## TODAY'S GAME/LAST TIME OUT

The Razorbacks are set to host Mercer at Bud Walton Arena. This is the 6th matchup between each team and the Razorbacks lead 4-1 with their most recent matchup being won in overtime by Mercer in 2015 (69-66).

## ABOUT THE RAZORBACKS

Arkansas enters the 2021-22 season after reaching the Elite 8 in the NCAA tournament. They would eventually end up losing to the 2020-2021 NCAA Champions, Baylor. Since Eric Musselman's arrival, Arkansas leads the SEC in overall wins with 45 and overall home wins with 30. Arkansas returns five lettermen from last year, with eight total transfers listed on their roster this season.

## SERIES HISTORY

The Bears and Razorbacks are set at 4-1 in the series with the Razorbacks on top. Four of the five meetings have come on neutral courts including the first and last outings. Our first meeting was in the 1981 NCAA Tournament in Austin, Texas. The Hogs won 73-67. Our last meeting was a 69-66 Mercer win in overtime at North Little Rock on Dec. 19, 2015.

## Preseason Voting

Mercer was named the preseason ranked 4th by the coaches, in addition to being selected 4th by the media behind Chattanooga, Furman, and Wofford.

## Field Goal Efficiency

Junior James Glisson III returns to make another impactful year. In 2019-20 he shot .509% from the floor and will look to duplicate that success this year and he is expected to see more minutes throughout this upcoming season.

## New Year, New Faces

There will be plenty of new faces around Hawkins Arena this season as the Bears welcome four newcomers to the squad for the 2021-22 season. Freshmen Jordan Jones and will be playing his first season of collegiate hoops this year, while transfers Jalen Johnson (Wake Forrest) and Shawn Walker Jr. (Tallahassee CC) are entering their first season donning the Black and Orange. Johnson is a graduate transfers, while Walker Jr. is in his junior year. Also the addition of Harrison Drake, manager turned player, has made his arrival to the squad and looks to make an impact early for the Bears.

## Last Time Out

Mercer saw its 2020-21 season come to a close in the Southern Conference Finals with a heartbreaking 69-61 loss to No. 1 UNCG at Harrah's Cherokee Center.

Leon Ayers III and James Glisson III led the Bears in scoring as they had helped out in all season with 16 points apiece, while Glisson recorded two blocks on the day. Leon went 5-11 from the field and 2-3 from beyond the arc while knocking down all of his free throws in the games.

## Series History

This is the 6th matchup between Arkansas and your Mercer Bears. The Razorbacks lead the series 4-1. The Bears won the game back in 2015 in an overtime battle ending at 69-66.

## Scouting the Razorbacks

Razorbacks enters the 2021-22 celebrating their 30th anniversary of entering the SEC.

Arkansas has been picked 15th in the 2021-22 coaches preseason top 25 poll and 16th by AP. This is the first time Arkansas has appeared in the AP preseason poll since 2007-08, coming in at #19 that season. The last time Arkansas was ranked as high as 16th was in 2000-01 when the Hogs were ranked 15th.

Arkansas finished their most previous season in '20-'21 with a loss in the elite 8 to the most previous NCAA champs, Baylor. Prior to that loss they were on a 8-1 run. That one loss coming from LSU in the SEC championship, 71-78.

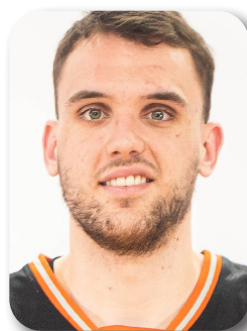

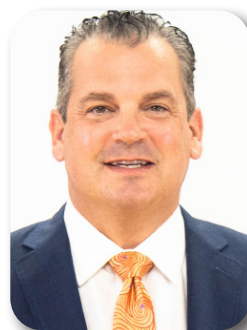

## Greg Gary

Head Coach - 3rd Season

Greg Gary enters his third season at the helm of the Mercer men's basketball program in 2021-22 after leading the Bears to 35 wins through two seasons, the most for Mercer men's basketball head coach in his first two seasons.

