## FLORIDA ON DECK

No. 17 Arkansas (22-8) and No. 10 Florida (22-5) meet in Fayetteville March 24-26 for a three-game series at Bogle Park. Friday's series opener is set for 6 p.m. CT on SEC Network+. Saturday's first pitch is set for 8 p.m. on ESPN2.

## RAZORBACK NOTABLES

### Last Time Out

The Razorbacks made history this past weekend as they secured their first series victory vs. Alabama in Tuscaloosa. After falling 2-0 in Saturday's series opener, the Hogs bounced back with a 5-3 decision Sunday evening. In Monday night's rubber match, Arkansas outlasted Alabama, 2-1 (10 inn.), in an epic marquee matchup. Arkansas handed the Crimson Tide their first SEC home series loss since April 16-18, 2021.

### The Series

Arkansas and Florida meet for the 66th time on Friday. The two teams square off in Bogle Park for the first time since the 2017 season. Arkansas is seeking its first WIN vs. Florida in Bogle Park, which opened for the 2008 season. The Hogs are also chasing their second consecutive series win vs. Florida. In 2022, Arkansas swept Florida for the first time in history. Last year's series sweep in Gainesville also marked the first three-game series Arkansas had won vs. Florida. Familiar with one another, the Razorbacks went 4-0 against the Gators last season. After the Hogs swept Florida on April 22-24, 2022, Arkansas downed Florida again, 4-1, in the SEC tournament semifinals on May 13, 2022. With the win against Florida at the SEC Tournament in 2022, Arkansas advanced to the SEC Tournament Championship game for the second time in history. Arkansas went on to win the program's first-ever SEC Tournament title.

### First Time for Everything

The series also dates back to the 1997 season - SEC softball's inaugural season. On March 5, 1997, Arkansas and Florida made history by participating in the FIRST SEC softball game. Arkansas vs. Florida delivered the first pitch, first hit, first extra-base hit, first run, first RBI, first stolen base and first win in an SEC softball game. Florida won, 2-1, in nine innings. It was also the first extra-inning SEC game - the game lasted two hours and 20 minutes (5:01 p.m. CT first pitch) and 713 people were in attendance.

### HAWWWWWWWWWgs on the Road

The Hogs have won their last nine SEC road series - their last SEC road series loss was at Alabama on March 6-8, 2020. The Razorbacks have won 10 of their last 11 SEC series, dating back to the 2021 season. Arkansas won all eight series in 2022 before their streak was snapped vs. Texas A&M on March 12. Additionally, seven of Arkansas' last nine conference road series victories have come against top-25 teams, including two top-10 decisions.

## SEC Week 3: Florida

### Robyn Is HER

Freshman LHP Robyn Herron leads all SEC freshmen pitchers and ranks sixth in the conference in strikeouts with 84 on the season.

The Tampa product earned her third career double-digit strikeout performance after fanning 12 against Iowa State on March 2 at the Woo Pig Classic. Herron is the first Razorback freshman pitcher since Mary Haff in 2018 to throw multiple complete-game shutouts and amass multiple double-digit strikeout performances.

In a five-inning run-rule win over Texas A&M-CC on March 4, Herron threw her second straight one-hitter to earn the victory. Herron went 4.1 innings and amassed 11 strikeouts before giving up TAMU's one hit in the top of the fifth. Herron fanned 11 in 4.1 innings, posting her fourth double-digit strikeout game of the season which leads Arkansas' staff. Herron tossed three innings of shutout ball against North Texas (March 5), struck out three and worked around two walks and a hit.

### Don't Run on LoCam

Freshman catcher Lauren Camenzind ties for second in the SEC in runners caught stealing by, throwing out four would-be base stealers. Camenzind has caught the last 18 games after assuming starting catcher duties against Arizona on Feb. 24. Camenzind also holds a 1.000 fielding percentage.

### Walk It Out

Arkansas ranks ninth in the nation and fourth in the SEC in walks drawn after registering 117 in 30 games. The Hogs hold a 11-0 record when they draw 5 or more walks in a game. Arkansas was issued a season high 10 walks against UNLV on Feb. 10.

