Series Record: This will be the third-ever meeting between Hofstra and Arkansas in men's basketball. The Razorbacks won both previous meetings in 1974-75 and 1977-78. The first meeting was played in Fayetteville and the second encounter was played in Pine Bluff. Bernard Tomlin led Hofstra with 22 points and John Irving had 10 points and 16 rebounds in the game on December 12, 1974. Doug Swanson had a team-best 22 points in the meeting on January 4, 1978.

Five Averaging 12 Points Per Game: Hofstra is one of only three schools in the entire nation to have five players averaging at least 12 points per game. Syracuse and Weber State are the other schools to achieve this feat.

Consistent Success: The Hofstra men's basketball program has had a consistent level of success, especially recently. Remarkably, prior to the loss at #20 Maryland, Hofstra has not been two games under .500 since March 3, 2017, when it dropped its season finale to Delaware in the opening round of the Colonial Athletic Association Championship to fall to 15-17 that season. Hofstra is one of only 54 programs nationally that had gone at least four full seasons without ever being two games under .500. Among non-Power 5 schools, Hofstra was one of only 21 programs nationally that has gone at least four full seasons without ever being two games under .500.

Ranked Season Opener: This year marked the second consecutive season Hofstra opened the year against a ranked opponent after facing #24 Rutgers in the 2020-21 season lid-lifter.

Overtime: Hofstra's 83-75 season-opening overtime loss to #15 Houston marked the first time the Pride has gone to overtime in a season opener.

Quite The Debut: Graduate student Zach Cooks poured in 26 points in his Hofstra debut at #15 Houston on November 9. It marked the most by a Hofstra player in their debut since Demetrius Dudley had 33 points against Navy on November 23, 1991.

Two Games...Two Shows: Graduate student Zach Cooks followed up his impressive debut with an even better second outing as he scored 29 points in the win over Duquesne on November 13. Cooks is the second Hofstra player in the past 30 years with back-to-back 25-point (or more) performances to start their Pride careers. Demetrius Dudley had 33 (vs. Navy) and 32 points (vs. Lehigh) to open his Hofstra career in 1991.

Farmer Inks NLI: Hofstra University Head Men's Basketball Coach Speedy Claxton announced on November 12 the signing of Khalil Farmer to a National Letter of Intent to begin his academic and athletic career at Hofstra in the Fall of 2022. Farmer, a 6-3 guard, is a native of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and attends Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia. "Khalil is a dynamic guard who will be a great addition to our program," commented Claxton. "He is skilled at multiple levels and his work ethic is second to none. We are thrilled to have him part of the Hofstra family and know our fans will enjoy watching him play." As a sophomore, he averaged 18.2 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. This past season he poured in 18.9 points and 5.9 rebounds per outing in earning Philadelphia Catholic League All-League honors.

It marked the first time Hofstra had six players in double figures since November 9, 2019 when Desure Buie (17), Eli Pemberton (17), Isaac Kante (15), Jalen Ray (14), Omar Silverio (13), and Tareq Coburn (11) all cracked double figures in a 94-74 win over Monmouth.

Defense Without Fouling: In Hofstra's games against Richmond and Molloy, the Pride has committed a TOTAL of only nine personal fouls. Hofstra had four fouls at Richmond and five versus Molloy. Record Are Made To Be Tied: Senior Omar Silverio had a game for the ages against Detroit Mercy on November 27 as he tied the school record for three-pointers in a game with eight on the way to a career-best 28 points. He tied the record established by Brian Bernardi against Canisius in 2015-16 and tied by Jalen Ray a season ago. The eight three-pointers are the seventh-most in an NCAA Division I game this season.

20/20 Vision: Senior Omar Silverio (28) and graduate student Zach Cooks (20) teamed up to lead Hofstra to a victory against Detroit Mercy on November 27. It marked the first time two Hofstra teammates had 20 or more points since Tareq Coburn (21) and Isaac Kante (20) achieved the feat against Towson on February 27, 2020.

Hot Shooting: In the Pride's 98-84 win over Detroit Mercy on November 27, Hofstra shot a stellar 62.5% (35-56) from the field. It was Hofstra's first shooting performance of at least 60% since shooting 60.4% (29-48) at #23 Richmond on December 22, 2020.

