RAIDERS HEADED TO NCAA TOURNAMENT FOURTH TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Colgate Men's Basketball is in the midst of its best stretch in program history. The Raiders are the first team in Patriot League history to reach four straight championship games and punched their ticket to their second NCAA tournament in three years with an 85-72 win over Loyola in the title game. The win marked Colgate's 13th straight, a program record for longest winning streak in school history. Head Coach Matt Langel became the first coach in Patriot League history to win three consecutive Coach of the Year awards in 2019 after guiding the Raiders to a program-record 25 wins and second consecutive regular season title. Over the last four years, Langel and the Raiders have a +47 in win/loss differential.

BURNS COLGATE'S SECOND PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN THREE YEARS

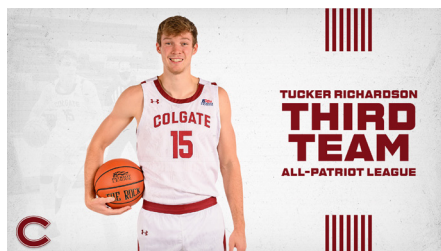
Jordan Burns is the second player in Patriot League history with 1,600 points and 400 assists. He is Colgate's second Player of the Year in the last three years (Ivanauskas, 2019). The San Antonio sharpshooter has quite the collection of hardware, starting with All-Rookie honors and second team recognition as a sophomore. Back-to-back first team selections were topped off with this year's top honor. And don't forget his Patriot League tournament MVP trophy after blitzing Bucknell with 35 points in the 2018-19 championship.

**CUMMINGS ONLY JUNIOR TO LAND ALL-LEAGUE SECOND TEAM HONORS**

Cummings was named to the second team with eight games in double figures this season. He matched his career high in the season opener with 24 points against Army on Jan. 2, connecting on 9-of-13 from the floor with four made 3-pointers. This is the first postseason honor for Cummings, who came to Colgate in 2018-19 after spending his freshman year at Bowling Green. The junior guard is hitting on 51% of his shots from the field en route to 13.0 points per game. Cummings has paced Colgate in scoring four times this season.

**2018-19 ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RETURNS TO ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE HONORS**

Tucker Richardson returned to All-Patriot League form with third team laurels. The 2018-19 Rookie of the Year leads the team with a +18 efficiency rating per game and is averaging 11 points and six rebounds per game. He has posted three double-doubles with eight games in double-figure scoring. Richardson ranks third in the Patriot League in assists per game (4.3). The Flemington, New Jersey product was just shy of a triple-double in Colgate's win over Boston U (2/20), finishing with a season-high 17 points, 10 rebounds, and 10 assists.

**WOODWARD RISES TO ALL-ROOKIE TEAM**

Jeff Woodward becomes Colgate's sixth straight All-Rookie selection under 10th year head coach Matt Langel. The 6-11 big man has shined off the bench this season, averaging over eight points, four rebounds, and two assists per contest. Woodward turned it on down the stretch of the regular season, reaching double figures in each of the last five games. Woodward posted a season-high 15 points against Boston University (2/20) to earn Patriot League Rookie of the Week honors. The Audubon, Pennsylvania native joins Malcolm Regisford, Will Rayman, Jordan Burns, Tucker Richardson, and Keegan Records on the list of consecutive All-Rookie Raiders.

SETTING THE SCENE

The 14th-seeded Colgate Raiders make their fourth NCAA tournament appearance when they tussle with #10 Arkansas in the first round on Friday. Colgate is the first team in Patriot League history to reach four consecutive championship games and punched their ticket to their second title in the last three years with an 85-72 win over Loyola on Sunday. Colgate carries a 13-game winning streak into the Big Dance, good for the third-longest win streak in the country. The Razorbacks had won nine in a row before falling to LSU in the SEC semifinals. Friday's first round bout is the first meeting between the two programs.

WE SEE THE SEC

Colgate is dancing for the second time in three years, and once again the Raiders face an SEC foe in the first round of the NCAA tournament. In 2019, the 15th-seeded Raiders took Tennessee to the limit in a narrow 77-70 decision. Jordan Burns earned a CBS Shining Moment after connecting on eight treys and pouring in 32 against the Vols. The Raiders are 3-7 all-time against the SEC, with two of those wins against Tennessee. Colgate's last win over an SEC foe came in 1995, a 53-51 victory over Ole Miss. The Patriot League is 1-4 in five March Madness meetings against SEC opponents. Bucknell defeated Arkansas 59-55 in the first round of the 2006 tournament.

