since Georgia shot just 25.5 percent from the floor in a 64-39 Mizzou win at Athens, March 6, 2019.
- Mizzou is also cleaning up on the glass, thanks in large part to Jeremiah Tilmon, Jr. Mizzou is 10-0 this season and 49 of the Tigers' 63 wins during the Martin-era have come when they have won the rebounding battle.

## MIZZOU MADE IN THE NBA

- In June of 2018, Michael Porter, Jr., was selected 14th overall by the Denver Nuggets, becoming the Tigers' first NBA First-Round selection since DeMarre Carroll was taken 27th overall in 2009. Porter, Jr., was Mizzou's highest NBA Draft pick since Keyon Dooling was selected 10th by the Orlando Magic in 2000.
- Jordan Clarkson is averaging 14.8 points per game over his career, the highest average of any former Mizzou player. Clarkson put up 15.6 points per game in 2019-20 with the Utah Jazz. he's averaging 17.8 per game this season, which is the highest among any 6th man in the Western Conference. Clarkson also surpassed the 7,000-career point mark this season. Former All-SEC forward Jontay Porter, who played for Cuonzo Martin, recently inked a 3-year, 6-million dollar deal with the Memphis Grizzlies, giving Mizzou three NBA pros.
- Mizzou also has a host of former Tigers overseas, including a trio of recent graduates under Martin - Jordan Barnett, Jordan Geist and Kassius Robertson. Barnett and Geist are both in Germany and Robertson is a standout in Spain.
