

- This season marks Little Rock's inaugural campaign in the Ohio Valley Conference.
- Joe Foley has reached 800+ career wins, ranking him third in the nation among active Division I head coaches
- Little Rock continutes its mantra of playing the toughest competition available in the non-conference slate. The Trojans will face five Southeastern Conference (SEC) teams along with Missouri State before opening OVC play.

QUITE THE INTRODUCTION

Jaiyah Smith made quite the introduction to Trojan fans in the season opener on Nov. 10 against Arkansas-Pine Bluff as the guard erupted for 11 rebounds, six assists and seven points in Little Rock's 60-56 win over the Golden Lions. Her 11 rebounds ranks 40th in the nation early on this year while her six assists ranks 45th nationally.

CALL HER A SERVER...

... because she can dish it out. Entering Sunday's matchup against the Hogs, Jaiyah (Harris-)Smith ranks 20th in the country and second in the Ohio Valley Conference in assists per game, averaging 6.5 dishes per contest.

SHE'S NOT THE ONLY ONE

Little Rock enters this game with a 65.8% assisted shot rate, a mark that ranks 33rd in the nation and ranks fourth in the OVC, behind Southern Indiana (70.0%, 13th nationally), Tennessee Tech (66.2%, 30th) and Eastern Illinois (66.0%, 32nd). The assisted shot rate is the percentage of field goals made by a team that were assisted.

YOU'VE GOTTA HAVE FAITH

George Michael knew and if you haven't been paying attention then maybe you'd know too. Little Rock freshman Faith Lee has found her groove early on, currently shooting 66.7% from the floor. That mark leads the OVC and ranks 35th in the nation.

STOP US IF YOU'VE HEARD THIS BEFORE

But the Trojans lead the league in scoring defense. Entering this game, Little Rock ranks 84th nationally and first in the Ohio Valley Conference by limiting opponents to 57.0 points per game. The next best OVC team, Eastern Illinois, ranks 132nd in the country and is allowing an average of 61.0 ppg.

DEATH. TAXES. JOE FOLEY'S DEFENSE.

If there's one thing coaches don't want to face, it's Joe Foley's defense. If there's two things they don't want to face, it's Joe Foley's defense twice in the same season. That is because Little Rock and Joe Foley have set the standard when it comes to the Trojans defensive efforts, ranking in the top two of their conference in 11 of the past 12 years in scoring defense while ranking in the top 25 nationally in scoring defense in nine of past 12 years.

The 2021-22 season was no different as Little Rock led the Sun Belt and ranked 49th in the nation in scoring defense.

DENY THE THREE

The Trojans have found initial success this season limiting opponents from their 3-point shooting success. Entering this game, Little Rock opponents are shooting 22.4% from beyond the arc, a number low enough to rank the Trojans 41st in the nation and atop the Ohio Valley Conference.

A BIG TEST SUNDAY

While that 3-point defensive number is impressive, Sunday's game against Arkansas will truly put it to the test. The Razorbacks enter the contest ranking ninth nationally and leading the SEC in 3-point attempts (106) and 79th in the country in 3-pointers per game (7.8), ranking second in the SEC.

NATURAL SUCCESS

With the 60-56 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 10, Little Rock continued its home domination over in-state foes at the Jack Stephens Center. Since the building opened in 2005, the Trojans have only suffered one loss at home against an in-state opponent at the Jack. That came at the hands of Arkansas in an 80-70 thriller in 2020.

CHARGE IT

Little Rock's defense is not a cash-operating group. The Trojans drew five charges in the season-opener against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 10. That's the most in a single game in recent memory. Last year, the Trojans drew four charges at South Alabama in a 74-52 win in Mobile.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

- ★ Arkansas heads to the Capital City with a 4-0 mark after a Thursday dismantling of Kent State.
- ★ With that win, Razorbacks coach Mike Neighbors recorded his 100th win as coach of the Hogs.
- ★ Sunday's game marks the second in-state road game Arkansas will play after visiting UA-Pine Bluff on Nov. 7 to open the season.
- ★ Arkansas ranks fourth nationally and second in the SEC in free throw attempts. Maybe don't foul them?
- ★ Or maybe do. The Hogs rank 321st in the nation and 14th in the SEC in free throw percentage with a 57.6% clip so far this season. May the odds be ever in your favor.
- ★ Arkansas ranks ninth nationally and first in the SEC in 3-point attempts per game.

