# Matt McMahon

## Head Coach

@CoachMcMahon

1st Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

When Matt McMahon stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach he listed the core values of his coaching career and his teams.

"Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy."

Those words are now the cornerstone of LSU Basketball as it moves into a new era as a very successful head coach begins to reshape the program in his image.

The image was on display during the past seven years at Murray State University where the Racers posted a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Two of those players, Williams and Hill, are now at LSU.

Williams, who ranked 12th nationally in 3-pointers made (94), became the third Murray State player to score 1,500 points and grab 800 rebounds. Hill took over point guard duties in a Racer program known for good guards, leading Murray State in assists in 19 games with a plus-101 margin in assists to turnovers.

McMahon's Racers, picked third in the OVC preseason poll, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have

three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Although the 2019-20 season was called early because of the pandemic, it marked the third year in a three-year run when Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

Coach McMahon's commitment to defense showed in those years as the Racers ranked as the league leader twice in defensive field goal percentage and each of the three seasons the team led the league in defending the 3-point shot.

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette. That season is when Morant stepped to the forefront at Murray State.

He was named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA. In the NCAA Tournament win over Marquette, Morant posted a triple double of 17 points, 11 rebounds and 16 assists as he became the eighth player to record a triple double in the tournament.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

### PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian

State. Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Like his time at Murray State, McMahon coached some outstanding talent in the early stages of his coaching career, including Southern Conference POY Donald Sims as well as all-league picks Jeremy Clayton and D.J. Thompson.

At UNCW, he recruited Adam Smith, a Parade All-America Second-Team selection.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

### A NEW DAY FOR LSU BASKETBALL

What all began in 1909 has now begun its 115th season of play as LSU Basketball enters a new age under Coach Matt McMahon. The proven winner from Murray State has had to build a roster completely from scratch as players after the 2021-22 season left for NBA dreams, end of eligibility and the transfer portal. As listed above in



some 46 days, Coach McMahon has been able to rebuild his roster from 0 to 16 players which includes 13 scholarship players and three walk-ons. Three players on scholarship returned to be a part of this new day of Tiger basketball -- Mwani Wilkinson, Justice Williams and Adam Miller. Miller is the only one that didn't play last year, having torn an ACL just prior to the team's exhibition contest a year ago.

So, after a combined 36 years of Dale Brown and John Brady, Matt McMahon is the fourth LSU Basketball head coach in the last 15 seasons.

Super senior KJ Williams had his second 30-point game of the year and the second highest point total of his college career with 35 points, hitting 14-of-21 field goals, including seven treys ... Derek Fountain, making his first start, had 11 points and Hayes had 13. Williams also had 10 rebounds, his third of the season and his 30th career double double.

## WEDNESDAY'S OPPONENT

Arkansas comes in nationally ranked and 11-1 on the season. Ironically, both LSU and Arkansas are 8-0 on the year at their home arenas and 3-1 on neutral courts. The two teams have also won six straight. This will be Arkansas's first true road game.

The Hogs are coming off an 85-51 win over UNC Asheville last Wednesday at Bud Walton Arena. Jalen Graham scored 16 on 8-of-10 shooting to lead the Razorbacks. Ricky Council IV added 12 points while Joseph Pinion and Anthony Black each scored 10. Arkansas forced 20 turnovers in the game, leading to 32 points off turnovers. The Hogs made 17-of-27 field goals in the first half and finished 32-of-60 (53.3%), out rebounding UNCA, 36-28.

Council leads the team at 18.3 points per game, while Nick Smith Jr. averages 12.8 and Black 12.6. The Razorbacks average 79.4 points a game, while giving up 61.9.

Eric Musselman is in his fourth year as the head coach of the Razorbacks. He served as associate coach at LSU during the 2014-15 season.

Arkansas leads the overall series, 41-34. The series began in 1949 here in Baton Rouge and of course it became a yearly series when the Razorbacks joined the SEC in the 1991-92 season. Arkansas is on a present three-game win streak, having won all the contests a year ago. The teams have split the last 12 meetings over five seasons. LSU leads the series in Baton Rouge by a 19-13 count.

## THE START FOR THE TIGERS

Coach Matt McMahon's Tigers at 11-1 is off to the best start by an LSU first-year coach since Trent Johnson was 11-1 to start the 2008-09 season

The only other better starts came over 100 seasons ago as Branch Bocock in 1920-21 and Frank "Tad" Gormley in 1921-22 were 12-0 after 12 games in their careers. Bocock won his first 13 games at LSU, Gormley won his first 14.

