Cardinal Quick Hits

- The University of Louisville softball team will hit the road for the third straight weekend when the Cardinals head to Fayetteville, Ark. for the Woood Pig Classic. Due to inclement weather in the area, the tournament schedule has been altered from its original format. Louisville will now open tournament play on Sunday, when the Cardinals will on Nebraska and No. 10/8 Arkansas. Louisville will face the Huskers and Razorbacks again on Monday.
- Louisville brings a 7-3 overall record into the weekend after a 3-2 performance in Florida's T-Mobile Tournament. The Cardinals opened the weekend with a 10-7, nine-inning win against Villanova and followed with a 10-0 win over Florida A&M on Friday. Saturday brought a pair of losses against top-15 teams with a 9-1 setback at No. 4/4 Florida and a 6-3 loss to No. 14/14 Duke in a non-conference matchup. The Cards bounced back with a 3-2 eight-inning win against Villanova on Sunday.
- The Cardinals are led offensively by freshman Ally Alexander, who carries a .462 batting average and has reached base safely via a hit or walk in the last five games. Graduate senior Carmyn Greenwood follows closely at a .444 clip with a team-high 16 hits, five doubles, 17 runs and 14 RBI.
- Redshirt senior RHP Taylor Roby has shouldered the bulk of the pitching duties and holds a 2.75 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 28.0 innings of work. She has also belted out a team-best five homers.
- Freshman Easton Lotus has reached base safely via a hit or walk in each of the Cardinals' 10 games.
- The Cardinals return 15 players from last year's team including NFCA All-Southeast Region and All-ACC selections Carmyn Greenwood and Taylor Roby.
- Among the returners are 12 upperclassmen including seven seniors and five juniors, as well as senior transfer Hannah File (James Madison) and graduate transfer Kendall Smith (Western Kentucky).
- Louisville was picked to finish sixth in the ACC in a preseason vote by the league's head coaches.
- Graduate senior Carmyn Greenwood was selected to the Preseason All-ACC Softball team.

THE APRILE ERA

- Holly Aprile is entering her fourth season as UofL's head coach. With the 2020 campaign suspended prior to its midway point due to the outbreak of COVID-19, Aprile has compiled a 73-67-1 record and guided the Cardinals to an NCAA regional final appearance in 2019.
- Prior to her arrival at Louisville, Aprile, 2018 ACC Coach of the Year spent 10 seasons (2009-18) as Pittsburgh's head coach and five years (2004-08) as an assistant. In 2018, she earned ACC Coach of the Year honors after leading the Panthers to the 2018 ACC Coastal Division title and a runner-up finish in the ACC tournament.

Louisville will wrap up a 14-game road swing with a midweek contest at Miami (Ohio) before playing host to Hofstra, Western Michigan and Illinois in the Cardinal Classic which will take place March 4-6 at Ulmer Stadium.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

Louisville vs. No. 10 Arkansas

Series History: Louisville leads 1-0

Last Meeting: Louisville defeated Arkansas 11-5 on Feb. 14, 2015.

Scouting the Razorbacks: No. 10 Arkansas (7-3) is coming off a 13-3 win over Western Illinois at home. The defending SEC champions were picked to finish third in the SEC this season and are led by Preseason All-SEC members Danielle Gibson and Mary Haff. The Razorbacks return 15 players from last year's team that advanced to the Super Regional and welcome the No. 1 signing class in the country. Head coach Courtney Deifel is in her seventh season leading the Razorbacks.

Louisville vs. Nebraska

Series History: Nebraska leads 4-2

Last Meeting: Nebraska defeated Louisville 3-2 in the 2016 NCAA Regional on May 19, 2016.

Scouting the Cornhuskers: Nebraska (6-4) is coming off a 11-1 win over Southeast Louisiana in six innings. The team returns 14 players from a season ago, including all five pitchers, led by senior Courtney Wallace. Nebraska welcomes three newcomers to the roster. Head coach Rhonda Revelle is entering her 30th season at the helm for Nebraska.

CARMYN GREENWOOD SHINES IN T-MOBILE TOURNAMENT

Graduate senior Carmyn Greenwood batted .474 (9-for-16) with 10 RBIs and six runs on the weekend as the Cardinals posted a 3-2 record at Florida's T-Mobile Tournament. The left fielder had at least one hit, run and RBI in four out of five games and finished the weekend with three home runs, three doubles and a 1.105 slugging percentage.

