Set for three games against Power 5 opponents, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks arrive at the Paradise Jam in St. Thomas of the U.S. Virgin Islands with three consecutive victories. Beating UC San Diego, California Baptist and Park University, Gilbert (AZ), Northern Arizona sits above .500 through five games this season.

The Lumberjacks have scored 100+ points in consecutive games for the first time in program history, beating the Californa Baptist Lancers 110-104 in double overtime and Park (AZ) 111-44 in regulation. The scoring outputs rank second and third in school history and stand as two of Northern Arizona's eight all-time games at or above 100 points scored. The 111 points against Park, an NAIA program, are the most in a regulation game, surpassing the 109 scored against Antelope Valley during the 2016 season

Five Lumberjacks set new career highs in points scored against Park, as true freshmen Audrey Taylor (18), Sophie Glancey (17), Taylor Feldman (15) and Mary McMorris (10) all reached double-digits. Junior Sanjana Ramesh recorded her first career double-double with career highs in points (10) and rebounds (11).

 Just five games into the season, nine Lumberjacks have set or tied their career-highs in scoring as Lumberjacks. While six of those players are new to the program and scored for the first time as Lumberjacks, Nyah Moran (25 vs. California Baptist) and Ramesh (10 vs. Park AZ) set new career bests with Fatoumata Jaiteh (12 vs. UCSD) tying hers.

The Lumberjacks recorded 23 steals in the game against Park, the second-most in school history behind the record of 29 set against Denver in 1986, while forcing 34 turnovers. NAU surpassed its school record of 43 field goals made in a game, set last season against Grand Canyon, by hitting 45-of-78 from the field. Leading by as much as 70 in the fourth quarter, the Lumberjacks threatened their program record of 72 points for the largest victory set against Sacramento State in 2002. Scheduled to face off against Arkansas, Kansas State and Clemson across a three-day stretch, Northern Arizona will make it five Power 5 opponents across their first eight games of the season. The game against Kansas State will be the third meeting in school history while Arkansas and Clemson are the first ever meetings.

OUTLASTING THE LANCERS

- Battling with the California Baptist Lancers on Nov. 16 in Riverside, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks emerged from double overtime with a dramatic victory.
- Trailing by as much as 11 points and leading by as much as 14, the Lumberjacks finished regulation even at 80-80. A three-point play by Emily Rodabaugh gave Northern Arizona an 80-78 victory with18 seconds left after trailing by one point. While a pair of free throws by the Lancers sent the game to overtime, Rodabaugh's isolation play inside the paint helped the Lumberjacks extend the game.
- After taking a five-point lead early in overtime, the Lumberjacks found themselves down 89-87 with two seconds left, setting up Olivia Moran for a buzzer beater in the paint on a pass from Montana Oltrogge. The basket tied the game at 89, forcing a second overtime.
- A three-pointer by Emily Rodabaugh put the Lumberjacks ahead 96-94 with 3:41 left and Montana Oltrogee broke a 96-96 tie with a three at 3:08 left. Taylor Feldman added another three with 1:41 left, giving the Lumberjacks a secure lead at 103-97.
- With five Lumberjacks fouling out in a game, as 37 fouls were called on Northern Arizona, the team turned to its freshmen depth. Stuck without starters Nyah Moran, Regan Schenck and Sophie Glancey, as well as Fatoumata Jaiteh, Northern Arizona sent out Emily Rodabaugh, Montana Oltrogee and Olivia Moran alongisde a rotation of three freshmen in Taylor Feldman, Mary McMorris and Saniyah Neverson. After Neverson fouled out near the end of the second overtime, the other five remained the primary players on the court.
- Playing back in their hometown of Riverside, twins Nyah and Olivia Moran produced impressive moments. Along with Olivia's buzzer-beater, Nyah finished with a career high 25 points. Taylor Feldman, from nearby Tustin, also scored a career high (before it was reset against Park AZ), with nine points in the pair of overtimes.
- Hitting 15 three-pointers, led by Nyah Moran's five and Emily Rodabaugh's six, the Lumberjacks tied a program record.