EVERYBODY'S NET DARLING

Colgate has turned a lot of heads with its NET ranking, checking in at No. 9 this week. The Raiders were posted up at a season-best eighth before Selection Sunday. Colgate has been ranked in the top 20 all season. The NET rankings, introduced in 2018-19, are determined by using a formula that takes into account who teams beat and lose to, where those games take place (home, away, neutral location) and how well teams play against given opponents.

RED-HOT RAIDERS

The Raiders roll into Indy with the third-longest win streak in the country. Since its only loss of the season on Jan. 2, Colgate rattled off 13 straight wins, breaking the 2018-19 squad's 11-game winning streak that carried into the NCAA tournament first round matchup with Tennessee. Only Gonzaga (21) and San Diego State (14) enter the tournament with longer winning streaks. Colgate connected on 50% (96-191) from the field in the Patriot League tournament and set a tournament scoring record with 105 points in the semifinal win over Bucknell, breaking its own record of 104 against Army in 1997.

14 CAN BE LUCKY, TOO

It's well known that Colgate's lucky number is 13. The Raiders' 13th straight win was a 13-point victory over Loyola in the championship last Sunday. But can 14 be the lucky number this time? The 14th seed is the highest in four trips to the Dance for the Raiders, who look to become the first 14-3 upset since Stephen F. Austin over West Virginia in 2016. The longest drought without a 14-3 upset since the tournament expanded in 1985 is four years (2000-04). Oddly enough, it was a PL team to end that gap with Bucknell's 64-63 stunner over Kansas in 2005. No. 14 seeds are 21-119 all-time in the tournament.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Colgate storms into the NCAA tournament ranked 2nd in the country in scoring (86.3). The Raiders broke their own Patriot League tournament scoring record with 105 points in this year's semifinal victory over Bucknell. The previous record was 104 in the Raiders' first round win over Army in 1997. Colgate's +17.7 scoring margin is 4th best in the land.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Paired with one of the best offensive units in the country, Colgate's defense has been just as good. The Raiders' 26.1 3-point field goal percentage defense is tops in the country and they rank 3rd nationally in defensive rebounds, averaging 30.0 per game.

40-POINT BURSTS

Colgate has beaten three teams by 40 points or more this season - all three opponents in the Patriot League North Division. The Raiders bested Army and Boston U by 44 points each, and then topped Holy Cross by 40 in Hamilton. All three margins were Colgate's largest ever against each opponent.

BEASTS ON THE BACKCOURT

It's no surprise that Colgate's strengths are built on its veteran backcourt. All three All-Patriot League guards in Jordan Burns, Nelly Cummings, and Tucker Richardson are averaging double-figures, led by Player of the Year Burns' 17.0 points per game. Plus Jack Ferguson comes off the bench and sits second on the team in scoring (12.6). Those same four players all rank inside the top 30 in the Patriot League in scoring. Each player has been Colgate's leading scorer in at least one game this season.

DISHING THE ROCK

Colgate ranks 7th in the nation in assists per game (17.7), racking up double-digit dimes in all but two games this season, including five games with at least 20. The Raiders had four total games with 20 or more assists in 2019-20. Colgate's 1.75 assist-turnover ratio is 2nd best in the country behind Iowa's 2.1 clip.

BURNS CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Jordan Burns is already Colgate's all-time assists leader and is the only player to rank in the top 10 in scoring, assists and steals. He sits fifth in scoring, first in assists, fifth in 3-point field goals made, and eighth in steals. Burns is the second player in Patriot League history with 1,500 points and 400 assists.

RICHARDSON FILLS STAT SHEETS

It's clear Tucker Richardson makes the team better when he's on the court. He leads the squad with a +198 rating this year. That's an average of +15 per game. Richardson leads the squad with three double-doubles and was just shy of a triple-double against Boston U (2/20), finishing with a season-high 17 points, 10 rebounds, and eight assists.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Colgate has had six different leading scorers in a game this season. The Raiders carried their way through the Patriot League tournament with a different leading scorer in each round, including Keegan Records' career-high 21 in the semifinals.

THE LANGEL EFFECT

Head Coach Matt Langel has the Raiders in the midst of their best run in 121 years of Colgate Basketball. Langel in 2020 became the first coach in Patriot League history to earn three straight Coach of the Year awards. The 10th-year head coach guided Colgate to program-record win totals in three consecutive seasons from 2017-20, including the program's first two 20-win campaigns in 2018-19 and 2019-20. Over the last three seasons, Langel and the Raiders have a +47 win differential.

