LEADING OFF

- » **STANFORD** entered the week ranked No. 4 in the nation according to the NCBWA and No. 5 according to *Collegiate Baseball* and *Baseball America* ... the Cardinal is also No. 6 according to D1Baseball and No. 10 in the College Baseball Foundation poll ... has recorded two shutouts in its first four games for the first time since managing the same feat in 1996 ... finished last season ranked No. 5 according to *Collegiate Baseball* and in the NCBWA poll, No. 7 according to *Baseball America* and the USA Today Coaches poll, and No. 8 according to D1Baseball ... made its 17th College World Series appearance, including its first since 2008, a year ago ... became one of three programs to have hosted an NCAA Regional in each of the last four seasons, joining Arkansas and Texas Tech ... dropped just one weekend series in the regular season (12-1) last year - posting notable series wins over UC Irvine, UCLA, Arizona State, Arizona, Oregon and Oregon State ... dropped back-to-back games just once in 2021 ... hit 22 home runs in the postseason last year - the most of any team in the field.
- » **DREW BOWSER** drove in 41 runs to rank third on the team, compiling 11 multi-RBI games last year ... led the team with 16 doubles a year ago ... batted .315 (34 for 108) with 11 runs scored, nine doubles, five homers and 24 RBIs in Pac-12 play.
- » **JOEY DIXON** was named All-Pac-12 honorable mention a year ago ... logged 10 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings over five appearances from May 15-28, compiling a win and a save over the span ... 1-1 with two saves and a 1.59 ERA over 21 career relief appearances (6 ER in 34 IP).
- » **DAVID ESQUER** won his 100th game at the helm of the program on March 4, 2021 as Stanford walked off with a 7-6 victory over San Francisco in 10 innings ... has amassed a 138-55 overall record at Stanford and owns a 663-522-2 record as a Division I head coach (18 seasons at California) ... made his eighth postseason appearance as a head coach last year (third with Stanford) ... previously guided California to Omaha in 2011 while earning National Coach of the Year honors.
- » **CARTER GRAHAM** carries a three-game hitting streak into the weekend (.308, 3 R, 2B, RBI)
- » **KODY HUFF** was named 2021 CoSIDA Academic All-District ... hit safely in each of the first nine games (.361, 7 R, 2 2B, HR, 6 RBIs), and had a hit in 38 of the 55 games he played last year ... hit safely in 19 of the final 22 games last year ... reached safely in all but 10 games played last year ... belted a pair of grand slams vs. No. 17 UC Irvine on June 5 to finish 3 for 4 with eight RBIs.
- » **BROCK JONES** is a consensus preseason All-America selection ... is listed on the watch list for USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award and the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award ... named an All-American according to *Baseball America*, D1Baseball and Perfect Game (second team) last year ... named to 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team ... connected for three home runs, including a grand slam, against Texas Tech on June 12, 2021 to total six RBIs and help send Stanford to the College World Series ... hit .361 with 13 runs scored, five doubles, five home runs and 18 RBIs in postseason play last year - the most RBIs of any player in the tournament - and became just the third player since BBCOR bats were adopted in 2011 to have 18 or more postseason RBIs (20 - Adley Rutschman, Oregon State, 2018; Preston Tucker, Florida, 2011) ... reached safely in all but five games last year while hitting .311 with 18 home runs to rank first in the Pac-12 and 16th nationally ... compiled a team-high 62 RBIs, 56 runs scored and a .453 on-base percentage as

a sophomore ... amassed 32 extra-base hits, including 13 doubles and a triple, while compiling a .646 slugging percentage to rank third in the Pac-12 a year ago ... recorded 16 multi-hit and 13 multi-RBI games last season ... finished with 23 runs scored, three doubles, six homers and 22 RBIs in Pac-12 play.

- » **VINCENT MARTINEZ** was named All-Pac-12 honorable mention last season.
- » **BRADEN MONTGOMERY** made his collegiate debut on Opening Day vs. Cal State Fullerton, striking out a pair to record his first career save in a 1-0 shutout victory ... debuted in the field on February 20 and went 3 for 5 with two home runs, six RBIs and three runs scored ... first freshman with a multi-homer game since Alex Blandino hit two vs. Arizona State on April 20, 2012 ... is hitting .500 (4 for 8) with four runs scored, two homers and seven RBIs in his last two games.
- » **EDDIE PARK** has hit safely in all four games this year ... went 3 for 3 with two walks vs. Cal State Fullerton on February 20.
- » **TOMMY TROY** batted .297 (19 for 64) with 11 runs scored, two doubles, four homers and 11 RBIs in Pac-12 play a year ago.