Cooks Was Cookin': Graduate student Zach Cooks had 20 points, five rebounds, five assists, and five steals against Detroit Mercy on November 27. He is only the fifth player this season in NCAA Division I to have at least 20 points/5 rebounds/5 assists/5 steals in a game.

Teammates Again, Sort Of: Hofstra graduate student Zach Cooks and redshirt senior Abayomi Iyiola have been on the same team before, sort of. The duo were both members of the 2017-18 ASUN All-Freshman Team. Cooks averaged 8.5 points, 2.2 rebounds, and 2.1 assists per game that season for NJIT, while Iyiola averaged 10.1 points and 6.2 rebounds per game for Stetson.

Fresh Faces: With four newcomers appearing in the starting lineup for Hofstra in the season opener at #15 Houston, it marked the most newcomers in the starting lineup since the 2014-15 season opener when four transfers (Brian Bernardi, Juan'ya Green, Malik Nichols, and Ameen Tanksley) joined Moussa Kone in the starting five against Jacksonville.

Big Bench Production: Senior Omar Silverio poured in 28 points in Hofstra's win over Detroit Mercy on November 27. It was the most points by a Hofstra player off the bench since Justin Wright-Foreman scored 30 points against Rider on December 9, 2017.

Rebounding Machine (?): Graduate student Jalen Ray has led Hofstra in scoring 15 times in his career...but never prior to the Pride's game against Princeton on December 1 had Ray ever led or tied for the team lead in rebounding. His seven rebounds were a team-high in the 81-77 victory over the Tigers marking the first time in his then 129-game career that he led Hofstra in rebounding in a game. Ray would follow that game up and lead the Pride with seven rebounds against Bucknell and eight at Stony Brook.

Perfect From The Line: In the Pride's 81-77 win over Princeton on December 1, Hofstra was a perfect 10-10 from the free throw line. It marked the first time that Hofstra was perfect from the free throw line, with a minimum of 10 attempts, since going 15-15 against Delaware in a 79-60 win on February 26, 2011.

Silverio Is On Fire: Senior Omar Silverio keyed Hofstra's recent four-game win streak with his strong shooting on the court. During the four-game stretch, Silverio shot 54% (23-43) from the field overall and 52% (17-33) from three-point range. He scored in double figures in all four games and averaged 18.3 points per game during the stretch.

Lockdown Defense: Hofstra held Molloy to only 49 points in the Pride's 87-49 victory over the Lions on November 24. It marked the first time Hofstra has held an opponent below 50 points since holding Drexel to 43 in a 61-43 win on March 8, 2020.

Nearly Records: In Hofstra's 102-51 win over John Jay on December 12, the Pride came close to a pair of program records as they compiled 28 assists and 21 steals in the game. The 28 assists was two shy of tying the 2019-20 team, which had 30 assists against New York Tech that season. The 21 steals was one shy of tying the 1992-93 team, which had 22 steals against Central Connecticut State.

20 x 3: In Hofstra's win over John Jay on December 12, Hofstra had three players with at least 20 points as sophomore Darlimestone Dubar had 24, graduate student Jalen Ray tallied 22, and senior Omar Silverio chipped in with 20. It marked the first time since January 21, 2016 that Hofstra had three players with at least 20 points in a game as Juan'ya Green (23), Rokas Gustys (23), and Denton Koon (22) achieved that feat in a 96-92 triple overtime win over Northeastern.

The Century Mark: Hofstra scored 102 points in its win over John Jay on December 12. It marked the first time since a 102-75 win over Elon on January 4, 2000 that the Pride had reached the 100-point plateau in a game.

50-Point Win: The 51 point victory over John Jay on December 12 was Hofstra's largest margin of victory and first win of at least 50 points since a 107-54 win over Rosemont on December 22, 2018.

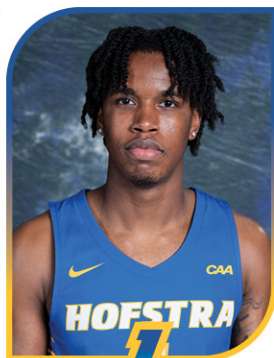
