GAME NOTES

- » QB KJ Jefferson completed 22-of-30 passes for 326 yards and three touchdowns. Jefferson became the fourth Arkansas QB to throw for 300+ yards against Alabama and the first since Austin Allen in 2016 (400). He threw a touchdown pass in his sixth straight game and recorded his fourth game with three or more passing touchdowns this season. His 326 passing yards are tied for his second-highest output of the season.
- » P Reid Bauer completed his first career pass in the fourth quarter, finding TE Blake Kern for a 32-yard touchdown on a fake field goal.
- » WR Treylon Burks hauled in eight receptions for 179 yards and two touchdowns. Burks became just the third receiver since 2000 to record at least 150 yards and two receiving touchdowns against Alabama, joining Ole Miss' Kenny Yeboah (181 yards, 2 touchdowns) in 2020 and Auburn's Sammie Coates (206 yards, 2 touchdowns) in 2014.
- » Burks has produced 2,270 career receiving yards, the sixth-most in school history.
- » Burks totaled his fifth 100+ yard receiving game of the season, which is tied for the most in a season in program history with Anthony Lucas (1998) and Anthony Eubanks (1997). Burks has totaled nine career games of 100+ receiving yards, which is tied for second-most in school history.
- » Burks' performance is the fourth 100+ receiving yard outing by a Razorback against the Crimson Tide in the all-time series. He is the first to reach the 100-yard mark since Jared Cornelius (5 catches, 146 yards) in 2016.
- » Burks has produced 975 receiving yards this season and is the first Arkansas receiver to have back-to-back 800+ yard receiving seasons since Anthony Lucas (1998-99). He scored his 10th touchdown of the year in the second quarter, which is tied for the third-most receiving scores in a single-season in school history.
- » TE Blake Kern posted season-highs of three catches and 47 receiving yards and scored his second touchdown of the year.
- » RB Trelon Smith led the team running for 42 yards on nine carries (4.7 ypc).
- » RB Raheim Sanders made his first career touchdown grab on a 17-yard grab in the fourth quarter.
- » LB Grant Morgan led the team with 11 tackles, his 11th career double-digit tackle performance and fifth of the season.
- » DB Montaric Brown forced and recovered a fumble in the fourth quarter, both firsts on the season.
- » DB Myles Slusher set a career-high recording nine tackles.
- » Arkansas' defense posted a season-high 4.0 sacks, its most since tallying 4.0 against Texas A&M in 2019. It is the most sacks Arkansas has recorded against Alabama since 2006 (5).
- » Arkansas' defensive recorded 8.0 tackles for loss, the most by the Razorbacks against Alabama since 2015 (8).
- » Alabama out-gained Arkansas, 671-468. Arkansas produced over 400 yards of total offense for the seventh time this season.
- » Alabama improved to 22-8 in the all-time series.
