GENERAL:

- **Made the Department's Honor Roll (3.0-3.49 GPA) for Fall 2021**
- Spent four seasons with the Miami Hurricanes but only played two games his senior year (2020-21) after injuring his ankle on Dec. 4 ... Graduated from Miami (Spring, '21- sport administration/marketing) ... Pursuing a second undergraduate degree at Arkansas in arts and sciences ... Preseason 1st team All-ACC prior to 2020-21 season ... **2020 All-ACC HM ... 2019 and 2018 ACC All-Academic Team** ... Led the team – and ranked among the ACC top 10 – in scoring in both 2019-20 and 2018-19.
- **INSIDE THE FINAL 3 MINUTES (AND OT), IS 46-OF-49 (93.8%) AT THE FREE THROW LINE ...** Is the first Razorback since Joe Kleine in 1983-84 to have multiple games in a season shooting 10-10 or better at the free throw line (12-12 vs Elon and 10-10 vs. Kansas State).
- **Made 21 straight at the line spanning five games (Hofstra-Vandy) before missing his final attempt vs Vandy.**
Made 19 straight (made his last FT vs A&M; 4-4 vs WVU; 4-4 vs AUB, 6-6 vs UT; 4-4 at UT)
Was 13-of-13 at the line in the NCAA Tournament ... Closed the season making 39 of his final 41 FT

2021-22 HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Mercer:** Scored 16 off the bench thanks to making 7-of-8 FT ... 10 of his points came during Arkansas' decisive 18-3 run to turn a 54-53 deficit into a 71-57 lead.
- **UNI:** Led the team with 26 points ... [CLICK TO WATCH: his acrobatic layup that was the top play on ESPN's SportsCenter](#) ... Scored 12 straight points on his own, including a 7-0 Razorback run, in the first half ... Arkansas was down 3 (75-72 with 4:25 left) before Lykes ignited a 21-5 run with nine points — including 6-of-6 FT — over the final 4:10 to secure the win.
- **HOF Classic:** Named to the **Hall of Fame Classic All-Tournament Team** ... Made a huge impact by making 18-of-20 free throws, **including 10-of-10 inside the final 1:46 versus K-State and 4-of-4 inside the final 21 seconds vs Cincinnati** ... Scored 14 vs KSU and 15 vs Cincy ... Only made one 3-pointer, but it came with Arkansas down 4 with 5:49 to play.
- **UCA:** Posted season-highs with five assists and two steals.
- **LR:** Tied season-high with two steals ... Was 6-of-7 at the line, including 4-of-4 inside the final 2:33 to seal the win.
- **Charlotte:** Played his best defensive game according to Coach Muss ... Added 13 points and three assists.
- **Hofstra:** Scored 19, making a season-high 4-of-9 3-pointers, and was 5-of-5 at the line ... Added a **season-high three steals**
- **Elon:** In his first start of the season ... Led the team with 21 points on 4-of-8 FG (1-4 3PT) ... Was **12-of-12 at the free throw line**.
- **Vandy:** Only had 1 point, 1 steal and 3 rebounds in 10:27 played ... However, the point, steal and two boards came inside the final 20 seconds to give Arkansas a chance to tie/win ... **Also, in 10:27 minutes played, tied for the team lead in Plus-Minus at +10.**
- **Missouri:** Recorded his 11th career blocked shot and first as a Razorback, which made SEC Now's Patric (Young's) Poster segment.
- **Texas A&M:** Only had two assists, but both came in overtime and both baskets put the Hogs up three ... Also drew a charge and snapped an 0-for-9 dry spell from 3-point range (5-game stretch).
- **@ Georgia:** Was praised by Coach Musselman for his preparation and responded accordingly ... Only had nine assists and one steal in the first eight SEC games then, in game nine, dished out **season-highs of seven assists and had four steals**
- **Miss State:** Followed that with another outstanding performance at both ends ... Had 10 points and did not get score on the defensive end ... Drained two 3-pointers, including one with 25 seconds left to give Arkansas a 7-point lead and secure the win.
- **Auburn:** Was 4-of-4 at the free throw line and scored six points ... Sank two FT with 27 seconds left to put the Hogs up five
- **Tennessee:** Was 6-of-6 at the line and tied for the team lead with two assists ... Was 4-of-4 at the line inside the final 58 seconds.
- **@ Tennessee:** Led the Hogs at +10 in a four-point loss, including +18 in the second half ... Scored 15 points — 10 in the second half (3-5 G; 2-3 3PT) ... Dow 19, scored 8 in a 12-4 run, including back-to-back 3-pointers to make it an 11-point game with 5:09 left.
- **vs LSU (SEC):** Had 18 points off the bench, making 5-of-9 from the field and 7-of-8 at the line ... Added three steals ... Scored 6 straight to end the first half (4 free throws and a jumper at the buzzer after a steal).
- **vs New Mexico State (NCAA):** Scored seven points — all at the free throw line and all inside the final 5:30 — on 7-of-7 shooting ... Was fouled shooting a 3 and made all 3 FT to put the Hogs up eight ... Made a pair at the line with 10 seconds left for a 4-point lead ... Sealed the win with two free throws with two seconds left.
- **vs Gonzaga (NCAA):** Only scored two points — 2 free throws with 15 seconds left to put the Hogs up five.

