FROM THE TIP

- ▶ Oklahoma and No. 9/8 Arkansas clash in the Crimson and Cardinal Class at BOK Center in Tulsa on Dec. 10 at noon. The Sooners and Bazorbacks have met 29 times and UA leads the series, 16-13. Oklahoma won the inaugural battle in Tulsa, beating the Razorbacks 88-66 in the last meeting between the two schools.
- ▶ The Sooners are 45th in the NET (12/8) and 2-1 in the first two quadrants. Seven Big 12 teams are ranked in the top 50 in the NET and OU is ranked sixth in the conference.
- ▶ Doc Sadler, OU's special advisor to the head coach, was a four-year student manager and an assistant coach (1982-85) at Arkansas under head coach Eddie Sutton. The Razorbacks advance to the NCAA Tournament each season Sadler was an assistant coach
- ▶ Grant Sherfield recorded his second straight 20-plus point game, finishing with a team-best 24 points against Kansas City. Sherfield scored a team-high 21 points at Villanova and has made 11 3-pointers in the last two games. He has recorded double-figure points in all nine contests and has three 20-plus point games.
- ▶ Milos Uzan received his first career start against Kansas City, finishing with 11 points and a team-high five assists.
- ▶ The Sooners beat Ole Miss 59-55 on Sunday, Nov. 27 to win the ESPN Events Invitational title. Grant Sherfield was named tournament MVP and averaged 15.7 points and 5.3 assists per contest in three games.
- ▶ Guard **Grant Sherfield** was voted Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year and forward **Tanner Groves** received Preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades. Sherfield is the first Sooner since Amath M'Baye in 2012 to be selected as the preseason newcomer of the year and the seventh such selection in program history.
- ▶ Grant Sherfield was named to the preseason Bob Cousy Award Watch List and was one of 20 point guards named to
- ▶ Oklahoma was picked to finish seventh in the Big 12 Preseason Poll. The Sooners received 32 points and were ranked above Iowa State, West Virginia and Kansas State.
- ▶ Former Oklahoma men's basketball head coach Lon Kruger was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame on Nov. 20. He joined former Oklahoma standout and three-time All-American Wayman Tisdale.
- ▶ Porter Moser and Jake Moser are one of 22 father/coach and son/player duos in Division I.
- ▶ Doc Sadler joined the OU staff as special advisor to the head coach on Nov. 17. Sadler, Ryan Humphrey (assistant coach) and Tad Glibert (director of operations) are new to
- ▶ The Sooners finished their first season of the Porter Moser era 19-16 (7-11 Big 12). Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the 2022 NIT. The Sooners made their eighth appearance in the NIT and first since 2004
- ▶ Tanner Groves was named to the 2022 CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team and was one of 10 men's basketball student-athletes that were selected as a 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award Finalist.
- ▶ The Sooners return 44.1% of their scoring, 52.9% rebounding and 38% assists from the 2021-22 team. **Tanner Groves** is Oklahoma's top returning scorer (11.6 PPG) and Jalen Hill is the top returning rebounder (5.9).
- ▶ Tanner Groves was one of four Sooners who earned 2021-22 All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades. C.J. Noland was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team.

- ▶ Oklahoma earned the 88-66 victory over Arkansas in the inaugural Crimson & Cardinal Classic at the BOK Center in Tulsa.
- ▶ Elijah Harkless recorded a double-double, finishing with a team-high 21 points and 11 rebounds. Tanner Groves scored 16 points an finished 3-for-5 from deep. Jordan Goldwire added 14 points and dished out a team-best six assists. Umoja Gibson scored 12 points and Jalen Hill tallied 11 points and eight boards.
- ▶ The Sooners shot 54.9% (28-51) from the field and 59.1% (13-22) from three. Oklahoma finished 19-of-22 from the free throw line and recorded 20 attempts in the second half.

