### BILLIKENS OPEN 27TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S SOCCER

•Saint Louis kicks off its 27th season of women's soccer tonight when the Billikens take on eighth-ranked Arkansas at Robert R. Hermann Stadium.

•SLU owns an all-time record of 295-170-57 (.620).

### SAINT LOUIS IN SEASON OPENERS

•The Billikens are 15-10-1 in season openers and have lost three of their last four debuts, including a 1-0 defeat at home vs. Xavier last year.

•When SLU plays its season opener at home, the Bills are 12-3. •Saint Louis is 21-4-1 in all home openers.

#### **BILLIKENS VS. THE SEC**

•Saint Louis owns a 10-9-1 edge vs. current members of the Southeastern Conference. That includes a 2-1 mark vs. Missouri when the Tigers played in the Big 12 Conference.

•The Billikens are 1-1 vs. Arkansas, 0-1 vs. Auburn, 3-2 vs. Ole Miss, 2-0 vs. Mississippi State and 2-4-1 vs. Vanderbilt.

•SLU's most recent SEC opponent was Ole Miss. The Billikens defeated the 17th-ranked Rebels 2-1 in Oxford in last season's NCAA Championship opening round.

### THE SAINT LOUIS-ARKANSAS SERIES

•SLU recorded three shots on goal and made all of them count in a 3-1 victory over No. 7 Arkansas in Fayetteville Feb. 28, 2021.

•Sophia Stram, Hannah Larson and Emily Groark scored the Saint Louis goals. Hannah Friedrich tallied two assists, Karsen Kohl had an assist, and Emily Puricelli made five saves.

•The win lifted the then-unranked Billikens to No. 17 in the United Soccer Coaches poll, their highest-ever national ranking.

•Arkansas topped SLU 2-0 in the teams' first meeting Aug. 30, 2013, in Fayetteville.

### **BILLIKENS vs. RANKED TEAMS**

•Saint Louis is 2-3-2 vs. nationally ranked opponents under **Katie Shields**, part of a 5-18-5 all-time record vs. nationally ranked teams (1-7-4 home, 3-9 away, 1-2-1 neutral).

•In 2006, SLU defeated No. 18 Illinois 2-1 in double overtime at Hermann Stadium for its lone home victory vs. a ranked team.

•Arkansas is only the third ranked team the Billikens have played in a season opener. SLU fell at No. 12 Duke in 2006 and to No. 18 Memphis at home in 2010.

•Arkansas' No. 8 ranking matches the highest for a Saint Louis home opponent; No. 8 Duke visited Midtown in 2005. The Billikens hosted No. 9 Charlotte in 2002. SLU is 0-2 at home and 1-6 overall vs. top-10 teams.

### **BILLIKENS PICKED TO WIN A-10 TITLE IN PRESEASON POLL**

•Saint Louis was a near-unanimous choice to win the 2022 Atlantic 10 Conference crown in balloting by A-10 head coaches. The Billikens received 14 of 15 first-place votes and totaled 224 points.

•Dayton (one first-place vote) finished second with 197 points. League newcomer Loyola Chicago (189) was third, while defending regular-season champion VCU (180) and Massachusetts (170) rounded out the upper third of the 15-team conference.

### SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. ARKANSAS

#### FIVE BILLIKENS MAKE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

•A league-high five Billikens landed on the A-10 preseason All-Conference team.

•Sixth-year defender **Brionna Halverson**, senior midfielder **Abbie Miller** and junior goalkeeper **Emily Puricelli** made the list after earning first-team All-Conference plaudits in 2021.

•They are joined by sophomore forward **Emily Gaebe**, the 2021 A-10 Rookie of the Year and a second-team All-Conference selection, and fifth-year midfielder **Hannah Friedrich**.

### **EXHIBITION RECAP: SLU NOTCHES TWO VICTORIES**

•Saint Louis recorded two shutouts in exhibition play, blanking Lindenwood 9-0 and Evansville 4-0.

• Eight different Billikens scored at least one goal.

### SAINT LOUIS IN 27TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S SOCCER

•The 2022 season is the 27th in Saint Louis University women's soccer history.

•The Billikens are 295-170-57 overall, a .620 winning percentage.

•In conference play (Conference USA 1996-2004, Atlantic 10 since 2005), SLU is 155-71-26 (.667).

•The 2021 campaign was Saint Louis' 17th winning season.

•Ten Billiken teams have posted a winning percentage of .700 or better.

•Saint Louis has captured 12 conference championships (six regular-season, six tournament) and has made six NCAA Championship appearances (2005, 2006, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021). The 2005, 2006 and 2021 teams reached the second round with first-round wins; the 2020 Billikens were seeded into the second round in an abbreviated 48-team tournament field.

### 22 RETURN FROM 2021

•SLU returned 22 players from its 2021 squad that posted records of 13-9-1 overall and 7-3 (third place) in the Atlantic 10 Conference, captured a fourth consecutive A-10 tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Championship for a fourth straight year, winning a first-round game at Ole Miss.

•Eighteen of the 22 returnees combined to make 246 of the team's 253 starts a season ago. Additionally, returning players accounted for all but three goals and three assists tallied by the 2021 Billikens.