## MATT MCMAHON RECORD

Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Coach Matt McMahon has won 42-of-46 games (91.3 winning percentage).

Coach McMahon was 31-3 last year at Murray State and started off 11-1 here at LSU.

## HOME WINNING STREAK

The Tigers have won 12 straight games at the Maravich Center dating back to the last four games of the 2021-22 season. That ranks T23 in the NCAA as of Monday.

Kentucky (26 games), Auburn (25), Tennessee (23), Arkansas (17) and LSU (12) are the five SEC schools with present winning streaks of 12 games or more at home.

Entering play this week, LSU, Arkansas, Mississippi State and Missouri are all at 11-1 with the ninth best winning percentage in college basketball (91.7%).

## SEC OPENERS

The Tigers lost its opener last year on the road at Auburn, but won openers at home in the 2020-21 season against Texas A&M and in 2019-20 at Tennessee.

LSU is 51-39 in SEC opening games.

## AGAINST RANKED TEAMS

The Tigers are 88-273 against ranked teams in the AP poll or 24.4 percent against those teams. LSU is 40-142 (22.0 percent) against teams ranked in the top 10 of the AP poll. LSU is 5-14 against teams ranked No. 9.

## CAM HAYES EARNING PLAYING TIME AND STARTING SPOT

The junior transfer from North Carolina State did not have his best game against ETSU (12/21), but he has still had good numbers and number comparable to his first two years at NC State.

In the three previous games to the East Tennessee game, Hayes' numbers were:

**Vs. Wake Forest (12/10) – 13 pts – 28 minutes, 5-10 FG, 2-6 3FGs, 1-1 FTs, 5 Rebs, 6 assts**

**Vs. NC Central (12/13) – 14 pts – 28 minutes, 6-10 FG, 2-5 3FGs, 0-0 FTs, 7 rebs, 2 assts**

**Vs. Winthrop (12/17) – 25 pts – 31 minutes, 8-11 FG, 4-6 3FGs, 5-6 FTs, 1 rebs, 4 assts**

Even with his ETSU game added in Hayes has scored 54 points on 20-of-34 FG shootings with 6-of-9 from the arc in the last four games.

At NC State, Hayes averaged 7.8 points in 20-21 and 7.0 points in 21-22. He shot 38.6 percent as a freshman and 33.5 percent as a sophomore. So far in 12 games, Hayes is 33-of-60 from the field or 55.0 percent.

This year, Hayes is averaging 8.8 points, 1.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists. He has had five games of three or more assists. He also was named in the starting lineup each of the last three games.

## KJ CONTINUES ROLLING ALONG

KJ Williams posted his second 20-10 game of the season against ETSU when he scored 28 points and grabbed 12 rebounds (12/21). He made 11-of-18 field goals with three treys and three free throws. He also equaled his second high for assists (3) and steals (3).

Williams other 20-10 game was against Wake Forest (12/10) when he scored 35 points and had 10 boards.

The last LSU player with more than two 20-10 games in a season was Tari Eason last year who had four. Before that you have to go back to Ben Simmons in the 2015-16 season who had three.

Williams, who was SEC Player of the Week after his 35-point effort against Wake Forest (12/10), is averaging 19.3 points per game, 8.3 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.7 steals.

## IS IT A BASKETBALL WALKOFF?

A feature on social media has been the half court shots which conclude LSU's game-day practice or the final practice prior to a game and before the Winthrop game (12/17), KJ Williams led off as usual and ended things quickly by swishing the half-court shot and literally as captured on video walked to the exit of the Maravich Center.

That was his first half-court make of the season which has seen the following makes:

## NOW AT 105 AND 95 AND COUNTING

Two milestones in this five-year career of KJ Williams took place on against Wofford (11/27) as the Tigers won 78-75.

The game marked his 100th win of his college career in games he has played in. Murray State actually won 101 games in which he has dressed, but a win early in his freshman season at Murray State in 2018-19, Williams did not play-coaches decision. So, he came to LSU with 94 wins in games he participated in and now, after the ETSU game (12/21) has 105 and counting.

His double figure scoring game against ETSU marked his 11th double figure game of the season (ninth straight), giving him 95 total for his college career in 135 career games played.

KJ now has 102 college starts between Murray State and LSU and he has started every game (72) over the 2020-21, 2021-22 and now 2022-23 seasons.

And, when he made his one three-pointer against NCCU (12/13) (with 1:09 to go in the first half), it was his 100th career three-point field goal made. He is now at 105 career made three-pointers.

