
MIzzou ranks third nationally with a turnover margin of +7.1, outscoring teams 22.3 to 12.6 in points off turnovers.

D'Moi Hodge is averaging 16.7 points in wins this year but just 9.3 points in losses.



- Free baseball hats will be given away to the first 1,000 students, while the baseball team will also be signing autographs prior to the game.
- The NCAA National Championship trophy will be on display on the concourse, as well as the Battle Line Rivalry Trophy.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Mizzou is 13-4 during the 2022-23 season and is receiving votes in both national polls.
- The Tigers are 2-3 in SEC play, winning both of their home games with an 0-3 record on the road.
- Senior **Kobe Brown** leads the Tigers with 15.6 points and 5.6 rebounds per game.
- Overall, four Tigers are scoring in double figures with D'Moi Hodge (14.9), Noah Carter (10.7) and DeAndre Gholston (10.5) following Brown.
- Nick Honor leads Mizzou with 3.5 assists.
- Mizzou ranks ninth in the country with a scoring offense of 84.4, while allowing 75.4 points.

ABOUT THE RAZORBACKS

- Arkansas enters with a 12-5 record and 1-4 mark in SEC action, earning a No. 25 ranking in both the AP and coaches polls.
- The Razorbacks have lost their last three games and are 0-3 in SEC play away from home.
- Ricky Council IV leads Arkansas with 18.3 points.
- Anthony Black is second with 12.4 points to go with a team-best 5.1 rebounds and 3.6 assists.
- The Razorbacks are averaging 76.2 points, while allowing 66.1 on defense.

SERIES HISTORY

- In a series that dates back to the 1950-51 season, Arkansas holds a 33-26 advantage over Mizzou.
- The Razorbacks are also 14-8 since Missouri joined the SEC prior to the 2012-13 campaign, while MU is 16-12 against Arkansas in Columbia.
- The schools are meeting for the second time this season as the No. 13 Razorbacks earned a 74-68 win over No. 20 Missouri in Fayetteville on Jan. 4.
- The Arkansas victory extended its winning streak in the series to five games.

TOP-10 SCORING OFFENSE

- One of the biggest keys to success this season for Mizzou is owning a top scoring attack.
- Mizzou enters the game ranked ninth nationally with an offense of 84.4 points.

TARGETING 70 POINTS

- While the Tigers are averaging well over 80 points this season, the magic number is just 70 for MU.
- MU has won its last 16 games when scoring at least 70, including a perfect 12-0 mark this year.
- On the opposite end, Mizzou is just 1-4 this year when held under the target – losing 22 of its last 23 games overall with 69 or fewer points.
- Overall, Mizzou is averaging 90.2 points in its 13 wins this year but just 65.8 in its four losses.

TRIPLES EQUALS SUCCESS

- Missouri's performance beyond the 3-point arc has largely been a key to success.
- The Tigers are shooting more than 12 percent better from beyond the arc in wins with nearly five more makes per game.

- With shooting being vital to success, MU is happy to be returning to Mizzou Arena this week.
- Missouri is shooting nearly 10 percent better at home this season compared to true road games and more than 14 percent from beyond the arc.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

- Kobe Brown has done a little bit of everything for the Tigers this year.
- Brown leads the Tigers with 15.6 points and 5.6 rebounds per game, while also adding 2.4 assists and 1.3 steals.
- The senior's versatility was once again on display in MU's most recent game – scoring 21 points to go with a career-best five steals.
- Perhaps his most impressive game was against Illinois – scoring a MU Braggin' Rights-record 31 points to go with a career-best eight assists – the first Tiger with at least 30 points and eight helpers in a game since Clarence Gilbert in 2001.
- Brown is on pace to be the first Tiger to average 15 points, five rebounds and two assists since Marcus Denmon in 2011-12.