Erynn Barnum ranks 12th nationally and third in the SEC in points scored (81) while ranking 49th nationally and second in the SEC by averaging 20.2 ppg.

Samara Spencer ranks 36th in the nation and third in the SEC in 3-point attempts. Seriously, somebody guard the long-range shot.

Chriss Carr, Makayla Daniels and Samara Spencer lead the Hogs with seven 3-pointers made each so far this season (a combined average of 5.25 per game). By contrast, Little Rock has only made a combined four 3-pointers through two games this year (2.0 per game).

SERIES HISTORY VS. ARKANSAS

- ★ This will be just the fifth meeting all-time between the Razorbacks and the Trojans.
- ★ Arkansas will be making its second trip all-time to the Jack Stephens Center. In that prior meeting at the Jack, the Razorbacks won 80-70 marking the first time an in-state team has won at the Jack Stephens Center.
- ★ Little Rock is looking for its first-ever win over Arkansas.
- ★ Last season's game in Fayetteville, Little Rock's first-ever trip to Bud Walton Arena, was not the "Flu Game" you'd hope to see. Trojan players began exhibiting signs of the flu the night before the game, lost the following day and canceled the remainder of its non-conference games due to an influenza outbreak that wrecked havoc on the team and its schedule.

Smith's 13 total assists currently led the OVC while her 6.5 assists per game ranked second in the league. Her 19 total rebounds and 9.5 rebounds per game both ranked second in the conference that week. Of her 19 total rebounds, 15 came on the defensive end of the floor, a mark that led the OVC. Those numbers, combined with an average of 9.0 points, nearly gave the transfer guard a double-double in her first week in a Little Rock uniform.

WE DON'T SHARE WELL WITH OTHERS

Little Rock doesn't like to share with others. That is why opponents are finding out it is difficult to get their hands on the ball. Little Rock opponents are averaging 6.0 steals per game early on this season, a mark that ranks Little Rock 72nd nationally. The Trojans have limited opponents to a steal rate of just 7.8%, ranking Little Rock 107th nationally. That tracks with Little Rock's Team as last season opponents averaged just 6.0 steals per game, ranking Little Rock 31st in the country, while recording a 7.5% steal rate, a mark that ranked 34th nationally.

FINISHING .500 IN SEC PLAY

Little Rock ended the non-conference part of its schedule last year by going .500 in games against Southeastern Conference opponents with wins over Auburn and Vanderbilt while falling to Arkansas and Texas A&M. Can the Trojans manage that success again this year?

THE TROJANS ARE STILL ALL ALONE

Little Rock was the only non-P5 team last season to record multiple wins over Southeastern Conference opponents. While some other teams managed to claim wins against the competitive league, Little Rock wass the only team to have found repeated success against the SEC. Two wins just means more ... than one. Coincidentally, the two wins came over Vanderbilt and Auburn and marks more wins over SEC foes than those two teams had combined the previous season.

BUT MAYBE TRY AMEX NEXT TIME

The Trojans will likely be opting for American Express or Mastercard next time as Sali Kourouma will not join the team until mid-December due to visa issues. Kourouma, who averaged 18.4 ppg last year, was required to return to her native Mali over the summer to renew her student visa.

BEWARE THE SCORING TROJANS

Because if Little Rock's shots start falling, things don't go well for others. The Trojans were 5-0 last season when scoring 70 or more points.