SCOUTING THE RAZORBACKS

- ▶ Eric Musselman is in his fourth season at Arkansas and has compiled a 81-29 (.736) record. Musselman spent the four years prior to leading the Razorbacks at Nevada. He finished his time with the Pack 110-34 (.764) and is 191-63 (.752) in eight seasons as a NCAA Division I head coach. No. 9/8 Arkansas is 8-1 to start the 2022-23 slate. UA opened the season with four wins and recorded its lone loss against then-No. 10/8 Creighton in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational. The Razorbacks last played against UNCG, earning the 65-58 victory on Tuesday, Dec. 6.
- ▶ Four Razorbacks average 10-plus points per game. Ricky Council IV is the team-leader with 18.4 points per contest and adds 3.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game. Anthony Block adds 13.1 points, 5.4 rebounds and a team-high 3.6 assists per contest. Nick Smith Jr. averages 12.7 points and 2.7 assists per game. Trevon Brazile averaged 11.8 points and a team-best 6.0 rebounds. Council IV. Black and Makhi Mitchell have started all nine games.
- Arkansas is ranked 21st nationally in turnovers forced per game (18.1), 24th in free throws made per game (16.7) and 27th in steals per game (9.7). UA is 30th in the NET.

RANKING SUMMARY (12/5)

- ▶ Oklahoma is ranked in the top 60 in six NCAA Division I categories. OU is 14th in scoring defense (57.9 PPG), 22nd in three-point percentage defense (27.0%), 33rd in field goal percentage (49.3%), 41st in effective field goal percentage (56.0%), 43rd in three point percentage (38.1%) and 51st in fouls per game (14.7).
- ▶ **Grant Sherfield** is second in the nation in 3-point percentage (55.6%) and 59th in free throw percentage (87.9%). Sherfield is the only NCAA DI men's basketball player this season to shoot 55% or greater from three (min. 2.5 made per game) and 85% or greater from the free throw line (min. 2.5 made per game). Sherfield is second in the Big 12 in minutes per game (33:46), 3-pointers per game (2.78) and 3-point field goals made (25). **Tanner Groves** is third in the Big 12 in defensive rebounds per game (6.3).
- ▶ Sherfield is 14th among active NCAA Division I career leaders in assists per game (4.99), 17th in assists turnover ratio (1.94), 25th in total assists (464) and 24th in scoring average (15.2).

PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Guard **Grant Sherfield** was voted Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year and forward **Tanner Groves** received Preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades. Sherfield is the first Sooner since **Amath M'Baye** in 2012-13 to be selected as the preseason newcomer of the year and the seventh in program history. Sherfield was also named to the Bob Cousy Award Watch List.
- ▶ Sherfield played two seasons at Nevada and started his collegiate career at Wichita State. He was named to the 2021-22 All-Mountain West Third Team and led the Pack in points (19.1), assists (6.4) and minutes per game (35.7). Prior to the 2021-22 season, Sherfield was voted the Preseason Mountain West Player of the Year and was selected to the Preseason All-Mountain West Team. After his sophomore campaign, he was named Mountain West Newcomer of the Year and selected to the All-Mountain West First Team. Sherfield led the Pack in points (18.6), assists (6.08) and steals (1.62) per game.
- ▶ Groves made his debut in the Crimson and Cream last season and averaged 11.6 points, 5.8 rebounds and 1.6 assists per contest. The Spokane, Wash., product started 34 games and earned 2021-22 All-Big 12 Honorable Mention honors. Groves was a three-time Big 12 Newcomer of the Week and is Oklahoma's top returning scorer. Prior to his time in Norman, Groves was the 2020-21 Big Sky Conference Most Valuable Player and was selected to the All-Big Sky First Team and NABC All-District 6 First Team.