WARMING UP FOR THE ISLANDS

- Facing off with NAIA opponent, the Park University, Gilbert (AZ) Buccaneers, Northern Arizona impressed with another offensive onslaught. Scoring 111 points, the most in a regulation game in school history with a school record of 45 field goals made, seven Lumberjacks reached double-digits.
- Five Lumberjacks set new career highs against Park, highlighted by Sanjana Ramesh's first career double-double of 10 points and 11 rebounds. True freshmen Audrey Taylor, Sophie Flancey, Taylor Feldman and Mary McMorris also set new career highs in the game.
- Forcing 34 turnovers, Northern Arizona recorded 23 steals in the game against Park, the second-most in school history behind the record of 29 set against Denver in 1986

SCARING THE SUN DEVILS

- Playing for the first time since 2010, Northern Arizona and Arizona State went down to the final moments of the season opener on Nov. 7.
- Leading by as much as four points in the fourth quarter, the Lumberjacks missed their final

seven shots from the field while also forcing the Sun Devils to miss 10 consecutive shots from the field over a nearly five-minute stretch. Scoring five of their final seven points from the free-throw line in the game's closing 4:06, Arizona State escaped as Northern Arizona hit just 7-of-15 from the line in the game.

Having dropped five straight meetings against Arizona State, Northern Arizona was seeking its first win over the Sun Devils since 1995 and its first victory over a Pac-12 opponent since an 84-66 victory in Flagstaff over the Arizona Wildcats in 2017. The win against Arizona is also the most recent win over a Power Five opponent for the Lumberjacks.

BIG SKY AND NCAA RANKINGS

- Entering the Paradise Jam as the top scoring team in the Big Sky, Northern Arizona's 86.4 points per game has the Lumberjacks 19th in all of the NCAA.
- The team's 17.2 assists per game and 42.0 rebounds per game also top the conference and rank 52nd and 87th nationally.
- Regan Schenck's 35 total assists and 7.0 assists per game rank fifth and 10th in the nation respectively. Having recorded 13 assists in the season opener against Arizona State, Schenck is tied for third in the nation for most assists in a game this season.
- Montana Oltrogge and Emily Rodabaugh rank fourth and fifth in the Big Sky Conference with 11 and 10 three-pointers made respectively this season.

ROLLING IN ROLLE

- Winning 17 of their past 20 games in Rolle Activity Center, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks will open the season with their three home games set for the location before moving into the Walkup Skydome (now with the moniker of Findlay Toyota Court) in late December.
- Since beating Seattle 88-80 in the 2019 season opener at Rollle, Northern Arizona finished 9-2 in Rolle during the 2020-21 season as all games were played in Rolle during the pandemic and 5-1 in 2021-22 with a heavy December of home games giving the Lumberjacks plenty of opportunities. The season-opening victory against UC San Diego, beating the Tritons 87-54, made it five consecutive wins to start their home schedules before a 111-44 victory against Park added to the impressive stretch.
- Northern Arizona also won its past four home openers, with victories against UNLV in 2021 (84-62), UTEP in 2020 (83-75), Seattle in 2019 (88-80) and Fresno State in 2018 (86-73).
- In those 20 games, the Lumberjacks have broken 80 points on 14 occasions, with all 14 ending in a victory for Northern Arizona.

SEASON OPENERS

- After opening their seasons with a member of the Mountain West Conference for three straight seasons between 2018 and 2020, the Lumberjacks faced a Pac-12 opponent to start the season for the second straight year.
- During her tenure, Payne is 2-4 in season openers after falling to Arizona State in Tempe 69-68 this season. Last year, Northern Arizona fell to the Washington State Cougars 62-54 in Pullman, Wash. Opening the 2020-21 season, Northern Arizona defeated UNLV 79-75 in Las Vegas. In 2019, Northern Arizona opened the season with an 83-76 loss to New Mexico after beating Fresno State 86-73 to open the 2018 season. Payne's debut against UCSB in 2017 came as a close 96-93 loss.

