NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

- → After the first week of the season. Arkansas is 2-1.
- → The Hogs beat Tarleton State and UAPB in week one, before falling to No. 2 UConn on Sunday.
- → Despite the final score, Arkansas hung around with UConn all game, fighting back from a 17–2 deficit early to cut the lead down to three and four during the second period.
- → Arkansas' offense has continued to hum along this season, as their 87 PPG is the 28th best mark in the NCAA this season.
- → Arkansas has also been a much improved team on the boards, as they are ranked 36th in the nation in total rebounds (132).
- → The Hogs also continue to take care of the ball, as their 10 turnovers per game is the eighthfewest in the nation.
- → Versatile forward Erynn Barnum has had a stellar start to the season, showcasing her ability to do a little bit of everything. She leads the team in points (14.6 PPG), rebounds (6.7 RPG) and steals (2.3) through three games.
- → Sasha Goforth has been a welcome addition, as she is second on the team in scoring (12.0).
- → Barnum and Goforth were both good against UConn Barnum tallied 16 points and eight rebounds, while Goforth totaled 17 points, five boards and a blocked shot.

ONE FEARLESS FRESHMAN

- → After playing just one week of collegiate basketball, Samara Spencer is making her mark.
- → After averaging 11.3 points, 2.7 assists and 2.0 rebounds over her first three games, Spencer was named the SEC's Freshman of the Week.
- → Spencer became the first Hog to win the award since Makayla Daniels did so in 2019.
- → The Fort Lauderdale product started her college career with back-to-back double-figure scoring nights, dropping 12 points on Tarleton State and 14 on UAPB.
- → Against mighty UConn, Spencer showed that was no fluke she scored eight points in just 17 minutes, providing a spark for the Hogs off the bench.

A STRONG DEFENSIVE START

- → Despite being known for their offensive prowess and pace, the 2021–22 Hogs have shown signs of being a much improved defensive team.
- → The Hogs held Tarleton State to just 33 points in the season opener, as the Texans shot just 22 percent from the field.
- \rightarrow That's the first time the Hogs have held an opponent to under 35 points since 2014 (W, Northwestern State, 78–30, 11/23/14).
- → The Texans shot the ball even worse on the perimeter, as the Hogs' length held the Texans to just 13 percent from deep.
- → Arkansas also put its new size to good use, dominating the battle on the boards, 47–31.
- \rightarrow That was the most rebounds for Arkansas since the season opener last year against Oral Roberts (11/25/20).

FIVE STARS ABOUND

- → The 2021 Incoming Class is arguably the greatest ever assembled for the program.
- → Jersey Wolfenbarger, the No. 7 overall player and top-rated wing in the 2021 Hoopgurlz Recruiting Rankings, is a unicorn, a 6-5 guard.
- → Fellow McDonald's All-American Maryam Dauda, who was flipped from Baylor this spring, will serve as the Hogs anchor down low for years to come
- → She is rehabbing an ACL injury.
- → Both Sasha Goforth and Elauna Eaton will have four years of eligibility at Arkansas due to COVID-19.
- → Goforth, a former McDonald's All-American, returns to Fayetteville after a year at Oregon State.
- → Eaton, meanwhile, comes back off rehabbing an ACL injury of her own.

LAST TIME OUT

- → Arkansas Women's Basketball suffered its first loss of the season, falling to perennial women's basketball power No. 2 UConn, 95–80.
- → UConn got off to a 17-2 lead early, and though Arkansas would cut the lead back down on several occasions, the Hogs would never lead in the game.
- → Sophomore phenom Paige Bueckers paced the Huskies, going for a career-high 34 points in the game.
- → Redshirt senior guard Amber Ramirez led the Hogs in points, going for 20.
- → Sasha Goforth chipped in with 17 points, while Erynn Barnum added 16 of her own.
- → The Huskies stormed out of the gates, scoring 17 of the game's first 19 points. Connecticut shot 63 percent from the field in the first quarter, while Arkansas only shot 26 percent in the frame. Despite that, Arkansas only trailed the No. 2 team in the nation after one by eight points.
- → The Hogs showed resilience, chipping the lead in the second quarter all the way down to three, starting the period on a 7–2 run, capped by a Makayla Daniels layup. Arkansas would get the lead back down to four at the 4:37 mark of the second period on a Samara Spencer bucket, but the Razorbacks would get no closer. UConn would finish the first half up 10, and the Hogs would end up falling by 15.
- → Ramirez tallied her first 20-point game of the young season, and the 16th such game of her career.
- → Barnum's 16 points were a season-high, while Goforth's 17 were the most of her Arkansas career.
- → Barnum also pulled down eight boards, nearly double-doubling.
- → Freshman guard Samara Spencer continued to impress, scoring eight points, dishing two assists and nabbing a steal.

- → Erynn Barnum, now a redshirt junior, is the oldest of the Arkansas bunch. After an extremely successful season coming off the bench, she is poised to breakout.
- → Junior Marquesha Davis, like Barnum, is poised to have a much larger role this season as well. The McGehee, Ark. native showed how good she could be in Arkansas' monster wins over both Baylor and UConn. She put up eight points, four rebounds and four steals against Baylor, while going for seven points, three boards and several huge stops against Paige Bueckers in the win over the Huskies.
- → Junior Avery Hughes of Bentonville, who was the first walk—on of the Neighbors era at Arkansas, was recently put on scholarship.
- → Coming off an ACL tear, reshirt freshman Elauna Eaton is set to make her debut for Neighbors & Co. in 2021–22. The scoring guard was highly touted out of Nettleton High School, ranked as a five-star player and as the No. 37 player in the class of 2020.
- → Transferring in this season, sophomore, and former McDonald's All-American, Sasha Goforth retruns home to Fayetteville and will make an immediate impact. The All-Freshman Pac-12 player brings her versatile game to Arkansas, and will be immediately eligible.
- → Freshman Jersey Wolfenbarger arrives on the Hill as perhaps the most highly touted player in the program's history. The 6–5 wing ranked No. 7 in the 2021 Hoopgurlz rankings was the Arkansas Gatorade Player of the Year twice in a row, and earned a spot on the gold medal winning U19 FIBA World Cup squad.
- → Not far behind her, though, is fellow freshman Maryam Dauda. Dauda, like Wolfenbarger was a McDonald's All–American and Jordan Brand Classic Invitee. Dauda is currently rehabing a torn ACL.