BECAUSE THE DEFENSE IS SECOND-TO-NONE

Joe Foley's defense is legendary. So much so it is the most cited reason for nightmares among Sun Belt head coaches. That is because when Little Rock holds teams below 60 points, the Trojans were 14-0 last season. Following the 60-56 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 10, that streak continues into this season. The streak came to an end on Nov. 13 when Ole Miss topped the Trojans, 58-40.

EFFECTIVE DEFENSE

Little Rock opponents often get frustrated when facing the Trojans and it's not hard to see why. In conference play last season, the Trojans led the Sun Belt by allowing just 58.2 ppg. The next best scoring defense in league play was Louisiana, who allowed 60.2 ppg.

YOU CAN'T STOP THIS LIQUE

Angelique Francis is seemingly unstoppable on the floor. Francis finished the 2021-22 season ranked 26th in the nation with a 60.0% field goal percentage. But if you think that's good, just look at the Fun she had in the Fun Belt. In league games last year, Francis as compiled a 64.3% field goal percentage, a mark that led the league.

HOME, SWEET, HOME

Little Rock is fond of the Jack Stephens Center and it isn't a place at which teams prefer to play. That's because the Trojans finished the 2021-22 season with an 8-4 home record. That's a remarkable stretch considering talented teams like Auburn, Coastal Carolina and Memphis have all left The Jack disappointed.

LITTLE ROCK STANDS ALONE...

As the only team from the state of Arkansas to win at Vanderbilt's Memorial Gym last season. The Trojans shut the Dores down in a 56-40 win on Nov. 12. Overall last season (men and women combined), Vanderbilt is 2-1 against teams from Arkansas with both the Commodore men and women registering wins in league play.

IT WASN'T THE FIRST...

When Little Rock beat Auburn on Nov. 24, 2021, that win was big but wasn't necessarily a first. With the win over Vanderbilt already on the books, the Trojans' victory over Auburn marked the third time in program history that Little Rock has registered multiple wins over Power 5 teams in a single season. It first happened in 2008 (Oklahoma State, at Ole Miss) and then again in 2014 (at LSU, Oklahoma).

JOE FOLEY

HEAD COACH | 20TH SEASON | CENTRAL ARKANSAS (1979)

Joe Foley, the 2010, 2011, 2015, 2017 and 2018 Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and 2010 Russell Athletic/WBCA Regional Coach of the Year, has led the Little Rock Women's Basketball program to 20win seasons 11 of the last 14 years, outright Sun Belt Conference West Division titles in the final six years the Sun Belt had divisions, three Sun Belt regular-season championships, post-season appearances in 10 of the last 13 years - including five NCAA berths - and Sun Belt Conference Tournament titles in 2011, 2012, 2015 and 2018. The third-winningest active coach in Division I, Foley has recorded an 833-29 (.738) career record and a 377-214 (.638) record at Little Rock as he begins his 20th season in 2022-23. He has led the Trojans to the semifinals of the Sun Belt Tournament in 14 of the past 15 years.

The Hall of Fame coach reached a remarkable milestone during the 2019-20 season when he recorded his 800th career victory - one of only five active head coaches to reach that plateau. In that season, Kyra Collier claimed first team All-Sun Belt honors marking the seventh consecutive year a Trojan has been represented on the first team. Little Rock has placed a Trojan on the league's all-conference teams list every single season Foley has guided Little Rock's Team.

Foley earned his 700th career victory in the NCAA Tournament's first round in 2015, and he signed a contract extension in April 2015 that will keep him as the Trojans' head coach through the 2023-24 sea-

In his tenure at Little Rock, Foley has compiled the most overall wins (29) and conference victories (18) in a season while producing the school's first All-Sun Belt Conference selection in Alicia Cash in 2004. He also recruited back-to-back Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year winners in Renee Renz (2006) and Kim Sitzmann (2007). No other Sun Belt Conference school has achieved this feat. Foley also coached the school's first-ever Honorable Mention All-America honoree in Chastity Reed in 2010. His Trojan student-athletes have earned 23 All-Conference selections.

