- → Leading 3-point shooter on team
- → Has started in 118 of 120 collegiate games
- → Graduate transfer by way of Syracuse & K-State

- → Katrina McClain Preseason Watch List
- → Has double digits in all five games
- → Delivered career-high 27 points vs. Tulsa and followed that up with 20 vs. Kent State
- → Leads SEC in FG perc. (.673) [7th in NCAA], second in scoring and sixth in rebounding











NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

- \rightarrow Arkansas has started the year 5–0 for the first time since 2019. This marks the second time a Mike Neighbors team at Arkansas has gotten off to a start like such
- → The Razorbacks will hope to continue the momentum going into the Paradise Jam with three games lined up. Arkansas got off to an 8-0 start in 2016-17 and will look to match that with three more wins at the Paradise Jam
- → With a win on Thursday, **Neighbors** will have achieved the 200th in his career as a Division I head coach. He just earned his 100th at Arkansas in the Razorbacks' 80–59 win over Kent State
- → The Razorbacks keep on besting its season-high point total after every game, scoring 70 in the season opener at UAPB, 72 versus Central Arkansas, 79 against Tulsa, 80 at home against Kent State and 93 most recently at Little Rock
- → Arkansas is now 10–0 against in–state schools since the ban was lifted prior to the 2019–20 season and 3-0 versus teams in the Natural State this year
- → Four Razorbacks delivered double-digit numbers in scoring at Little Rock, marking the third time that has happened this season. Chrissy Carr put up a season-high 22, Erynn Barnum logged 15, Makayla Daniels had 12 and Samara Spencer delivered 11
- → After four games, **Barnum** is leading Arkansas with 19.2 points and 8.6 rebounds per game. She is leading the SEC in field goal percentage at .673 and is second in scoring and sixth in rebounding in the league
- → **Barnum's** field goal percentage is tied for the seventh best nationally
- → **Spencer** paces the team with 24 assists (sixth most assists/game in the SEC with 4.8) and **Daniels** has the most steals on the team with 10
- → The team leads the SEC in 3-point attempts per game and 3-pointers per game (8.2) and is second least turnovers committed per game (12.8) and free throws made per game (19)
- → Arkansas teams in the past few years have not been known for rebounding the ball effectively. but that has changed, as the Razorbacks have outrebounded opponents in all five games so far. Arkansas is third in rebounds per game with 47.40 (17th in the NCAA), as well as second in defensive rebounds per game with 34.4 (eighth in NCA) and fourth in rebounding margin at 10.8 (44th in the country)
- → With **Neighbors** in charge, the Hogs are coming off back—to—back NCAA Tournament appearances (should be back-to-back-to-back had the COVID-19 pandemic have not cancelled the 2020 tournament) and four consecutive winning seasons. Neighbors also has the most wins of any collegiate coach with 10 years of experience
- → The Razorbacks were projected to finish fourth in the SEC Preseason Media Poll and tied for fifth in the SEC Preseason Coaches Poll. **Daniels** represents Arkansas on the Preseason Second Team (Coaches poll)

HEADLINERS

- → Arkansas is traveling out of the states for a tournament for the first time since 2019 when the team played at the Bahamas Hoopfest in 2019
- ightarrow The Razorbacks will look to win another tournament title after taking home the title in the Bahamas in 2019
- → This edition of the Paradise Jam is the 23rd year of the event
- → Arkansas will play Northern Arizona for the first time in school history, Clemson for the fourth time and Kansas State for just the seventh time
- → Mike Neighbors is one win away from earning the 200th win of his career. He is most recently coming off his 100th win at Arkansas, becoming the fourth head coach in Razorback WBB history to do so
- → Makayla Daniels is now tied with Blair Savage (1989–93) at No. 27 on the all-time scoring list with 1,072 points. Her next step is reaching No. 26 to tie **Kelly Johnson** (1992– 96) at 1,109 points

SCOUTING NORTHERN ARIZONA ABOUT THE LUMBERJACKS

- → Northern Arizona was projected to finish third in the Big Sky Media Poll and fourth in the Coaches Poll out of 10 teams
- → The Lumberjacks are 3-2 heading into St. Thomas behind two 100-point wins (at Cal Baptist, 110-104 in 20T and versus Park Gilbert, 111-44) and a tight 69-68 loss to Arizona State
- → After five games, **Montana Oltrogge** leads the team with 14.2 points and 6.8 rebounds
- → **Regan Schenck** has been putting in work as a floor general with a team-leading 35 assists, while her and **Emily Rodabaugh** have the most steals on the team with 10
- \rightarrow NAU finished the 2021–22 season with 17–14 record, 12–8 in Big Sky play
- → The team is coming off a Big Sky Championship game appearance, falling to No. 2-seed Montana State, 75-64

 ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

- → **Loree Payne** is in her 13th year as a head coach and sixth season at the helm of NAU
- → Since Payne has taken over at the helm, NAU has the team trending in the right direction, most recently coming off a trip to the Big Sky Championship game
- → **Payne** is coming off her 200th career win, which was done in a big way with a double-

SCOUTING CLEMSON

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- \rightarrow Clemson was picked to finish 12th in the ACC Blue Ribbon Panel Preseason Poll. The Tigers are coming off a 10-21 season
- → Ruby Whitehorn made a spot on the Blue Ribbon Panel Newcomer Watch List. Whitehorn is a freshman from Detroit
- → The Tigers are 3–1 going into the Virgin Islands with wins coming over Gardner–Webb, Wofford and Richmond. Their lone loss is vs. No. 1/1 South Carolina
- → Amari Robinson leads the Tigers with 14.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game
- → Daisha Bradford paces the team in rebounds (7.3 RPG), assists (13) and steals (8)

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

- → Head coach **Amanda Butler** is in her fifth year at the helm of Clemson
- → **Butler** has experience playing against the SEC and Arkansas, as she was the head coach at Florida for nine years. **Butler** has an 11–2 record against the Razorbacks
- → Has led her teams to 12 postseason berths in 16 years, including an NCAA and WNIT second round appearances for the Tigers in 2019 and 2021, respectively

SERIES HISTORY OF CLEMSON VS. ARKANSAS

- → Arkansas is 3-0 in the series vs. the Tigers
- → The last time these two teams met was on Dec. 7, 2007, which resulted in a 79–63 win
- → The first game of this series was on March 15, 2002 in the NCAA Tournament (79–63, Arkansas)

SCOUTING KANSAS STATE

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- \rightarrow Kansas State is 5–0 coming into the Paradise Jam with its biggest win of the season coming against No. 4/6 lowa (84–83)
- → K-State was projected to finish sixth in the Big 12 with 37 votes
- → Serena Sundell earned her way on the All—Big 12 Preseason Team
- → After five games, **Gabby Gregory** leads with 21.4 points per game
- → Sundell pulls down a team's most rebounds per game with 7.0 and has the most assists (25). Jaelyn Glenn has tallied a team's most 15 steals
- → The Wildcats are coming off a 20-13 season in 2021-22, which ended in a second-round appearance at the NCAA Tournament, losing to NC State, 89-57

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

- → **Jeff Mittie** is in his 31st season as a head coach and approaching his ninth year at K-State
- → He is recently coming off his 600th win in the first game of the season
- → At K-State, Mittie has led his teams to six postseason appearances and four NCAA Tournament trips
- → He is among the top 20 in wins for active coaches in the NCAA

SERIES HISTORY OF KANSAS STATE VS. ARKANSAS

- → Arkansas and K-State are tied in the series, 3-3
- → These two teams met last on Dec. 7, 2019, resulting in an 81–72 win for Arkansas
- → Arkansas is on a two-game winning streak
- → The first time these two teams met was in 1982, when the Razorbacks won 68-53 in Fayetteville

LAST TIME OUT

- → Arkansas handed it to Little Rock on Sunday with a 93-49 win at the Jack Stephens Center
- → The Razorbacks shot a season best 62.5 from the field, marking the first time since 2020 the Razorbacks shot 60+ percent (Feb. 16, 2020, vs. 0le Miss)
- → Four players reached double digits in scoring for the fourth time this season
- → Chrissy Carr logged a season-best 22 points off 7-of-10 shooting and 4-of-6 from 3-point, delivering 15 of her points in the third quarter





→ **Erynn Barnum** registered 15 points and nine rebounds, while **Saylor Poffenbarger** had nine points and nine boards, with both just shy of reaching a double-double

→ Makayla Daniels delivered 12 points and four assists and Samara Spencer had 11 points, seven rebounds and six assists

→ All 12 players played, while 11 scored

AN ARKANSAS WIN MEANS... VS. NAU

→ **Mike Neighbors** will reach 200 career wins for the first game of the series

→ It will be the best start for Coach **Neighbors** at Arkansas

→ The first time since 2016 a Razorback team has been able to start a season 6–0

VS. CLEMSON

→ Head coach **Amanda Butler** will suffer just her third loss to Arkansas

 \rightarrow Arkansas will remain perfect in the series at 4-0

VS. K-STATE

ightarrow Arkansas will beat a ranked opponent for the first time since last season's 90–76 win over No. 12/11 LSU

→ The Razorbacks will improve to 4–3 in the all-time series

OFF TO A GREAT START

→ **Erynn Barnum** keeps pushing her foot on the gas, averaging 19.2 points and 8.6 rebounds per game

