→ With **Neighbors** in charge, the Hogs are coming off back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (should be back-to-back-to-back had the COVID-19 pandemic have not cancelled the 2020 tournament) and four consecutive winning seasons

→ The long-awaited debuts of Maryam Dauda, Saylor Poffenbarger and Chrissy Carr took the stage in Pine Bluff on Monday night. Poffenbarger and Carr both got the start and reached double digits in scoring, with 11 and 10 points, respectively, while Dauda came off the bench to log four points

→ After one game, Erynn Barnum and Samara Spencer are the team's leading scorers with 15.0 points per game. **Barnum** also paces the team in rebounds with 11 boards per game  $\rightarrow$  The Razorbacks were projected to finish fourth in the SEC Preseason Media Poll and tied for fifth in the SEC Preseason Coaches Poll. - → Mike Neighbors will remain perfect against other Arkansas teams, improving his record to 9–0 vs. in-state schools

### MAK ATTACK

- → Makayla Daniels has started in all 89 career games she has appeared in at Arkansas, even as a true freshman
- **→** Was held to just four points on five shot attempts on Monday night at UAPB, but managed to get six rebounds and lead the team in efficiency with +29

 → She earned a spot on the SEC Preseason Second Team, her first recognition by the league since she was SEC Freshman of the Week in 2019–20
 → Coming off last season having averaged 14.0 points and a team-leading 5.3 rebounds per game in the guard spot. Daniels also averaged 2.9 assists and 1.8 steals per game

 $\rightarrow$  Became the 31st member of the 1,000-point club at Arkansas by getting it done versus Utah early in that game of the NCAA Tournament  $\rightarrow$  Scored two 30-point games last season (32 vs. Cal and 34 vs. Creighton) to join Chelsea Dungee, Alexis Tolefree and Shameka Christon as the only Hogs with multiple 30+ point games in the same season since 2000

→ Leading returning scorer and rebounder from last season

### DO THEY GIVE OUT SEC SOPHOMORE OF THE YEAR?

→ Samara Spencer is coming off an exceptional first year of collegiate ball, being named SEC Freshman of the Year, a first for Arkansas since 2009 when C'eira Ricketts won it

- → She led the team (along with Erynn Barnum) with 15 points, while also adding four boards and four assists at UAPB
- → Third among active SEC players in all-time award count after earning four SEC Freshman of the Week honors last year
   → Spencer averaged 12.2 points, 3.7 rebounds, 3.1 assists, 1.2 steals and 30.1 minutes per game last season
- → Led the team with 96 total assists last season
- → Logged 20 games in double figures, three of which were 20+-point performances

→ Scored a career-best 22 points and seven rebounds at Missouri and finished the season at the NCAA Tournament versus Utah with 18 points, five rebounds and three dimes

### **MISMATCH PROBLEM**

- → **Saylor Poffenbarger** is the textbook definition of a big guard
- → If you needed Poffenbarger to play any position one through five, she could handle the task. That's how versatile she is

 $\rightarrow$  She is coming off her first collegiate start, having tallied 11 points and eight rebounds. She achieved a collegiate career-high in pretty much every statistical category in Monday's game at UAPB after appearing in 12 games at UConn

### **DOUBLE DOUBLEEEEE**

- → Erynn Barnum is primed to add to her career double-double count this season and already did so on Monday
- → She tallied 15 points and 11 rebounds for her third double-double of her career
- → Barnum is the longest tenured Razorback, approaching her fifth year on the team (redshirted in 2018–19)
- $\rightarrow$  She is coming off last season having averaged 7.6 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. She started in 10 of 22 games, missing a large chunk due

→ The Little Rock native tallied career-high 18 points with nine boards vs. SMU last season. She had 8+ rebounds in 11 games

### WATCH LIST SZN

→ Erynn Barnum was named to the Katrina McClain Award Preseason Watch List as one of 20 power forwards in the country to do so

 $\rightarrow$  She is the first Arkansas player to be a candidate for this particular award and the first Razorback on a preseason watch list since prior to the 2020-21 season

### **TRANSFER PORTAL JACKPOT**

→ Chrissy Carr has started in 114 of 116 career games

→ She earned the start on Monday and delivered 10 points in 20 minutes played

→ An overall well-rounded player, **Carr** can shoot, attack the basket to get to her midrange, rebound and defend. Along with her leadership, she will be able to pick up a lot of what was lost from Sasha Goforth absence

→ She has averaged double digits, or near to it, all four years thus far. After averaging 9.8 PPG as a freshman and sophomore at Kansas State, Carr tallied a career-high 15.2 points and 4.9 rebounds per game as a junior. Coming off her senior year at Syracuse, Carr averaged 11.7 points and 4.6 boards per game and led the team in 3-pointers (60), while shooting 36.3 percent from deep

### TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

 $\rightarrow$  Being told to play in position you have never played before is quite tough, especially as a freshman in college, but Jersey **Wolfenbarger** handled that task with ease

MIKE NEIGHBOR

Arkansas women's basketball has been transformed into a nationally recognized program in just five short vears thanks to head coach Mike Neighbors. During his time back home at his alma mater, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best five-year period of sustained success in program history. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers -Neighbors has accumulated 194 wins during his nine seasons as a head coach, which is the most of any Division I head coach who has been a head coach for nine years.

Entering his sixth season on the bench for Arkansas, the program is coming off its fourth consecutive winning season and second straight NCAA Tournament appearance (would be three had the 2020 NCAA Tournament not have been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic). The Hogs' NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022 marked the first time since 2003 the program had played in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments (2002 and 2003). Arkansas finished yet another season with one of the most prolific offenses in the Southeastern Conference, leading the league in 3-pointers per game (8.1) and 3-point attempts (810), while finishing second in scoring offense (73.6 PPG). Neighbors' 2021-22 team was efficient at taking care of the basketball, leading the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.12) and fewest turnovers per game (11.1), which was fourth in the country. The Hogs were just one of six teams in the nation to commit two turnovers in a game (vs. Missouri on Jan. 9, 2022), which led the country.

Under Neighbors' leadership, Samara Spencer became the first Hog to win SEC Freshman of the Year since 2009, while Amber Ramirez was named an All-SEC Second Team choice and Jersey Wolfenbarger was tabbed to the SEC All-Freshman Team. Ramirez, who played three stellar seasons on the court as a Hog, finished the season second in 3-pointers per game (2.6) and 3-point percentage (40.2), as well as ninth in points per game (15.4) in the SEC. The Hogs were also just one of four SEC schools with 4+ players who averaged double digits (Ramirez [15.4], Makayla Daniels [14.0], Spencer [12.2] and Sasha Goforth [11.5]).