THE MAGIC NUMBER

- Dating back to the 2018-19 season, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks are 31-1 when scoring at least 80 points, including a 9-0 record during the 2021-22 season.
- This season, Northern Arizona has added three wins to the run, beating UC San Diego 87-54 in its home opener before outlasting California Baptist 110-104 in double overtime in Riverside. Most recently, Northern Arizona beat Park University, Gilbert (AZ) 111-44.
- Eight of the nine games with 80 points last year came in Flagstaff, with Northern Arizona beating UNLV (84-62), Weber State (83-79), Idaho State (81-74 OT), Grand Canyon (108-77), Cal Poly (88-73), Portland State (94-66), Eastern Washington (81-76) and Idaho (86-69). Northern Arizona broke through with its first 80-point game away from Flagstaff with an 89-77 victory against Weber State, the program's ninth consecutive win against the Wildcats and the seventh straight time scoring at least 80 points.
- The only loss in the past four seasons came in the 2020-21 regular season finale in Cedar City, Utah against Southern Utah, 97-80. The streak includes an 21-0 record in Flagstaff, a 5-1 record on the road and a 2-0 run on a neutral court with both victories coming in 2020-21 against Weber State at the Big Sky Tournament and FIU in the 2021 WBI.
- Northern Arizona is also 21-3 in the past three seasons when shooting 45 percent or better from the field,
- including 11-2 last year. The losses came to Portland in the 2021 WBI and to Montana State twice in 2022. In 2022-23, the Lumberjacks hit 46.8 percent from the field against California Baptist for their first victory to add to the record this season before hitting 57.7 percent against Park University.

RECORDS WATCH

- Needing just two games this season, Regan Schenck moved into the Top 10 all time in rebounds thanks to her two against Arizona. Schenck sits 10th all-time at 594, 17 back of ninth.
- Schenck has also moved into the Top 4 all-time in minutes played (3,715) and took second all-time in games played (126). The fifth-year senior also needs 130 more assists to tie for the most in program history, a record that has stood since 2009 when Sade Cunningham finished her four-year career with 637.
- Sitting at 948 points, Schenck is also 52 points away from becoming the 20th 1,000-point scorer in school history.
- Emily Rodabaugh hit her 100th career three-pointer in the game against Arizona State, now sitting at 109 for her career. With one more make, Rodabaugh will tie for 10th all-time at Northern Arizona.

ANOTHER STRONG PRESEASON PICK

- Having made a run to the Big Sky Conference Championship game a year ago, the Lumberjacks once again rank near the top of the Big Sky's two preseason polls. Voted to finish in third by the media and fourth by the coaches, five freshmen and a transfer have not deterred those from pushing Northern Arizona up in the polls again. Last year, the Lumberjacks were voted to finish fourth and fifth by the coaches and media respectively and ranked third in both polls ahead of the 2020-21 season.
- Finishing 12-8 in the Big Sky's schedule last season, the Lumberjacks have now won 34 Big Sky games

over the past three seasons, the most conference wins in a three-season stretch in program history. Following their run to the Big Sky championship game last season, the Lumberjacks finished above .500 at 17-14 for the third consecutive year, stringing together winning seasons for the first time since recording three straight between 2004-05 and 2006-07.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST IN 2021-22

- Finishing the 2021-22 season seventh in the nation with a 37.2 three-point percentage and 31st in the nation with a 44.3 field-goal percentage, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks ranked as one of the best offenses in the country.
- Scoring 72.8 points per game, Northern Arizona finished 34th in the nation and ranked 46th in the nation with 15.2 assists per game. All three scoring and shooting totals ranked atop the Big Sky Conference while the assists per game average finished second.
- The scoring average ranked in a tie for third all-time for a single season, the highest average since the 2013-14 season when the Lumberjacks also averaged 72.8 points per game. The team's 848 field goals made set a new program record, and the 187 three-pointers finished fourth in history. Primarily aided by Regan Schenck's record-breaking assist season, the team's 470 assists finished fourth in history.
- The 44.3 percent shooting from the field ranked fourth in school history, with the team's free-throw percentage of 72.3 percent ranking fifth and the 37.2 percent from three-point range landing second.

