AGGIES AT RAZORBACKS:

The Texas A&M men's basketball team takes on the Arkansas Razorbacks in a road SEC matchup at 6 p.m. on Saturday at Bud Walton Arena in Fayetteville, Ark.

- The Aggies have just a single victory on the Hogs' home court in the past 35 seasons (Aggies are 1-14 in that span). The lone win was an 87-80 victory on Feb. 23. 2019.
- Arkansas is a "mirror opponent" with the Hogs making a return trip to Aggieland in two weeks on Feb. 15.

ANATOMY OF A TURNAROUND:

Since a demoralizing 67-62 loss to Wofford prior to the holiday break, the Aggies have reeled off nine wins in their last 10 games, while improving from 6-5 to 15-6.

TRENDS & STREAKS:

- Tyrece Radford has scored 14 or more points in eight of 10 games, including four games with 20 or more.
- Radford's FG% in the first 11 games of the season was 31.5% and is 50.9% in the last 10.
- Wade Taylor IV has averaged 6.0 assists/G over his last three contests.
- Andersson Garcia's "per 40" rebounds average is 10.8.
- The Aggies have earned a rebounds advantage in eight of past 10 games.
- Texas A&M has matched its season low of nine turnovers in its last two games.
- The Aggies are averaging an 11-point scoring margin advantage in the first half over the past 10 games. In the first 11 games, the Aggies outscored their opponents by just four points in the first half (376-372).
- In SEC play, the Aggies are allowing an average of 24.3 first-half points in SEC play, while limiting opponents to 31.9% FG-FGA / 26.0% 3FG-3FGA in the first stanza.
- Texas A&M ranks No. 2 in scoring defense in SEC play, allowing an average of 61.6 points/g. The Aggies have lopped nearly nine full points off their average vs. non-conference opponents (70.4) to SEC foes.

GETTING TO THE LINE:

The Aggies rank No. 2 nationally in free throws made per game and No. 3 in FTs attempted. Texas A&M has shot 100+ more free throws than nine SEC teams

- The Aggies average 18.7 25.0 FTM-FTA per game, which is well ahead of the pace set by ALL Texas A&M squads after 1970.
- Texas A&M has been to the line 25 or more times in 14 of 21 games and has hit 20 or more FTs nine times.
- Tyrece Radford and Wade Taylor IV are in the SEC top 10 in free throw makes and attempts.

The Aggies are 13-1 when posting six or more "turkeys" in a game. In Aggie Hoops venacular, a "turkey" is when an opponent is held scoreless on three straight possessions. The Aggies have had five or more turkeys for 10 straight games.

Sophomore guard Wade Taylor IV, the 6-foot doit-all dynamo from Dallas, Texas, ranks in the top 10 in the SEC in a wide array of statistical categories:

WHAT'S UNIQUE ABOUT AGGIE HOOPS?

- During gameday shoot-arounds, the Aggies traditionally vibe to The Commodores Pandora station on the team Turtlebox bluetooth speaker. This may have changed Bruno Mars.
- "Shooting with Buzz" is a staple of the Aggies' practice regimen. As described by the Bryan-College Station Eagle: "Each player must move their way through 18 shooting spots some straight catch and shoot and some off of movement and make 7 of 10 shots. The clock starts after the player's first make and stops once the whole circuit is done. Managers rebound the shots and pass a ball to Williams, who stands near the player, handing the ball off for each shot. On the sideline, a manager stands in front of a giant white board, keeping tallies of the players score at each position. On the other side, a record book of times it took to complete the course are logged."

Williams told the Eagle the impetus for "Shooting with Buzz" was, "I wanted to try to figure out a way, coming off of COVID and all the protocols and having, in essence, a completely revamped roster — how could I find some time working, while at the same time not screaming, while, in an unspoken way, they know I'm trying to invest in their life and in their game."

Buzz Williams is a voracious reader, generally completing 4-5 books every month. On Jan. 2, 2023, he tweeted from @TeamCoachBuzz his "2022 Reads" which listed the 53 books he consumed throughout the year. For the last 11 years, Williams has selected and gifted a book to every player, staff member and their family on the initial road trip of the season. Describing his commitment to reading, Williams said, "Who you are today and who you will be five years from today are the people you meet and the books that you read. Regardless of the genre of book that you read, they say it's worth five years of experience." (Source: @AggieMBK/Dec. 16)