- ▶ Oklahoma earned the 75-53 victory over Kansas City on Tuesday, Dec. 6 at Lloyd Noble Center to improve to 7-2 on the season and 4-1 at home.
- ▶ Grant Sherfield scored a team-high 24 points, scoring 22 in the second half. It marked back-to-back games that Sherfield recorded 20-plus points and tallied five 3-pointers. Milos Uzan recorded 11 points and a team-high five assists in his first career start. Tanner Groves recorded 11 points, three rebounds and two assists. Sam Godwin added 10 points off the bench.
- ▶ Despite being down nine with 12 minutes to go in the first half, the Sooners rallied to tie the game at 27 to enter the half. OU scored 48 points in the second half and limited KC to 26. OU shot 66.7% (16-24) from the field in the final 20 minutes.

THE GROVES BROTHERS

▶ Tanner and Jacob Groves have appeared in the starting lineup each game this season. T. Groves is the team's leading rebounder (6.9) and both average 8.5-plus points per contest. The duo score 29.6% of Oklahoma's points, 31.5% of its rebounds and 27.7% of its assists.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 59-19 record at Lloyd Noble Center since 2017. The Sooners have won 83.2% (592-119) of their games at LNC since the building opened in 1975. OU's winning percentage at Lloyd Noble Center is second in the Big 12 only to Kansas' 87.8% at Allen Fieldhouse (835-116).
- ▶ Oklahoma's victory over Oklahoma State on Feb. 26, 2022, marked the Sooners' 10th home win of the 2021-22 season. It marked the fifth consecutive season the Sooners have won 10-plus games at home. In the past 41 seasons, only two times were the Sooners unable to win 10 games at Lloyd Noble Center.

CRIMSON AND CREAM DEBUT

▶ Grant Sherfield, Joe Bamisile, Milos Uzan, Sam Godwin and Otega Oweh donned the Crimson and Cream for the first time against Sam Houston. Sherfield earned the start and scored a team-high 14 points. Yaya Keita and Benny Schröder made their season debuts against UNC Wilmington.

WE HAVE COMPANY

▶ **Jalen Hill** led the Oklahoma offense with 22 points in a 66-58 victory over Arkansas - Pine Bluff. Hill finished 8 of 10 from the field (80%). Hill's 80% field goal percentage (min. 10 attempts) is only the 12th such game since 2010. Hill's eight made field goals and 22 points were career highs.

NON-CONFERENCE. HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- ▶ The Sooners finished their 2021-22 home non-conference schedule 7-2 and opened the year with four-consecutive victories against such foes at Lloyd Noble Center. The Sooners are 4-1 against home non-conference opponents at home this season with wins against UAPB, UNCW, South Alabama and Kansas City.
- ▶ In the last 11 seasons, OU has compiled a 59-7 record at Lloyd Noble Center against non-conference foes. The Sooners have six undefeated seasons dating back to the 2014-15 season and have compiled a 48-5 record in the previous eight seasons.

AGAINST THE SEC

▶ The Sooners are 10-1 in their last 11 games against the SEC. Prior to its loss against Auburn last season, Oklahoma had won its nine previous meetings against the SEC, which included two AP top 15 victories last season against Florida and Arkansas. OU beat Ole Miss to win the ESPN Events Invitational this season.

▶ Tanner Groves success on the court was matched by his success in the classroom. The senior transfer from Eastern Washington was named a CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honoree following the conclusion of Big 12 tournament play. Groves graduated from Eastern Washington with a Bachelor of Arts degree in interdisciplinary studies and held a 3.89 GPA. He is pursuing a Master of Arts degree in organizational leadership and has a 4.00 GPA.

EFFICIENCY IS KEY

- ▶ The Sooners finished the 2021-22 slate 14-1 when shooting 50.0% or greater from the field. When Oklahoma recorded a higher field goal percentage than its opponent, the Sooner were 18-1. 0U is 5-0 when shooting 50% or greater during the 2022-23 season, including victories over Nebraska, Seton Hall and Ole Miss at the ESPN Events Invitational.
- According to KenPom, Oklahoma finished the year seventh nationally in two-point field goal percentage (56.7%) and 20th in effective field-goal percentage (54.8%).