AWARD WINNERS ALL RETURNING

- Despite finishing fourth in the Big Sky Conference last season, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks had just two players named to the Big Sky All-Conference team a year ago. Only Regan Schenck remains from the honorees as she earned an All-Big Sky Honorable Mention as well as Big Sky All-Tournament honors in 2021-22.
- The two honors brought NAU's total to 10 during head coach Loree Payne's tenure, with the Lumberjacks earning at least one spot on an all-conference team for six straight years.

CHASING HISTORY

- After Khiarica Rasheed spent her final season jumping up multiple all-time lists, Regan Schenck will do the same in 2022-23.
- Having set the single-season record for assists last year and the single-season three-point percentage
 record in 2020-21, Schenck will now chase 1,000 career points and a place in the program's Top 10
 of scoring. Needing just seven rebounds, Schenck will break into the Top 10 for rebounding soon and
 become just the third Lumberjack ever to rank Top 10 in both rebounding and assists. Also currently
 fourth in games played and sixth in minutes played. Schenck has a chance to become the program's
 leader in both categories by the end of the season.
- Schenck will need to average 5.32 assists per game in Northern Arizona's 31 regular season games to reach Sade Cunningham's career record of 637 assists. With her career average of 7.46 points per game, Schenck should reach 1,000 career points in the 13th game of the year against UNLV to finish non-conference play. Schenck's career average should also place her among the Top 8 in scoring while her rebounding average of 4.75 should place her among the Top 5 all-time.
- Sitting at 121 career games played Schenck will set the program record for games played, surpassing Khiarica Rasheed's record of 143 set last season, against Montana State on Feb.2 after tying the record against Northern Colorado on Jan. 28. As for minutes played, Schenck's career average of 29.6 should put her as the program's record holder in the game at Idaho on Jan. 19, if not sooner.
- Along with Schenck, Emily Rodabaugh will look to continue her impressive career from outside so far. Sitting at 99 career threes, Rodabaugh will soon break into the Top 10 in threes made while also trying to hold onto her third-place ranking on the program's three-point percentage mark. Rodabaugh is also just 19 blocks from reaching the Top 10 and finished with 22 and 29 blocks over the past two seasons.
- Hitting 1.58 three-pointers per game over the past two seasons, Rodabaugh should move into sixth all-time by the end of the season while her .86 blocks per game over the past two seasons should place her eighth all-time by the end of the season.

NON-CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

- Northern Arizona's 13-game non-conference schedule includes five schools from Power 5 conferences with a total of four programs that reached the NCAA Tournament in 2022 and five ranked among the Top 75 in the NET rankings at the end of the 2021-22 season.
- Part of Northern Arizona's challenging non-conference schedule comes from the Thanksgiving trip to the United States Virgin Islands to face Arkansas, Kansas State and Clemson at the Paradise Jam.
- Finishing 12-14 last season, including a 4-9 record in the Pac-12, the Arizona State Sun Devils still finished 49th in the NET rankings last season.
- Finishing 21-8 with a 10-6 record in the Pac-12, the Arizona Wildcats earned a No. 4 seed in the NCAA Tournament and reached the second round while finishing 22nd in the NET rankings. The Wildcats enter the season ranked No. 19 in the nation.
- California Baptist finished the year 23-9 overall with a 13-5 record in the WAC. Falling to Grand Canyon
 in the WAC Tournament semifinals, the Lancers went on to play in the WNIT and finished 134th in the
 NET rankings.
- Arkansas nearly reached 20 wins last season, finishing at 18-14 with a 7-9 mark in the SEC. The Razorbacks were a No. 10 seed in the NCAA Tournament while ranking 34th in the NET rankings last season. Arkansas earned votes in the preseason Top 25 Poll.
- Kansas State finished at 20-13 overall and 9-9 in the Big 12 to earn a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament, where it beat No. 8 seed Washington State in the opening round. Kansas State earned votes in the preseason Top 25 Poll.
- No longer a member of the Big Sky Conference as they joined the WAC this past July, Southern Utah finished 18-12 overall and 14-6 in the Big Sky last year. The Lumberjacks and Thunderbirds are tentatively scheduled to face each other annually while alternating hosting duties.
- UNLV finished 2021-22 with a 26-7 record and a 15-3 mark in the Mountain West Conference to earn a No. 13 seed where it faced Arizona in the first round. The Lady Rebels finished 75th in the NET rankings while having lost to Northern Arizona 84-62 in Flagstaff last season.