THIS WEEK

- » No. 6 Stanford will travel to Round Rock, Texas for the 2022 Karbach Round Rock Classic.
- » The tournament will feature No. 6 Stanford, No. 2 Arkansas, Louisiana and Indiana.
- » Every game from the tournament will be broadcast on FloBaseball.
- » The Cardinal last competed at the Round Rock Classic in 2020 - going 0-3 against Houston, No. 6 Texas Tech and Tennessee.

UP NEXT

- » After the three games in Round Rock, Stanford will stay in Texas and visit UTSA for a Monday game at 11 a.m. PT.
- » Stanford will then return home to host CSUN in a three-game series starting on Friday, March 4.

A LOOK BACK

- » Stanford won a three-game series over Cal State Fullerton last weekend to open the 2022 season.
- » The Cardinal posted a 1-0 shutout victory on Opening Day - the first 1-0 victory to open a season since January 29, 1999 vs. Fresno State.
- » Stanford was shut out 11-0 on Saturday - the first home shutout since a 4-0 setback vs. Texas on March 7, 2019.
- » The Cardinal won the rubber game of the series on Sunday, exploding for 11 runs on 15 hits to back a strong start from sophomore Drew Dowd.
- » Freshman Braden Montgomery led the way on Sunday, batting 3 for 5 with two homers and six RBIs.
- » Sophomore Eddie Park hit safely in all three games and reached in all five plate appearances in the finale (3 for 3, 2 BB).
- » Dowd earned the Sunday victory after tossing 5 2/3 innings and allowing just one run on three hits with four strikeouts.
- » Freshman Ty Uber tossed four scoreless innings in his first collegiate start on Tuesday night, guiding Stanford to a 5-0 shutout victory over Santa Clara ... Uber allowed just two hits and one walk while striking out five over his four frames.
- » Stanford's offense scored the five runs on nine hits while leaving 12 runners on base.
- » Junior Brock Jones finished 2 for 3 with three RBIs, a double, a triple and two walks ... Jones plated the first runs of the game in the fourth inning with a bases-clearing three-RBI double.

HANGING ZEROES

- » The Cardinal has posted two shutouts in its first four games for the first time since 1996.
- » Five pitchers combined in each shutout this year, with Ty Uber, Joey Dixon and Braden Montgomery contributing to both.
- » Stanford has allowed just one run over the last 20 innings pitched entering the Round Rock Classic.

THE 2021 SEASON

- » Stanford finished the 2021 season 39-17 and 17-10 in Pac-12 play to claim third place in the conference standings.
- » The Cardinal made its 17th College World Series appearance, including its first since 2008.
- » Stanford dropped the opener in Omaha to NC State before rebounding to defeat Arizona in its second game.
- » The Cardinal's magical run ended one game later as Vanderbilt rallied to defeat Stanford in the bottom of the ninth.
- » Stanford dropped back-to-back games just once in 2021 and finished the year 12-1 in weekend series.
- » Senior Brendan Beck was a unanimous All-American and was named 2021 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year ... went 9-3 with a 3.15 ERA (fifth in Pac-12) over 17 appearances and 15 starts ... struck out a Pac-12 best 143 compared to 26 walks over 108 2/3 innings of work, finishing with a 5.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 11.84 strikeouts per nine innings ... 143 strikeouts were the most for a Cardinal in a single season since John Hudgins in 2003 (143), and the fourth-most strikeouts in the nation.
- » Sophomore Brock Jones and senior Zach Grech also earned All-America honors ... Grech led the Pac-12 and ranked fourth in the nation in saves with 13.
- » Eight Cardinal players claimed All-Conference recognition, while Grech also earned Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.
- » Holding the highest GPA of any player in Omaha, Owen Cobb secured the prestigious NCAA Elite 90 Award.
- » The Cardinal's 85 home runs were the eighth-most in Stanford history, while the .979 fielding percentage was the third-best in program history.

