GYMBACK NOTABLES

Arkansas Posts Third-Highest Season Score In Missouri Tri-Meet

The No. 16 Gymbacks competed in their second road meet of the season on Feb. 20 and also set a new season road high with a final score of 196.800 against No. 11 Missouri and No. 5 LSU.

While both sets of Tigers came out ahead of the Hogs, Arkansas still outscored its season average of 196.370 by nearly half a point. The Hogs also posted a 49+ on all events for the third time this season and their second-highest event scores on bars (49.350) and beam (49.325).

Arkansas' freshmen and veterans again proved to be big players for the team. Senior Bailey Lovett got the Hogs off to a good start on floor with a 9.900 to tie for second place, and rookie Makie Sedlacek followed with a 9.900 on vault in the second rotation for a new career high and third place.

Freshman Maddie Jones continues to excel week to week and posted a 9.925 on bars for a new personal best, second place and her second top three finish in two weeks. Senior Amanda Elswick rounded out the podium finishes for Arkansas with a 9.925 to take second as the anchor on beam.

Newcomers And Floor Shine, Arkansas Falls Short To KentuckyArkansas hosted its third-annual Women's Empowerment Night on Feb. 11 and saw its second-biggest crowd of the season, but the Gymbacks came up short to the Kentucky Wildcats by a final margin of 195.675–196.700.

Arkansas was without senior all–arounder Kennedy Hambrick on the evening, but still had plenty of bright spots on the night, especially from the team's freshmen. Maddie Jones competed on two events and matched her career high on bars with a 9.850 and set a new one on floor with a mark of 9.900 for the event title, the first in her career as a Hog. Makenzie Sedlacek and Leah Smith also posted scores of 9.8+ on vault, and Kalyxta Gamiao made her Arkansas debut on beam and earned a 9.825.

Graduate student and All-American Maggie O'Hara bounced back in a big way after falls on bars in the last two weeks and put up a 9.925 for her second event title of the season. Senior Bailey Lovett shined again as the floor anchor and posted a 9.900 to cap the meet and share first place on the event with Jones.

"Despite some of the falls, we did have quite a few highlights. Maggie coming back on bars and changing her routine and hitting it was awesome," head coach Jordyn Wieber said. "Vault was right where it needed to be, consistent with controlled landings; but we've got to stay on the equipment to put up a score, so we're going to go back to the gym and practice and address and work on, and hopefully we'll come back next Sunday at Mizzou a little more confident than we were tonight."

A total of 4,139 fans were in attendance at Barnhill Arena on Friday, which included an energetic student section that helped propel the Gymbacks all night, including on floor. Arkansas posted a 49.375 on the event to extend its streak of 49+ on floor to 37 meets.

The team also recognized its alumni and celebrated women's empowerment yet again on Friday, which included special themed warm-up leotards for Arkansas and an in-meet introduction of the Gymbacks who made the program what it is today, including first head coach and Wieber's predecessor, Mark Cook.

Gymbacks Set New Personal Highs, Win On Equality Night

Despite a change in the schedule and a new opponent, the Gymbacks returned to Barnhill Arena on Feb. 6 for Equality Night and came away with a big win over SEMO, 197.050–194.150.

A highlight of the day was the all-around victory from freshman Leah Smith, her first at Arkansas, with a final score of 39.425. She recorded new personal bests on vault (9.850) and floor (9.875) and matched her high on bars (9.850)

Arkansas swept the event titles on its way to the meet win. Senior Kennedy Hambrick earned first place on vault (9.925), beam (9.975) and floor (9.950), all of which were season highs and a new career high on beam. Sixth–year Gymback Sarah Shaffer claimed the top spot on bars with a 9.925, which ties her personal best. The Hogs also took second and third on vault and floor.

It was also the first–ever Equality Night for the team, complete with a pre–meet celebration of what equality means to them and special Black History Month and Be True t–shirts, along with a weeklong campaign spotlighting community art that illustrates diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Gymbacks Set New Attendance Record At Night In The Palace Meet
It was a Friday night like no other as the Gymbacks hosted a meet in Bud Walton Arena for the first time on Jan. 14 and shattered the program attendance record with 10,345

The previous record was set at Barnhill Arena on Jan. 17, 2020, which was head Coach Jordyn Wieber's home debut at Arkansas

Wieber had set a goal of 10,000 fans for the meet, but was extremely pleased with the showing from the Arkansas faithful.

"I knew that 10,000 was a lofty goal, and that's totally my style. But to exceed it was really amazing," Wieber said.
"I'm just so overwhelmed at the support for our student—athletes and for this program, and from our athletic department for allowing us to have a meet in Bud Walton; not only the crowd, but the energy, the atmosphere. It was so special. Chills just thinking about it."

The Razorbacks were edged by the Auburn Tigers by just one-half of a tenth with a final score of 197.250–197.200. Despite the loss, Arkansas has never scored over 197 in the first two weeks of any season, and it was the sixth-highest team score in program history.