- Last fall, Williams presented four lectures to Texas A&M students for SOMS 380 (School of Military Science), in collaboration with the Corps of Cadets and the Hollingsworth Center for Ethical Leadership.
- Williams' coaching/support staff has been together for a combined 80 seasons of experience.
- On the occasion of a player or staff member's birthday, Williams honors the occasion with an emoji-filled tweet that always includes a wrong number of birthdays for the celebrator.
- #getBETTER is the long-time mantra for Buzz Williams and his teams. It refers to "the continual improvement in all facets of life. Always finding something to work on, to make progress on. Never being satisfied. Always looking for ways to grow."
- A staple of every road trip are the Aggies' Thank
 You letters. Each coach/player/staff member on
 the trip writes a Thank You letter to someone in
 their life at the first team meal of the roadie.
- "Buzz's Bunch" was implemented by Williams as a way to bring together children with special needs and allow them to fall in love with basketball through an annual free camp and free tickets to a game.
- Quote Shirts have been a pillar in the culture of Buzz Williams' programs throughout his career as a head coach. So far in 2022-23, seven Quote Shirts have made their debuts:
- 'We Are Always Choosing'
- 'Be Allergic to the Big Meal'
- 'Never Let That Influence This'
- ' Airtime Equals Our Time'
- 'In Order To Climb the Ladder, You Must Go One Step At a Time'

ABOUT THE NICKNAME:

Tyrece Radford was dubbed "Boots" by Buzz Williams as a freshman at Virginia Tech becasue he was "as tough as boot leather."

SUCCEEDING IN THE TREES:

There are 10 total players in the SEC averaging 13.0+ points and 5.0+ rebounds per game. Texas A&M's 6-foot-2 Tyrece Radford is the SEC's only 13.0+/5.0+ player under 6-foot-8.



Radford is one of nine 6-foot-2 and shorter players **nationally** to average 13.0+ points and 5.0+ rebounds.

INJURIES UPDATE:

- Super sub Manny Obaseki has missed the past seven games due to a fractured pinkie on his shooting hand (left) suffered vs. Florida on 1/4.
- Freshman Solomon Washington has missed the last three games after suffering a concussion vs. Florida on 1/18.

HONORING ALISE SVIHLA:

- Tyrece Radford shaved off his trademark dreadlocks prior to the Aggies' Jan. 11 matchup with Missouri to honor his academic mentor at Virginia Tech, Alisa Svihla (Ah-LEASE Aah-VILL-ah), who is battling stage 4 colon cancer.
- An academic redshirt as a freshman, Radford, with Svihla's guidance, earned his degree from Virginia Tech in three years. He will leave Texas A&M with a master's degree.
- At last Saturday's "breast cancer awareness" game, the Aggies wore special uniforms with pink accents. Radford's jersey had "SVIHLA" on the back rather than "RADFORD."

LITTLE BIG MAN:

Despite generally being one of the shorter players on the court, the 6-foot-2 Tyrece Radford makes a huge impact in the paint.

MARKED IMPROVEMENT:

Tyrece Radford is getting to the line and hitting the freebies at a significantly higher rate in his fourth season as a collegian.

- After averaging only 2.5 free throw attempts per game for the first three years of his career, Radford is making 5.7 trips to the charity stripe per game in 2022-23.
- Radford has already hit 97 free throws in just 21 games. His previous high season total was 56 from his freshman season at Virginia Tech (56-of-81) when he played 32 games.
- Radford's 80.8 FT% is markedly improved from last year when he hit 67.1% from the line. Radford's threeyear FT% entering 2022-23 was 70.6%.

HCIII LEADING THE WAY:

Junior F Henry Coleman III, along with women's basketball player Jada Malone, represent Texas A&M as members of the SEC Basketball Leadership Council. The council serves as a conduit of communication from student-ath-



letes to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience and wellness and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

- Coleman is an avid fisher and hunter. "Fishing and hunting teach you to be calm under pressure,"
 Coleman said. "When you set that hook on that fish, you can't just start reeling it in. You've got to be a little bit calm and kind of work it in. When you're hunting and you see a buck right in front of you, you have to wait a little bit. I know you want to pull the trigger as soon as you see it, but you have to wait for the right time. It teaches you to be calm in the moment and stay in the moment." (Source: 12thMan.
- Coleman's father, Hank, was a standout defensive end for Virginia Tech and started for the Hokies' 1995 Sugar Bowl Champion team. HCIII told the Bryan-College Station Eagle (Jan., 7, 2022), "Enter Sandman' is one of my favorite traditions. A&M football is fun, but Virginia Tech football is deep in my heart."
- Coleman transferred to Texas A&M from Duke prior to the 2021-22. Former Duke head coach Mike Krzyzewski said of HCIII: "I hope I'm around when he's stopped playing to see who he becomes, not just as a player. I just think he's going to be a very special guy in our country. He's that good." (Source: USA Today Network, Nov. 18, 2020)
- In SEC play, HCIII is averaging 2.4 offensive rebounds per game.

EARLY SIGNEE LINDSAY:

Texas A&M announced the addition of standout guard prospect Bryce Lindsay (Baltimore, Md.), who will join the Aggies for the 2023-24 season.

- Associate Head Coach Devin Johnson said, "We are thrilled to add Bryce Lindsay to our program. His toughness, shot-making ability and high IQ are going to fit well here in Aggieland. Bryce will continue to help Coach Buzz (Williams) build something special here at Texas A&M!"
- The 6-foot-4 Lindsay, who is playing a post-graduate season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Fla., averaged 19.6 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists for St. Frances Academy (Md.) in 2021-22 while leading the Panthers to a 35-6 record. He was coached by Nick Myles at St. Frances. Rated a four-star prospect by Rivals.com, Lindsay chose Texas A&M over Villanova, West Virginia and South Carolina.

