GAME NOTES

- » WR Treylon Burks made his 100th career reception, becoming the fastest Hog to reach the mark since 1997, doing so in his 25th career game. Burks is one of five FBS receivers to make a catch in every game played of their careers (minimum 20 games played). The junior led the team hauling in three receptions and totaled 10 yards.
- » QB KJ Jefferson was 8-of-13 for 65 yards through the air, and added five rushing yards.
- » QB Malik Hornsby completed 2-of-3 passes for 22 yards.
- » RB AJ Green led the team accruing 28 rushing yards on six carries (4.7 ypc).
- » RB Raheim Sanders totaled one catch for a team-leading 22 receiving yards and also had six carries for 21 yards (3.5 ypc).
- » LB Grant Morgan tallied the eighth double-digit tackle game of his career, making 12 stops, which led the team. He also made 1.0 tackle for loss.
- » LB Bumper Pool was second on the team in tackles (11), recording double digit tackles for the 12th time in his career.
- » DL John Ridgeway tallied a season-high eight tackles.
- » DB Greg Brooks tied his career-high, making seven tackles.
- » DB Simeon Blair recorded a pass breakup.
- » The Razorbacks defense registered four tackles with loss with Morgan, Markell Utsey, Jayden Johnson and Zach Williams each totaling 1.0 tackle for loss.
- » Offensively, Arkansas totaled 162 yards, 87 through the air and 75 on the ground.
- » Arkansas surrendered its first points allowed in the first quarter all season.
- » Arkansas' defense allowed less than 75 passing yards (72) for the first time since 2014 against Texas (57).
- » Arkansas was shutout for the first time since 2018 against Missouri.
- » Arkansas was shutout as a ranked team for the first time since 1995 at LSU (28-0).
- » Arkansas accumulated 13 penalties for 100 yards, the 13 penalties tie the team's season-high against Rice and is tied for seventh-most in a single game in school history.

Arkansas Postgame Quotes Georgia vs. Arkansas | Oct. 2, 2021 Dooley Field at Sanford Stadium

Head Coach Sam Pittman

Opening statement...

"I just want to start out by congratulating Georgia. They have -- at this point -- by far the best football team we played. Kirby had his team ready, and I didn't -- that is the bottom line. There were a lot of mistakes in the game. But the bottom line is that we were not where we needed to be physically yet because they dominated on both sides of the ball. Certainly, our special teams early in the game were not productive. We wanted to come in and start fast, take their crowd out of the game, and the opposite happened. They put us in a hole, and we couldn't climb out of it because of their physicality."

On his takeaways from the game...

"Well, a bunch of it was that we started in a hole. We worked on the movement and all that but definitely not enough because we had several jump offsides. You know, it is hard to get 10 against Georgia let alone 15 and on the first one it was 20. Guys, I don't want to simplify this, but they just whipped us physically. It wasn't guys in the backfield turned loose or anything like that, we just couldn't block them. We couldn't get our blocks a lot of the day. Then, when we did, it took us a long time to get them on the ground. We have to get better, and we will. But today they just were more physical than us and kind of played bully ball on us and made us like it. We didn't like it but there was nothing we could do about it at times in the game. They were just rolling us out of there on both sides of the line of scrimmage."

On the game...

"That was a really good football team. You have to be able to say the facts. We came in thinking we would have to play a perfect game to be able to win the game. Just be us. We didn't win any of the three phases – special teams, offense, or defense... We have to not let this let make it into two. We have to be able to go back and start preparing for Ole Miss."