Gary led the Bears to 18 wins in year two and 17 wins in year one. In his second season in charge, he led the Orange & Black to its first Southern Conference championship game since the University joined the conference prior to the start of the 2014-15 academic year. Mercer got off to a hot start in 2020-21 beginning the year 6-0 for the first time since the 1966-67 campaign. In just the second game of the season, the Bears defeated Georgia Tech on the road, 83-73, for the team's first win over a Power Five opponent under Gary's tutelage. In a nationally televised game against Wofford, redshirt senior guard Ross Cummings reached a pair of milestones, scoring his 1000th career point and knocking down his 200th three-pointer. Cummings finished his time with the Orange & Black with 246 career three-pointers, the second-most in program history behind Langston Hall's 257, and 1,244 points, the 16th-best total in Mercer men's hoops history. The Bears entered the Southern Conference tournament led by a pair of All-SoCon selections in Cummings (Second Team Coaches, Third Team Media) and Neftali Alvarez (Third Team Coaches and Media). The seventh-seeded Bears promptly dispatched No. 10 Samford, 87-59, No. 2 Wofford, 61-60, and No. 6 VMI, 73-59, to reach the winner-take-all championship game against UNCG. A trio of Bears – Alvarez, Leon Ayers III and Felipe Haase – earned all-tournament honors as Mercer finished as the runner-up. Mercer led the SoCon and finished 11th nationally with 479 total assists, and the Bears concluded the 2020-21 season with an RPI higher than multiple P5 schools including Duke, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Miami, NC State and a host of others.

By virtue of 17 wins in year one, Gary is tied for the most victories by a first-year head coach in Mercer men's basketball program history. His first season in Macon was notable due to several team and individual accomplishments – including a record 30 assists by the Bears in a 106-66 rout of Samford. His nephew, Jeff Gary, tied the Hawkins Arena record for made three-pointers in that same contest with eight. Gary led Mercer to six consecutive Southern Conference victories from January 15 – February 1, 2020, which was the program's longest winning streak since 2017-18. On February 4, the team was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week thanks to wins at ETSU and in Hawkins Arena against The Citadel. The Bears were the only team to defeat ETSU on its home floor in 2019-20.

At season's end, Mercer secured the No. 4 seed in the Southern Conference tournament but bowed out to Western Carolina. Three players – Djordje Dimitrijevic, Ethan Stair and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic also earned NABC Second Team District XXI recognition and was named a Second Team College Sports Information Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America, becoming the first Mercer men's basketball player to accomplish such a feat since Will Emerson in 2006.

Off the court, the Bears earned the NABC's Team Academic Excellence Award, which was given to teams that had a 3.0 GPA or higher for the 2019-20 academic year. Three of Gary's players - Dimitrijevic, Victor Bafutto and Mitch Prendergast - were named to the NABC's Honor Court.

Gary was appointed head coach on March 26, 2019. He was introduced as the program's new leader at a formal introductory press conference on April 3, 2019.

"When we set out to look for a new head coach, we recognized Greg early in the process as someone we were confident in leading our men's basketball program," said Director of Athletics Jim Cole at the time of Gary's hire. "Greg not only stood out for his proven background and style of play, but for the role he has played as a mentor to student-athletes throughout his career as well as his commitment to growing them into leaders off the court. We're so happy for Greg, his wife, Claudia, and his children – Gabrielle, Logan, Alexandra, Brooklyn and Nash – to be joining our Mercer Family."

A veteran coach entering his 29th year at the NCAA Division I level, Gary spent the eight seasons prior to his arrival in Macon working under Matt Painter at Purdue University. He helped the Boilermakers reach the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight in 2019 and make back-to-back Sweet 16 appearances in 2017 and 2018.

Gary has made 16 postseason appearances as a college assistant and player, reaching the NCAA Tournament nine times.

His on-court focus for the Boilermakers centered on the development of their wing and post players. Calling Purdue's offensive sets, Gary helped Purdue lead the Big Ten Conference in scoring in two of his last three seasons with the



nation's second-most efficient offense. The Boilermakers led the Big Ten in three-point percentage and free throw percentage while ranking second nationally in assists per game during the 2016-17 season.

Gary's guidance was significant in the improvement of Purdue standouts Vincent Edwards, Ryan Cline and Dakota Mathias during the 2016-17 campaign. During that season, Edwards made a jump from the power forward to small forward position and led the team in assists while ranking second on the team in scoring and third in rebounding.

