- 2nd team All-ASUN in 2019 and ASUN Freshman of the Year in 2018 ... Named the 2021 BLEACHER REPORT NATIONAL SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR and the 2021 SEC COACHES SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR.
- 2021-22 ALL-AMERICAN by seven publications including 3rd team honors by AP, Sporting News, NCAA.com
- 2021-22 Consensus 1st team All-SEC (unanimous by media) ... Was preseason All-SEC by the coaches but was not on the media preseason team
- 2021-22 SEC Community Service Team ... Volunteered at the Samaritan Community Center, a Northwest Arkansas nonprofit providing food and other resources to families living in need ... Also volunteered at the Potter's House Community Engagement Event, has written "Grateful Razorbacks" letters to donors and participated in RazorCall with Sequoyah Elementary in (Russellville) ... Volunteered at the Springdale community center.
- 2022 NCAA West Regional All-Tournament Team

Scored his 1,000th point as a Razorback, converting an old-fashion 3-point play early in the second half versus Texas A&M in the SEC semifinal ... He became the 45th player to score 1,000 points in a Razorback uniform ... He is the sixth Razorback to accomplish the feat in two seasons joining Mason Jones (1,146), Jaylen Barford (1,087), Daryl Macon (1,070), Bobby Portis (1,047) and Dusty Hannahs (1,047).

