RAZORBACKS TO HOST 2ND ANNUAL BLESSINGS COLLEGIATE INVITATIONAL OCT. 4-6

- Arkansas will once again host **THE MOST UNIQUE** collegiate golf tournaments this fall - the Blessings Collegiate Invitational, presented by Tyson Foods, Oct. 4-6 at Blessing Golf Club - home of the Razorback men's and women's golf programs.
- For the second consecutive year, GOLF Channel will televise the event live each day from 3:30-6:30 pm (CT).
- The Blessings Collegiate Invitational is a 54-hole stroke play competition, with the men's and women's teams competing on the same course, at the same time and in the same conditions throughout the week. At the end of the competition there will be six champions declaring including men's individual, women's individual, men's team, women's team, man/woman "best ball" and men's/women's combined team.
- **The 2021 field includes Arizona, Arkansas, Houston, Illinois, Louisville, North Carolina, Ole Miss, Tennessee, Texas Tech and UCLA.**
- Last year due to COVID-19, the inaugural BCI featured all 14 SEC teams. Winners included: Alabama men; Alex Goff (Kentucky) men's medalist; Arkansas women; Brooke Matthews (Arkansas) women's medalist; Arkansas won the men's/women's combined team and Arkansas' Matthews and Julian Perico won the men's/women's "best ball."

- ^ **2021 RUNNER-UP:** Arkansas was the 5th seed and: beat #4 seed and 23rd-ranked LSU (3-2) in the quarters beat #8 seed and 11th-ranked Texas A&M (3-1) in the semis lost to #6 seed and #15 Vanderbilt (3-2) in the championship

• ARKANSAS HAD THREE INDIVIDUAL MEDALISTS IN 2020-21:

- ^ Julian Perico won the Vanderbilt Legends Collegiate Invitational - an SEC only field
 - Shot 64-66-69 for a 199, the 2nd-best 54-hole score in school history
 - Perico owns the school record with a 197 winning score as a freshman at Alabama's Jerry Pate National.
- ^ Tyson Reeder was co-medalist at Auburn's Tiger Invitational by Jason Dufner.
 - Shot rounds of 67-69-70 for a 206 to tie Georgia's Davis Thompson
- ^ Segundo Oliva Pinto won the SEC Championship (-6) by two strokes and was 1 of 4 under par.

• BEST 2-IRON IN COLLEGE GOLF THIS SEASON? AND CAME IN NASHVILLE:

- ^ Speaking of Julian Perico's win this year - versus an SEC-only field - at Vandy's Legends Collegiate.
- ^ Perico may have hit the best 2-iron in college golf to win the tournament.
- ^ For the second time in three days, Perico eagled the par-5, 18th. The latter clinched the title as he was able to hold off Vanderbilt's John Augenstein (then #18 in the World Amateur Golf Ranking) and defeated Georgia's Davis Thompson (then #3 in the WAGR) by three strokes.
- ^ Perico was tied with clubhouse leader Alex Goff (Kentucky) - winner of the Blessings Collegiate Invitational earlier in the year - going into the final hole. **Perico launched a 2-iron WITH THE BALL SITTING ON THE CART PATH for his second shot on the 527-yard, par-5 18th hole and reached the green in two. He then sank a 20-foot putt to get to -14 and hold the clubhouse lead.**
- ^ From there it was a waiting game as Augenstein was still on the course in striking distance with two holes to play. Augenstein came to 18 at -12 but had to settle for a birdie and finished in second. Smith birdied 17 to get to -12 with the reachable 18th remaining. However, Smith took a par and tied for third with Goff.

• JULIAN + MANUEL = SEGUNDO

- ^ Julian Perico and Segundo Oliva Pinto are longtime friends. In fact, the two played together in the final round of the 2020 Latin America Amateur Championship. Perico finished T-6 and Oliva Pinto was T-8.
- ^ With Arkansas' success at the Latin America Amateur Championship (including 2019 champion Alvaro Ortiz), head coach Brad McMakin was able to attract Manuel Lozada. Lozada and Oliva Pinto are both from Cordoba, Argentina.
- ^ With his previous friendship with Perico and Lozada committing to Arkansas, Oliva Pinto's decision to join the Razorbacks was easy.