The Gymbacks posted 49-plus on each of the four events and defeated Auburn on bars with a 49.550, which ties the second-best bars score in program history.

Senior Kennedy Hambrick won her second all—around title in as many weeks with a score of 39.525 and also took the title on beam with a 9.950. She finished in second on floor (9.875) and third on bars (9.925). Freshman Lean Smith made her collegiate all-around debut and came in third with a score of 39.175.

Arkansas Reaches New Program Beam Record In Loss To Gators
Arkansas gymnastics kicked off its road schedule with an SEC dual in Gainesville on Jan. 28, and while the Gymbacks came up short for the meet victory, they still made some history is the process.

No. 11 Arkansas Opens Season With Win Over No. 22 Ohio State

In their return to Barnhill Arena on Jan. 7, the No. 11 Gymbacks earned their first season-opening win since 2014 with a victory over the No. 22 Ohio State.

Arkansas posted a final score of 195.450, while the Buckeyes earned a 195.025. Arkansas outscored Ohio State on each event, and senior Kennedy Hambrick earned the all—around crown with a score of 39.350. Hambrick

ROSS JOINS STAFF AS VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT

The Gymbacks also bolstered the coaching staff for 2021 with the addition of Kyla Ross as a volunteer assistant coach. Ross. a 2012 Olympic gold medalist and 11—time UCLA All—American, comes to Arkansas after one season as an undergraduate assistant coach for the Bruins, which followed a historic career as a student-athlete.

Ross and Wieber have a decorated history as members of the "Fierce Five" squad that won team gold at the 2012 Summer Olympics in London. The two also spent several years at UCLA together while Wieber served as a team manager and volunteer assistant coach and Ross competed on the team, from 2016 to 2019.

While finishing her undergraduate degree in molecular, cell and developmental biology, Ross served as an under-graduate assistant coach at UCLA for the 2020–21 season. She helped lead the Bruins to the regional final, and six gymnasts received All-Pac-12 honors.

Before beginning her coaching journey, Ross cemented herself as one of the most successful gymnasts in NCAA history — from her collegiate debut against Arkansas in 2017, to her final meet in 2020. She won NCAA titles in each season that the championships were held during her career (canceled in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic) with one on each event, in addition to UCLA's team first place finish in 2018. This made Ross the first female gymnast to hold Olympic, World and NCAA titles. She's also a two-time Pac-12 all-around, uneven bars and team champion, and she won the 2017 and 2019 Pac-12 beam and floor titles, respectively.

Ross tallied 22 Perfect 10s in her collegiate tenure, which includes two Gym Slams: a 10 on each event. She's one of just 11 gymnasts to achieve a Gym Slam, and the first to record two in the same year (2019). Her 11 uneven bars perfect scores are an NCAA best, and she also holds records for 10s in consecutive meets (10 in 2019) and most in one season (14 in 2019).

Ross was the 2020 recipient of the Honda Sports Award, given to the best female collegiate athlete in her sport, and was named Pac-12 Gymnast of the Year in 2019 and 2020.

With the addition of Ross, each member of Arkansas' coaching staff is a former national team member (Wieber, assistant coach Chris Brooks and assistant coach Felicia Hano), three are world team members and Olympians (Ross, Wieber and Brooks), and two are Olympic gold medalists (Ross and Wieber).



JORDYN WIEBER

THIRD-YEAR HEAD COACH

Olympic gold medalist Jordyn Wieber was introduced as the head coach of the Arkansas Women's Gymnastics program on Wednesday, April 24, 2019, by Vice Chancellor and Director of Athletics Hunter Yurachek.

In her first year, Arkansas scored a 49.00 or higher in 14 of 16 events over the course of four home meets, nearly 90 percent of all events. Wieber has coached three regular-season All-Americans in Sophia Carter (2020), Maggie O'Hara (2021) and Kennedy Hambrick (2020, 2021). Under Wieber, the Razorbacks have set an all-time attendance record, all-time team score (197.425 at Auburn on March 5, 2021) and Hambrick became the new all-around score record holder with an impressive 39.750 vs Missouri on Feb. 19, 2021.

In the post-season, the Gymbacks earned their first-ever spot in the SEC night session and advanced to the second day of NCAA Regionals after scoring a post-season program best 197.250 on day one. In total, Arkansas registered fives scores of 197.000 or better in 2021 for the first time in program history.

In 2020, the Gymbacks ranked as high as fourth in the nation on floor and finished the season ninth in the nation. It was against No. 13 Kentucky on Jan. 24 that Arkansas scored a 49.525 on the floor, the second-highest event total in program history. Headed into 2022, Arkansas is holding onto the third-longest active streak for meets with a score of 49.000 or higher, coming in with 32 straight meets, behind Alabama (33) and Florida (37).

