### Scouting Arkansas (12-0)

The Razorbacks come to Nebraska sizzling hot, with a 12-game win streak. Arkansas hasn't even been tested this season as the Hogs' closest contest were a pair of nine-point victories over Tulsa (79-70 on Nov. 14) and Northern Arizona (82-73 on Nov. 24).

While Arkansas has certainly been on a roll, there are a few factors that have helped the Razorbacks this season. Seven of the 12 contests have been home games, while three were played in the Virgin Islands as part of the Paradise Jam. The two road games that Arkansas played were within the state, against Arkansas-Little Rock and Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

Four Razorback players come into the game against the Bluejays averaging double-digits, led by Samara Spencer (15.8 ppg) and Erynn Barnum (14.9 ppg).

Last season the Bluejays were torched by Makayla Daniels as she finished with 34 points on 11-of-17 from the field. Daniels, however, has not played in the last three games for Arkansas.

### Scouting #16 Creighton (8-1, 2-1 BE)

Creighton returned home for just the second time this season, besting Drake 75-71 on December 10.

Creighton has had a 20-point scorer in eight of nine contests. Four different Bluejays have topped the 20-point mark, with Lauren Jensen, Morgan Maly, Molly Mogensen and Emma Ronsiek each doing so twice.

Jensen leads Creighton with 17.2 ppg, while Morgan Maly is just a step behind at 17.0 ppg. Ronsiek and Mogensen check in at 12.1 ppg and 10.4 ppg, respectively.





### Keys To the Game on Saturday, December 17

- **Defending Dribble Penetration:** Arkansas has multiple highly skilled players that can get to the rim and create shots. This has been an area of concern for the Bluejays.
- **Rebounding:** Last season the Bluejays out rebounded the Razorbacks 39-31, despite a significant height disadvantage. Creighton grabbed 13 offensive board, leading to 16 second chance points.
- **Handling Ball Pressure:** The Bluejays committed just nine turnovers in the win last season, but Arkansas forces better than 17 turnovers per game this season.

### Players to Watch for Creighton

**Molly Mogensen:** Creighton's junior point guard had 11 points and seven rebounds in 18 minutes last season against the Razorbacks. Over the last two games Mogensen has hit just 2-of-16 from the field.

### Saunders Returns With Style

Senior Rachael Saunders did not miss a beat after returning to the floor on Saturday, December 10. Sidelined for six games with a leg injury, Saunders played 28 minute, delivering 11 points, four assist and two offensive rebounds off the bench.

### Maly Has Been HOT, HOT, HOT

Junior Morgan Maly capped one of the best three-game stretches in her career with a personal best 24 points to help the Bluejays down Drake, 75-71 on December 10. Over her last three games Maly has hit 22-of-37 (59.5%), delivering 55 points (18.3 ppg) and 19 rebounds (6.3 rpg).

### Three-Point Streak Keeps Going and Going and Going

The Bluejays have hit at least one three-pointer in 463 consecutive games. During Flanery's 639 games at the helm, just once were the Bluejays held scoreless from long range.

Creighton went 0-for-6 from beyond the arc against Southern Illinois on Feb. 14, 2008. Unofficially Creighton has the seventh longest streak in the NCAA.

### Bluejay Women's Hoops Leaps to #13 in AP Poll

With two more victories last week, the Creighton women's basketball team continued to climb the Associated Press Top 25 poll, reaching a program high of #13 when the poll was announced on Monday, November 28.

The Bluejays have been ranked each week of the 2022-23 season, climbing from No. 21 to open the season. In their first six games Creighton has posted a pair of Top-25 victories (78-69 at No. 23 South Dakota State on Nov. 7 and 77-51 win over #22 Nebraska on Nov. 15).

**Battle of Ranked Conference Foes a First for Bluejays**  
Friday's contest at #25 Villanova was the Bluejays' first conference battle when both teams are ranked in the AP Top-25.

The 67-46 victory is the largest win over a ranked conference foe, moving the Bluejays to 2-0 against Villanova when the Wildcats are ranked. Creighton earned a 69-57 win over a #18 Villanova squad on Dec. 28, 2017.

### Maly is Creighton's Quiet Killer

In an offseason interview with the NCAA, Morgan Maly referred to herself and the Bluejay team as quiet killers. Morgan has lived up to the name in the first seven games.

Maly is second on team with 16.3 ppg and has reached double figures in each contest.

### Fast Start is a Rarity for the Bluejays

Creighton 7-0 start ranked as the second best in school history and its best start under head coach Jim Flanery. The only season to begin slightly better came in the 1986-87 campaign as the Bluejays started 8-0.

### Creighton Answered the Bell at Cintas

Trailing 46-44 with just over two minutes remaining the Bluejays delivered a knockout punch with a 7-0 run in a span of 63 seconds.

Creighton pulled even with 2:08 remaining as Emma Ronsiek found Jayme Horan on a back door cut yielding a layup. Moments later Ronsiek split three defenders in the paint for the go-ahead bucket. Finally as the defense collapsed on Ronsiek the South Dakota native found Lauren Jensen on the wing for her fourth trey of the game. Staked to a 51-46 with 1:05 left, the Bluejays knocked down six free throws to complete the 57-51 win.

### BIG EAST Openers vs. Conference Openers

Creighton is 8-2 in opening games as a member of the BIG EAST Conference, while the Bluejays are 24-12 overall in conference openers. Under head coach Jim Flanery, Creighton is 15-6 in its conference opener.

The Bluejays have opened up conference play at home five of eight seasons. In BIG EAST home openers the Bluejays are 4-4.

The Nov. 25 game at Xavier is the earliest conference game Creighton played as a member of the BIG EAST.

Creighton women's basketball head coach Jim Flanery announced the signing of McKayla Miller on the first day of the fall signing period, Wednesday, November 9.

Miller is a 6'1 guard from Cimmarron High School in Cimmarron, Kansas. Already a two-time All-GWAC (Great West Activities Conference) First Team selection, she earned Wichita Eagle All-State honors during her sophomore and junior seasons as well. McKayla led her squad in points, rebounds, steals, blocks and assists in each of the last three seasons. Miller was named a Kansas 3A Player of the Year finalist and to the All-State First Team following the 2021-22 season by Sports in Kansas. Prep Hoops ranks Miller as the top player in her position and the second ranked player in Kansas. Last season she averaged 17.6 ppg with over eight rebounds and three assists per game.

"McKayla is another in our line of hybrid players that are multi-skilled," said Flanery. "She can post-up, but also face up to pass or score and can shoot the three as well."