 Northern Arizona's other opponents in non-conference play include UCSD which finished with a winning Big West Conference record in the program's second year as a Division I school and the UC Davis Aggies who finished 8-8 in the Big West and 15-13 overall.

ALL NEW JACKS FROM NEW PLACES

- Moving away from their heavy Oregon and Washington influence during head coach Loree Payne's early seasons with the program, Northern Arizona's six additions this year came from the Southwest with the exception of a pair from Boise, Idaho.
- Adding five freshmen from four different states, the Lumberjacks brought in Taylor Feldman from California, May McMorris from Nevada, Saniyah Neverson from Arizona and high school teammates Audrey Taylor and Sophie Glancey from Idaho.
- Feldman arrived in Flagstaff following her time as a four-year starter for the Crean Lutheran Saints. Finishing her career as a four-time First Team All-League honoree, four-time First Team All-CIF honoree and three-time All-State honoree, including First Team in 2021, Feldman set multiple school records.
- Setting the marks for points (2,401), assists (436) and steals (456), Feldman
 also finished with the second-most rebounds (615) and holds the school's single-game record with 54 points and single-season record holder with 708 points.
 Feldman and the Saints reached the CIF Tournament in all four seasons, including a trip to the 3AA Finals during her sophomore season. The Empire League
 MVP as a senior, Feldman helped the Saints reach the CIF-Southern Section
 2AA semifinals last February. Driving to the basket against the Sonora Raiders
 with just seconds remaining, Feldman hit a layup with just 3.4 seconds remaining
 to break a 46-46 tie. Feldman finished the quarterfinal with 27 points, scoring 11
 in the fourth, as the Saints beat the Raiders 48-46.
- McMorris won a Class 4A state title with Centennial in 2020, a sixth straight state championship for the Bulldogs, finishing the year 24-6 and on a 12-game winning streak. A 5-6 guard, McMorris had her high school career disrupted by COVID-19 as high school schedules were canceled in 2021. Last spring, McMorris won another 6A state title and averaged 5.6 assists a game.
- Neverson spent the first two years of her high school career playing for Valley Vista High School in Surprise, winning a 6A Conference State Championship during her sophomore year. An All-6A Conference Southwest Region Second Team honoree as a sophomore, Neverson transferred to PHH Prep entering her junior season. The 6-1 power forward helped PHH Prep finish off its inaugural season with a Grind Session championship and a 40-3 record.
- The duo from Timberline finished as the state runners-up with Timberline in 2019-20 with a 19-2 record. The team also won its conference in 2020-21 and was named the Academic State Champions in both years. Playing on varsity for Timberline all four years of their high school careers, Taylor and Glancey both earned All-5A SIC First Team honors during their high school careers. Taylor doing so last spring as a junior and Glancey was honored as a sophomore and junior years while also earning all-state second team honors as well in her sophomore year. Taylor and Glancey helped lead Timberline to a state title during their senior seasons. Taylor finished with 13.9 points, 3.7 assists and 2.7 steals as a senior while Glancey averaged 17.0 points, 9.7 rebounds and 1.7 blocks per game.

