GAME NOTES

- » QB KJ Jefferson ran for three scores in a game for the first time in his career, and became the first Razorback quarterback to have two games with at least two rushing touchdowns in the same season since at least 1997. Jefferson also completed a career-high 25 passes on 35 attempts, throwing for 326 yards, one touchdown and one interception, his second 300+ yard passing game of the season.
- » Jefferson became the third Arkansas QB to throw for 300 yards against Ole Miss in series history, and the first since Brandon Allen in 2015 (442 yards).
- » WR Treylon Burks made a season-high seven catches, recording 136 receiving yards. He produced over 100 receiving yards in a game for the third time this season and seventh time in his career. The seven career 100+ yard games is tied with Joe Adams for fifth-most in program history. Burks is also one of four FBS receivers to make a catch in every game played of their careers (minimum 20 games played), recording a grab in his 25th career game.
- » TE Trey Knox made his first touchdown grab of the season (fourth of his career) in the third quarter, his first score since Nov. 29, 2019 against Missouri. He totaled season-highs of five receptions for 37 yards.
- » RB Trelon Smith scored his ninth rushing touchdown in his last 10 games played in the second quarter. Smith ran 11 times for 85 yards.
- » RB Raheim Sanders ran for a career-high 139 yards on 17 carries, his first career 100+ yard game and the second by a Razorback this season (Trelon Smith - 102 vs. Rice). He is the first Arkansas freshman to rush for at least 100 yards in a game since Chase Hayden (120 yards) did so against Florida A&M in 2017. Sanders is the 20th Razorback to total a 100+ yard rushing game against Ole Miss. Sanders posted career-highs of three receptions for 26 yards.
- » Arkansas' trio of ball carriers of Sanders, Jefferson and Smith each ran for over 70 yards, becoming the first trio to each run for 70+ yards in the same game since Sept. 3, 2005 against Missouri State (De'Arrius Howard, Peyton Hill, Darren McFadden).
- » Arkansas totaled 676 yards, its most in a game since producing 663 total yards against Mississippi State on Nov. 19, 2016. The 676 yards are the fourth-most in a game in school history.
- » Arkansas and Ole Miss (611 total yards) each totaled over 600 yards of total offense, it is the 66th time in FBS history both team have each posted at least 600 yards of offense in the same game.
- » Arkansas and Ole Miss combined for 1,287 total yards, the 10th-most in a single-game in SEC history.
- » Arkansas recorded 39 first downs, the most in a single-game in school history.
- » Arkansas rushed for a season-high 350 yards, its most since totaling 359 against Mississippi State in 2016. The Hogs ran 58 times, its most attempts since Sept. 13, 2014 against Texas Tech (68 attempts).
- » Ole Miss' defense surrendered a season-high total in rushing yards allowed.
- » Arkansas had a 300-yard passer (Jefferson - 326) and a 100-yard rusher (Sanders - 139) for the first time since 2019 against Colorado State.
- » LB Grant Morgan (13), LB Bumper Pool (12), DB Joe Foucha (11) and DB Hayden Henry (11) each recorded double-digit tackle games. Pool and Foucha each tied for the team lead with 1.5 tackles for loss.
