KEY STORYLINES

CARDINAL NOTABLES

- PORTIAS AND PORTIAS OF THE PROBLEM IS:** Portia Adams helped ignite a 76-63 victory over Loyola-New Orleans with a career-high 24 points. This included 17 points in the first half and 11 in the first quarter alone. In that first quarter, she sparked a seven-point rally by herself in the win. Averaging 13.4 ppg, she only trails teammate Sabria Dean, who leads with 16.1 ppg. The two are third and fourth respectively in the Southland Conference.
- FIRST START FOR R=MONEY:** R'Mani Taylor earned her first start in the win over LNO and she would finish with her first double-digit game scoring 13 points on 5-of-11 from the field and 3-of-4 from downtown. She opened the game with five straight points. The Houston native record
- ROYAL REBOUNDERS:** Emma Imevbore, London native, and Malay McQueen are averaging over 7.5 rebounds per game. This puts them 3rd and 4th in the conference respectively.
- HISTORY AGAINST THE RAZORBACKS:** LU is 3-2 all-time against the Razorbacks. The last meeting between the two teams was 11 years ago. The last time LU came out with a win against Arkansas was on January 28, 1983.

OPPONENT INFO

- WELCOME BACK TO CLUB 25:** The Razorbacks are off to a 10-0 start, which included a 92-58 thrubbing of Oral Roberts in their last game. As a result, they are back in the top 25 for the first time since the 2020-21 season. They are also one of 15 undefeated teams in the nation and currently sit in first place of the SEC.
- RUNNING AN ERYNN:** Erynn Barnum leads the Razorbacks by averaging 15.8 points per game despite posting 18 and six points in the last two games she played. This is seventh in the SEC.
- SAMARA DESERT:** Samara Spencer averaged 25.5 ppg in the last two games, which included a career high 32 points against ORU. Averaging 15.3 ppg, she trails Barnum in team and conference scoring.

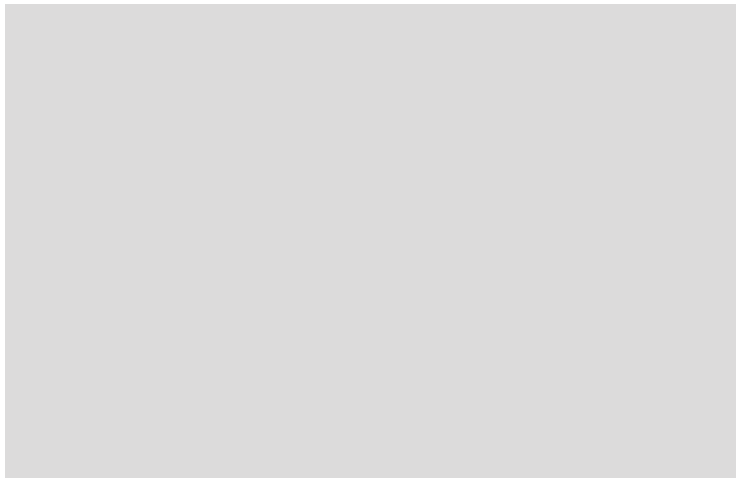

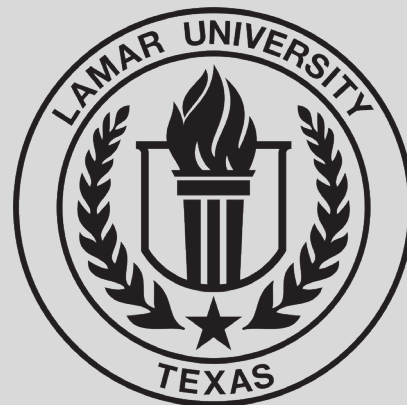

Lamar Head Coach Aqua Franklin

Aqua Franklin was named the 14th women's basketball head coach at Lamar University on May 1, 2019.

Prior to being named the head coach at Lamar, Franklin was on the sidelines of Allen Fieldhouse as the associate head coach at Kansas. In her second stint with the Jayhawks, Franklin spent four seasons as the Jayhawks' associate head coach and five overall in Lawrence. During her time at Kansas, Franklin has worked to help rebuild the KU program.

During her career, Franklin has recruited and coached eight all-conference players and three all-freshman team selections. Franklin guided yet another KU guard to All-Big 12 honors during the 2017-18 season after junior Christalah Lyons earned an honorable mention nod for her work on the hardwood. Lyons repeated honorable mention honors following the 2018-19 season as well.

During the 2016-17 season, Franklin mentored Jessica Washington to new heights in the red and blue. Under Franklin's guidance, Washington became the first Jayhawk to garner Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors after averaging a league-best 19.3 points per game in conference play.

Prior to returning to KU, Franklin spent the last three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State, where she helped the Bulldogs to a historic season in 2014-15. That year Mississippi State set a school record for overall (27) and conference (11) wins and advanced to the second round of the tournament. In addition to the Bulldogs work on the court, Franklin was also instrumental in helping Mississippi State bring in one of the top recruiting classes in program history with a top

20 national ranking.

During her first stint with the Jayhawks in 2011-12, Franklin helped Kansas to one of its best seasons in recent history, highlighted by the Jayhawks' trip to the NCAA Sweet 16. Franklin coached Angel Goodrich to a banner season after she paced KU with 23.3 points per game and shattered the single-season school record with 250 assists. Goodrich was named Honorable Mention All-America by both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Associated Press, and was one of the four finalists for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given annually to the top point guard in the nation.

Franklin spent the 2010-11 season at Stephen F. Austin under current Kansas head coach, Brandon Schneider. With the Ladyjacks, she tutored Tammara Marion to All-Southland Conference accolades after Marion became the 25th SFA player to score 1,000 points and set a school mark for three-pointers made in a season.

Franklin's coaching career got started at her alma mater serving as a graduate assistant for Texas A&M during the 2009-10 season. Her collegiate and professional experiences were a valuable asset to the Aggies as she helped guide the team to the Big 12 Championship and the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Franklin was selected with the 38th pick in the 2008 WNBA Draft by the Sacramento Monarchs. As a rookie, Franklin helped lead the Monarchs to the opening round of the 2008 WNBA playoffs. The following season she signed with the Seattle Storm before going on to begin her coaching career at her alma mater.

She concluded her four-year playing career at Texas A&M as one of the most-decorated guards in program history, ranking in the top three in assists with 627. Her final season with the Aggies was a memorable one for the program, as the team made its first run to the NCAA's Elite Eight. Franklin capped her career by claiming honorable mention All-America accolades from the Associated Press to go along with second-team All-Big 12 honors. During her collegiate career, Franklin led the Aggies to three NCAA appearances and was twice named Honorable Mention All-America.

A 2018 Texas A&M Hall of Fame inductee, Franklin graduated from A&M with a degree in recreation park and tourism science in 2009. She was also a member of the second Tyler ISD Hall of Fame class – one that also included NFL legend Earl Campbell.