FOE TURNED FRIEND

- Looking to play the final year of her college eligibility closer to home, former Idaho State Bengal Montana Oltrogge moved to the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks just a few hours north of where she played high school in the Valley.
- An All-Big Sky Conference Tournament selection in 2021, Oltrogge played 108 games with 24 career starts for the Bengals. Scoring 7.4 points and grabbing 2.9 rebounds, Oltrogge finished with a career-best 10.1 points per game last year.
- Scoring a career-high 24 points with six three-pointers made against Southern Utah in 2020, Oltrogge brings a career 33.9 percent from outside and 85.5 percent from the free-throw line.

SOPHOMORES STEPPING UP

- With just six players returning from the 2021-22 season, sophomores Nyah Moran, Olivia Moran and Fatoumata Jaiteh will all see drastically enhanced roles in 2022-23.
- Entering their third season with Northern Arizona, but still listed as sophomores due to the additional year of eligibility given to players as a result of COVID-19, Nyah Moran and Olivia Moran will take on crucial roles this season.
- Nyah Moran jumped to 40.0 percent from three-point range in her second season while playing in all 31 games for the Lumberjacks. Scored a season-high 13 points against Sacramento State, the same game twin sister Olivia Moran finished with 17 points as the duo helped lead the Lumberjacks to a 68-57 victory. Olivia Moran recorded her first career double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds in Northern Arizona's shorthanded game at Idaho before scoring 17 a week later in Sacramento. Olivia Moran closed out the regular season with a crucial 18-point performance against Idaho in Flagstaff, helping the Lumberjacks clinch a bye at the Big Sky Conference Tournament and land as the No. 4 seed.

Fatoumata Jaiteh played in 30 of 31 games as a freshman while starting three games. Scoring 12 points off the bench against eventual Big Sky Conference champion Montana State, Jaiteh added a career-best five rebounds in the game. Jaiteh shot 47.3 percent from the field as a freshman, with a strong 8-point, 4-rebound game against Northern Colorado in the Big Sky semifinals game in Boise.

BREAKING BARRIERS

- After playing in three games as a freshman, junior Sanjana Ramesh recorded her first career points during the 2020-21 season. Scoring four points in the third game of the year against Easthern Washington, Ramesh took the next step in her career with the Lumberjacks.
- In 2021-22, Ramesh matched her career high with 11 minutes played against Idaho while tying her career high of four points with the Lumberjacks beating the Vandals 76-63 in Moscow while playing with just seven players.
- Ramesh is the second Indian-born female player to receive a Division I scholarship, having captained India's U16 team in the FIBA's U16 Asia Cup in 2017 and proceeded to play for India in the 2018 William Jones Cup in Taiwan. Ramesh also participated in the NBA Academics Women's Program camp in May 2018 at the NBA Academy India and followed up by being named MVP of the girls division at Basketball Without Borders Asia, a three-day development camp featuring the top male and female basketball prospects throughout Asia.
- Since signing with Northern Arizona, Ramesh's story has been covered by ESPN, Good Morning America, CBS News and countless publications in India.

A NEW FIVE YEARS

- After reaching the Big Sky Conference championship game, head coach Loree Payne signed a new five-year extension with Northern Arizona.
- Payne's five-year tenure with the Lumberjacks has seen the program improve from a 7-23 season in 2017-18 to finishing above .500 for three consecutive seasons. Northern Arizona has won a game at the Big Sky Conference Tournament in the past four seasons, a total of five victories during the stretch culminating in a Big Sky Championship game appearance in Boise, Idaho to conclude the 2021-22 season.
- Northern Arizona's 17 wins in 2021-22 marked its highest win total since the 2006-07 season, the last time the team reached the conference title game. Payne's three consecutive seasons above .500 is the first such stretch since the mid-2000s, and the team's 34 Big Sky Conference wins is the most in a three-season stretch in program history.