- In the Cardinals' tournament opener against Villanova, Greenwood went 3-for-5 with two home runs, four RBIs and three runs to help Louisville to a 10-7, nine-inning win against the Wildcats. Her two-run homer in the top of the ninth broke a 7-7 tie to put Louisville on top in the eventual win. Greenwood recorded her first collegiate grand slam in the Cardinals' 10-0 win against Florida A&M. In Louisville's loss at No. 4/4 Florida, Greenwood accounted for the Cardinals lone RBI with an RBI double. She also scored a run in the loss to No. 14/14 Duke.

- Greenwood now leads the team with six multi-hit games this season.

T-MOBILE TOURNAMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Louisville 10 - Villanova 7 (9 inn.)

Carmyn Greenwood blasted a two-run homer and Kendall Smith connected on a solo shot in the top of the ninth to lift the University of Louisville to a 10-7 win against Villanova in the first game of Florida's T-Mobile Tournament Friday morning.

- Greenwood and Taylor Roby had two home runs apiece and Kendall Smith added another as the Cardinals totaled five homers in their first game of the day. Greenwood went 3-for-5 with three runs and tied a career high with four RBIs and Roby went 2-for-4 with three RBI and scored twice to lead the Cardinals at the plate. Senior Chardon-nay Harris (2-1) picked up the win after holding the

Wildcats scoreless on one hit and striking out four in 1.2 innings of relief.

Louisville 10- Florida A&M 0 (5 inn.)

- The Cardinals' hot offense continued in a 10-5 five-inning win against Florida A&M. Louisville matched a season high with 12 hits while freshman Easton Lotus paced the team with a 3-for-3 performance at the plate, adding a run, an RBI and a stolen base.

- Carmyn Greenwood matched her career-high four RBI for the second straight game on Friday.

- Greenwood now has a career-high four home runs on the season. Her two homers against FAMU mark her first career multi-homer game. Her four RBI against FAMU also tie her career game high.

No. 4/4 Florida 9 - Louisville 1

- Graduate senior Carmyn Greenwood belted out an RBI double and junior Jenna Servi singled and scored a run, but a five-run sixth inning by Florida propelled the fourth-ranked Gators to a 9-1 win.

No. 14/14 Duke 6 - Louisville 3

- Freshman Ally Alexander went 2-for-3 with a double, a run and an RBI to lead the Cardinals at the plate in a 6-3 loss to No. 14. Duke.

Louisville 3 - Villanova 2 (8 inn.)

- The Cards scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to beat Villanova 3-2 Sunday morning in the final game of the T-Mobile Classic.

- Senior Hannah File's one-out RBI single plated Korbe Otis to cap a three-run inning as Louisville rallied to beat Villanova after trailing 2-0 entering the bottom of the eighth.

- Freshman Korbe Otis drove her first career triple into left centerfield to send Greenwood home, tying the score at 2-2. Otis then scored the game-winning run on File's walk-off hit.

- Greenwood went 3-for-4 with a double, a run and an RBI to lead the Cardinals at the plate. Lotus and File tallied two hits apiece. Sophomore Gabby Holloway (2-0) picked up the win, holding the Wildcats scoreless and striking out one in the eighth inning. Roby tossed 7.0 innings and allowed two runs, one earned, on five hits while fanning six.

- Louisville turned two double plays, marking a season high through the first two weeks of play

- The Cardinals are now 2-0 in extra inning games this season (both against Villanova)

- Freshman Easton Lotus has reached via a hit or walk in each of Louisville's 10 games.

CHUNG COMING IN CLUTCH

Rebecca Chung connected on a pinch-hit RBI single to help give the Cardinals a 2-0 win against FAU on Feb. 10. It's not the first time she has delivered a clutch hit for the Cardinals. She is currently batting .400 (2-for-5) on the season as a pinch hitter with an RBI single and a double.

Holly Aprile enters her fourth season as the head coach of the University of Louisville softball team.

Aprile's Cardinals enjoyed a successful in the 2019 campaign which was highlighted by an at-large bid to the NCAA tournament and a regional final appearance. The team amassed a 35-23 overall record and a 12-12 mark in ACC play for a third place finish in the league's Atlantic Division and fifth in the overall conference standings. Louisville's 35 wins marked the most victories in a season since 2016 when the Cards posted a 35-17 record.