•Sixth-year defender **Brionna Halverson** (1G, 4A) is back after earning third-team All-Region plaudits and first-team All-Conference honors.

•Halverson was joined on the All-Conference first team by senior midfielder **Abbie Miller** (5G, 4A), junior defender **Lyndsey Heckel** (5G) and junior goalkeeper **Emily Puricelli** (0.92 GAA, eight shutouts).

•Sophomore forward **Emily Gaebe**, who led last year's team in goals (seven) and points (17), was selected A-10 Rookie of the Year and landed on the All-Conference second team along with junior defender **Sophia Stram** (1A). Gaebe was joined on the All-Rookie team by sophomore forward **Hannah Sawyer** (2G, 1A).

•Fifth-year senior midfielder **Hannah Friedrich** returns after leading the 2021 Bills with seven assists and adding three goals. Junior forward **Caroline Kelly** contributed five goals and two assists.

### EIGHT NEWCOMERS LOOK TO CONTRIBUTE

•A sophomore transfer and seven freshmen are in their first seasons at Saint Louis.

•Sophomore forward/midfielder Julia Simon transferred from Louisville, where she tallied four goals and three assists in 2021.

•Midfielders Lauren Hiatt, Taylor Krueger and Ellie Paloucek, forward Hannah Smith, defender Lauren Spaete, midfielder/ defender Clare Nicholas and goalkeeper Becca Wolterman comprise the Billikens' freshman class.

### HEAD COACH KATIE SHIELDS

•Now in her 10th season leading the Billikens, 2018 and 2019 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year **Katie Shields** owns a 114-54-14 (.665) career record (all at Saint Louis).

•Shields, who spent one season as a SLU assistant before taking the head-coaching reins, has guided the Billikens to a conference-best 92-25-9 (.766) mark since the beginning of the 2016 season. That record includes a 48-6-4 (.862) ledger in A-10 regular-season play.

•A year ago, Shields' Billikens played in the NCAA Championship for a fourth straight season after becoming the first team in A-10 women's soccer history to win four consecutive conference tournament crowns.

•The Billikens also made history two seasons ago when they became the first A-10 women's soccer team to capture both regular-season and tournament titles in three consecutive years. Shields and her staff were selected East Region Coaching Staff of the Year by the United Soccer Coaches.

•Shields' players have earned All-America honors twice, All-Region plaudits 20 times and Atlantic 10 accolades (first team, second team, All-Rookie) 53 times. In addition, Billikens have been selected A-10 Defensive Player of the Year five times (five of the past six seasons), Midfielder of the Year and Rookie of the Year twice each, and Offensive Player of the Year once.

•Shields began the 2022 campaign ranked 27th in winning percentage among active NCAA Division I head coaches.

### FRIEDRICH REWRITING BILLIKEN RECORD BOOK

•Hannah Friedrich owns one Saint Louis career record and is on the verge of setting several others.

•Friedrich holds the school record of 15 game-winning goals. Six of those clinchers have come in the 84th minute or later, including two golden goals.

•She ranks second in points (93), trailing only Jamie Perry (104); assists (35), trailing only Courtney Hulcer (37); and gamewinning assists (17), trailing only Hulcer (21). Friedrich also is tied for second in goals (29), although it's a more distant second to Perry's school-record 41.

•Friedrich's game-winning goals and game-winning assists total of 32 is the highest in Billiken women's soccer history.

### SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. ARKANSAS

•With 83 games played and 82 games started, Friedrich needs just four more in each category to set Billiken career marks.

•Friedrich ranks fourth all-time at SLU with 217 shots, well within striking distance of Perry's school standard of 261.

•Two seasons ago, Friedrich's 14 assists tied for the national lead and were just one shy of matching the school record.

•In her freshman season (2018), Friedrich scored a school-record 30 points (11G, 8A).

•Friedrich tallied a school-record seven game-winning goals in 2019, including a pair of golden goals.

### PURICELLI MARCHING UP SAINT LOUIS GOALKEEPING LISTS

•In just two seasons, **Emily Puricelli** has established herself as one of the most prolific goalkeepers in Billiken history.

•Puricelli began the season third in career goals against average (0.74) at SLU. She ranks fourth in wins (28) and is in position to challenge **Meghann Burke's** Billiken record of 48 victories. Next for her to catch is **Amanda Martin** (34).

•Puricelli stands sixth in shutouts (16) and minutes (3,625). On the shutouts chart, she needs three for fifth place, four for fourth and five for third. Puricelli is on track to ascend into the top three in minutes as well; third-place **Katie Walsh** played 5,151 minutes.

• Puricelli's 124 career saves rank seventh.

•In SLU's NCAA Championship second-round game vs. Rutgers last year, Puricelli tied the Billiken single-game record of 14 saves.

#### HALVERSON MAKES IT A HALF-DOZEN

•Defender **Brionna Halverson** returns in 2022 for a sixth year as a member of the Billiken women's soccer program.

•The combination of a medical redshirt after missing her second year (2018) due to injury and the extra year of eligibility granted student-athletes due to COVID-19 led Halverson to become the second Billiken in recent years to spend six years at SLU. Goalkeeper **Mary Niehaus** spent the 2014 through 2019 seasons in the Saint Louis program.