Foley began his coaching career at the high school level as both the boys and girls basketball coach at Oxford (Ark.) High School from 1979-81, and then at Morrilton High School as an assistant for the boys team until 1984.

Foley has earned many personal accolades during his career. He has been named national coach of the year twice, region or district coach of the year seven times, chosen to be on the 1994 United States Olympic Festival coaching staff and was inducted into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame as a member of the class of 2002.

Foley earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Central Arkansas in 1979. He is married to the former Chris Fields of Alpena, Ark. The couple has two children, C.J. and Miranda.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. - It was Homecoming at the Jack Stephens Center on several levels Thursday evening. For a pair of Trojan new-comers, their first appearance in one of the toughest venues to play in resulted in yet another win for Little Rock's Team, this time a 60-56 win over UA Pine Bluff.

Nikki Metcalfe (16 points) and Faith Lee (14 points) led all players in scoring as Little Rock (1-0) celebrated its Homecoming game with a win.

For UA Pine Bluff's Raziya Potter and Azaria Robinson — former Trojans that transferred down to UAPB — the Homecoming wasn't quite as sweet. Potter was limited to nine points and whistled for four fouls while Robinson was held to three points and only four rebounds in the loss for the Golden Lions (0-2).

Although the Trojans rarely trailed, leading for over 30 minutes, the game was also never out of reach. Neither team built a double-digit lead and both teams struggled from the free throw line, shooting well under 60 percent. But the defensive resiliency that is Little Rock's Team prevailed yet again by forcing 21 Pine Bluff turnovers, six of which came off steals. That defensive pressure, which Little Rock is known for, managed to withstand a 44-38 deficit in rebounds.

The new-look Trojans have seemingly picked up key aspects of Foley's man defense early on. Of the eight players in maroon that saw the court Thursday, seven were making their first appearance in a Little Rock jersey. That includes Ole Miss transfer Jaiyah Smith, who scored seven points and grabbed 11 rebounds in her final preparation before she faces her old team on Sunday. Little Rock's scoring mostly came from new players, but it was from a mixture of young and old. Metcalfe, a graduate transfer from Arkansas Tech, led all players with 16 points while Faith Lee, a true freshman from Louisiana, scored 14 in her collegiate debut.

Coriah Beck led the Lions with 12 points. Little Rock held Maori Davenport to just five points and eight rebounds just days after she had a double-double (15 points, 14 rebounds) against Arkansas.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. - Joe Foley's teams over his 20 years at Little Rock have been known for their defensive pressure causing frustration that leads to turnovers and low scoring. On the day the court at the Jack Stephens Center was named for Foley, Ole Miss employed a similar tactic to claim the 58-40 win over the host Trojans.

Little Rock (1-1) may have forced 18 turnovers but 0le Miss (3-0) forced 20 turnovers out of Little Rock and used a 42.9 percent shooting mark and 38-25 rebounding advantage to claim the win Sunday.

Foley, now in his 20th season guiding the Trojans, was accepting of the outcome and not disappointed in the effort his team gave, knowing this was just another step in the meticulous process he cultivates to build a championship team. His record, with 834 wins, proves he right in that line of thought a lot more than not.

For Sunday's effort, it involved Tia Harvey's 13 points and six rebounds while Jaiyah Smith, guard that was on the Ole Miss roster a year ago, scored 11 bounds with eight rebounds and seven assists.

While Little Rock shot 37.8 percent from the field, it was the cold outings in the second and fourth quarters that became too much to overcome. The Trojans scored just 10 of their 40 points in those two quarters combined.

Marquesha Davis led Ole Miss with 13 points while Madison Scott was prevented from reaching a double-double, scoring just eight points and grabbing 10 rebounds. Davis was the only Rebel in double figures just days after Ole Miss had three reach double figures and scored 83 points in a win over Southeast Missouri, a new conference mate of Little Rock.

Angel Baker, last year's SEC Sixth Woman of the Year, was limited to just nine points over nearly 33 minutes.