The Razorbacks' success on the floor helped them lock in back-to-back SEC wins against No. 20 Missouri and No. 10 Georgia mid-way through the season. The consecutive wins marked the first time since 2017 that Arkansas won two-straight conference meets and consecutive meets against a ranked opponent.

During her first season at the helm, Wieber coached two regular-season All-Americans in Sophia Carter and Kennedy Hambrick. Carter finished the season ranked 11th on the floor while Hambrick closed out her sophomore campaign ranked 16th in the all-around. Arkansas saw six Gymbacks wrap up the season ranked in the top 100 by Road to Nationals in at least one event, with four Hogs finishing with multiple top 100 rankings. With Wieber's lead, Arkansas won 27 event titles through 10 meets. Hambrick finished the season with the most individual titles among the Gymbacks, securing 11 event titles including a team-high four all-around titles.

The first home meet of the Wieber era was held on Jan. 17 against No.3 Denver, bringing a record crowd of 6,714 fans to Barnhill Arena. On Feb. 21, Coach Wieber and her Arkansas squad hosted Auburn for a Women's Empowerment Meet, the first of its kind in NCAA gymnastics. 5,224 fans gathered at Barnhill Arena for Women's Empowerment Night, the ninth highest attendance in program history, making it the third top-10 attendance for 2020 alone. All-in-all, 21,661 fans saw the Gymbacks in action in Barnhill in 2020. The average



attendance of 5,415 fans per meet is a program record, approximately 2,400 more than the 2019 average and over 1,000 more than the previous record, set in year two (2004), when an average of 4,401 Gymback fans attended each meet. The Razorbacks finished ninth in the nation for average attendance, making it the ninth time Arkansas finished the season ranked in the top-10 for attendance.

Beyond the gym, Wieber has served as an outspoken advocate for victims of child sexual abuse. Wieber has used the platform of gymnastics to encourage and inspire generations of young girls and others around the nation.

Wieber is a familiar name in the gymnastics community after a prolific career as a competitor, including earning a gold medal as part of Team USA in the 2012 Olympics. After finishing her competitive career, Wieber served as an assistant for legendary UCLA coach Valorie Kondos Field, helping lead the Bruins to the 2018 NCAA Championship.

Wieber coached the Bruins on floor exercise, an event in which UCLA finished the 2018 and 2019 regular seasons ranked No. 1 in the nation. In 2019, the Bruins recorded scores of 49.5 or better in 11 of 14 meets, averaging a national-best 49.604 on floor. UCLA hit a season-high 49.825 on March 16, which ranks No. 3 all-time in school history, behind five scores of 9.925 or better in that meet, including two perfect 10s. The floor squad also posted marks of 49.775 (March 23) and 49.750 (Feb. 16) over the course of the year, as four Bruins earned regular season All-America honors in the event - Katelyn Ohashi, Kyla Ross, Gracie Kramer and Felicia Hano.

At the NCAA Championships on April 19–20, 2019, Wieber coached Ross to the individual floor title with a score of 9.950, the program's second in as many years after Ohashi took home the crown in 2018. After winning their semifinal session with a 197.650 (49.6125 in the floor), UCLA finished third overall in the finals.

The 2018 Bruins scored 49.4 or higher in 11 meets and 49.6 or higher in three meets, including a national season-high of 49.775 set Feb. 25. She and her fellow UCLA coaches were named the 2018 West Region Assistant Coaches of the Year, as they helped lead the Bruins to Pac-12, NCAA regional and NCAA national titles.

Wieber, who has been a vocal advocate for safe sport, has won several awards over the past few years, including the Arthur Ashe Courage Award at the ESPYs, the Rising Star Award by the Los Angeles Business Journal, and the Giant Steps A Hero Among Us Award.

A member of the "Fierce Five" United States squad that won team gold at the 2012 Olympics, Wieber was a two-time U.S. allaround champion (2011 and 2012) and the 2011 World all-around champion. Her illustrious Elite career included three medals (all-around and team gold, beam bronze) at the 2011 World Championships, four U.S. senior national titles (all-around, bars and floor in 2011 and all-around in 2012). She was also the 2008 U.S. junior all-around, vault and floor exercise champion and the American Cup all-around champion in 2009, 2011 and 2012. She dominated the competition at the 2010 Pacific Rim Championships, winning four gold medals (all-around, uneven bars, floor exercise, team) and one silver (vault). In her first international competition at the 2007 Junior Pan American Championships, she won gold medals on uneven bars and balance beam, silver in the all-around and bronze on floor exercise. Wieber officially retired from competitive gymnastics in 2015.

Wieber, from DeWitt, Mich., graduated from UCLA in 2017 with a degree in Psychology. She was a 2016 inductee into the Greater Lansing Sports Hall of Fame, a 2021 Michigan Sports Hall of Fame Inductee and is also a member of the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame as a member of the 2012 U.S. Olympic team.