This season he is 23-of-46 from the arc and for his career he is a 37.9 percent shooter from distance having made 105-of-277 attempts.

## 2000-1000

It is now just 13 to go for the first of the milestones.

KJ Williams is in the hunt for 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds between Murray State and LSU.

He enters SEC play just 13 shy of 1,000 career rebounds at 987 boards.

Presently, he is 1,899 points, needing just 101 to hit the magic 2,000 mark.

Unofficially, 122 players in college basketball have hit the 2,000-1,000 mark in their careers entering the 2022-23 season including some of the biggest named in the history of the game. Among those of interest here in Louisiana would be of course Rudy Macklin of LSU (1976-81) who had 2,080 points and 1,276 rebounds.

Also, from schools in Louisiana are Shawn Long at UL-Lafayette (2012-16) with 2,342 points and 1,447 rebounds; Reggie Jackson at Nicholls (1991-95) with 2,124 points and 1,271 rebounds; Willie Jackson of Centenary (1980-84) with 2,535-1,013; Calvin Natt of ULM (1975-79) with 2,581-1,281; and Robert Parish of Centenary (1973-76) with 2,334 points and 1,820 rebounds.

## DOUBLE DOUBLES

Williams made his first game at LSU a good one with his 28th career double double of 13 points and 14 rebounds versus Kansas City (11/9). Williams had 10 boards

entering the final 25 seconds of the first half and six of his 14 were offensive.  
Here are the Williams double doubles this season:

- Vs. Kansas City (11/9) – 13 points, 14 rebounds**
- Vs. Kansas State (11/23) – 17 points, 10 rebounds**

**HILL AT THE POINT**

Justice Hill's fake of the defender and drive through an open lane was a game-winner for the Tigers against Wake Forest (12/10) with 1.2 seconds to play at Holiday Hoopsgiving.  
Hill hit three three-pointers in each of the last two games to score nine in 27 minutes against Winthrop (12/17) and nine against ETSU (12/21) in 35 minutes. He had three assists against Winthrop and five assists against ETSU, his sixth game of five assists or more this season.  
He is averaging 4.2 assists a game with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.13. He is fourth in the league in assists average and is first in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio with 50 assists and just 16 turnovers. Hill's assist-to-turnover ratio is presently ranked 20th in the NCAA.  
Like KJ Williams, he is one of the transfers who played for Coach McMahon at Murray State. He is in his third year of playing for Coach after beginning his career at a junior college.  
Hill had seven assists in the opening game and added 11 points. He was in double figures again against UNO (11/17) with 12 points, five assists and three steals and an early season best +32 in plus-minus numbers.  
He recorded his season high points game against Akron (11/22) with 14 points on 5-of-11 shooting.  
Hill's next three-pointer will be his 100th of his career in Division I basketball. In his three years (2 at Murray State and one at LSU) he has 316 career assists and 127 turnovers. He is averaging 8.8 points and 1.9 rebounds. Hill is 14-of-31 from the arc (45.2%).

**ADAM MILLER**

Adam Miller continues to look for the scoring consistency he was showing in the early part of the season as the calendar turns to league play.  
Miller earned all-tournament honors in the Cayman Islands Classic after averaging 15.7 points, 1.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the three games of the tournament. He had a best of 23 against Akron when he hit five three-pointers in the Tigers semifinal wins.  
Against Wofford (11/27), he was important for the Tigers rallying win, hitting a late three-pointer that gave the Tigers the winning points in the game.  
The Wofford game was the third time that Miller has scored over 20 points this season and the second time he scored 26 (vs. Arkansas State, 11/12; Wofford, 11/27).  
So far Miller has hit at least four three-point field goals in four games:

- 6 – vs. Wofford (11/27)**
- 5 – vs. Akron (11/22)**
- 4 – vs. Arkansas State (11/12)**
- 4 – vs. Kansas City (11/9)**

Miller hadn't played in a counting regular season game since March of 2021 when Illinois played its final game of the 2020-21 season. He transferred to LSU but tore his ACL prior to the team's exhibition game and missed the entire 2021-22 season. He was medically cleared during the summer for a full go this season and Tiger fans couldn't be happier.  
Miller has started all 43 games he has played in (31 at Illinois), averaging 8.3 points at Illinois. At LSU, he averaging 13.5 points and 2.0 rebounds to go with 1.4 assists.  
Miller is at 28 made three-pointers this season to give him 80 for his two seasons of playing.