HIGH SHOOTING MARKS FOR BROWN

- Senior Kobe Brown has been one of the most efficient players for the Tigers this year.
- Brown ranks third in the SEC and 56th in the country with a field goal percentage of 55.7, while also adding a 3-point clip of 42.6.
- In fact, Brown is one of only five players in the nation shooting at least 55 percent from the field (5.0 FGM per game) and 40 percent from 3-point range (1.0 3PM per game).

SHOOTING IMPROVEMENT

- Senior Kobe Brown has shown a tremendous amount of improvement during his career with his shooting touch.
- Brown has raised his shooting percentage by 9.8 percent from his first three years, while increasing his 3-point mark by 18.9 percent.

- On the defensive end, the Tigers have excelled forcing turnovers en route to their strong start.
- The Tigers currently rank first in the country with 11.6 steals per game, while placing ninth overall by forcing 18.8 turnovers per game.

A THEFT IN HODGE

- The 2022 Horizon League Defensive Player of the Year, **D'Moi Hodge** is replicating his success at MU.
- Through 17 contests, Hodge is first in the SEC and seventh nationally with 2.65 steals per game.

 In fact, Hodge is on pace to set the Mizzou singleseason record as his 2.65 steals per game is the best in MU history.

- The new coaching staff has taken advantage of the transfer portal during their short time on campus.
- Players with past Division I experience and in their first year at Mizzou are accounting for 74.5 percent of its points, 65.4 percent of rebounds, 83.1 percent of assists, 48.1 percent of blocks and 79.8 percent of steals.

- Hodge leads MU with 14.9 points per game the third-highest total by a Tiger in his first year at MU during the shot-clock era (last 38 seasons).

HIGH RANKS FOR HODGE

- Steals aren't the only thing that D'Moi Hodge ranks highly in.
- In addition to leading the SEC in steals, Hodge is 12th in points (14.9), seventh in field goal percentage (49.5), third in 3-point percentage (39.3) and second in 3-point makes per game (2.82).

HODGE KEY TO SUCCESS

- The player the Tigers need to get going is **D'Moi Hodge** as he has been the biggest key to success this year.
- Hodge is averaging seven more points in wins, while shooting nearly 20 percent higher.
- Overall, Mizzou is 12-1 when he scores 11 or more points but 1-3 when held under the target.

TEMPO TEMPO

- Tempo is one of the biggest changes in the Tigers' attack this season.
- MU ranks 39th nationally in adjusted tempo with 71.1 possessions per game, while placing 28th with 15.8 seconds per offensive possession.
- Missouri hasn't ranked in the top 100 nationally in tempo since 2012-13 (94th) and in the top 50 since 2010-11 (14th).

NO. 10 NATIONALLY IN ASSISTS

- Another area where the Tigers rank among the nation's elite is in assists.
- Mizzou currently ranks 10th of 363 schools nationally with 18.1 assists per game.
- · The Tigers recorded at least 20 assists in the first seven games of the season - the team's longest streak in school history.

ASSISTS WITHOUT TURNOVERS

- Perhaps what is most impressive about MU's high assist number is doing it while limiting turnovers.
- Mizzou leads the SEC with 11.7 turnovers per game and is 11th in the country with an assist-toturnover ratio of 1.54.
- The team's leader in assists. Nick Honor ranks 10th nationally with a 3.16 assist-to-turnover ratio, including a 4.75 mark in SEC play
- Six times, Mizzou has recorded at least 10 more assists than turnovers - including in each of its last three wins versus Illinois, Kentucky and Vanderbilt when it totaled 58 assists to just 24 turnovers (2.42 ratio).

NO. 3 IN TURNOVER MARGIN

- With MU's ability to limit turnover on its end and cause miscues on the defensive end, Mizzou has been able to take advantage on the scoreboard.
- The Tigers rank third nationally with a turnover margin of +7.1.

- The Tigers have won or tied the turnover battle in 16-of-17 games this season, including six games by at least 10 turnovers.
- It has led to MU posting a 396-214 advantage in points off turnovers (average of 23.3 to 12.6).

