THE GAME

Following a 64-58 season-opening defeat to UNLV in its season opener, Gardner-Webb traveled directly from Las Vegas to Fayetteville for its second meeting all-time against Arkansas, who enters Saturday's contest ranked No. 16 in the nation. The showdown inside Bud Walton Arena will stream live on SEC Network Plus at 3 p.m. ET (2 p.m. CT) with Josh Haley on play-by-play and former Razorback Ronnie Brewer, Jr. as analyst.

GARDNER-WEBB QUICK LOOK

- ► Head Coach Tim Craft is the third coach in Gardner-Webb history to reach 100 career wins in six seasons. The Tallahassee, Fla., native joined Hall of Famers Eddie Holbrook (141) and Jim Wiles (103) on that list when GWU rallied for an 87-74 over time win against Hampton on January 19, 2019 in Paul Porter Arena.
- ▶ Under Craft, the Runnin' Bulldogs have not endured a losing season in Big South Conference play in his eight seasons. Craft is 81-61 (.570) in the Big South, reaching at least 10 wins in seven of his eight seasons. Gardner-Webb won its final three games of the regular season a year ago to reach 10-10 in Big South play.
- ▶ One season removed from welcoming nine newcomers aboard, Gardner-Webb has reversed script in 2021-2022 by returning nine players this time around, including a core of starters (Kareem Reid, Ludovic Dufeal, Lance Terry) and major role players (D'Maurian Williams, Jordan Sears, Anthony Selden) whose experience and veteran leadership will be relied upon to close out games, a major struggle for the Runnin' Bulldogs in 2020-2021. GWU went 0-3 in one-possession games last season and, in games decided by five points or less, finished 0-6.
- Gardner-Webb enters 2021-2022 on the heels of just its second losing season under Craft. The 'Dogs, who went 11-15 overall and finished in a tie for sixth-place in the Big South, were voted to finish third in the league's South Division this season behind UNC Asheville and Winthrop, the preseason favorite to take this year's crown.
- ► Gardner-Webb opened its season on Wednesday night against UNLV, a 64-58 loss to the Runnin' Rebels inside Thomas & Mack Center. The Runnin' Bulldogs gave UNLV all it could handle, leading for almost eight minutes of the first half and storming back from a nine-point deficit in the second half to nearly steal the game in the final minute. Following a technical foul on a layup opportunity, Lance Terry went to the line for four shots and a chance to take a lead with 47 seconds remaining down 60-57. Terry sunk only one of his four tries, however, as UNLV hit a bucket its next trip down and finished the game on a 4-0 run to seal the win.
- ► The 'Dogs were led by a strong double-double performance from sophomore guard, D'Maurian Williams, who registered his first-career double-double with 21 points and 10 boards. Williams tied a career high in points and set a new career high in rebounds as the Big South Conference All-Freshman Team selection last season poured in 17 second-half points and connected on all three of Gardner-Webb's makes from downtown.
- Craft is not shy about scheduling top-tier opponents during his tenure. Saturday's game will be Gardner-Webb's fifth game against a ranked opponent in the last five seasons, with a second consecutive top-25 team on deck on Tuesday against Duke. GWU's last ranked matchup came on Nov. 15, 2019 at #6 UNC in Chapel Hill.
- Though Gardner-Webb did not place a player on this season's Preseason All-Big South team, the Runnin' Bulldogs do return an All-Freshman team selection in D'Maurian Williams, as well as Big South Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Kareem Reid.

Gardner-Webb has only faced Arkansas once before, a late November showdown in Fayetteville nearly 17 years ago in which the Razorbacks won by 16 ... Four different Runnin' Bulldogs scored in double figures, led by Brian Bender with 17 points and Tim Jennings with 12 points ... GWU shot a serviceable 47.2% from the field and 42.9% from long range, but connected on only 4-of-9 free throws to Arkansas' 17-of-27 tally from the line, which helped to make the difference.