ROAD WARRIORS

Colgate posted a perfect 6-0 record away from home this season. The Raiders are one of three teams in the nation to be perfect with at least six tries on the road. In those road games, Colgate averaged 84 points per game with a 16.5 scoring margin.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

It's clear that Colgate enjoys the friendly confines of Cotterell Court. The Raiders are 8-1 in Hamilton this season, averaging 88.4 points per game with a +19.3 scoring margin in the eight home games. Over the last three seasons, Colgate is 38-4 at home.

RECORDS ON THE RISE

Keegan Records shined in the Patriot League tournament, averaging 13.3 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. The sophomore big man poured in a career-high 21 points in Colgate's 105-75 win over Bucknell in the semifinals last Wednesday.

BURNS STRIKES LUCKY NO. 13 IN OT

Jordan Burns shined when the lights were brightest, scoring all of Colgate's 13 points in overtime at Holy Cross on Jan. 30. He outscored the Crusaders 13-2 himself to lead Colgate to a 74-63 road victory. This came after Holy Cross scored the last six points in regulation, including the game-tying layup that sent the game to overtime with two seconds left.

FERGUSON HAS BIG DAY AGAINST CRUSADERS

Jack Ferguson scored 21 of his career-high 24 points in the second half to help lead Colgate to a 96-87 victory over Holy Cross on Jan. 17. Ferguson's 24 points came on 6 of 9 shooting from the field and 4 of 6 from behind the arc. The senior guard stuffed the stat sheet, adding four rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks.

CUMMINGS MATCHES CAREER HIGH VS ARMY

Nelly Cummings matched his career high with 24 points in Colgate's season-opening 101-57 win over Army on Jan. 2. He was 9 of 13 from the field and 4 of 6 from downtown in the triumph. Cummings has posted 24 points twice in a Raider uniform, both times against Army.

LANGEL LAUDED WITH HONORS

Head Coach Matt Langel was named one of the Top 40 Rising Head Coaches by Silver Waves Media. No head coach in Patriot League men's basketball history had won three consecutive Coach of the Year honors until Langel was recognized with the league's top honor in 2020.

ASSISTANT RECOGNITION

Assistant Coach Dave Klatsky was tabbed by Silver Waves Media as one of the top 50 low-major assistant coaches in 2020. Klatsky, in his 10th season at Colgate, was also voted by his peers as the top assistant in the Patriot League this past season in a report by Stadium analyst Jeff Goodman.

THE PENN PIPELINE

Colgate has three members of its coaching staff from Penn. Langel (2000), Dave Klatsky (2003) and Trice (1995) are all former standouts. Langel and Klatsky led the 1999-2000 Quakers to a perfect 14-0 league record, an Ivy League title and NCAA Tournament appearance. Trice played a key part in three straight undefeated Ivy League seasons from 1992-95.

2020-21 PATRIOT LEAGUE FORMAT

The 10 Patriot League teams are divided into three regional mini-conferences, with teams playing four games against each regional opponent. Colgate's mini-conference is made up of Army, Boston U, and Holy Cross, meaning the Raiders play four games (two home, two away) against those opponents.

COLGATE'S LUCKY NUMBER 13

Unlike the common stigma, Colgate considers 13 to be its lucky number. Colgate was founded by 13 men on \$13 with 13 articles and 13 prayers. The University celebrates Colgate Day every Friday the 13th. The 13 stripes pay homage to those student-athletes who have come before us, and who earned their stripes competing for championships.

CHANGE MORE THAN JUST THE GAME

CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP VS. LOYOLA [FEB. 16, 2021]

HAMILTON – Colgate captured its second Patriot League Men's Basketball Championship in the last three seasons with an 85-72 victory over Loyola here Sunday afternoon.

The Raiders with their 13th consecutive victory improved to 14-1 on this Covid-shortened season and head to Indianapolis for the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship, which begins Friday. All 67 games of this year's tournament are taking place in Indianapolis, and the Raiders departed immediately after the game.

Jordan Burns scored 14 of his 16 points in the second half en route to MVP honors of this event for the second time in his career. Tucker Richardson paced Colgate with 17 points and Jack Ferguson added 16, with Ryan Moffatt scoring 11 and Nelly Cummings 10.

Colgate never trailed in the game after Richardson struck for a pair of threes and a 6-0 cushion. But Santi Aldama's answer from long range and then a three-point-play from Jaylin Andrews pulled Loyola within 9-8 at the first media timeout.