2020-21 (Senior at Miami):

Preseason first team All-ACC (the third Miami player to be selected to the preseason All-ACC first team and the first in program history to be a two-time preseason All-ACC pick) ... Played in two games prior to suffering a season-ending ankle injury ... In the season opener, had 11 points and six assists versus North Florida ... Despite suffering his season-ending injury versus Stetson, scored 20 points (5-9 FG, 7-7 FT) in 22 minutes with five assists and four rebounds.

2019-20 (Junior at Miami):

All-ACC honorable mention ... Air Force Reserve Basketball HOF Invitational Game MVP (12/17) ... Preseason Second Team All-ACC (just the fourth Hurricane to earn preseason All-ACC honors) ... Played in 26 games, missing five due to injury, and started 24, including each of the first 18 ... Averaged 15.4 points to rank 10th in the ACC ... Led the Hurricanes in points, assists and steals per game, as well as made field goals (140), made free throws (70) and free-throw attempts (86) ... Finished fourth in the ACC in free-throw percentage (81.4), ninth in field-goal percentage (43.2), 10th in scoring and 12th in 3-pointers per game (1.96) ... In ACC-only action, placed fourth in free-throw clip (84.3), ninth in scoring (15.6) and 14th in 3-pointers (1.93) ... Notched the eighth-best, single-season free-throw clip in program history ... Recorded the only two instances (11 and 10) of a Miami player hitting double-digit made field goals, plus tied for second in made free throws (eight) and made free throws without a miss (eight) ... Paced Miami in scoring a team-best 13 times ... Opened the season with an 18-point, five-assist showing against #5 Louisville (11/5) ... Tallied 16 points on 7-of-12 shooting against Florida (11/22) in the Charleston Classic ... Dropped a season-best 28 points in the win at Illinois (12/2), adding four steals and finishing 11-of-17 from the floor to set a career high in makes ... Recorded 17 points to go along with a season-high six assists and career-best five steals against Temple (12/17) at the Barclays Center, hitting the game-winning free throws with 4.4 seconds left ... Registered 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting in 41 minutes in the overtime victory at Clemson (12/31) ... Put up 18 points and four rebounds in 38 minutes at #11 Louisville (1/7), finishing 8-of-8 at the stripe ... Totaled 20 points and four boards at NC State (1/15), as well as hit all seven of his free throws ... Notched 24 points and a career-high two blocks in a career-best 42 minutes against ninth-ranked Florida State (1/18), tallying a 9-of-18 mark from the floor and a 6-of-10 ledger from long range, tying his career high in made 3-pointers ... After playing in the first 82 games of his career, missed Miami's contests at North Carolina (1/25), against Virginia Tech (1/28), at Pittsburgh (2/2) and against NC State (2/5) due to a groin injury sustained versus the Seminoles, snapping a 52-game streak of starts ... Scored 16 points against Boston College (2/12) ... Amassed 23 points in the triple-overtime triumph at Virginia Tech (2/19) ... Posted 14 points and a season-high five boards at Georgia Tech (2/29) ... Scored 16 points on 7-of-12 shooting against No. 22 Virginia (3/4), but missed the final 12 minutes after getting elbowed in the face ... Recorded 21 points and went 5-of-11 from 3-point range versus Clemson (3/11) in the ACC Tournament.

his scoring average by 6.6 ppg (9.6 to 16.2), which was third highest among ACC players ... Played at least 30 minutes in 26 of 32 games ... Ranked No. 14 in ACC in minutes per game (33.8) and No. 16 in league-only action (34.8) ... Ranked fifth in ACC in free-throw shooting in conference games (63-78, 80.8 percent) ... First Miami player to record three straight 20-point efforts since Shane Larkin in March 2013 ... Scored 20 or more points in each of the first three games this season, becoming first UM player since Joe Wylie in 1989 to do so ... Scored 22 points and also played then-career-best 39 minutes in season opener against Lehigh (11/9) ... Averaged 17.7 ppg in three games at Wooden Legacy ... Scored career-high 28 points on 10-of-15 shooting in ACC opener against NC State (1/3) ... Scored 25 points against Wake Forest (1/12), including 14-of-14 from free-throw line which is second-best FT performance in program history (Jack McClinton, 16-16 vs. NC State, March 7, 2009) ...