→ NCAA statistical rankings: seventh in free throw attempts (41), 16th in field goal percentage (67.3), 19th in points and 46th in rehounds

→ SEC statistical rankings: first in field goal percentage, second in free throw attempts, third in scoring, fifth in rebounding and 11th in blocks

→ Before the game against Tulsa, she never had a 20-point game, but is coming off backto-back 20-point games with a career-high 27 points and eight rebounds vs. Tulsa and 20 points with six boards against Kent State

→ Her 13 points in the fourth quarter against Tulsa were critical in solidifying the victory. She went 10-of-12 from the field, which also was a career best

→ She tallied 15 points and 11 rebounds for her third career double-double versus UAPB

→ Head coach **Mike Neighbors** has mentioned how **Barnum** has the capability of putting up a double-double every night

→ Longest tenured Razorback, approaching her fifth year on the team (redshirted in 2018–19)

→ Last season averaged 7.6 points and 4.8

→ Last season averaged 7.6 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. She started in 10 of 22 games, missing a large chunk due to injury

WATCH LIST SZN

→ **Erynn Barnum** was named to the Katrina McClain Award Preseason Watch List as one of the 20 best power forwards in the country

→ She is the first Arkansas player to be a candidate for this particular award and the first Razorback on a preseason watch list since prior to the 2020–21 season

MAK ATTACK

→ Makayla Daniels is one of three doubledigit scorers on the team with 11.5 PPG

→ Registered a season-high five assists, while

 \rightarrow Coming off 12 points and four assists at Little Rock. She took all of her shots off 3-point attempts and was 3-for-4

→ Now is tied with **Blair Savage** at No. 27 (1,072) on the all-time career scoring list. Then next stop is No. 26, which is currently held by **Kelly Johnson** who had 1,109 career points

→ Also tied with **Savage** for 20th on the all-time assist list (233)

→ Has fifth most points, fourth most steals (146) and sixth most assists (233) among active SEC players

→ She became the 31st member in the Razorbacks' final game last season in the NCAA Tournament versus Utah

→ Sits fifth in assist/T0 ratio (2.43) and eighth in 3-pointers per game (2.0) in the SEC

→ Has the 23rd best 3-point percentage in the country at a stellar 55.6, which is also No. 2 in the league

→ Earned a spot on the SEC Preseason Second Team, her first recognition by the league since she was SEC Freshman of the Week in 2019–20

→ Last season averaged 14.0 points and a team-leading 5.3 rebounds per game in the guard spot. **Daniels** also averaged 2.9 assists and 1.8 steals per game

→ Scored two 30-point games last season (32 vs. Cal and 34 vs. Creighton) to join Chelsea Dungee, Alexis Tolefree and Shameka Christon as the only Hogs with multiple 30+ point games in the same season since 2000

MIKE NEIGHB

THE MOST INTERESTING COACH IN COLLEGE BASKETBALL Sixth Season | Career Record: 199-105 (10) | Arkansas Record: 101-64 (6)

Arkansas women's basketball has been transformed into a nationally recognized program in just five short vears thanks to head coach Mike Neighbors. During his time back home at his alma mater, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best five-year period of sustained success in program history. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers -Neighbors has accumulated 194 wins during his nine seasons as a head coach, which is the most of any Division I head coach who has been a head coach for nine years.

Entering his sixth season on the bench for Arkansas, the program is coming off its fourth consecutive winning season and second straight NCAA Tournament appearance (would be three had the 2020 NCAA Tournament not have been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic). The Hogs' NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022 marked the first time since 2003 the program had played in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments (2002 and 2003). Arkansas finished yet another season with one of the most prolific offenses in the Southeastern Conference, leading the league in 3-pointers per game (8.1) and 3-point attempts (810), while finishing second in scoring offense (73.6 PPG). Neighbors' 2021-22 team was efficient at taking care of the basketball, leading the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.12) and fewest turnovers per game (11.1), which was fourth in the country. The Hogs were just one of six teams in the nation to commit two turnovers in a game (vs. Missouri on Jan. 9, 2022), which led the country.

Under Neighbors' leadership, Samara Spencer became the first Hog to win SEC Freshman of the Year since 2009, while Amber Ramirez was named an All-SEC Second Team choice and Jersey Wolfenbarger was tabbed to the SEC All-Freshman Team. Ramirez, who played three stellar seasons on the court as a Hog, finished the season second in 3-pointers per game (2.6) and 3-point percentage (40.2), as well as ninth in points per game (15.4) in the SEC. The Hogs were also just one of four SEC schools with 4+ players who averaged double digits (Ramirez [15.4], Makayla Daniels [14.0], Spencer [12.2] and Sasha Goforth [11.5]).