CARDINAL TABBED FAVORITE IN PRESEASON POLL

- » Coming off its first College World Series appearance since 2008, Stanford was voted the preseason favorite to win the 2022 conference title according to the Pac-12 coaches.
- » The Cardinal received eight first-place votes and 98 points to finish atop the poll for the first time since 2013.
- » Stanford, which last won the conference title in 2018, began the year ranked in the top 10 in all six national polls - including a No. 5 ranking in the USA Today baseball coaches poll.
- » Oregon State picked up one first-place vote and 84 points to finish second in the poll, followed by defending Pac-12 champion Arizona in third with 77 points.
- » UCLA received two first-place votes and 75 points to finish fourth in the poll, with Oregon (70 points) placing fifth.
- » Rounding out the poll were California (53 points), Arizona State (46 points), USC and Washington State (34 points apiece), Washington (19 points) and Utah (15 points).

A STACKED PAC

- » Perennially one of the top conferences in the nation, the Pac-12 boasted five teams in the top 25 of a major poll to open the season.
- » Stanford carried a top 10 ranking in each of the major preseason polls - topping out at No. 5 according to *Collegiate Baseball*, NCBWA and the USA Today Coaches poll.
- » Oregon State entered the year ranked as high as No. 11 according to *Baseball America*, while Arizona was tabbed a top 10 team according to the NCBWA.
- » UCLA was ranked as high as No. 18 according to *Collegiate Baseball*, while Oregon checked in at No. 21 in that same poll.
- » Six Pac-12 programs were selected to the 2021 NCAA Baseball Championship, including Arizona, Oregon and Stanford among the top-16 national seeds to host regional play.
- » Arizona and Stanford each reached the College World Series, with the Wildcats topping Ole Miss in a Super Regional.
- » Last year was the first since 2013 that the Pac-12 had multiple teams in Omaha in the same season (UCLA & Oregon State).
- » The Pac-12's six bids were tied for the second-most in Conference history (2011, 2015), trailing only the eight from 2010.
- » Pac-12 programs have combined to win 29 of the 74 NCAA baseball championships all-time, 15 more than the next closest conference ... the league also boasts nine Golden Spikes Award winners, tied for the most all-time, and paces its peers with eight No. 1 overall MLB Draft picks, including in four of the past 11 drafts and two of the past three.
- » The Conference has had a representative in all but seven NCAA College World Series fields since the championship began in 1947 ... a Pac-12 team has finished either first or second in 39 of those championships.
- » Pac-12 programs account for six of the 15 schools that have captured multiple college baseball national championships - double the number of schools of any other conference.

BROCK JONES IS ONE TO WATCH

- » Junior Brock Jones is listed on the watch list for USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award and the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award.
- » Jones is one of 55 players on the preseason Golden Spikes Award watch list, beginning the process of identifying the top amateur baseball player in the country for the 2022 season.
- » Sixteen different collegiate athletic conferences are represented on the 2022 preseason watch list with six of those conferences boasting multiple selections, including the Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Big West, Colonial Athletic Association, Pac-12, and Southeastern Conferences.
- » There are a total of seven players on the list from the Pac-12, with California (Dylan Beavers & Josh White) and Arizona State (Ethan Long & Sean McLain) each boasting two ... Jones is also joined by Max Rajcic (UCLA) and Daniel Susac (Arizona).
- » Amateur baseball fans will be able to vote for their favorite players on GoldenSpikesAward.com, starting on May 24 with the naming of the Golden Spikes Award semifinalists ... USA Baseball will announce the finalists for the award on June 8 and fan voting will open at GoldenSpikesAward.com concurrently, remaining open through June 12.
- » The Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award (BBCSA) watch list consists of 44 players representing 18 conferences.
- » The BBCSA started out in 2017 as an honor going to the top college hitter in Texas ... in 2019, the award expanded as a regional award covering Division I programs in Texas, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico and Oklahoma ... the BBCSA became a national award in 2020; however, no winner was announced due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- » Six players from the Pac-12 are on the watch list for the BBCSA, including Jones, Dylan Beavers (California), Cole Elvis (California), Josh Kasevich (Oregon), Tanner Smith (Oregon) and Daniel Susac (Arizona).
- » The winner of the BBCSA will be announced in June and honored at a gala in the fall at the Fort Worth Club.