•Halverson is a two-time United Soccer Coaches All-East Region honoree, including a first-team nod in the 2020 season, and her three All-Conference selections include first-team accolades the past two seasons. Halverson also made the 2020 and 2021 A-10 Championship All-Tournament teams, was an A-10 All-Rookie choice as a freshman, and was voted to the Billikens' 25th Anniversary Team a year ago.

•Halverson holds a bachelor's degree in public health and is pursuing a master's degree in organizational leadership. She was SLU's 2022 NCAA Woman of the Year nominee.

### **BILLIKENS' VETERAN PLAYERS HEAVILY DECORATED**

•Postseason accolades have been plentiful for Saint Louis in recent seasons, and players on this year's team have collected their fair share. The 2022 Billiken squad includes 12 players who have combined to capture 50 postseason awards.

•The list of awards comprises All-Region plaudits; Atlantic 10 major ("of the Year") awards; A-10 first-team, second-team and All-Rookie recognition; and A-10 Championship Most Outstanding Player and All-Tournament nods.

•Hannah Friedrich leads the team with 13 postseason honors, followed by Brionna Halverson with eight, Emily Puricelli with seven, Abbie Miller with five, Lyndsey Heckel and Hannah Larson with four apiece, and Sophia Stram with three.

•Emily Gaebe has two awards, while Emily Groark, Anna Lawler, Hannah Sawyer and Caroline Kelly claim one apiece.

### BILLS MAKE HERMANN STADIUM A SOCCER FORTRESS

•Saint Louis is 51-5-6 (.871) in its last 62 games on the home pitch of Robert R. Hermann Stadium, a stretch that dates to the final home game of the 2015 campaign.

•In those 62 games, the Billikens outscored their opponents 129-24, registered 38 shutouts, and never allowed more than one goal.

#### ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE WELCOMES LOYOLA CHICAGO

•Loyola University Chicago became the 15th member of the Atlantic 10 Conference on July 1. The Ramblers joined the A-10 following nine years of Missouri Valley Conference membership.

•Loyola's women's soccer team finished its MVC tenure with a flourish, capturing the league's regular-season and tournament titles in each of the past four seasons.

•The Billikens are 2-0 vs. the Ramblers. The teams met in 1996 (SLU won 3-1 in Chicago) – Loyola was the fifth opponent in SLU women's soccer history – and again in 1997 (SLU 6-0 in St. Louis).

•Saint Louis and Loyola are the only A-10 members located in the Central time zone.

### WHAT'S A BILLIKEN?

The Billiken was born Oct. 8, 1908, when Kansas City art teacher and illustrator Florence Pretz patented a design for an elflike creature with pixie ears, a mischievous smile and a tuft of hair on his pointed head. Reportedly, the image came to her in a dream.

Although it didn't appear on the actual patent, some believe Pretz found the Billiken name in a fanciful work entitled, "Mr. Moon: A Song of the Little People," by Canadian poets Bliss Carman and Richard Hovey.

Within a short time, Pretz sold her patented image to the Billiken Company of Chicago. Initially manufactured as a bank and statuette, and later as a doll, this good luck charm soon became a national craze. By 1911, the Billiken's likeness adorned everything from marshmallow candies to hood ornaments.

In his heyday, the Billiken enjoyed worldwide fame. Artisans in Alaska began carving his image into ivory, and in Japan, he appeared in shrines, amusement parks and even a movie.

Like many other fads, the Billiken might have faded into obscurity if it were not for Saint Louis University law student John Bender, who also happened to be the coach of SLU's football team during the height of Billikenmania.

One story claims that nearby drugstore owner Billy Gunn called Bender a Billiken when the coach walked into his establishment one day. Supposedly, legendary sportswriter William O'Connor



was within earshot of the remark and took up the moniker not only for Bender but also for SLU's sports teams.

Another tale claims O'Connor himself dubbed the coach a Billiken after a particularly good practice left Bender beaming with a big smile. After practice, Bender's fellow law student Charles Z. McNamara, a local cartoonist, sketched Bender as a Billiken, posted it in Gunn's drugstore window and tabbed the football team "Bender's Billikens."

> Yet another yarn reports that the druggist asked McNamara to decorate his store window the night before a homecoming game. Supposedly, McNamara drew a Billiken, a popular good luck charm, causing one of his fellow students to exclaim, "That looks like coach Bender!"

> Whatever the case, O'Connor is generally credited for popularizing the name throughout the city, but one fact flies in the face of this legend and lore. O'Connor did not join the St. Louis Post-Dispatch until Nov. 26, 1911, one full month after the newspaper first mentioned "Bender's Billikens."

> Regardless of how the story is told or whether his mysterious origins are ever finally resolved, the Billiken remains a good luck charm for Saint Louis University's sports teams and always brings smiles to the faces of SLU fans.

> Legend has it that the Billiken has three kinds of luck – good, better and best. Buying a Billiken gives the buyer good luck. To have one given to you is better luck. The best luck comes if the Billiken is stolen.