NEW FACES ON STAFF

- For the first time during her tenure, head coach Loree Payne added a pair of new coaches to the staff.
- TJ Harris joined Northern Arizona from Portland State and returns to Flagstaff where he previously served as the head coach of the Northland Prep Academy Spartans boys and girls basketball teams,
- Before moving north to Portland prior to the 2021-22 season, Harris spent a year as an assistant coach at Chandler-Gilbert Community College while teaching at Combs High School in San Tan Valley, Ariz.
- A graduate of the University of Great Falls, now known as the University of Providence, Harris played for the Vikings from 2011 to 2015. Earning First Team All-Conference honors as a senior, Harris averaged 14.8 points, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals while hitting nearly 43 percent from the three-point line. While at Providence, Harris played alongside his brother Michael after finishing high school career at Huntley Project High School in Montana as a three-sport athlete. Named First Team All-Conference and All-State, Harris landed on the Montana All-Star team.
- Harris earned a bachelor's of art in secondary education in 2016 from Providence and later added a master's of education in educational leadership from Northern Arizona in 2020.
- Ryan Freeman arrives at Northern Arizona after four seasons on the staff for the New Mexico Lobos. In 2021-22, Freeman served as the special assistant to the head coach of the New Mexico women's basketball program after two years as the team's video coordinator and one as a graduate assistant.
- In his role last season, Freeman was responsible for the Lobos' scheduling,travel, team operations and camps. Before taking on his role as video coordinator in 2019, Freeman's duties as a graduate assistant during the 2018-19 season included assisting with scouting and team workouts, cutting and editing game and practice video, and creating content for recruiting and social media purposes.
- Before arriving in Albuquerque, Freeman completed his undergraduate degree at the University of Florida where he served in multiple roles for the women's basketball program. Starting out as a student video assistant, Freeman worked as a student manager for the Gators' 2017-18 season.
- Along with his experience within a pair of collegiate women's basketball programs, Freeman also worked as a referee for the Mid Florida Officials Association and as a support staff member for USA Basketball in 2014.
- A graduate of Florida in 2018, Freeman left Gainesville with a bachelor's degree in sports management.

TOP 25 OPPORTUNITY

- Northern Arizona faces a Top 25 opponent for the fourth straight season when they travel to Tucson for another meeting with the Arizona Wildcats. Ranked No. 19 in the Coaches Poll and the Associated Press Poll, the Wildcats continue their annual meeting with the Lumberjacks.
- Last season in Flagstaff, the Wildcats defeated the Lumberjacks 82-55 while ranked No. 4 in the nation. During the 2020-21 season, Northern Arizona faced the No. 7 Wildcats in Tucson and fell 76-63 in the second game of the year. During the 2019-20 season, the Lumberjacks lost to the No. 4 Oregon State Beavers 91-57 at the Maui Jim Maui Classic in Hawaii.
- The Lumberjacks last defeated a ranked opponent in 2007 when Northern Arizona beat No. 25 Montana 64-59 in Missoula during the Big Sky Conference Tournament Semifinals. Northern Arizona is 1-19 all-time against ranked opponents.

SMART JACKS

- Last season, eight Lumberjacks landed on the Big Sky Conference's All-Academic Team and 12 Lumberjacks earned Golden Eagle Student-Athletes honors from the Northern Arizona University Athletic Department. Among the 12, former Lumberjack Lauren Orndoff was named the Co-Top Female Golden Eagle Scholar-Athlete.
- During Loree Payne's tenure, Northern Arizona has earned a place in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll multiple times. The Lumberjacks placed in a tie for 20th during the 2019-20 academic year with a 3.646 GPA after ranking 12th with a 3.616 GPA following the 2018-19 season.
- The two honors gave the Lumberjacks seven appearances during the 27-year history of the WBCA compiling honor rolls ro recognize Division I, II, III, NAIA and two-year schools. Northern Arizona's 3.646 GPA in 2019-20 was the highest annual GPA going back to the 2001-02 season.

A new era of Northern Arizona women's basketball tipped off with the hiring of Loree Payne as the 12th head coach in program history on April 7, 2017.

In her five seasons in Flagstaff, Payne has the Lumberjack women's basketball program trending in the right direction. After posting seven victories in her inaugural season, Payne nearly doubled NAU's win total to 13 in her second year. The Lumberjacks' Big Sky win total also doubled from four in 2017-18 to eight in 2018-19 and Payne's second season ended with the program's first conference tournament win in 12 years.