**LSU BY THREE**

In 10 games this year, the Tigers have had three players in double figure scoring. Not necessarily the same three, but no more than three. In the games against UTA (12/2) and ETSU (12/21), the Tigers had two players in double figures.

Fountain picked up his first college double double against NCCU (12/13). In the last four games Fountain has posted 54 points, 40 rebounds and made 21-of-31 field goal attempts.

Against UNO (11/17), the junior had a line of 15 points, eight rebounds and seven steals. Fountain was 4-of-5 from the field with a trey and 6-of-6 from the free throw line.

Fountain is averaging 7.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals a game. His average in the last four games as gone from 5.1 to 7.3 points.

Fountain's best season of his two at Mississippi State was the 2020-21 campaign when as a freshman he started 10-of-19 games and averaged 5.4 points. Ironically, his career high came against LSU in Baton Rouge when he scored 20 points.

In 12 games at LSU, he already has 16 more field goals made than he had in his sophomore season at Mississippi State in 25 games, 20 more rebounds and 42 more points.

## TRAE HANNIBAL

The third Murray State transfer, Trae Hannibal, has been making his presence felt in several games.

Hannibal apparently got the Tigers to overtime in the Cayman Islands against Kansas State (11/23), scoring the tying bucket that was later overruled when the clock operator failed to start the clock.

He is averaging 4.5 points and 4.0 rebounds to go with 2.8 assists. Against Wofford (11/27) and UTA (12/2), he scored 19 points combined (12 against Wofford, 7 against UTA).

Against Wofford (12/27), Hannibal was 4-of-6 field goal shooting and a perfect 4-of-4 at the line. He had one field goal but got to the line, making 5-of-7 against UTA (12/2).

Against Winthrop, Hannibal posted six assists and no turnovers in 21 minutes off the bench and in the ETSU game (12/21) posted seven points and six rebounds.

## PLUS-MINUS NUMBERS

The box scores this season are including the plus-minus numbers on each the players individually. This number represents how much the team scores while they are on the floor how many points the team gives up at the same time which gives a player a plus or minus total for the night.

KJ Williams is at +118 for the season, while Derek Fountain, after going +13, +15, +13, +11, 15 in a five-game stretch in December, is next at +106. Adam Miller is at +90, while Cam Hayes is at +83.

## MWANI WILKINSON

Mwani Wilkinson elected to come back to the LSU program after briefly entering the transfer portal following the 2021-22 season. He is the veteran scholarship returnee, having been a part of the Tiger team in both 2020-21 and 2021-22. He has been a part of two NCAA teams and a team that went to the finals of the SEC Tournament in 2021.

Wilkinson had a good opening night (11/9) for the Tigers with nine points making 3-of-4 three-pointers, tying his career highs in treys made in a 22-minute start for LSU.

Wilkinson is averaging 2.9 points and 1.9 rebounds. Wilkinson is 8-of-18 from the arc.

## JALEN REED

The freshman from Jackson, Mississippi started the first eight games before coming off the bench in the last three games.

His best game came against UNO (11/17) when he scored eight points, hitting all three field goal attempts in 21 minutes. He added six rebounds and a steal in the game.

For the season, Reed is averaging 3.4 points and 3.0 rebounds. He is averaging 17.4 minutes a game. Reed is the son of the late SEC star Justin Reed, who played at Ole Miss (2000-04).

## KENDAL COLEMAN

Coleman played 11 minutes against Wofford (11/27), making both field goal attempts and 3-of-3 at the line to finish with seven points, his second highest total of the season.

In the next game against UTA (12/2), Coleman played 13 minutes, making 3-of-4 field goals to again score seven points with six rebounds.

Against NCCU, he made the most of his six-plus minutes, making both field goal attempts with a rebound and a block. It has been the case when asked, Coleman has made the most of his minutes. In the Winthrop game (12/17), Coleman made 2-of-4 from the field with five points and two blocks and for the second time this season grabbing seven rebounds.

The Northwestern State transfer is averaging 2.9 points and 2.8 rebounds, playing 8.7 minutes per game. He is 15-of-23 from the field.

Coleman's season high at LSU was eight points versus Illinois St. in the Cayman Islands (11/21).

## JUSTICE WILLIAMS

He hadn't been on the court since the Nov. 17 game against UNO where he suffered an injured left ankle, but when called upon to return to action against Wake Forest (Dec. 10) after missing five games, sophomore Justice Williams was ready.

Last season, he missed the entire non-conference schedule as a freshman before being thrust into action due to other injuries at the start of conference play.

