## GAME NOTES

- » QB KJ Jefferson earned the Liberty Bowl's MVP while RB Rashod Dubinion was named as offensive player of the game and DB Dwight McGlothorn was selected as defensive player of the game.
- » Arkansas has won back-to-back bowl games for the first time since the 2014 & 2015 seasons.
- » Arkansas' 24 points in the first quarter are the most points scored by a team in a quarter in Liberty Bowl history.
- » The Razorbacks have forced multiple turnovers in a game for the seventh time this season. It's also the fourth time this season the Hogs have forced 3+ turnovers in a game.
- » The Hogs' 55 points are the most Arkansas has ever scored in a bowl game.
- » Arkansas set the school record for sacks in a season (42). The previous record of 40 was set in 1998.
- » Arkansas' two interceptions are the most its had in a single game since Jan. 1, 2022 (Penn State).
- » Arkansas 500+ yards of total offense in five games this season this season: vs. Missouri State, BYU, Auburn, Ole Miss and Kansas.
- » The Hogs have recorded 400+ total yards of offense in 10 of their 13 games this season, including two consecutive games with 500+ total yards of offense against BYU (Oct. 15) and Auburn (Oct. 29).
- » Cam Little's 37-yard field goal in the first quarter marks the first time Arkansas has scored on its first offensive series of the game since against South Carolina.
- » The Razorbacks have scored 30 or more points in 16 of Jefferson's 26 career starts at quarterback.
- » QB KJ Jefferson tallied his 10th career game and seventh game of the season with at least one passing and one rushing touchdown. Jefferson finished 19-for-29 with 287 passing yards and two scores.
- » QB KJ Jefferson has eclipsed the 100-yard mark on the ground for the third time in his career. It is the second straight bowl game that Jefferson has hit 100 yards on the ground. Jefferson finished with 14 carries for a career high 130 yards and two touchdowns.
- » QB KJ Jefferson recorded his first career game with 200+ passing yards and 100+ rushing yards.
- » K Cam Little is now 33-of-40 on field goal attempts, including a 23-of-24 (95.8%) mark on field goals inside 40 yards.
- » WR Matt Landers recorded his fourth straight game with a touchdown reception after hauling in a 59-yard pass from QB KJ Jefferson in the first quarter. The 59-yard reception is also a season long.
- » WR Matt Landers filed his sixth career 100-yard receiving game after hauling in three receptions for 121 yards and a touchdown.
- » TE Ty Washington recorded his first career reception and touchdown on a 17-yard pass from KJ Jefferson in the first quarter. Washington finished with one reception for 17 yards.
- » RB Rashod Dubinion carded a career high 123 rushing yards on 20 carries and two touchdowns. Dubinion also added 3 receptions for 19 yards.
- » LB Chris Paul Jr. logged his first career double-digit tackle performance, finishing with a career high 12 stops and a quarterback hurry.
- » DL Cam Ball had his first career forced fumble in the fourth quarter. Ball carded three stops, including one sack for a loss of four yards.
- » DBs Quincey McAdoo and Dwight McGlothorn grabbed their second and fourth interceptions of the season.
- » DB Quincey McAdoo notched a career high nine tackles to go along with one interception, returning it for 17 yards.
- » DB Dwight McGlothorn posted his first career double-digit tackle game with 10 stops, including one tackle for a loss of five yards, and an interception.