FASTBREAK POINTS

- An increased tempo, strong passing team and one that forces turnovers is a recipe for high fastbreak numbers.
- Missouri is averaging 17.2 points per game via fastbreak - ranking seventh nationally.
- In fact, 20.3 percent of team team's points this season have come via the fastbreak.

• The Tigers have outscored their opponent in

fastbreak points by a total margin of 292-152 (average of 17.2 to 8.9).

ADVANCED METRICS LEADERS

- A number of Tigers rank among the best in advanced metrics this season.
- D'Moi Hodge is 33rd nationally in offensive rating (129.5), while Nick Honor is 44th (127.5).
- Hodge is also 45th in effective field goal percentage (62.6), while Kobe Brown ranks 66th (61.5).
- Mizzou is the only school to feature two players in the top 10 in the SEC in player efficiency rating (PER) with Brown placing third at 27.6 and Hodge fifth at 26.7.
- Overall, Mizzou is eighth in the country with 1.151 points per offensive possession.

DEPTH IN NUMBERS

- Behind MU's attack is a number of weapons.
- Nine Tigers have scored in double figures this year, while Mizzou features four players averaging at least 10.0 points.
- Additionally, the Tigers are one of just 14 Division I teams to have seven different players that have led the team in scoring.

BENCH LEADER

- DeAndre Gholston has maximized his minutes since first coming off the bench versus UCF.
- In the last seven games, Gholston is averaging 12.0 points - shooting 47.5 percent from the field and 50.0 percent from 3-point range.
- Overall, Gholston averages 10.5 points, shooting 43.2 percent with a 3-point clip of 32.6 percent.

NEW SEC COACHES

• Coach Dennis Gates is among a group of six new coaches at SEC schools, currently tied for first with a 13-4 start to his tenure.

FIRST RANKING FOR GATES

- When the Tigers entered the national rankings earlier in January, it marked the first time **Dennis Gates** has earned a ranking as head coach.
- Gates becomes just the second Tiger coach to earn a spot in his debut season since the AP poll was introduced. He joins Frank Haith in 2011-12 among the eight eligible Mizzou coaches.

RANKED WINS

- Wednesday's game is another chance for the Tigers to shine against a nationally-ranked school this season.
- Mizzou has two wins over ranked foes this year, defeating No. 16 Illinois (Dec. 22) and No. 19 Kentucky (Dec. 28).
- It marks the first time the Tigers defeated a nationally-ranked school in back-to-back games since the 2009 NCAA Tournament and the first time in the regular season since 2001-02.

DOMINANT VICTORIES

- Not only did Mizzou win consecutive games over ranked foes but it did so in dominant fashion, defeating the Illini (93-71) and Wildcats (89-75) by a combined 36 points.
- The 22-point win over Illinois is its biggest over its rival (previous high was 18 in 1994), while also marking MU's largest win over a ranked team since a 92-53 victory versus No. 20 Cal in 2011.
- Mizzou then scored 89 points in the win versus UK the most allowed by a John Calipari-coached Kentucky team in SEC play (232 games).

A PAIR OF 30 PIECES

- The key for Mizzou's nationally-ranked wins was the performance of senior **Kobe Brown**.
- Brown scored 61 points in the two victories shooting 60.6 percent from the field (20-33) and

58.3 percent from 3-point range (7-12).

- The senior is the first Tiger with back-to-back games with at least 30 points since Thomas Gardner in 2005-06.
- In fact, Brown is just the third Division I player in the last 25 years to score at least 30 points in back-to-back wins against ranked teams – joining Davidson's Stephen Curry (2007-08) and Iowa's Matt Gatens (2011-12).

WEEKLY HONORS

- After its back-to-back impressive wins, the Tigers and **Kobe Brown** both collected accolades.
- The Tigers were named Team of the Week on Dec. 26 by NCAA.com and Andy Katz and on Jan. 2 by ESPN.
- Brown collected both Lute Olson Award National Player of the Week and SEC Player of the Week accolades on Dec. 26, while being named Field of 68 National Player of the Week on Jan. 2.