In 2014-15, Gary had a large impact on the development of Mathias, Rapheal Davis, and Kendall Stephens and helped the Boilermakers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2012. Gary's tutelage helped Davis become the Big Ten's best defensive player, while also improving his offensive game. In Big Ten games, Davis averaged 12.2 points per game, a 5.3 points per game improvement from the previous season. He also improved his three-point shooting 13.2 percent from his freshman to his junior year.

In 2012-13, Gary oversaw an influx of youth in the Boilermaker frontcourt and helped guide center A.J. Hammons through one of the finest freshman seasons in program history. Hammons earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors after finishing the season with averages of 10.6 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game. He led the Big Ten with an average of 2.3 blocks per contest in league play, and wrapped up the campaign ranked second on Purdue's freshman charts in blocks (67), third in rebounds (204) and sixth in points (359).

Gary's first season in West Lafayette was a successful one, as he helped guide the Boilers to the NCAA Tournament for the sixth year in a row. Forward Robbie Hummel was named an honorable mention All-American and received first team All-Big Ten recognition after leading Purdue in scoring, rebounds and blocked shots. Hummel was selected by the Minnesota Timberwolves in the second round of the 2012 NBA Draft, becoming one of 12 players to be drafted by an NBA franchise or spend time on an NBA roster after receiving Gary's guidance.

Gary came to Purdue from two stints at Duquesne, where he spent the 2007-08 and 2010-11 seasons as an assistant coach, sandwiched around two seasons as head coach at Centenary. Gary resigned from his post at Centenary after the school announced in July 2009 that it would seek reclassification as an NCAA Division III member. A program that had won a total of 10 Summit League games in the four years prior to Gary's arrival, Centenary posted nine league wins in his two seasons at the helm.

Prior to arriving at Duquesne, Gary spent three seasons (2004-07) as an assistant coach at South Florida, helping the Bulls transition from Conference USA to the Big East. While in Tampa, Gary worked with big man Solomon Jones, who was drafted by the Atlanta Hawks in 2006 and played parts of seven seasons in the NBA.

Gary served as an assistant coach under Perry Clark at Miami from 2000-04, helping lead the Hurricanes to the NIT in 2001 and the NCAA Tournament in 2002. During his tenure at Miami, Gary aided in the development of former NBA players James Jones and John Salmons, as well as former NBA player Robert Hite. He also served as the 'Canes' academic coordinator.

Gary spent six of his first seven years (1993-97, 1998-00) in the coaching industry at Tulane, helping guide his alma mater to the NCAA Tournament in 1995 and the NIT on four occasions. In his second stint with the Green Wave, he also served as the team's recruiting coordinator and oversaw academics for the student-athletes. At Tulane, Gary coached three players – Jerald Honeycutt, Linton Johnson and Chris Owens – who spent time on NBA rosters.

Gary served as an assistant coach at McNeese State for the 1997-98 campaign.

After graduating from Anderson Highland High School in 1988 and spending a year at Aquinas College in Nashville, Tenn., Gary transferred to Tulane. He was a vital component in the revitalization of a program that was dropped in 1985 and reinstated in 1988, leading the Green Wave to the 1992 NCAA Tournament as a senior. Despite playing only three seasons in New Orleans, Gary finished his career as Tulane's all-time leader in assists and now ranks fifth (370). He is second in career assist-to-turnover ratio (1.97).

Gary and his teammates, including assistant coach Kim Lewis from the 1991-92 Green Wave team, the first in program history to make the NCAA Tournament, were inducted into the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame in April of 2020.

A native of Anderson, Indiana, Gary was born on February 14, 1970. Gary earned a B.S. in sport management from Tulane in 1992. He and his wife, Claudia, have five children - four daughters, Gabrielle, Logan, Alexandra and Brooklyn - and one son, Nash.



# Bobby Kummer

Assistant Coach - 3th Season at Mercer

Bobby Kummer was hired as an assistant coach on Greg Gary's staff on April 17, 2019 and will begin year three with the Mercer Bears and his 26th season at the NCAA Division I level for the 2021-22 season.

