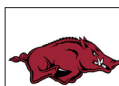

GAME AT A GLANCE

THE RUNDOWN

The Bearcats mowed down No. 14 Illinois for their first ranked win since No. 21 Houston on Feb. 1, 2020 and highest one since also taking down No. 11 Houston in the 2019 AAC Championship game. UC erased a 23-8 deficit to outscore Illinois 63-28 over the final 32 minutes. It earned its largest margin-of-victory against a ranked foe since March 5, 2011 against No. 17 Georgetown (69-47). UC also held Illinois to their fewest points since Jan. 19, 2017.

Mike Saunders Jr.'s career-high 20 points off the bench paved the way, including a team-high 11 at the break. It was his fourth-career double-figure scoring game, all since Feb. 28. Jeremiah Davenport's 19 points gave him a fifth-straight double-figure scoring game to begin the season. Cincinnati has led at the half and out-rebounded its opponent in every game this season. The Bearcats are also 83.6 percent at the line the last three games after going 56.8 percent the first two.

UC is seeking consecutive ranked wins for the first time since 2017-18 (March 4 vs. #11 Wichita State and March 11 vs. #21 Houston). Wes Miller also became the first of UC's 28 all-time head coaches to start his tenure 5-0. Cincinnati remains the only team nationally to be undefeated in football (11-0) and men's basketball.

CINCINNATI TRADITION

Cincinnati, ranked the No. 9 basketball program all-time by CBS' Matt Norlander in 2019, boasts 1,848 all-time wins, good for No. 12 nationally. The Bearcats have produced 32 All-Americans (last: Jarron Cumberland in 2019), 86 All-Conference selections, 57 NBA Draft picks (last: Jacob Evans III in 2018) and 54 members of the 1,000-Point Club. The program has spent 434 weeks Ranked in the AP Top 25, 212 in the Top 10 and 45 at No. 1. Jack Twyman and Oscar Robertson are both members of the Basketball Hall of Fame, with Robertson earning a spot on the NBA's 75th-Anniversary Team this fall.

LAST TIME OUT

KANSAS CITY — The University of Cincinnati men's basketball team turned an early 15-point deficit into a stunning, 71-51 statement win over No. 14 Illinois in the semifinals of the Hall of Fame Classic on Monday night.

Cincinnati earned its highest-ranked win since defeating No. 11 Houston, 69-57, in the 2019 AAC Championship game. Wes Miller also became the first UC coach to win his first five games at the school. Only Anthony Chez (1902) and Tay Baker (1965) had won their first four out of the program's 28 all-time head coaches.

It was also UC's largest margin of victory over a ranked team since a 69-47 dismantling of No. 17 Georgetown on March 5, 2011.

"I'm excited for our guys and our program," Miller said. "It was our first time on a national stage, and I thought our guys performed well. I didn't like how we started the game in terms of our offensive execution and what we believe in defensively. After the first eight minutes or so, our team really started trying to guard the right way. That's something we're trying to build our program on, and I thought we did a nice job against a real good team. We held a top-15 team to under 30 percent from the field and 14 percent from deep."

Kofi Cockburn, arguably the nation's top player, had 12 points in the first eight minutes as Illinois built a 23-8 lead. UC pulled within 24-17 at the 7:25 mark, making five of seven field goals in the process. The Illini also went the next 6:44 until their next field goal, as the Bearcats pulled within 26-22 before that dunk at 5:12.

Viktor Lakhin's put-back dunk off his own miss gave Cincinnati its first lead of the night, 30-29, at the 2:04 mark.

Saunders had a team-high 11 points at the break, as UC led 34-31, and finished with a career-high 20. He had 19 against Memphis last season as a freshman.

Jeremiah Davenport poured in eight of the Bearcats' first 12 second-half points, including a three at the top of the key from Abdul Ado, that forced an Illini timeout at 16:54, trailing 46-35.

Illinois had a 9:48 field-goal drought as UC built a 17-1 run during that time. It was ended by a Cockburn layup but answered by one from DeJulius on the succeeding possession for a 58-38 lead at 8:29.

Cincinnati will take on the winner of Arkansas and Kansas State at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday night for the championship.