RANDOM NOTABLES:

Dexter Dennis' 16 rebounds vs. Florida on 1/18 were the most by an Aggie vs. a SEC opponent since Robert Williams had 16 vs. Missouri on 2/8/2017. Interestingly, Texas A&M Radio Network analyst John Thornton had 17 rebounds against Baylor on 2/14/1974.



- Easily the Aggies' most prolific shooter from deep, Wade Taylor IV has improved his 3-point % significantly from last year. Taylor is hitting 34.9% in 2022-23 after making 27.8% as a freshman.
- The Aggies' starting lineup has a definite Pelican State flavor with at least two Louisiana natives in it for every game so far this season - Tyrece Radford (Baton Rouge) and Dexter Dennis (Baker).
- The Aggies have used the same starting lineup (Coleman III, Dennis, Marble, Radford and Taylor IV) for the last 10 games. For the season, the fivesome is 10-2 with losses to Boise State and Kentucky.
- The defensive-minded duo of Andersson Garcia and Andre Gordon have been the first players off the bench either individually or as a pair for the last nine games.
- The Aggies' 2022-23 roster was bolstered by the addition of six newcomers in the offseason -- five transfers and one scholarship freshman. Headlining the group was **Dexter Dennis**, who was the American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year at Wichita State in 2021-22, and **Julius Marble**, who helped Michigan State advance to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Both have earned spots in the starting five.







BUZZ WILLIAMS AT A GLANCE


- Buzz Williams is in his fourth season as the head coach at Texas A&M and his 16th year as a collegiate head coach.
- Prior to being named head coach of the Aggies on April 3, 2019, Williams served as head coach at Virginia Tech (5 years, 2014-19), Marquette (6 years, 2008-14) and New Orleans (1 year, 2006-07).
- He received the nickname "Buzz" while working as an energetic student assistant for longtime Navarro Junior College coach and mentor Lewis Orr. Brent Langdon Williams or "Buzz" was inducted into the Navarro College Bulldog Hall of Fame in

(population 4,369), which is located 50 miles north of the Cotton Bowl in Dallas, Texas. Van Alstyne is pronounced Van ALLsteen. This is Williams' second stint at Texas A&M - he also served as assistant

Williams was born in Greenville, Texas and grew up in the small Texas town of Van Alstyne

As part of "Buzz's Bunch," the Williams family endowed a scholarship at Virginia Tech, which is awarded annually to a Virginia Tech student with a disability. Additionally, Williams' wife, Corey, helped endow a scholarship -- The Buzz and Corev Williams Family Student-Athlete Scholarship -which is awarded to a female student-athlete.


Williams was named the Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year in 2019-20

He guided the Aggies to first-ever appearance in the NIT championship game in 2021-22

He has eight NCAA Tournament appearances in 14 postseason opportunities as a head coach, including four career Sweet 16 appearances (3 at Marquette, 1 at Virginia Tech) and one Elite Eight appearance (2013 Marquette)

Williams guided Virginia Tech to the NCAA Tournament three straight seasons from 2017-19

He has won 20-or-more games in 10 of his 15 seasons as a head coach.





MOLDING YOUNG MINDS:

Buzz Williams presented a trio of lectures to the SOMS (School of Military Science) 380: Workshop in Leadership Education class this fall semester in a collaboration with Texas A&M's Corps of Cadets and the Hollingsworth Center for Ethical Leadership.

- Dr. Dave Keller, Director of the Hollingsworth Center, said, "The
 Hollingsworth Center works primarily with students who are not
 going into the military upon graduation, although we certainly have
 several that do. Our SOMS [School of Military Science] program of
 study begins during the spring semester of their sophomore year,
 where we focus on helping cadets find their strengths and lead from
 a perspective of authenticity.
- Keller added, "SOMS 380 is the second course for our students. It
 focuses heavily on finding their leadership constraints and blind
 spots, and then developing an action plan to intentionally improve
 in these critical areas. In later semesters, students learn more
 about the science of leadership, along with how to lead teams and
 organizations more effectively."
- Dr. Darin Paine, Associate Director for the Hollingsworth Center, said, "Whenever cadets can learn from a presenter such as Coach Buzz Williams, there are many opportunities for personal and professional gain. It could reinforce what they are already learning in SOMS, or present a new concept, or allow them to hear something that applies to their life right now. There are countless opportunities to benefit from an experience like this. Coach Williams is a high achiever, lifelong learner, and very enthusiastic about teaching. He has so much to offer and we are thrilled with this partnership."
- One of the class attendees, sophomore Luke White, told the Bryan-College Station Eagle: "I think it's really cool that he's doing this. He's going beyond being just a coach. He's really trying to connect with us as students."