Kummer mentored the Mercer big men throughout the 2020-21 season, which ended with an appearance in the Southern Conference championship game. Mercer started the year 6-0 for the first time since 1966-67 and upset Georgia Tech on the road, 83-73. Kummer was responsible, in large part for the development of forward Felipe Haase, who played his first season in a Mercer uniform in '20-

21. Haase was instrumental in Mercer's quick start, reaching double figures in four of the Bears' six wins and recording his first double-double in a narrow win at Georgia Southern on Dec. 16. Haase shot 5-of-7 from the floor in the win over the Eagles and pulled down a career-high 16 boards. Haase and fellow big man James Glisson III utilized Kummer's instruction in a big way when Mercer made its run through the SoCon tournament. Haase averaged 11.9 points and a team-best 7.9 boards over the course of the season but increased his averages to 14.5 points and 10.5 boards during Mercer's four tournament games, earning All-SoCon Tournament honors. Glisson III started the final 13 games of the season and provided a major spark in the Southern Conference championship, going 7-of-8 from the floor and 2-of-2 at the charity stripe, tying his season-high of 16 points and finishing one rebound shy of a double-double.

In year one as an assistant coach under Gary, Kummer was instrumental in helping the team win 17 games overall and 11 in the Southern Conference en route to securing the No. 4 seed for the league tournament. The Detroit, Mich. native was a driving force behind Mercer's six-game winning streak from January 15 – February 1, 2020 which garnered the squad National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week honors on February 4. Under Kummer's mentorship, three players – Ethan Stair, Djordje Dimitrijevic and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic was also recognized by the NABC as a Second Team All-District XXI selection and a College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Second Team Academic All-America



# D.J. Byrd

Assistant Coach - 3rd Season at Mercer

The 2021-22 season is D.J. Byrd's third season as part of the Mercer Bears men's basketball program and second as an assistant coach.

Byrd was elevated to assistant coach from Director of Basketball Operations in late July 2020.

In his first season as an assistant coach, Byrd helped Mercer make its first trip to the Southern Conference title game. The Bears finished 18-11 overall after jumping out to a 6-0 start for the first time since 1966-67, and in the former Purdue standout's second game as an assistant coach, Mercer topped Georgia Tech, 83-73, on the road. Byrd mentored Mercer's guards and helped Neftali Alvarez lead the team in both points (13.3) and assists (4.2) per game. Alvarez's 113 helpers ranked second in the SoCon and 69th nationally, and as a team, the Bears finished the season 11th overall with 479 helpers. Guard Ross Cummings also reached a pair of milestones, surpassing 1,000 points and 200 made three-pointers. He finished the season with 1,244 points, the 16th-highest total in program history, and 246 three-pointers. Cummings ended his time with the Bears only 11 treys away from surpassing Langston Hall's school record. Both Alvarez and Cummings were All-SoCon selections, while Alvarez and another guard that Byrd guided, Leon Ayers III, landed a spot on the conference's all-tournament team.

The Crawfordsville, Ind. native spent the 2019-20 as DOBO and was in charge of all logistical aspects of the program including but not limited to travel arrangements, practice schedules, overseeing all undergraduate and graduate managers and ensuring that team needs were met.



# Kim Lewis

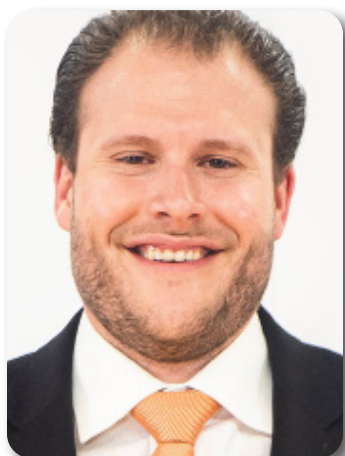
Assistant Coach - 3rd Season at Mercer

Kim Lewis will begin his third season as an assistant coach at Mercer for the 2021-22 season, which will be his 21st at the NCAA Division I level. He was hired on April 17, 2019.

Lewis helped the Bears go 18-11 overall in his second season under Gary and advance to the SoCon championship game for the first time since the University joined the league in 2014-15. The Bears began the season with a bang, starting 6-0, which included an 83-73

win at Georgia Tech, for their best start since 1966-67. Lewis worked primarily with the guards and played a vital role in the development of redshirt sophomore guard Neftali Alvarez. In his first season with the Orange & Black, Alvarez led the team with 13.3 points and 4.2 assists per game. He dished out 113 assists, the second-highest total in the Southern Conference, which placed him 69th nationally. As a team, the Bears led the conference and were 11th among all NCAA Division I schools with 479 total helpers. Under Lewis' guidance, Ross Cummings reached 1,000 career points and 200 made three-pointers, reaching both milestones in a December game against Wofford on national TV. Cummings ended his career with 246 three-pointers, second only to Langston Hall's 257, and 1,244 points, which placed him 16th all-time. Cummings and Alvarez both earned All-SoCon honors at the end of the regular season. At the end of the conference tournament, two of Lewis' mentees – Alvarez and Leon Ayers III – were named to the All-SoCon Tournament team.