Ferguson's 3-pointer pushed the Raiders to an 18-10 lead before Isaiah Hart halted a three-minute Loyola drought with a jumper.

Then it was Colgate's turn for a mini-drought, this one covering nearly three minutes in return before Ferguson finally swished it to a close with a 3-ball from top of the key that kept the Raiders in front 21-17.

Consecutive driving layups from Richardson and Jeff Woodward lifted Colgate back to a 29-21 advantage. Then when Richardson swished from the left corner, Colgate had its largest lead of the half at 32-23 with 3:28 showing.

After Burns scored his first points of the night on a driving layup inside the final minute, Loyola sank three free throws to pull within 38-33 at intermission.

All that was missing were more contributions from Burns and Cummings, and as if on cue those came right out of the break.

First Cummings cashed a pair from long range and then Burns did the same – both buckets their first treys of the night – and Colgate went in front 52-41 with 15:32 showing for its first double-digit advantage of the game.

Moffatt's 3-pointer from the corner handed Colgate a 65-48 cushion with 10:47 remaining, but Loyola kept fighting. It wasn't until Cummings swished a fast-break 3-pointer, was fouled and sank the free throw that Colgate led 78-62 with 4:52 and finally had some breathing room.

Burns found Records for a contested layup and the Colgate margin was 80-62 with 3:14 until the finish.

The Raiders maintained their composure, milked the clock and rode off toward their 13th straight victory and second Patriot League championship in the last three seasons.

BUILDING A WINNING CULTURE

Matt Langel continues to establish a winning tradition for a Colgate Basketball program that is competing for Patriot League championships.

Since arriving in Hamilton in 2011, Langel has mentored two Patriot League Players of the Year, two Patriot League Defensive Players of the Year, two Patriot League Rookies of the Year, 20 All-Patriot League picks, six Patriot League All-Rookie selections, four All-District honorees, and an AP All-American honorable mention.

Entering his 10th season as the head coach of the Raiders in 2020-21, Langel is already the second winningest head coach in Colgate men's basketball history. With his recent accomplishments, Langel has elevated to uncharted territory in Colgate men's basketball history.

INSPIRING GREATNESS

No head coach in Patriot League men's basketball history had earned three consecutive Coach of the Year awards until Langel was honored with the league's top honor for the third year in a row in 2020. That came on the heels of another historic season, which saw Colgate set program records in total wins (25), league wins (14), and home victories (15).

Colgate is 68-34 (.667) over the last three seasons, including a 39-15 record (.722) in Patriot League play. The Raiders have finished in the top two of the Patriot League standings in four of the last six seasons, including back-to-back first place productions in 2018-19 and 2019-20 and two-second place postings.

Since 2017, Colgate ranks No. 1 in the Patriot League in total wins (68), Patriot League wins (39), Patriot League championship appearances (3) and regular season titles (2). The Raiders during that time have set school records for wins, league victories, and home triumphs in three straight seasons.

Colgate rewarded head coach Matt Langel with back-to-back contract extensions in 2018 and 2019 and he is now under contract through the 2026-27 season.

NEXT LEVEL PREPARATION

The success has continued beyond collegiate basketball, evident by the development of nearly 20 professional players, including recent graduates Will Rayman '20, Francisco Amiel '19, Jordan Swopshire '18, Jordan Robertson '18 and Sean O'Brien '18.

BEYOND THE COURT

Colgate's long tradition as one of the top academic universities in the country is proven year after year with the NCAA unveiling of Graduation Success Rates (GSR) and Academic Progress Rates (APR). Colgate's GSR is annually over 95%, ranking alongside the top schools in the nation. In 2019-20, Colgate's APR rating of 86% placed second nationally. Men's basketball was one of 19 programs to earn public recognition for its multiyear APR scores.

COLLEGE PLAYING CAREER

A 2000 graduate of Penn's Wharton School of Business, Langel helped lead the Quakers to two Ivy League titles and NCAA Tournament appearances during his four-year playing career (1996-2000). The Quakers went 27-1 in Ivy League action in his junior and senior campaigns and sported a 42-14 overall record. Langel was named Ivy League and Big Five Player of the Week numerous times and received the Big Five's Most Improved Player Award.

Langel etched his name in the Penn record books in several different categories. He is a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,191 points in a Red and Blue uniform. He stands second all-time in Penn basketball history in three-pointers made in a game with eight, is eighth in three-pointers made in a season with 70, and fourth in career three-pointers made with 201.