• LOZADA HAS ONLY PLAYED COMPETITIVE GOLF FOR THREE YEARS NOW:

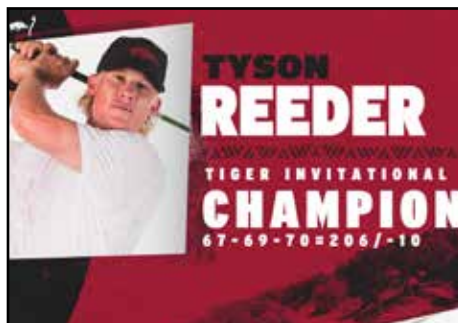
- ^ Manuel Lozada grew up hoping to be a professional soccer player. While he played golf growing up, it was not his primary focus until he realized he wasn't going to be a footballer.
- ^ However, once he did start playing golf seriously, Lozada quickly became one of the top junior golfers in Argentina. He was on the Argentina National Team for the 2020 South American Championship, was seventh on the Argentina Association of Golf (AAG) national amateur ranking and was the top-ranked amateur and junior golfer in Cordoba.

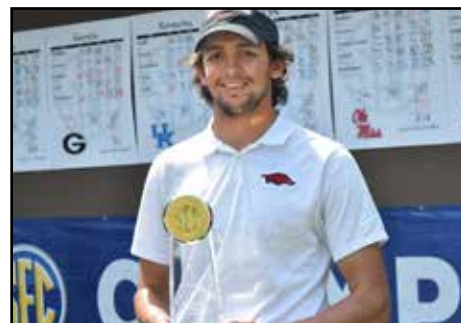

TYSON REEDER was co-medalist at the Tiger Invitational for his second career win. He was also SEC co-Golfer of the Week, the first Razorback to earn the league's weekly honor since March of 2018.



SEGUNDO OLIVA PINTO is the third Razorback to be SEC Champion. His 204 was the second-best score by a Razorback in school history at the SEC's and his 6-under was the third-best in relation to par.



PERICO TO PLAY IN 2021 PALMER CUP

- Arkansas junior Julian Perico is one of 12 to be selected to play for the International Team at the 2021 Arnold Palmer Cup, it was announced on May 4 by the Golf Coaches Association of America. The 25th annual event is set for June 11-13 and will be played at Rich Harvest Farms (Ill.).
- Perico will be the **fourth Razorback from the men's program** to play in the Palmer Cup, the **first player from Peru** and just the **third from South America**.
- Previous Razorbacks include:
 - 2010: David Lingmerth (Sweden) for Team Europe.
 - 2011-12-13: Sebastian Cappelen (Denmark) for Team Europe.
 - 2018: Alvaro Ortiz (Mexico) for Team International.
- The Arkansas women's program in the Palmer Cup: **Maria Fassi** (Mexico in 2018), **Alana Urieli** (USA in 2018), **Dylan Kim** (USA in 2018 and 2019), **Kaylee Benton** (USA in 2019) and **Brooke Matthews** (USA in 2021).
- Previous South Americans in the Palmer Cup include:
 - 2019: Ivan Ramirez (Colombia and Texas Tech)
 - 2020: Sofia Garcia (Paraguay and Texas Tech)
- This year will mark the fourth Arnold Palmer Cup to be held under the expanded format to include men's and women's USA collegiate golfers against their counterparts from around the world.
- This is the second time the Palmer Cup has been played at Rich Harvest Farms with the other coming in 2015. The site also hosted the **2017 NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Golf Championships** when then Razorback freshman **Mason Overstreet** was the national runner-up.