Lewis played a pivotal role in Mercer's 17 wins in 2019-20, including six consecutive from January 15 – February 1, 2020, which helped Mercer earn National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week honors on February 4. The Bears won 11 Southern Conference contests and locked up the No. 4 seed for the league tournament before bowing out in the quarterfinals. Three players – Djordje Dimitrijevic, Ethan Stair and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic was also honored by the NABC as a Second Team All-District XXI selection and a College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Second Team Academic All-American.



# Luke Brenneman

Director of Basketball Operations - 3rd Season

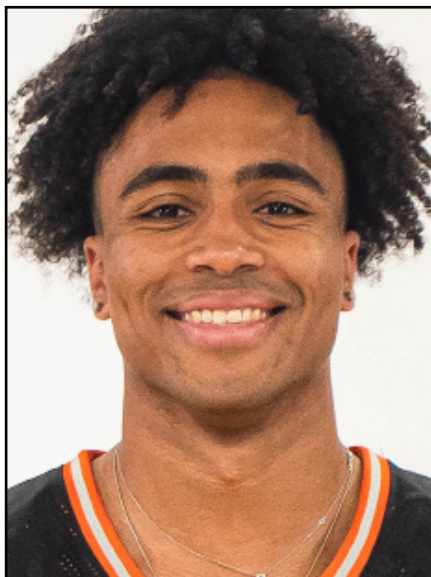
Luke Brenneman enters his third season with the Mercer basketball program in 2021-22 and second as Director of Basketball Operations.

Brenneman was named Director of Basketball Operations in August 2020. He spent the 2019-20 campaign as a graduate manager.

In his two seasons on staff, Mercer went 35-26 overall and made its first appearance in the Southern Conference championship game in 2020-21. Brenneman is in charge of travel reservations, camps, and the annual Greg Gary Basketball Camps golf tournament. He also oversees both graduate and undergraduate managers within the program. During Brenneman's first two seasons on staff – five players have earned All-SoCon honors, including guard Ross Cummings. Cummings finished his career with the Bears at the end of the 2020-21 season and ranked second all-time in made three-pointers (246) and 16th in points (1,244). Following the Bears' run to the 2021 So-Con championship contest, Neftali Alvarez, Leon Ayers III and Felipe Haase earned all-tournament honors.

Before joining the staff at Mercer, Brenneman spent one year as an assistant coach at Goshen College. In that role, he oversaw the team's scouting and recruiting. He also managed player development through skill and video sessions.

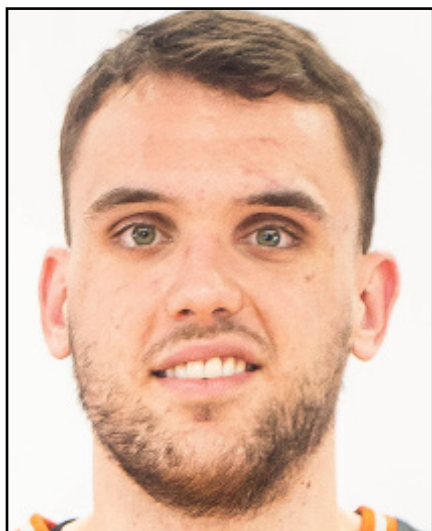

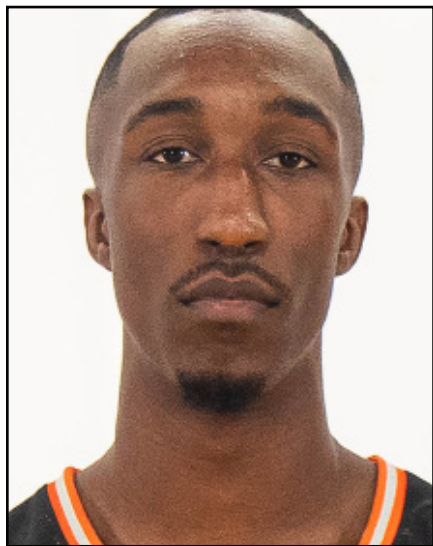