Aprile became just the second head coach in the history of UofL softball following the retirement of Sandy Pearsall who started the program in 2000.

"First, I have tremendous respect for Sandy Pearsall and the program that she built," said Aprile. "There is a strong tradition of winning at Louisville and I am honored to become a part of it. I have competed against UofL both in the Big East and in the ACC, and there have been some extremely talented student-athletes that have come through the program. My goal is to build upon the solid foundation that is here and elevate it to new heights. I want to win championships and I know that the administration, Vince [Tyra] and Amy [Calabrese] are firmly committed to that as well. The facilities are first-class, the resources are tremendous, and I am so grateful for the opportunity to be a part of all that the University of Louisville has to offer."

Before Louisville

Aprile comes to Louisville from the University of Pittsburgh, where she spent 10 seasons (2009-18) as the Panthers' head coach and five years (2004-08) as an assistant. This past season, she earned ACC Coach of the Year honors after leading Pitt to the 2018 ACC Coastal Division title and a runner-up finish in the conference tournament where it fell in the championship game to eventual national champion Florida State.

Pitt finished the 2018 campaign with a 33-18-1 overall record, marking the program's third 30-win season in four years. The Coastal Division champions notched a program-best 16-6 mark in ACC play while winning seven of their eight conference series. During the regular season, the Panthers defeated then-No. 9/13 Florida State 1-0 in Tallahassee, halting the Seminoles' 36-game ACC win streak and marking Pitt's first victory over the perennial conference power.

Under Aprile's direction, Pitt achieved several milestones while making the transition from the BIG EAST Conference to the ACC. In 2015, she guided her team to the championship game of the ACC Tournament for the first time in school history. The Panthers went on to earn their first NCAA bid and advanced to

the regional finals. After finishing the season with a program-best 37 wins, Aprile and her assistants garnered National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Mid-Atlantic Region Coaching Staff of the Year honors.

While at the helm, Aprile guided Pittsburgh to 271 wins and oversaw 12 NFCA All-Region selections and 13 All-ACC selections, with eight players earning ACC All-Tournament nods. Her teams and players have put up impressive numbers, leading the ACC in fielding percentage (.975) in 2017 and home runs (75), slugging percentage (.552) and doubles (82) in 2016. In the past four seasons, her teams have continually set school records in wins, hits, batting average, RBI, home runs, runs scored and shutouts.

Success Off the Field

Aprile's student-athletes have also been successful in the classroom with 19 NFCA Scholar-Athlete selections and 10 ACC All-Academic honorees. Additionally, her teams achieved perfect scores in the NCAA Public Recognition Awards for Academic Progress Rates in 2017 and 2018.

As an Assistant

Before being named the Panthers' head coach in July 2008, she served as an assistant coach at Pitt for five years, helping the program produce its first winning season in school history and earn its first BIG EAST Conference tournament berth.

Prior to her arrival in Pittsburgh, Aprile was an assistant coach at South Carolina, where she was the recruiting coordinator and assisted in the development of the team's offense while working specifically with the pitchers and outfielders. During her nine-year stint in Columbia, she helped direct the Gamecocks to five Southeastern Conference titles, five NCAA Regional appearances and a Women's College World Series appearance in 1997.

Aprile began her coaching career at Eastern Illinois, where she served as a graduate assistant coach for two seasons working primarily with the pitchers and the outfielders.

Playing Career

As a player, Aprile built an impressive resume at the University of Massachusetts, where she was a four-year all-Atlantic 10 selection. As a senior, she was the Most Valuable Player for the Minutewomen softball team that finished third in the 1992 Women's College World Series and was selected to the WCWS All-Tournament team. That same year, she earned third-team All-America honors. Aprile produced stellar results both as a pitcher and an outfielder, earning Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Year (1989), Player of the Year (1990 and 1991) and Pitcher of the Year (1992).

Aprile was a participant on USA Softball's national team for seven years (1993-99). During that time, she helped Team USA to gold medals in the Pan-American Qualifiers in 1994 and 1997 and the South Pacific Classic in 1998.

The Afton, N.Y., native earned her bachelor's in sports management from UMass in 1992 and received her master's degree in political science from Eastern Illinois in 1995.