SHOOTING 50 PERCENT

- One reason for the Tigers' strong start offensively is due to efficient and effective shooting.
- MU leads the SEC and is 16th in the country in both overall field goal percentage (48.9) and effective field goal percentage (56.3).
- In fact, Mizzou has made at least 50 percent of its field goals in 7-of-16 games this season, going a perfect 7-0 in those matchups.
- Despite being just 17 contests into the year, it is already the most times MU has made at least half of its baskets since doing so nine times during the 2017-18 campaign.

GHOLSTON GAME WINNER

- The Tigers improved to 10-1 thanks to a buzzerbeating winner from senior **DeAndre Gholston** on Dec. 17 versus UCF.
- The graduate student sunk a near 40-footer as time expired to lead Mizzou to the 68-66 win.
- The winner ranked as the No. 2 play of the day on SportCenter's Top 10.
- It is the second game-winner for Gholston during his college career with, ironically, the first coming against Coach Gates and Cleveland State – a layup with 3.2 seconds left in a 81-80 win (Jan. 23, 2021).

EFFICIENT INSIDE

- Another area where Mizzou has been successful is scoring inside.
- Missouri ranks fourth nationally by making 58.8 percent of its 2-point baskets.
- **D'Moi Hodge** leads MU and ranks 25th nationally with 70.0 percent shooting inside the arc.

DOUBLING UP

- Senior **Kobe Brown** highlighted the seasonopening win versus Southern Indiana.
- Brown recorded his eighth-career double-double in the victory with 20 points and 14 rebounds.
- The senior is just the second Tiger in the last 17 years to register a double-double in the season opener (also Mark Smith in 2018-19).
- Brown is also the first Mizzou player to collect at least 20 points and 10 boards in the opener since Kareem Rush had 24 points and 15 boards versus Savannah State to open the 2000-01 campaign.
- Brown leads MU in scoring (15.6) and rebounding (5.6) this season.

ALL-CONFERENCE PLAYERS

- Despite returning only three players from last year's team, Missouri features an experienced roster with numerous accolades.
- Five Tigers earned all-conference honors in their respective leagues last season – Kobe Brown (second-team All-SEC), Noah Carter (secondteam All-MVC), Tre Gomillion (third-team All-Horizon), D'Moi Hodge (first-team All-Horizon) and Isiaih Mosley (first-team All-MVC).

HODGE NAMED SEC POTW

W3

- Graduate student D'Moi Hodge was the first Tiger to earn SEC Player of the Week honors, collecting the accolade on Nov. 21.
- Hodge led MU to a 2-0 week, averaging 24.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.0 steals per game.
- He scored 30 points in the win over SIUE before adding 18 points and a career-best six steals versus MVSU.

PRESEASON ALL-SEC

- Senior Kobe Brown was recognized as one of the top players in the SEC by earning first-team preseason all-conference honors as voted on by the league's coaches.
- Brown is the first Tiger in five years to collect the first-team accolade Michael Porter, Jr. earned the honor prior to the 2017-18 season.
- A second-team All-SEC selection last season, Brown led MU in scoring (12.5 per game), rebounds (7.6) and steals (40), while ranking second in assists (81).

DEBUT SEASON FOR GATES

- After leading Cleveland State to a successful three-year run, **Dennis Gates** is in his first season as the Missouri Whitten Family Head Coach.
- Gates becomes the 20th head coach in 117 years of Missouri basketball.
- In his three years with the Vikings, Gates posted a 50-40 overall record – including a 39-19 mark the last two years and two regular-season Horizon League titles, one Horizon League Tournament championship and one NCAA Tournament trip.
- Gates was named Horizon League Coach of the Year following both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.