- Arkansas not only hosted two of the toughest collegiate events, it played one of the nation's toughest schedules.
 - ^ Three fall events consisted of SEC only programs due to COVID-19 restrictions.
 - ^ The spring events were more mixed but still had a strong SEC flavor to minimize travel.
- WITH THAT, ARKANSAS PLAYED THE FIFTH-TOUGHEST SCHEDULE IN THE NATION.**
 - ^ The Razorbacks were 17-37 vs the Top 25, 49-50-2 vs the Top 50 and 70-51-2 vs the Top 100
 - ^ The fall season did not have Golfstat rankings, but as mentioned, each of the three fields were SEC only programs
 - ^ The first spring rankings took affect for the Razorbacks' own CABO COLLEGIATE with 12 of the 16 teams ranked among the nation's top 35, including five top 10 teams.
 - ^ The next three events Arkansas played featured 11 of the 15 teams in the top 50; 9 of the 14 teams in the top 50 and 13 of the 14 teams in the top 50. Of course, the SEC's 14-team field for the championship featured 13 of the nation's top 50.

BOUNCE BACK AFTER BENCHING

- Arkansas was without William Buhl in the fall and has seen three other of its NCAA golfers not make the top five at various points.
 - ^ **Julian Perico** is the only Razorback to make the team lineup in all nine events this season.
 - ^ **William Buhl** has made the lineup in all six spring events, missing the three fall events.
- TYSON REEDER** was left off the Razorbacks second trip of the fall - Vanderbilt's Legends Collegiate. He bounced back with a 19th-place finish at the fall finale Jerry Pate National.
 - ^ **Had the team's best spring scoring average (71.28) and was medalist at the Tiger Invitational.**
- MANUEL LOZADA** made the trip to all nine Razorback events, but only played as part of the lineup five times. He only played as an individual in the first four spring events, placing 111th, 79th, 83rd and 33rd.
 - ^ **That final placing got him back into the lineup for the regular-season finale (The Collegiate Invitational) and he responded by tying for sixth and earning SEC Freshman of the Week honors.**
- SEGUNDO OLIVA PINTO** was benched for the regular-season finale after posting spring finishes of 57th, 65th, 56th and 62nd.
 - ^ **However, he responded by qualifying for the SEC Championship - an event a won.**
- Alternate **Mason Overstreet** missed the season opener due to illness. He missed qualifying for the SEC Championship, but was on the trip as an alternate and will serve as the alternate at the NCAA Regional.

RAZORBACKS BY THE NUMBERS

- (-19) - Arkansas' second-round score at the Old Waverley Collegiate was the lowest in relation to par in school history. The total of 269 tied for the fourth-lowest, single-round in school history behind a pair of 267's and a 268.
- 64 - Julian Perico (2x) and Segundo Oliva Pinto shot the low round of the season
 - It ties for 3rd-best on the Razorback all-time list, trailing a pair of 63's
 - Oliva Pinto's 64 tied for the lowest round by a Razorback at the SEC, tied for the lowest first-round score in SEC history and tied for the third-best score overall behind a 61 in 2014 and a 63 in 2010.
- 199 - Julian Perico shot a 14-under-par 199 to win the VU Legends Collegiate. It was the second-best, 54-hole total in UA history (behind his own 197 in winning the Jerry Pate National as a freshman). Also, the 14-under score was the third-best in relation to par in school history.

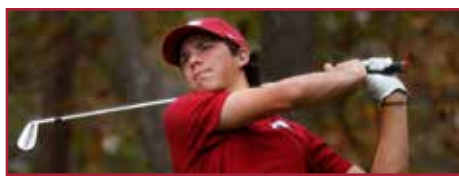

RAZORBACKS HOSTED CABO COLLEGIATE IN SAN ANTONIO

- The Arkansas men's golf program hosted the 11th annual CABO COLLEGIATE at TPC San Antonio's Oaks Course, from Mar. 1-3. The field once again featured the top teams and players in college golf.
- The event, usually played in Cabo San Lucas, Mexico, was moved to San Antonio this season due to COVID-19 concerns. However, the move proved to be positive this year. Since the event is being played on the Oaks Course - home of the Valero Texas Open - the CABO COLLEGIATE winner - Texas A&M's Sam Bennett - received an exemption to play in that PGA TOUR event (March 29-April 4).
- Of the 16 teams, 12 were among the nation's top 30 at the time, including #1 Arizona, #3 Arizona State, #4 Florida State, #7 Oklahoma and #8 Oklahoma State.
- Oklahoma won by one stroke of Florida State. Arkansas finished ninth.