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY

▶ Oklahoma is one of 28 NCAA DI teams that have two brothers (**Tanner** and **Jacob Groves**) on the team. The Sooners have had three pairs of brothers play on the same team - (Groves brothers, Wayman and William Tisdale, and Blake and Taylor Griffin).

SOONERS IN THE NBA

▶ Four Sooners are on a NBA roster for the 2022-23 season - **Buddy Hield** (Indiana Pacers), **Trae Young** (Atlanta Hawks), **Austin Reaves** (Los Angeles Lakers) and **Blake Griffin** (Boston Celtics).

MOSER VERSUS AP TOP-15 TEAMS

▶ **Porter Moser** earned his fifth victory over at AP top-15 opponent on March 10, 2022, beating No. 3 Baylor in the quarterfinal round of the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. Moser became the first Oklahoma coach to have three AP top-15 victories in his first 15 games and five such victories in his first season. **Kelvin Sampson** (1994-95) earned three victories against teams ranked in the AP's top 15 and tallied five top-25 wins.

BATTLED THE BEST LAST SEASON

▶ Oklahoma had the 7th-toughest strength of schedule according to the NET, WarrenNolan.com, KenPom and 11th by ESPN (3/7) last season. Oklahoma played 14 games against teams ranked in the AP Top 25 and finished the regular season tied with four other teams nationally for most wins over AP top 15 opponents (five).

WELCOME TO THE CREW

- ▶ In addition to the eight new student-athletes to the program, Moser added former Oklahoma men's basketball standout **Ryan Humphrey** as an assistant coach. He joins **Emanuel Dildy**. **Tad Glibert** was hired as director of operations and **Dylan Mihalke** was elevated to director of analytics and assistant director of operations.
- ▶ **Doc Sadler** joined the men's basketball staff as special advisor to the head coach on Thursday, Nov. 17. Sadler, a 40-year college coaching veteran and former 18-year head coach, most recently spent three years on staff at Nebraska (2019-22). He last served as head coach from 2014-19 at Southern Miss after spending six seasons as head coach at Nebraska (2006-12). He was also head coach at UTEP from 2004-06 and Arkansas-Fort Smith from 1998-03.

EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

- ▶ The Sooners signed **Jacolb Cole** to the 2023 signing class on Friday, Nov. 11. Cole, a 6-8 forward from Bellaire, Texas, is a four-star prospect by ESPN and Rivals and a three star by 247Sports. He is ranked No. 69 on the ESPN100, No. 107 nationally by Rivals and the No. 6 player in Missouri by 247Sports. He attended the 2022 USA Basketball Junior National Team April minicamp and was one of 16 finalists for the 2021 USA U16 National Team roster. Cole attended Bellaire High School for three years and moved to Missouri for his senior season. He averaged 16.8 points and 8.5 rebounds per contest in 84 starts for Bellaire. Cole was named 2021-22 6A Region 3 District MVP and earned 6A All-Region honors. He averaged 22.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.0 blocks per game in 28 games and led Bellaire to a 21-9 finish and an appearance in the 6A regionals.
- ▶ Kaden Cooper joined the 2023 signing class on Monday, Nov. 14. Cooper, a 6-6 guard from Ada, Okla., is a four-star prospect by 247Sports, ESPN, On3 and Rivals. He is ranked No. 44 in the ESPN100. Cooper is the first Oklahoma signee in the top half of the ESPN100 since Trae Young was ranked No. 23 in the 2017 class. The duo of Cooper and Cole are a part of back-to-back signing classes with two ESPN100 signees. Cooper and Cole join 2022 ESPN100 signees Milos Uzan (No. 57) and Otega Oweh (No. 76). Cooper attended Ada High School before transferring to The Skills Factory in Woodstock, Ga. He competed on the Adidas 3SSB Circuit for Team Trae Young and averaged 10.4 points, 7.4 rebounds, 1.8 assists, 1.7 steals and 1.1 blocks in 17 games. Cooper led the circuit in rebounds per game. In 28 contests for The Skill Factory, he averaged 12.9 points, 9.0 rebounds, 1.2 assists, 1.4 steals and 1.0 blocks per contest. Cooper shot 62% from the field (115-186) and 48% from deep (29-60).