PAC-12 ANNOUNCES PAC-12 BASEBALL TOURNAMENT

- » The Pac-12 announced the creation of a Conference championship event for baseball in partnership with the City of Scottsdale and The Arizona Sports & Entertainment Commission on August 25, 2021.
- » The inaugural Pac-12 Baseball Tournament is scheduled for May 25-29, 2022 at Scottsdale Stadium ... the Pac-12's initial agreement with the City of Scottsdale runs through 2024.
- » "The Pac-12 Baseball Tournament is a marquee event that will serve to enhance the exposure of the Conference's baseball programs with competitive, late-season matchups prior to NCAA Tournament selections," Pac-12 Commissioner George Kliavkoff said. "It will also provide student-athletes with a first-class experience and the opportunity to compete for a championship in a premier destination for the sport on the West Coast. A lot of work has gone into the creation of this tournament and we are grateful for the partnership of the City of Scottsdale and The Arizona Sports & Entertainment Commission in making it a reality."
- » The double-elimination tournament will be spread over five days at the Spring Training home of the San Francisco Giants ... the top eight teams in the Conference standings at the conclusion of the regular season will earn berths in the Pac-12 Baseball Tournament, from which the champion will receive the Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

JONESING FOR MORE ON BROCK JONES?

- » Junior Brock Jones is a consensus preseason All-America selection, earning a spot on the first team according to *Collegiate Baseball*, Perfect Game, D1Baseball and the NCBWA, and a second-team selection from *Baseball America*.
- » Jones, who competed last summer with USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team, was a second-team All-American according to Baseball America, Perfect Game and D1Baseball a year ago.
- » Reached safely in all but five games last year while hitting .311 with 18 home runs to rank first in the Pac-12 and 16th nationally.
- » Compiled a team-high 62 RBIs, 56 runs scored and a .453 on-base percentage while amassing 32 extra-base hits, including 13 doubles and a triple, while finishing with a .646 slugging percentage to rank third in the Pac-12.
- » Showing patience at the plate, Jones walked a team-best 49 times to rank third in the Pac-12 and 11th nationally.
- » Jones was one of two Pac-12 players with 10-plus home runs (18) and 10-plus stolen bases (14) in 2021.
- » In postseason play last year, Jones hit .361 with 13 runs scored, five doubles, five home runs and 18 RBIs - the most RBIs of any player in the tournament ... upon reaching the College World Series, he managed a pair of three-hit games, batting .429 overall with three runs scored, two doubles, two homers and eight RBIs in Omaha to earn a spot on the College World Series All-Tournament team.

BASEBALL COACHING ENDOWMENT CELEBRATES KATHY WOLFF

- » With a gift from an anonymous donor family, a newly endowed assistant coach position will pay tribute to Kathy Wolff - a longtime administrative associate for more than two decades to Stanford's baseball and women's volleyball programs.
- » Thomas Eager will be the inaugural Kathy Wolff Assistant Baseball Coach.
- » Often considered the "heart and soul" of the baseball program, Wolff was hired as an administrative assistant in the marketing department in 1985 ... the native of Palo Alto began working with the baseball program in 1987, later adding administrative duties with the women's volleyball program.
- » Wolff, who saw the Cardinal win two national championships during her first two seasons with the program, helped coordinate 11 trips to the College World Series in Omaha ... the beloved member of the Stanford Baseball family was busy coordinating another College World Series trip when she passed away on June 11, 2008 ... the Cardinal honored Wolff that year by wearing "KW" patches on its sleeves throughout the College World Series run.
- » In addition to helping the program recruit and retain the best coaching staff, the endowed assistant coaching position recognizes the influence that Wolff still has on the athletics department today ... Stanford's Department of Athletics, Physical Education and Recreation (DAPER) annually

recognizes a staff member with the Kathy Wolff Award for best exemplifying her spirit—a passion for Stanford and an ongoing desire to help and support his/her colleagues ... in the week leading up to baseball season every year, the athletics department celebrates Cake Week—a time when staff members are encouraged to continue Wolff's tradition of bringing in baked goods to enjoy together.