PROFESSIONAL PLAYING CAREER

Langel after graduation was drafted by Atlantic City of the USBL in 2000 and worked out in the Seattle SuperSonics camp. He then went overseas to play professionally in Europe, for Chene BC in Switzerland and ALM Evreux Basket in France.

The Moorestown, N.J., native participated in the Philadelphia 76ers summer camp in 2001, but returned to Europe to play for the MBC and Hagan in German Bundesliga I. His last professional stop before returning to Penn as an assistant coach was with the Eiffel Towers in Holland.

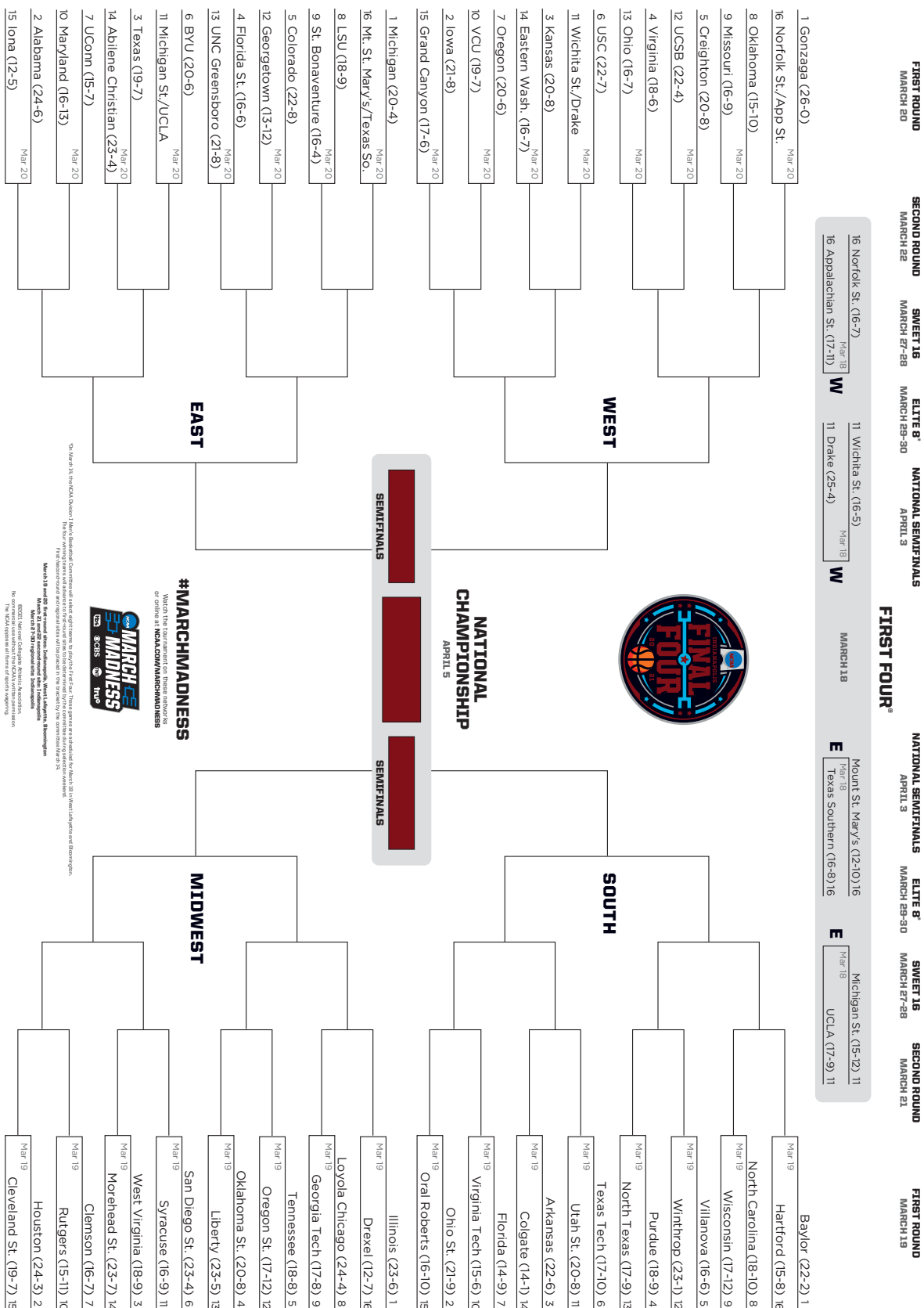