AS A RAZORBACK: Scored 1,070 career points

OVERALL: Scored 1,999 career points and had 228 career steals

2021-22 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Mercer:** Scored a game-high 30 while tying a then career-high seven steals ... 6 steals came in the 2nd half to spur the come-from-behind win ... His seven steals ties for 8th on the school's single-game list ... Just the 6th Razorback to score at least 30 in a season opener.
- UNI:** Just missed his second career triple-double with 17 pts • 9 assists • 8 rebounds ... Only committed one turnover ... Led the team in assists, was second on the team in points and rebounds.
- HOF Classic:** Struggled shooting, but still scored double-digits in both games ... However, had five assists and three steals vs K-State and added two steals vs Cincy, including one with 1:40 left that set-up the Hogs' game-winning run.
- Penn:** Scored a game-high 28 and tied for team lead with nine rebounds ... Added five assists (four in the second half) ... Scored 14 of Arkansas' final 18 points, including 10 straight for the Hogs from 5:28 to 27 seconds left.
- LR:** Tied for team lead in points with 18 ... Scored 16 of those in the second half ... Leading by 9 with seven minutes to play, scored nine straight for the Hogs to secure the win, with two steals.
- Hofstra:** Came off the bench for the first time in 2021-22 and scored a team-best 20 points, making 4-of-9 3-pointers ... Added six rebounds.
- Vandy:** Scored 16 points and led the team, while tying an SEC career high with five steals ... Added five assists and had 13 defensive ball touches (7 deflections, 5 steals, 1 blocked shot)
- @ A&M:** Led the team and had an SEC career-best with 31 points (also his best as Hog)... Scored 12 points to start game as Arkansas raced out to a 20-9 lead ... Scored seven in a 13-3 run to cut Arkansas' deficit from 11 to 1 with 1:08 to play ... Scored 17 in the first half and 14 in the second half with two of his three assists and both steals.
- Mizzou:** Scored 9 of Arkansas' first 18 points as the Hogs led 18-3 early ... Finished with a game-high 19 points.
- @ LSU:** Had a game-high 19 points, including a 3-pointer to cap a 10-0 Arkansas run ... Only played 27 minutes due to foul trouble ... Team was +18 in his 27 minutes played ... the only Hog in double-digits for Plus-Minus.
- South Carolina:** Led the team in assists (5) and tied then career high in blocked shots (3) ... Added 17 points (making 7-of-8 FT) and an SEC career-best seven rebounds ... Had a team-best +31 (+24 in the second half) ... Only played 9:24 in the first half due to foul trouble ... Played all 20 minutes of the 2nd half with 14 pts, 4 rebs, 4 assists and 3 BLKS.
- Texas A&M:** Led the team in both points (17) and assists (4) while adding six rebounds and three steals.
- @ Ole Miss:** For the third straight game, led the team in both points (25) and assists (5).
- West Virginia:** Only played the first 3:26 of the first half before picking up two fouls and sitting the rest of the half ... However, scored five points (a 3-pointer to start the game and a layup) with an assist ... Finished with 15 points.
- @ Georgia:** Scored 23 points and posted SEC career-bests with nine rebounds and six assists ... Helped Arkansas out-score UGA 46-26 in the second half with 11 points, five rebounds and four assists.
- Auburn:** Led Arkansas to just the program's 2nd win over AP #1 team with a game-high 28 points ... Had career highs in FT made (11), FT attempts (14), blocked shots (4) and minutes played (41:24) ... Had 9 early points as Arkansas jumped out to a 27-15 lead ... Made back-to-back defensive stops, blocking a shot and getting a steal ... The steal led two FT to tie the game with 54 seconds left ... Sealed the win with a FT with 12 seconds left ... Added a career-high 17 defensive ball touches (deflections, blocked shots, steals).
- @ Alabama:** Only played 3:44 in the first half due to foul trouble but had three assists ... Led the team at +7 ... Finished with 12 points (all in the second half) including a 3-pointer with 2:36 to play to give Arkansas a 65-64 lead ... Added three second-half steals (had four for the game) and finished with 11 defensive ball touches.
- Tennessee:** Tied for the team lead with 13 points (3-of-6 3PT).
- NATIONAL & SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (2/28):** Averaged 26.0 points, 5.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds in wins at Florida and against #6/3 Kentucky. For his efforts, named both the National Player of the Week by ESPN.com and Andy Katz/NCAA March Madness as well as being tabbed the SEC Player of the Week ... @ Florida: Had a team-high 22 points while adding six rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots in helping Arkansas snap a 14-game losing streak to the Gators in Gainesville ... Notae scored five key points late in the game to secure the win ... First, with Arkansas up one with 1:06 left, he drained a "dagger" 3-pointer to put Arkansas up four ... Then, after a defensive stop, Notae sank two free throws with 40 ticks left for a six-point cushion ... Kentucky: Had 30 points and eight assists to become the first Razorback to have at least 30 and 8 in any game since the Hogs joined the SEC (1991-92) ... Additionally became the first SEC player to have at least 30 and 8 versus an AP top 10 team in the last 25 years ... Eight assists both tied a season-high and were a career-high in an SEC game ... Led Arkansas to a 15-2 run to start the game versus Kentucky with eight points and two assists ... His eighth assist of the game came with 1:22 left (to Jaylin Williams) that put Arkansas up one (71-70), a lead the Hogs would not relinquish ... Up four with nine seconds left, Notae blocked a Ty Ty Washington shot to help seal the win.
- LSU:** Made two free throws with eight seconds left to put Arkansas up 77-76 ... Made his first 3-pointer, but did not have his best scoring game ... Finished with 12 points (3-of-12 FG; 2-6 3PT) ... However, grabbed seven rebounds and had a team-best five assists ... Inside the final 2:47, had three assists and three defensive rebounds.
- @ Tennessee:** Led the Hogs with 20 points, adding a team-best four assists, team-best three steals and team best one blocked shot ... 15 of his 20 (as well as three assists and two steals) came in the second half as Arkansas turned a 21-point halftime deficit to two inside the final minute ... Was +17 in the second half ... Scored nine points in a 14-3 run from 4:23 to 16 seconds to turn an 11-point deficit (73-62) to 2 (76-74) ... Was 6-of-6 at the free throw line during the span.
- vs LSU (SEC):** Scored 19 points with four steals, six rebounds and three assists ... Made 10-of-13 at the line.
- vs Texas A&M (SEC):** Only scored five points, but that 5th point gave him 1,000 points in a Razorback uniform ... Added a team-best five assists.
- vs Vermont (NCAA):** Had 17 points (all in the second half) thanks to 6-of-8 at the line ... Made two free throws with 9 seconds left to seal the win ... Added seven rebounds and a team-best four assists ... Led the team with a +11 (the only Hog in double figures).
- vs New Mexico State (NCAA):** Led the team with 18 points thanks to 7-of-8 at the line ... Had a career-high 8 steals, which also tied a school record for most in an NCAA Tournament game ... Scored 8 straight to cap a 17-2 run in the first half to put the Hogs up 13 ... Led the team with a +9.
- NCAA West Regional All-Tournament Team:** Averaged a team-best 17.5 points in the Regional rounds, including 21 pts vs Gonzaga and 14 vs Duke ... vs Gonzaga (NCAA): Led the Hogs with 21 points (attempting a career-high 29 shots), six assists and three steals ... The first Hog in at least 25 years to get at least 21 points, 6 rebounds, 6 assists, 3 steals and 2 blocks in a game ... Scored four points inside the final 1:25 of the first half to cap a 13-2 run—including a layup at the buzzer—for a 3-point halftime lead ... vs Duke (NCAA): Scored 14 points with a team-best four assists and two blocked shots while adding four rebounds and a steal.

2020-21 (R-Jr. at Arkansas):

• Named the Bleacher Report National Sixth Man of the Year and the SEC Coaches Sixth Man of the Year.

Was Arkansas' first sub 16 times and Arkansas was 13-3 in those games ... Third on the team in scoring (12.8 ppg) but led the team in scoring 22.2 points per 40 minutes (Moses Moody was second at 19.9 ppg) ... Led the team in steals (46) and ranked 12th in the SEC in steals per game (1.44) ... Was seventh in the SEC in free throws made (92) ... Led team in scoring seven times ... Scored his 1,000th career point (5:09 of 2nd half) versus Central Arkansas ... Had a game-high 22 points versus the Bears, including 17 in the second half, adding three steals and six assists with just one turnover ... Versus Oral Roberts (Dec. 20), finished with 15 points, five rebounds, three assists and tied career-high with three blocked shots ... Scored 19 points in the win over Abilene Christian, including 17 in the second half ... Made two key 3-pointers – one to put Arkansas up 12 with 3:05 left and hit another to seal the win with 1:23 left ...