ON TOP EARLY, PRODUCTIVE LATE

- » The Cardinal finished 27-9 when scoring first in a game last season, including 12-3 when scoring in the first inning ... so far this season, Stanford is 3-0 when scoring first in a game.
- » Stanford outscored opponents 90-50 in the first two innings last season – 47-29 in the first and 43-21 in the second ... so far this season, Stanford holds a slim 1-0 lead over the first two innings of games.
- » Stanford outscored its postseason opponents 24-6 in the first two innings last season – 16-3 in the regional round, 7-0 in the Lubbock Super Regional and 1-3 in the College World Series.
- » Fast forwarding to the end of games, Stanford outscored the opposition 20-15 in the ninth and 12-2 in extra innings a year ago.

OFFENSIVE UPTICK

- » Stanford's offensive output was impressive last year, as the Cardinal batted .283 with 380 runs scored on 566 hits – including 101 doubles, four triples and 85 home runs (.465 slugging).
- » In 16 games played in 2020, the Cardinal managed a 5-11 record and hit .207 with 47 runs scored, 29 doubles, two triples and two home runs.
- » Stanford averaged 6.79 runs per game last year after averaging 2.94 runs per game in 2020
- » The Cardinal scored 10-plus runs in 15 of the 56 games, and six-plus in 30 of 56, last year after finishing with eight or fewer in each of the 16 contests in 2020.

LONG BALLS LEAD THE WAY

- » Stanford hit just two home runs over 16 games played in 2020, but connected for seven in the first three games last season – including four on Opening Day vs. Santa Clara.
- » Held homerless just 14 times last year, the Cardinal launched 85 through 56 games to rank first in the conference and 12th in the nation for home runs per game (1.52 per game).
- » The 85 round-trippers, first in the conference and 13th nationally, were the eighth-most for Stanford in a single season.
- » The Cardinal also hit 22 home runs in the postseason - the most of any team in the field.
- » Stanford's game high for home runs last season was four – managing the feat four times (Feb. 25 vs. Santa Clara; March 7 at San Francisco; June 4 vs. North Dakota State; June 12 at No. 8 Texas Tech).
- » Stanford was 34-8 when hitting at least one home run in a game and 22-4 when hitting two or more a year ago.
- » So far this year, Stanford has hit just two home runs through four games - both coming from freshman Braden Montgomery.

FRESHMAN ARMS PROVING BIG

- » While fifth-year senior Zach Grech proved himself as the go-to option out of the bullpen a year ago, having locked up 13 saves in 31 appearances to rank fourth nationally, three of the next five most-used arms out of the bullpen were freshmen.
- » Tommy O'Rourke appeared in 25 games in relief, followed by Brandt Pancer (22), senior Austin Weiermiller (22), senior Jacob Palisch (21) and Joey Dixon (19).
- » Dixon allowed six earned runs and sported a 1-1 record and two saves to accompany a 1.84 ERA over his 19 relief appearances, spanning a string of 29 1/3 innings.
- » O'Rourke compiled a 4.07 bullpen ERA, allowing 11 earned runs on 16 hits with 25 strikeouts over 24 1/3 innings ... the right-hander inherited 25 runners last year, allowing seven to score.
- » Pancer pitched to a 4-2 record with a 3.62 ERA over 22 appearances, allowing 13 runs with 24 strikeouts over 32 1/3 innings.
- » First-year arms also made a difference starting games, with Drew Dowd (6), Dixon (4), Pancer (3) and Ryan Bruno (1) each starting at least one.

THIEVES ON THE BASES

- » Stanford swiped 50 bases in 66 attempts last year to rank fifth in the Pac-12.
- » Brock Jones went 14 for 19, while Adam Crampton was 4 for 7 and Tommy Troy was 4 for 5.
- » The Cardinal was successful on its first 14 attempts last year.
- » So far this season, Stanford is 8 for 9 in stolen bases, led by Troy with four in as many attempts.

