GAME NOTES

- » QB KJ Jefferson completed 18-of-25 passes for 142 yards with one touchdown toss. Jefferson also led the team rushing for 41 yards on 15 carries.
- » RB Dominique Johnson recorded his first career receiving touchdown in the third quarter, scoring on a 43-yard reception from QB KJ Jefferson. Johnson is second on the team with seven touchdowns scored this season. He finished with 14 carries for 39 yards.
- » WR Treyton Burks led the team making four catches for 16 yards. He made a catch in his 30th consecutive game, which is the third-longest streak in FBS (minimum 20 career games).
- » DB Montaric Brown intercepted his team-high fourth pass of the season in overtime, which set up Cam Little's game-winning field goal.
- » DB Myles Slusher logged his second interception of the season in the third quarter. Since Barry Odom began his tenure as defensive coordinator in 2020, the Razorbacks have intercepted 23 interceptions in 20 games.
- » LB Bumper Pool led the team with 13 tackles, his sixth double-digit tackle game and 15th of his career. Pool led the team in tackles for sixth time this year and 14th time of his career. The senior set a season-high posting 2.0 tackles for loss and also added a pass broken up.
- » Arkansas' defense had three double-digit tacklers in LB Bumper Pool (13), LB Grant Morgan (11) and LB Hayden Henry (10).
- » DL John Ridgeway tallied his second sack of the season. His 2.0 sacks this year are a career-high.
- » DL Taurean Carter recorded his first career sack, wrapping up LSU QB Max Johnson for a loss of two yards in the first quarter, forcing a punt.
- » P Reid Bauer tallied a rush for the first time in his career, running 23 yards on a fake field goal in the third quarter.
- » K Cam Little connected on 3-of-3 field goals of 48, 31 and 37 yards. Little has made 17 field goals this season, the most by an Arkansas freshman kicker since Zach Hocker (16) in 2010. Little hit the game-winner of 37 yards in overtime.
- » Arkansas held LSU to 13 points or fewer at Tiger Stadium for the first time since Florida held the Tigers to 10 points in 2016. Its the first time Arkansas held LSU to 13 or fewer points in Baton Rouge for the first time since a 6-6 tie on Nov. 29, 1906.
- » Arkansas snapped a five-game losing streak to LSU and won in Baton Rouge for the first time since Nov. 23, 2007.
- » Arkansas held LSU to 13 points or fewer for the first time since a 17-0 win in 2014.
- » Arkansas played its first overtime game since 2017 against Texas A&M, and first against LSU since 2009. The Razorbacks improved to 13-7 all-time in overtime games.
- » Arkansas won a game on the game's final offensive play for the first time since 2017 at Ole Miss with a 34-yard field goal.
- » Arkansas improved to 7-3 (3-3 SEC) on the season, its most wins in a year since 2016 (7).