FOUNDATION BUILDERS

- ▶ Oklahoma's roster features five key returners from a squad that earned five victories against AP top 25 ranked teams. The Sooners return 44.1% of their scoring, 52.9% rebounding and 38% assists.
- Two Sooner starters from 2021-22 **Tanner Groves and Jalen Hill** are slated to comprise the frontcourt. Groves finished second on last season's roster in points and rebounds per game, averaging 11.6 points on 53.2% shooting from the floor and 5.8 rebounds per contest. Groves started 34 games last season and was a three-time Big 12 Newcomer of the Week. He earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades and was selected to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team. Hill was one of three Sooners to start every contest last season and led the Sooners with 5.9 rebounds per contest. Hill added 9.1 points per game.
- ▶ **Jacob Groves** made an immediate impact last season off the bench and moved into a starting role for the final nine games of the season. The younger Groves appeared in 34 games and started 12. He tallied 4.6 points and 2.9 rebounds per contest.
- ▶ **C.J. Noland**, a 2022 All-Big 12 Freshmen Team selection, appeared in 33 contests and tallied 3.9 points and 1.6 rebounds per game. **Bijan Cortes** donned the Crimson and Cream 30 times last season and tallied 2.0 points, 1.4 assists and 1.4 rebounds per game. In addition, Oklahoma returns two walk-ons **Jake Moser and Blake Seacat**.

NEW TO TOWN

- ▶ **Joe Bamisile**, a 6-4 junior guard from Chesterfield, Va., is a three-level scorer that provides the Sooners instant athleticism. He started his collegiate career at Virginia Tech before transferring to George Washington. Bamisile appeared in 30 games and started 29 at GW, averaging 16.3 points and 5.0 rebounds in 31.3 minutes per game. He shot 45.8% from the floor and 35.1% from beyond the arc. He was named to Atlantic 10 All-Conference Third Team and finished fourth in the A-10 in scoring.
- ▶ Grant Sherfield, a 6-2 senior point guard from Fort Worth, Texas, is a dynamic guard that can control the offense. Sherfield started his college career at Wichita State before transferring to Nevada for the last two seasons. Sherfield started 28 games for the Pack last season and boasted a team-high 35.7 minutes per game. He tallied a team-best 19.1 points per contest and led the Mountain West and finished fourth in the NCAA in assists per game (6.3). Sherfield added 4.2 rebounds per contest and was named to the All-Mountain West Third Team. Following his sophomore season, he was voted preseason Mountain West Newcomer of the Year.
- ▶ Yaya Keita, a 6-9 sophomore forward from St. Louis, Mo., is an extremely physical and high-level defender that has a nonstop motor. He started his collegiate career at Missouri, playing for the Tigers for one season. Keita appeared in 21 games and averaged 1.2 points and rebounds per game.
- ▶ Sam Godwin, a 6-10 junior forward from Ada, Okla., joined the Sooners as a preferred walk-on after two seasons at Wofford. Godwin, appeared in 30 games last season for the Terriers and recorded 12 starts. He shot 62.1 percent from the field and averaged 6.3 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Otega Oweh, a 6-6 guard from Somerset, N.J., was a four-star prospect on ESPN.com, 247Sports and Rivals. Oweh was ranked No. 73 by 247Sports, No. 76 by Rivals and No. 89 by ESPN nationally. During the 2021-22 campaign for Blair Academy, he averaged 20.1 points per contest. Oweh led Team Final EYBL (PA) to a 17U Peach Jam title and averaged 14.9 points, 4.9 rebounds, 1.8 steals and 1.3 assists per game. He was named Nike EYBL Peach Jam Breakout Player of the Session.
- Luke Northweather, a 6-10 forward from Blair Oaks High School in Jefferson City, Mo., was a three-star prospect by 247Sports and was the No. 6 rated player in Missouri in the 2022 class. Northweather was named the 2021-22 Gatorade Missouri Boys Basketball Player of the Year and averaged 29.2 points, 11.4 rebounds, 3.4 assists, 2.4 blocks and 2.0 steals per contest. He led the Falcons to a 26-2 record last season and to the Missouri Class 4, District 9 Championship game. The senior forward shot 71.6 percent from the field and 38.8 percent from deep. He concluded his high school career with a school record 2,018 points and was a two-time Tri-County Conference Player of the Year.
- ▶ Milos Uzan, a 6-4 point guard from Las Vegas, was ranked No. 52 on the ESPN100 and the No. 1 prospect in Nevada. He was a four-star prospect by 247Sports and ESPN. Uzan played for Dream City Christian (Ariz.) at the 2021 Geico Top Flight Invite and also played for Prolific Prep in the 30-game Grind Session in Arizona. He averaged 13 points, 6.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Benny Schröder, a 6-7 guard from Munich, Germany, is considered one of the most promising European prospects that committed to the college route per ESPN. He played for Kickz IBAM in the U19 NBBL and averaged 26.7 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.8 assists in 31.6 minutes per game. Schröder played for the U18 German National Team in the 2021 FIBA U18 European Challengers tournament. He averaged 16.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.4 assists in 23 minutes per game.