TWENTY-EIGHT NAMED TO SPRING ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

- » Three hundred and thirty-five Stanford student-athletes were named to the Pac-12 Spring Academic Honor Roll, including 28 baseball players.
- » The Spring Academic Honor Roll includes student-athletes who participated in the conference-sponsored sports of baseball, beach volleyball, men's and women's golf, lacrosse, men's and women's rowing, softball, men's and women's tennis, and men's and women's track and field.
- » Any student-athlete with a cumulative grade-point average of 3.30 or above who has served at least one year in residence at Stanford was eligible for the distinction this year.
- » The full list of Stanford baseball players lauded last year include: Brett Barrera, Brendan Beck, Drew Bowser, Jaden Bruno, Owen Cobb, Adam Crampton, Drew Dowd, Nathan Fleischli, Henry Gargus, Carter Graham, Zach Grech, Cole Hinkelman, Kody Huff, Brock Jones, Austin Kretzschmar, Quinn Mathews, Max Meier, Justin Moore, Jacob Palisch, Brandt Pancer, Eddie Park, Alberto Rios, Zach Sehgal, Matt Swartz, Tim Tawa, Tommy Troy, Alex Williams and Jonathan Worley.

MARQUESS NAMED TO COLLEGE BASEBALL HALL OF FAME

- » Legendary Stanford head coach Mark Marquess, who spent 41 years with the Cardinal and retired in 2017 as the eighth-winningest coach in NCAA history, was named a member of the National College Baseball Hall of Fame Class of 2021.
- » The latest class was inducted as part of the virtual College Baseball Night of Champions ceremony on June 26.
- » Headlining the class alongside Marquess were 1995 National Player of the Year Todd Helton from Tennessee and Auburn pitcher Gregg Olson.
- » When he retired from coaching following the 2017 season, Marquess had compiled a record of 1,627-878-7 for a .649 winning percentage.
- » Marquess led Stanford to the College World Series 14 times with back-to-back titles in 1987 and 1988.
- » Of his 41 seasons as a coach, 30 of his teams reached the postseason and he sent more than 200 players into professional baseball.
- » A member of the ABCA Hall of Fame, Marquess was a three-time NCAA Coach of the Year recipient and nine-time Pac-10 Coach of the Year pick.
- » Marquess finished with a career 133-66 record in postseason play, including an 84-29 mark in the NCAA Regionals, a 13-10 ledger in the NCAA Super Regionals and a 36-25 (.590) record at the 14 College World Series.
- » A three-year starter at first base for Stanford (1967-69), he earned first-team All-America honors in 1967 and garnered second-team All-America recognition in 1968.
- » Having played in the 1967 College World Series before embarking on his coaching career, Marquess is one of 17 people to play in the College World Series and later lead a team to Omaha as a head coach ... is one of 12 to play in and then lead his alma mater to Omaha.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- » Often considered one of the most beautiful college baseball facilities in the country, Klein Field at Sunken Diamond is the home to Stanford baseball.
- » The "Sunken Diamond" name comes from the excavation to provide fill for the earthen berm within which Stanford Stadium was built in 1921, leaving a large, sunken field.
- » The fixed seating capacity of Klein Field at Sunken Diamond is 2,113 ... with the addition of disabled seating and general admission lawn seating, the total capacity of the facility is 4,000.
- » The original dimensions were 360 feet to left field, 350 to right, and 500 feet to center ... in 1978, a new seven-foot high fence was installed, bringing the dimensions to the current 335 to both left and right field, and 400 to center ... the outfield fence was increased to 10 feet in 1995.

David Esquer '87 was named Stanford's Clarke and Elizabeth Nelson Director of Baseball on June 16, 2017, becoming the 21st head coach in program history.

Esquer succeeded Mark Marquess, who retired after 41 years at the helm of the program. Esquer played under Marquess on Stanford's 1987 national championship team, and served as an assistant on The Farm from 1991-96. Prior to taking over the reins at Stanford, Esquer spent the previous 18 seasons as the head coach at Cal, where he was the 2011 National Coach of the Year and led the Bears to five NCAA Regionals and the 2011 College World Series.

The 2022 season will be Esquer's fifth in charge of the program after most recently guiding the Cardinal back to Omaha in 2021. In four seasons at the helm of the program, Esquer has amassed a 135-54 (.714) overall record - the highest winning percentage of any coach in Stanford baseball history. Esquer owns a career record of 660-521-2 through 22 seasons as a collegiate head coach. Included in the overall ledger is a 279-283 record in Pac-12 play, including a 61-25 mark while at Stanford.