BUILDING A STAFF

- Joining **Dennis Gates** on the bench is a veteran staff that includes multiple years of head coaching experience.
- All three bench assistants have enjoyed time leading a college program: Charlton "C.Y." Young (Georgia Southern, 2009-13), David "Dickey" Nutt (Arkansas State, 1995-08; Southeast Missouri State, 2009-15) and Kyle Smithpeters (John A. Logan CC, 2012-22).
- Additionally, director of scouting and analytics Michael Fly spent the last four seasons as head coach at Florida Gulf Coast (2018-22).

OH CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Four Tigers are set to serve as team captains during the 2022-23 campaign.
- Graduate students Tre Gomillion, Nick Honor and Ben Sternberg plus senior Kobe Brown are all set to take on the top leadership roles with Mizzou this season.

THE RETURNING PIECES

- Missouri is returning only three letterwinners from a season ago in Kaleb Brown, Kobe Brown and Ronnie DeGray III.
- Mizzou's three players to feature on both this year's and last year's roster are the fewest in the SEC with Arkansas (four) the only other school with less than five.
- Kobe Brown led MU in scoring (12.5) and rebounding a year ago (7.6), while DeGray added 8.3 points and Kaleb Brown scored 24 total points.

WELCOME HOME

- After spending the last three years at Missouri State, senior Isiaih Mosley has returned home.
- A native of Columbia, Mosley led Rock Bridge High School to a Class 5A state title in 2019.
- Mosley averaged 23.2 points and 6.9 rebounds with the Bruins en route to earning Mr. Show-Me Basketball honors.

20 POINTS & 50-40-90 CLUB

- Senior Isiaih Mosley joined an elite club last season as just the third player in the last 20 years to average 20 points, while shooting 50-40-90.
- Mosley averaged 20.4 points at Missouri State in 2021-22 – making 50.4 percent of his attempts from the field, 42.7 percent from beyond the arc and 90.2 percent from the charity stripe.
- He joined Utah State's Jaycee Carroll (2007-08) and Nevada's Luke Babbitt (2009-10) as the only three players to accomplish the feat during the last 20 seasons.

TRANSFER RECRUITING RANKINGS

- With nine players and four starters departing from last year's roster, the Tigers had to hit the transfer portal to build its 2022-23 roster.
- Mizzou responded by compiling the No. 2 class in the nation among incoming transfers, according to EvanMiya.com.
- Senior Isiaih Mosley highlighted the transfer newcomers and was a top-10 recruit from both CBS Sports (No. 4) and ESPN (No. 6).
- Noah Carter (No. 34 ESPN) and D'Moi Hodge (No. 70 Stadium) were also top-100 transfers.
- Mosley and Hodge were both first-team allconference selections at Missouri State and Cleveland State, respectively, while Carter was a second-team honoree at Northern Iowa.

CLEVELAND STATE CONNECTIONS

- Coach Gates brought some familiar faces with him from his time at Cleveland State.
- Fifth-year players **Ben Sternberg**, **Tre Gomillion** and **D'Moi Hodge** plus junior **Mabor Majak** all moved West with Gates.

- Gomillion (2020-21) and Hodge (2021-22) are the last two Horizon League Defensive Players of the Year, while Hodge was also a first-team allconference selection last season.
- Additionally, six members of the current staff was also with Gates at Cleveland State – assistant coach Dickey Nutt, special assistant to the head coach Ryan Sharbaugh, chief of staff Matt Cline, director of operations Chase Goldstein, scouting coordinator Dalon King and player development coordinator Perin Foote.

ADDITIONAL TRANSFERS

- The Tigers also add two additional transfers with Division I experience.
- **DeAndre Gholston** is a graduate transfer from Milwaukee who tallied 14.3 points per game last year in his second season with the Panthers.
- Graduate **Nick Honor** joins MU after spending the last three years at Clemson averaging 7.7 points last season.