SEASON REWIND

- ▶ Oklahoma finished the season 24th nationally and second in the Big 12 in field goal percentage (47.6%). The Sooners were 47th in total steals (258), 51st in scoring defense (65.0) and 59th in total assists (491). Oklahoma finished third in the Big 12 in 3-pointers made (266) and attempts (767).
- ▶ **Jalen Hill** led the Sooners at the charity stripe and finished 12th in the leagued in free throws made (84) and 13th in free throw attempts (111). The Las Vegas product led the Sooners with 205 total rebounds, ranking eighth in the Big 12. Fellow frontcourt starter **Tanner Groves** ranked fifth in the Big 12 in defensive rebounds per game (4.53) and 11th in total rebounds (197).

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser enters his second season at the helm in 2022-23. Moser, who is the 15th coach in program history, was hired by Vice President and Director of Athletics Joe Castiglione on April 3, 2021,

Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and a postseason berth during the 2021-22 campaign. The 18-year Division 1 head coach amassed five victories over teams ranked in the too 25 at the time of competition and the Sooners received a No. 1 seed in the National Invitational Tournament. Oklahoma earned a victory over Missouri State in the opening round of the NIT.

Four Sooners earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors under Moser at the conclusion of last season and C.J. Noland was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Tanner Groves was named a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and selected to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the past half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Prior to his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021. He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the CBI title in 2017 and qualifying for the NIT in 2019. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mentions All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC, Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins and posted the most wins in a single season in school history during the 2017-18 season (32).

His most successful season at Loyola occurred during the 2017-18 season. Moser led the Ramblers to the Final Four - Loyola's first appearance since winning the NCAA Championship in

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed. The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed ever to advance to the Final Four, earning wins over Miami, Tennessee,

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year and was selected as the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year

The 2017-18 squad ranked second in the nation in fewest personal fouls per game (13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer became the first player in Loyola history to be named MVC Player of the Year and earn Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America honors. Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his second-year working with Moser as the director of video operations and player development.

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 - tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside of major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola, Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in the 2020-21 season. As an eight seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season. Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 312-258 (.547) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season prior to his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories prior to his tenure, but Moser turned the program around in just one season to finish with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003. After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011.

He then returned to a head coaching role by being named Lovola's head coach prior to the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children - Jordan, a member of OU's women's basketball team, Jake, a member of the Sooners' men's basketball team, and Max and Ben.
