Colorado State, 2002

Head Coach

Second Season

Angie Nelp is in her second season at The University of Tulsa after being appointed as the head women's basketball coach on April 12, 2021.

Nelp (formerly Angie Gorton) has coached 14 seasons in Division I college basketball and has helped teams reach postseason competition nine times. She has coached 34 all-conference players, eight conference players of the year, four conference freshman of the year honorees, 43 academic all-conference selections and 18 professional players.

In her first season at Tulsa, Nelp led Tulsa to the Second Round of the WNIT, the program's first postseason appearance in seven years. The Golden Hurricane recorded a 17-11 overall record, the most wins in eight years, and started the year with a 10-0 mark for the best start in school history, as well as the longest winning streak in school history.

Nelp comes to Tulsa following four seasons on the coaching staff at Arizona State. She spent her first three years as an assistant coach and was promoted to associate head coach in April 2020. During her tenure, the Sun Devils posted a .617 winning percentage with an overall 76-47 record and advanced to the postseason three times. ASU played in the NCAA Tournament twice, moving to the "Sweet Sixteen" in the 2018-19 campaign. This past season, the Sun Devils participated in the WNIT.

Nelp also had stints at Rice (2015-17) and Mercer (2011-15) as an assistant coach, Marquette (2008-10) as an assistant director of operations and at Arkansas (2007-08) as a graduate assistant.

Nelp played collegiately at Colorado State, accumulating 1,397 points, 629 rebounds, 356 assists and 261 steals in four seasons, and leading the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances. She earned Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year honors, was a first-team All-MWC selection, a Kodak All-America Honorable Mention honoree and was named an academic all-conference performer all four seasons. Nelp was inducted into the Colorado State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019.

From Eufaula, Okla., Nelp starred at Canadian High School in Oklahoma, and led her team to the 1998 Oklahoma State Championship while earning state tournament MVP honors and was tabbed as the 1998 Oklahoma Gatorade Player of the Year.

After graduating from Colorado State in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in health and exercise science, she went on to spend two seasons with the NWBL Colorado Chill and one season with 08 Stockholm in Sweden. As a professional, she helped lead the Chill to the 2005 NWBL title and 08 Stockholm to the 2003 Swedish national crown.

Following her professional career, Nelp returned to the United States to serve as the head girls' basketball coach at Yorktown High in Yorktown, Ind.

Nelp and her husband Jake have four children: JJ, Louis, Ellie Kaye and Harrison.

Facing Arkansas

- Arkansas has a 2-0 mark this season, including wins over Arkansas - Fort Smith (92-62) and Arkansas - Pine Bluff (70-50).
- Erynn Barnum averages a double-double with 17.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg, while Samara Spencer adds 10.0 ppg
- Arkansas has a 23-3 lead in the all-time series, including wins in the last four contests.

On the Roster

- Tulsa returns seven players from last year's 17-11 and WNIT team, including three starters, while welcoming seven newcomers to this season's roster.
- The Golden Hurricane has two super seniors (Maddie Bittle and Maya Mayberry), three juniors (Jessika Evans, Katia Gallegos and Katelyn Levings), four sophomores (Delanie Crawford, Lexie Foutch, Alyssa Parmer and Temira Poindexter) and five freshmen (Caroline Lyles, Cam Mathews, Hadley Periman, Chloe Williams and Ahrray Young)

Oklahomans

- Tulsa's 14 member roster includes nine Oklahomans
- The breakdown includes one freshman, four sophomores, two juniors and two seniors

Three Players Tabbed to Preseason Team

- Temira Poindexter, Maddie Bittle and Maya Mayberry were named to the preseason all-conference teams, as announced by the league office. Poindexter was a first team selection, while Bittle and Mayberry were second team honorees.
- The trio averaged a combined 35.4 points and 11.4 rebounds per game last season. Poindexter, a sophomore from Sapulpa, Okla., who was the 2022 AAC Newcomer of the Year and an all-freshmen team selection, is TU's returning scoring and rebounding leader with 12.3 ppg and 4.6 rpg, while fifth-year seniors Mayberry and Bittle added 12.2 ppg and 10.9 ppg, respectively.

Tulsa Picked Fourth in The American Preseason Coaches' Poll

- In the American Athletic Conference coaches' poll, Tulsa was picked to finish fourth by the league's coaches
- The 2022-23 predicted order of finish was South Florida, Houston, SMU, Tulsa, Tulane and Memphis (tied for fifth), Temple, UCF, Cincinnati, Wichita State and East Carolina.

That's A Lot

- Maddie Bittle has played in 100 career games at TU
- Katia Gallegos is nearing the 1,000 point mark as she has 969 career points

An Accurate Career Shooter

- Maya Mayberry ranks second (.392 = 103-263) in program history for three-point field goal percentage
- Maddie Bittle ranks ninth (.821 = 115-140) in program history for free throw percentage

In Tulsa's Top-10

- Maddie Bittle ranks ninth in three-point field goals made in school history with 122.
- Temira Poindexter ranks ninth in blocked shots in school history with 54

Most Wins Since

- Tulsa's 17 wins during the 2021-22 campaign was the most in eight years, since posting an 18-14 record in the 2014-15 season
- In that year, Tulsa also made the WNIT, winning one of two games
- In the last 16 seasons, the 17 wins ties the second-most wins... Tulsa won 18 in 2014-15 and 17 games in 2012-13

Her Freshman Season

- Temira Poindexter concluded the 2021-22 season with five marks on the Tulsa Freshmen Single-Season Records list, ranking first in blocks (52), second in field goals made (131), third in scoring (344), fourth in scoring average (12.3) and fourth in free throw percentage (.796).

Tulsa in The American Championship

- In eight years, Tulsa has a 5-8 mark in The American Championship
- TU earned wins in the first round in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2022
- The Golden Hurricane lost matches in the quarterfinals in 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2022, and lost in the first round in 2020 and 2021

Tulsa in the Postseason

- Tulsa has made six postseason appearances
- TU earned WNIT bids in 2004, 2005, 2015 and 2022
- The Hurricane played in the NCAA Tournament in 2006 and 2013
- Tulsa lost in the first round in 2004 (Memphis), 2005 (Texas A&M) and 2013 (Stanford), but went 1-1 in 2006 (W, North Carolina State; L, DePaul), 2015 (W, Missouri State; L, Eastern Michigan) and 2022 (W, North Texas; L, Wyoming)
- The Hurricane has a 3-6 overall mark in postseason play

A Hurricane in Tulsa?

- The Origination of The University of Tulsa nickname - Golden Hurricane - was created in 1922. A new football coach, Howard Archer came to town and inherited a slew of nicknames dating back to 1895. In the past, Tulsa had been named "Kendallites," "Presbyterians," "Tigers," "Orange and Black," "Tulsans," and of course, "Yellow Jackets." The team started working out in the fall with a new nickname "Yellow Jackets" which was apparently due to the fact that the team was wearing new black and yellow uniforms. The team opened the season and it was apparent that Tulsa was going to have a great year, and trying to seize some publicity for his team, Archer wanted to find a new nickname quickly. After a remark was made in practice one day about "roaring through opponents," and because of their new jersey colors, he thought of "Golden Tornadoes." But a check showed that Georgia Tech already had chosen that tag in 1917. From the tornado, he evolved meteorologically to the hurricane. A few days before the team left for a game against Texas A&M, Archer asked the squad to vote on the name, and thus "Golden Hurricane" was born.