THE SPLASH SISTER

- → Now entering her third season at Arkansas, Amber Ramirez will start the 2021–22 season as the leader of the Razorbacks.
- → The Splash Sister is up to the task Ramirez finished the season last year averaging 13.5 points per game on 43 percent shooting.
- → The coaches in the league took notice, as Ramirez was named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team.
- → The honor was the first from the league office in her career, and she was the only Hog to be placed on either of the preseason teams.
- → Ramirez is a big game player, and that showed up once again in Arkansas' loss to UConn.
- → After struggling to start her COVID senior season, Ramirez broke out against UConn, going for 20 points in the game.
- → That mark led the team. She also hit three of her six long balls.
- → Ramirez's averages in the seven game she's played against top-5 teams while on the Hill are up over her normal averages: 17.3 PPG on 46.9 percent from the field and 50 percent from long range.

MONEY MAK

- → Junior guard Makayla Daniels is set for an expanded role in her third season on the Hill.
- → Daniels has yet to miss a start since arriving in Fayetteville she's started 63 straight games, including three starts this season.
- → Daniels has been versatile to start her junior campaign, leading the team in assists (2.7) while also averaging a career-best 5.7 rebounds per game.
- → Mak can still score the ball, and that showed in the opener against Tarleton State, as she led the team with 15 points.
- ightharpoonup She also stuffed the stat sheet against UConn, going for five points, six boards, and three assists.

DEPTH ON DEPTH ON DEPTH

- → A year after playing a shorter rotation, Coach Neighbors will have plenty of chess pieces to use during the 2021–22 season.
- → Makayla Daniels and Amber Ramirez will retain their starting spots, but from there, the depth chart becomes very competitive.
- → The guard rotation will be good for the Hogs once again, as Elauna Eaton, Rylee Langerman and Samara Spencer will all have an opportunity to secure playing time.
- → Eaton, the former five-star recruit, has made an immediate impact in her first three games as a Hog, averaging 9.7 points per game, hitting 41 percent of her long balls.
- → Langerman, meanwhile, brings a rugged presence to the backcourt, as she will rebound

and defend with the best guards in the league this season.

- → The only guard on the team that can match Daniels' speed, Spencer's ability to get to the cup has been on display already, as her 11.3 PPG is good for third on the team.
- → On the wing, the Hogs are stacked: Sasha Goforth, Marquesha Davis and Jersey Wolfenbarager will all vie for serious minutes.
- → Goforth has arguably been the Hogs' best newbie, as she is averaging 12.0 points, 4.7 rebounds, two assists and 1.3 blocks per game so far this season.
- → Davis flashed frequently during her sophomore season, showing herself to be a capable scorer and a lockdown wing defender.
- → Wolfenbarger, meanwhile, is one of the more unique players in the country already. At 6–5, she's as big as most post players, but brings guard skills along with that size. Her 10-point debut against Tarleton State showed flashes of how special she can be.
- → Down low, Erynn Barnum has a hold on the starting spot. She is an explosive scorer with an unorthodox game. She can also block shots.
- → Emrie Ellis, meanwhile, is a great playmaker and shooter as a big. While her impact early is not always reflected in the box score, Ellis does lead Arkansas in blocks, with seven of them.
- → The wild card of the group is Maryam Dauda – the McDonald's All–American is a menacing presence down low, standing 6–4. She can do it all – shoot, run the floor and block and alter shots of those that come into the lane.

MIKE NEIGHBORS

THE MOST INTERESTING COACH IN COLLEGE BASKETBALL

Fifth Season | Career Record: 178-92 (8) | Arkansas Record: 80-51 (4)

Four years after his return to his alma mater, Mike Neighbors has transformed Arkansas into a nationally recognized women's basketball program. During his time back home, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best four-year period of sustained success in program history. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers - Neighbors has accumulated 176 wins during his eight seasons as a head coach, one of only two NCAA Division I Head Coaches to do so in eight or fewer seasons.

Entering his fifth season on the bench for Arkansas, Neighbors is coming off a historic campaign unlike any other. Under his watchful eye, the Hogs have been transformed into a winner in the Southeastern Conference. His 2020-21 team helped cement that, as the Razorbacks finished 9-6 in the league, the first time in program history with back-to-back winning seasons since joining the SEC back in 1991. Neighbors' 2020-21 squad was also at its best when the competition was at its most fierce - his most recent team became the first Razorback squad to beat two top-five teams in the same season, as Arkansas beat both No. 4 Baylor and No. 3 UConn this past season. Their win against Baylor was the first top-five win for the program since 2003, and its first win against a defending national champion since 1996. Neighbors' Hogs accomplished all this in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, and during the regular season, played in 26 games, the most in the NCAA. That was not by accident - Neighbors and his staff went the extra mile in how they traveled, practiced and managed their team on gameday. The season culminated with the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2015, and if not for the COVID-19 pandemic, it would have been the first back-to-back appearances for the program since the 2002 and 2003 NCAA Tournaments.