NO. 1 JUNIOR COLLEGE PLAYERS

- Mizzou can also take advantage of adding two of the best junior college players in the country this offseason.
- Mohamed Diarra was named the No.1 rated JUCO recruit in the 2022 class by JUCORecruiting.com.
- Diarra averaged 17.8 points, while leading the NJCAA with 12.6 rebounds at Garden City.
- Sean East II was also named the 2022 NJCAA Player of the Year after averaging 20.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists at John A. Logan.

TRUE FRESHMEN

- Mizzou completes its roster with the addition of two true freshmen in Aidan Shaw and Jackson Francois.
- Shaw was a four-star recruit and is the highestranked recruit by 247Sports.com for Mizzou since 2017.
- Shaw averaged 21.2 points with 11.1 rebounds and 3.5 blocks at Blue Valley High School.

EIGHT CORE VALUES

- One goal of Coach Gates in building a program is to instill eight core values in the student-athletes that they carry into the classroom, on the court and into the community.
- The eight core values are: friendship, love, accountability, trust, discipline, unselfishness, enthusiasm and toughness.

MIZZOU LANDS TOP-25 CLASS

- The Tigers signed a top-25 class nationally during the early signing period in November.

- Missouri is slated to finish 11th in the SEC this season, as voted on by the league's media.

The program's 20th head coach, Gates joined the Tigers in March 2022, following a three-year run as the head coach at Cleveland State. At Cleveland State he led the Vikings to two Horizon League Championships and back-to-back postseason appearances.

CLEVELAND STATE

Gates rebuilt the Vikings program, winning fifty games, earning a 39-19 (.672) mark over the past two seasons. CSU won two Horizon League regular-season titles (2020, 2021), the 2021 Horizon League Tournament Championship and berths in the NCAA Tournament (2021) and Postseason NIT (2022). The Vikings' trip to the 2021 NCAA Tournament was just the third in program history and the first since the 2009 campaign.

A native of Chicago, Gates was tabbed as the Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2019-20 and 2020-21. CSU broke the 20win plateau in 2021-22, a first for the program since 2013-14.

During his three seasons in Cleveland, Gates mentored two Defensive Players of the Year, five all-conference honorees and five All-Defensive Team selections.

FLORIDA STATE

Gates, who has 17 years of Division I coaching experience, came to Cleveland State after eight seasons on Leonard Hamilton's staff at Florida State. Gates' tenure at Florida State mirrored the Seminoles rise to national prominence. With Gates on the staff, the Seminoles played in four NCAA Tournaments, advanced to the Elite Eight of the 2018 NCAA Tournament and advanced to the Sweet 16 in both 2012 and 2019.

He was instrumental in recruiting four straight Top-15 classes at Florida State, which produced five NBA Draft picks over four years - Jonathan Isaac (No. 9 selection in 2017), Malik Beasley (No. 19 in 2016), Mfiondu Kabengele (No. 27 in 2019), Dwayne Bacon (No. 40 in 2017) and Terance Mann (Nov. 48 in 2019). He helped recruit seven Top-100 players, overall, to the Seminoles during his tenure in Tallahassee.

EARLY COACHING POSITIONS

Before joining the staff at Florida State, Gates worked at Marquette, Cal, Northern Illinois and Nevada. During his coaching career, he has served on coaching staffs which have made 10 postseason appearances. Gates also worked as a skill development coach with the NBA's Los Angeles Clippers (2002-03).

PLAYING CAREER

A combo guard for the Cal Golden Bears, Gates served as a three-year captain, helping lead the team to three 20-win seasons. He played in 114 career games with 34 starting assignments, totaling 432 points, 140 rebounds, 148 assists and 100 steals.

Gates was a two-time Pac-10 First Team All-Academic Team selection during his tenure with the Bears, was named Cal's Most Inspirational Player in 2001 and was named the team's Outstanding Student-Athlete in 1999 and 2001. In addition, he was awarded the 2002 Pac-10 Medal of Honor, which is presented to the Pac-10 Universities Top Graduating Student-Athlete.