CINCINNATI HEAD COACH WES MILLER

Wes Miller was named the 28th University of Cincinnati men's basketball head coach on April 14, 2021.

Miller comes to UC after a decade as the head coach at UNC Greensboro.

Regarded as one of the top young coaches in college basketball, Miller built the Spartans into perennial championship and NCAA Tournament contenders, was named as ESPN.com's No. 1 Coach Under 40 in May 2020 and also was tabbed for The Athletic's 40 Under 40 list a year ago. His 185-career wins coming into the 2021-22 season also put him in the national lead for coaches under 40, ahead of LSU's Will Wade (177) and New Mexico's Richard Pitino (159).

"I am incredibly excited to welcome Wes into the Bearcats family," Cunningham said. "He is an extremely dynamic coach and mentor who impressed me with his drive, focus and attention to detail. He's a proven winner as a head coach and was able to rebuild a program and lead a remarkable turnaround at UNCG over the last decade. We cast a very wide net in this search and Wes emerged as the right coach to lead the Bearcats into the future."

"I'm absolutely thrilled to be the head coach at the University of Cincinnati," Miller said. "I'm thankful for President Pinto and [AD] John Cunningham for bringing me into the Bearcats family. I am honored to lead such a storied program and excited to get to work. I also can't thank UNCG enough because I wouldn't be here without my players and athletic director Kim Record. This last decade coaching the Spartans has been extremely rewarding."

Miller's collegiate head coach and mentor Roy Williams had high praise for his former player.

"Wes Miller is one of the most outstanding young coaches in our game and what he did at UNC- Greensboro makes me believe he is THE most outstanding," Williams said. "As a player at North Carolina he came closer to reaching his full potential than any player I've ever coached. His energy, his determination, his intelligence and his care for young people convinces me that he will continue at that level. I am so happy for him and the University of Cincinnati Basketball program and I look forward to being in the stands!"

AT UNCG

• The Spartans all-time winningest head coach, Miller totaled 185 wins in 10 seasons with four Southern Conference Regular-Season Championships. Over the last five years, UNCG has five-straight 20-win seasons, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT appearances, two Southern Conference Tournament Championships, 125 wins and 70-20 record in conference play.

- UNCG won 21 games during the 2020-21 season along with the SoCon regular season and tournament championship and earned its second NCAA Tournament appearance in four years.
- The Spartans won 20 or more games in each of the last five seasons, including a program record 29 in 2018-19. Miller led UNCG to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2017-18 and 2020-21.

AS AN ASSISTANT COACH

- Miller, who also spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at UNCG, also spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Elon and High Point. Miller also ran his own basketball camps in Charlotte and Greensboro for two summers.

PLAYING DAYS

- In three seasons as a player at North Carolina under Coach Williams, Miller helped the Tar Heels to the national championship in 2005, two Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title.
- He was team captain as a senior in 2006-07, leading UNC to 31 wins and the NCAA Elite 8 as well as the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and a final No. 3 national ranking.
- A fan favorite at UNC, Miller authored a book entitled The Road to Blue Heaven, which was published as a diary of his experiences as a North Carolina basketball player.
- In addition to his success on the floor, Miller excelled off the court, earning ACC Academic Honor Roll recognition and the UNC Athletic Director's Scholar Athlete-Award. He earned his degree in political science from North Carolina in 2007.
- Upon his graduation from North Carolina, Miller played one season of professional basketball for the London Capitals of the British Basketball League, where he averaged 19.6 points per game to rank eighth in the league.
- Miller was a prep standout at the New Hampton School in New Hampshire. He earned a scholarship to James Madison University, where he played one season before transferring to North Carolina to become a walk-on for Coach Williams' squad.

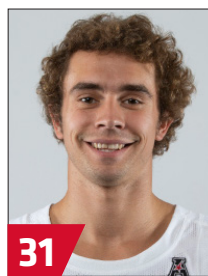

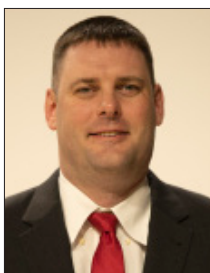