Williams played 17 minutes against the Demon Deacons, scoring five points with a rebound, two assists and a steal. He continued to get good minutes against both NCCU and Winthrop.

For the season, Williams is averaging 3.6 points, 1.0 rebounds and 1.0 assists.

## TURNOVERS

The Tigers were finally able to keep turnovers in the single digits against Wake Forest, recording only seven in the Dec. 10 game. For the season LSU is averaging 12.9 miscues a game with 155, still less than LSU's opponents (180).

After three games when LSU had 28 turnovers combined, the Tigers had 16 against ETSU (12/21).

## STEALS

Last year, the Tigers had their best season ever at stealing the basketball with 373 steals.



So far this season, LSU has also been good at getting steals again with 104 steals, an average of 8.7 per game. LSU had a season high of 17 against UNO (11/17). Opponents have only recorded 66 steals.

#### SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

Last year, LSU was the Division I leader in shot clock violations drawn according to @CBBAnalytics with 38, four more than Richmond and Virginia in college basketball. The total so far this season is eight.

#### FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

Last year, LSU was 16-1 when opponents shot under 40 percent and LSU is 4-0 this year in that category as Kansas City (32.8%), Arkansas State (38.6%), Akron (25.9%) and UTA (37.5%) have shot under 40 percent overall.

The Tigers are 56-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when opponents shoot under 40 percent.

However, LSU was 6-10 last year when opponents shoot 40 percent or better from the field. LSU is 7-1 this season when teams shoot over 40 percent.

Offensively, the Tigers have won the last 17 games when shooting 50 percent or more in a game and LSU is 104-9 in the last 112 games when LSU shot 50 percent or better since the start of the 2007-08 season. The 50 percent games this season:

**LSU vs. UNO (11/17) – 30-of-58, 51.7%**

**LSU vs. Wofford (11/27) – 28-of-53, 52.8%**

**LSU vs. Winthrop (12/17) – 35-of-64, 54.7%**

LSU is third in the league entering the week in field goal percentage at 46.3% (286-of-619).

#### FROM THE ARC

The Tigers last season shot just 31.6 percent from the arc and LSU has not shot over 35 percent from the arc since 2012-13 season.

But so far this year, LSU had been better from the three-point arc. For the season, LSU is 92-of-257 (35.8%). LSU is third behind Kentucky (39.9%) and Missouri (36.9%)

LSU has hit double figure treys in two-of-the-last-four games (10 against Wake Forest and 11 against Winthrop).

LSU has been in double figures three times this season.

Tiger opponents are 76-of-265 or 28.7 percent.

#### THE MARAVICH CENTER

The Tigers are in their 52nd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation followed by the untimely death of the star LSU player.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

LSU was 15-2 a year ago in the building and in 814 games the Tigers have an on-court record of 613-201 (75.3%) ... In non-conference games, LSU is 331-44 (88.3%).

Director of Player Development Ronrico White's father, Tony, was an All-America at Tennessee. Tony White played from 1983 to 1987 at Tennessee.

Then there is freshman Jalen Reed from Jackson, Mississippi, whose late dad, Justin, was an All-America at Ole Miss and the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2001. Justin Reed was an All-SEC selection in each of his four years at Ole Miss, guiding the Rebels to a first ever "Sweet Sixteen" appearance for the program.

#### SEC ON THE ROAD

The schedule will take LSU on the road for a week after the new year with LSU at Kentucky for a 7 p.m. CT game on Tuesday, Jan. 3 at Rupp Arena in Lexington. The Tigers then will take on Texas A&M at Reed Arena in Bryan-College Station on Jan. 7 at 5 p.m. Both games will be broadcast on the LSU Sports Radio Network with the Kentucky game on ESPN and the A&M game on the SEC Network.

LSU is next back in Baton Rouge for a game on Jan. 10.

The four-star recruit will play this season at Link Academy in Brandon, Missouri. Chest (6-8, 210) played the 2021-22 season at Eleanor McMain High School in New Orleans. He is ranked No. 75 in the 247sports.com and 89 in their national composite rankings. He is listed No. 95 in the ESPN Top 100 for the class of 2023.

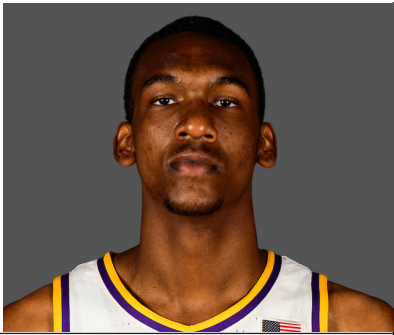