Northern Arizona took another step forward in 2019-20 under Payne as the Lumberjacks finished with their first winning season since 2006-07. With 12 conference victories, the Lumberjacks finished in a tie for 4th in the Big Sky. With a victory over Montana, the Lumberjacks reached the semifinals of the Big Sky Tournament in 2020 for the first time since 2007. Khiarica Rasheed (First Team), Jacey Bailey (Second Team) and Caitlin Malvar (honorable mention) all earned All-Big Sky honors for the 2019-20 season while Nina Radford was named the Big Sky's Newcomer of the Year.

Once again, the Lumberjacks reached the Big Sky Tournament and won a game in 2020-21, beating Weber State 82-68 to reach the quarterfinals. NAU also went to a postseason tournament for just the second time in program history as it accepted a bid to the 2021 Women's Basketball Invitational. A first-round victory over FIU brought NAU its first postseason victory and the team earned a third-place finish in the tournament after defeating Stetson to conclude its season. Regan Schenck earned her first career All-Big Sky honor when she landed on the second team while Rasheed ended up with third-team honors and JJ Nakai gave the Lumberjacks a second consecutive Newcomer of the Year award while the Flagstaff native also also wound up with honorable mention honors.

Reaching the Big Sky Conference Tournament championship game for the first time since 2007, Payne led the Lumberjacks to a pair of victories in the conference tournament after entering as the No. 4 seed. Finishing the regular season 15-13 with a 12-8 mark in the Big Sky, Northern Arizona defeated No. 5 Montana 75-57 in the quarterfinals and No. 8 seed Northern Colorado 72-67 in the semifinals before falling 75-64 in the championship game to Montana State. Both Regan Schenck and Khiarica Rasheed earned spots on the Big Sky All-Tournament Team and All-Big Sky Honorable Mention.

Payne's influence on the program goes far beyond the court though. Her emphasis on developing the complete student-athlete was apparent during the past two academic years as the Lumberjacks finished 12th and tied for 20th among Division I teams in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. NAU's 3.616 cumulative team grade point average for the 2018-19 academic year earned the program its first finish in the WBCA's top 25 academic ranking since the 2009-10 season and sixth overall. NAU was the only Big Sky Conference institution ranked that season and the Lumberjacks' 3.616 GPA was not only the program's best, but the fourth-highest by a conference program, in available data going back to 2001-02 year. During the 2019-20 academic year, the Lumberjacks topped their previous team GPA with a 3.646 and eight players landing on the Big Sky Conference's All-Academic list.

In 2018-19, Payne's Lumberjacks continued their ascent up the Big Sky standings with an eighth-place finish at 13-18 overall and 8-12 in conference play. The 13 victories matched the program's best in the last 12 years, and NAU collected impressive victories over eventual WNIT teams Fresno State, California Baptist and Loyola Marymount in the non-conference schedule. Payne's second season also featured wins over Montana (first since 2012), Montana State (first since 2015) and Northern Colorado (first since 2015). The 'Jacks swept the Montana schools at home for the first time since 2002. Additionally, with NAU's first win over Idaho State in Pocatello in a decade and a win over Weber State in Ogden, the Lumberjacks swept a conference road trip for the first time in nearly 14 years.

Before Payne's second season wrapped up, she coached the Lumberjacks to a first round victory over Sacramento State for NAU's first conference tournament win since 2007. The victory was part of a hot stretch to end the 2018-19 campaign with NAU posting seven wins in its last 11 games. Payne also helped Kaleigh Paplow cap her illustrious career in Flagstaff with an All-Big Sky Third Team selection during the 2018-19 campaign. Paplow finished her career as the only player in program history to rank in the top 10 in points, rebounds, assists, steals and minutes played.

A native of Havre, Mont. – where she was a 2009 inductee into the Montana High School Association Hall of Fame – Payne earned her bachelor's degree in Psychology from Washington in 2003.