Stanford finished the historic 2021 season ranked No. 5 nationally according to Collegiate Baseball and in the NCBWA poll, No. 7 according to Baseball America and the USA Today Coaches poll, and No. 8 according to D1Baseball after going 39-17 and 17-10 in Pac-12 play to claim third place in the conference standings. Esquer's Cardinal dropped back-to-back games just once in 2021 and finished the year 12-1 in weekend series. Stanford won the Stanford Regional and swept a Super Regional at Texas Tech to earn the berth in Omaha. Brendan Beck was a unanimous All-American and was named 2021 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, while Brock Jones and Zach Grech also earned All-America honors. Eight Cardinal players claimed All-Conference recognition, while Grech also earned Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year. The Cardinal's 85 home runs, including an NCAA-high 22 in the postseason, were the eighth-most in Stanford history, while the .979 fielding percentage was the third-best in program history. Three Cardinal were drafted following the 2021 season, headlined by Beck being selected 55th overall in the second round by the New York Yankees.

Stanford posted a 45-14 record in 2019 before registering a 5-11 mark in a 2020 season cut short by the COVID-19 global pandemic. The Cardinal's .763 win percentage in 2019 tied for the fifth-best in program history, while its 14 losses matched the third-fewest. Stanford finished 22-7 in Pac-12 play, claiming second place before earning its 11th Super Regional berth overall, and the first since 2014. Nine Cardinal were drafted following the 2019 season, and Maverick Handley was named Co-Defensive Player of the Year.

In 2018, his first season in charge of the program, Esquer guided Stanford to its first Pac-12 Conference title since 2004, matching a program record for fewest losses with 12 (minimum 50 games played) while picking up Pac-12 Coach of the Year honors. Stanford's 46 wins equaled the 10th-most in program history, while the Cardinal's .793 winning percentage ranked second. Nine Cardinal were named All-Pac-12, and Stanford hosted an NCAA Regional for the 17th time.

Through 18 seasons at Cal, Esquer compiled a 525-467-2 (.529) overall record, was named the 2001 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, and mentored five MLB first-round selections. Conor Jackson was the first of the five first-round picks, selected by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2003 before Brandon Morrow was selected fifth overall by the Seattle Mariners in 2006. David Cooper (Toronto Blue Jays, 2008) and Brett Jackson (Chicago Cubs, 2009) followed before right-hander Daulton Jefferies was drafted in 2016 by the Oakland A's.

During his time at the helm of the Cardinal program, Esquer has seen two more players selected in the first round of an MLB draft, running the total to seven in his career. Nico Hoerner was drafted 24th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 2018, while Kris Bubic was selected 40th overall by the Kansas City Royals in that same draft.

Through 22 seasons as a collegiate head coach in the Pac-12, Esquer has seen 11 of his players garner All-America honors, 11 named All-Region, two claim Conference Player of the Year, and one earn Conference Pitcher, Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year.

A shortstop at Stanford from 1984-87, Esquer was a starter on the Cardinal's 1987 College World Series championship team. He earned all-tournament honors after hitting .350 with six RBIs in Omaha. He also earned All-Pac-10 Southern Division honors as a senior, batting .318 with 41 RBIs and 16 stolen bases. Esquer went on to play professional baseball for four seasons with the Baltimore Orioles, California Angels and Milwaukee Brewers.

Following his playing career, Esquer spent six seasons as an assistant under Coach Marquess. His time as an assistant with the Cardinal included five NCAA Regional appearances and a fifth-place finish at the 1995 College World Series.

In three seasons as the top assistant at Pepperdine from 1997-99, Esquer was the program's chief recruiting coordinator as well as hitting instructor, infield coach and handler of the third base coaching duties.

Esquer was a three-sport star and class valedictorian at Palma High School in Salinas, Calif. He was tabbed the "Athlete of the Year" at Palma High School after being named team captain and MVP in baseball, football and basketball.

Esquer earned a bachelor's degree in economics and a master's degree in sociology from Stanford in 1987. He and his wife, Lynn, have a daughter, Gabrielle, and son, Xavier.

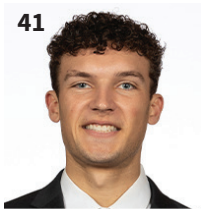

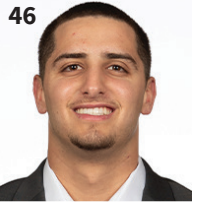