PERICO GETS 2ND CAREER WIN

- Julian Perico eagled the 18th hole for the second time in three days to win the Vanderbilt Legends Collegiate, played at VU Legends Club North Course. It was his second career win as he was medalist at the 2018 Jerry Pate National.
- Perico was 2-under par for the day and finished with a 14-under-par score of 199, marking the second time in his career he has broken 200. The 199 tied for the second-lowest 54-hole score in school history. (Perico owns the school record with 197 at Jerry Pate.) His -14 is the third-best, 54-hole score in relation to par in school history. (Perico has shot -13 twice in his career.)
- Going into the 54th hole, Perico was tied with clubhouse leader Alex Goff (Kentucky). Perico launched a 2-iron with the ball sitting on the cart path for his second shot on the 527-yard, par-5 18th hole and reached the green in two. He then sank a 20-foot putt to get to -14 and hold the clubhouse lead.
- From there it was a waiting game as Vandy's John Augenstein and Brandon Smith (Texas A&M) were still on the course in striking distance with two holes to play. Augenstein came to 18 at -12 but had to settle for a birdie and finished in second. Smith birdied 17 to get to -12 with the reachable 18th remaining. However, Smith took a par and tied for third with Goff.

REEDER GETS 2ND CAREER WIN; NAMED SEC CO-GOLFER OF THE WEEK

- Tyson Reeder rolled in a three-foot putt on his final hole for a birdie to take medalist honors at the Tiger Invitational by Jason Dufner, played at Grand National Lake Course. It was his second career win as he claimed the 2019 Git-R-Done Invitational.
- Reeder was tied for second after 36 holes and played 16 holes on a Tuesday before the final round was suspended due to inclement weather. Reeder finished the 54-hole event with a par, bogey and birdie to shoot a 2-under-par 70 in the final round for a three-day, 10-under-par total of 206 (67-69-70). He tied Georgia's Davis Thompson, who shot a final-round 73, for first and a playoff was not contested due to inclement weather.
- **Both Reeder and Thompson were subsequently named SEC Men's co-Golfer of the Week.**
- Reeder and Thompson defeated 22 other golfers in the field ranked among the nation's top 100, including four among the nation's top 20.
- Reeder, who started on hole 7, got his final round off to a good start with six pars and an eagle on the par-5, 12th hole. Overall, Reeder played the 12th hole at -5 over three days with a birdie, eagle and eagle. He dropped a shot on the 13th but got back to 2-under with a birdie on the 14th. He finished with seven pars Tuesday before play was suspended. He resumed his round Wednesday with a par, a bogey and a birdie to close for his 2-under-par round of 70.

LOZADA RESPONDS; NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- After playing as an individual in Arkansas' first four spring events, Manuel Lozada returned to the lineup for the regular-season finale - the Collegiate Invitational at the Country Club of Birmingham - the after a solid performance at the Old Waverly Collegiate Championship.
- At the Collegiate Invitational, Lozada, whose previous best finish was a tie for 16th in the season-opening Blessings Collegiate Invitational, was among the top 10 in each of the three rounds. He tied the nation's top-ranked golfer - North Florida's Nick Gabrelcik - and the 11th-ranked golfer - Vanderbilt's William Moll - while defeating 17 of the nation's top 100 players in the field.
- **Lozada was named the SEC Men's Golf Freshman of the Week.** Lozada became just the third Razorback to earn the honor and first since Luis Garza was tabbed in 2017.
- Lozada birdied two of his last three holes to earn the tie for sixth as well as pushing Arkansas from 10th to 8th in the 14-team field that featured 13 of the nation's top 50 programs.

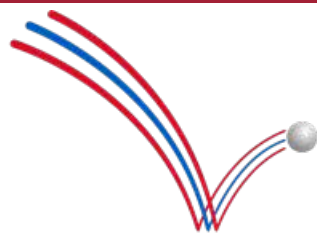