### Arkansas Picked to Finish 3rd in SEC

The back-to-back defending Southeastern Conference champion Arkansas Razorbacks have been picked to finish third in the league this season by conference's coaches. It's the second straight year the Hogs have been predicted to finish third in the SEC. Head Coach Courtney Deifel and the No. 6 Razorbacks received five first-place votes and 122 points overall in the poll finishing behind preseason favorite No. 5 Florida - five-first place votes, 134 total points - and No. 12 Tennessee, three first-place votes, 126 total points.

Points were compiled on a descending basis. Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.

### She's Just a Freshman

Freshman LHP Robyn Herron ranks fifth nationally (second among all freshmen) and second (first among all freshmen) in the SEC in strikeouts per seven innings (11.6). In 50.2 innings, Herron has struck out 84 batters. Herron is the first Razorback freshman pitcher to amass multiple shutouts and double-digit strikeout performances since Mary Haff in 2018.

### Leading Things Off

Freshman phenom Reagan Johnson has quickly emerged as a star in college softball. Through 30 games, Johnson sports a .352 batting average with a .400 on-base percentage and .410 slugging percentage. Johnson ranks third in the SEC and leads all conference freshmen in hits in hits with 37. On a national scale, Johnson's 37 hits are the sixth-most among all freshmen. Johnson has stole the most bases by an SEC freshman this season (12-for-12) and the fifth-most overall in the league. Dating back to Arkansas' Feb. 26 win against Drake, Johnson recorded a hit in EIGHT consecutive plate appearances (Feb. 26 vs. Drake, March 2 vs. Iowa State, March 3 vs. TAMU-CC and North Texas). Going 4-for-4 vs. Iowa State on March 2, Johnson became the first Hog to record four hits in a game since KB Sides did vs. Lehigh on March 11, 2022.

### 15 Games Slated for National TV

The Razorbacks will appear on ESPN's family of networks 15 times during the regular season this spring in addition to having games available on SEC Network+. All of Arkansas' home games that will not be broadcast on ESPN's family of networks are scheduled to be available on SEC Network+, starting March 5. Arkansas' Feb. 23 doubleheader against Arizona will be available on SEC Network+. During the Woo Pig Classic (March 2-5), all Arkansas games will be available on SEC Network+ EXCEPT the March 4 games. Arkansas will make its linear debut on Feb. 17 at noon against No. 7 Florida State on ESPNU.

### Rylin's Big Bat

Redshirt junior Rylin Hedgecock has quickly blossomed into a star. Hedgecock sits fourth nationally and second in the SEC in home runs with 12 so far this season, including a five-home run weekend performance at the Woo Pig Classic on March 2-5. Hedgecock ranks fifth nationally in home runs per game (0.40). Hedgecock has driven in the 10th-most runs in the country this season, putting up 34 RBIs. Through 30 games, Hedgecock paces Arkansas in home runs (12), RBIs (34), total bases (72) and slugging percentage (.857). Hedgecock has also powered two go-ahead home runs this season against ranked teams: on Feb. 24 vs. #19 Arizona (solo home run in the sixth) and March 20 vs. #13 Alabama (solo home run in the 10th).

### Delce Deals

Chenise Delce went the distance in Arkansas' 2-1 (10 inn.) win vs. Alabama Monday night. Delce tossed a career high 10 innings and 172 pitches to march Arkansas to a series-clinching victory. Redshirt senior RHP Chenise Delce hauled in weekly honors following her sensational performance at the Razorback Invitational on Feb. 23-26. Delce was named Wilson/NFCA's National Pitcher of the Week and the SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 28 after spinning to a 4-0 weekend that included two ranked wins. Acquiring a .076 ERA, Delce surrendered just two runs across 18.1 innings pitched and also checked opponents to a .127 batting average with 25 strikeouts. Five of Delce's nine wins have come against opponents currently ranked inside ESPN.com/USA Softball's Top 25 (Arizona twice, Baylor, Louisiana, Texas A&M).

### Wins By The Numbers

Arkansas is 20-2 when it scores three or more runs this season.

### Rookie Razorbacks

The Razorbacks boast one of the youngest lineups in the country this season. Freshmen Reagan Johnson and Lauren Camenzind are staples in Deifel's lineup while Atalyia Rijo has also started 23 games at short this season. On Sunday vs. Alabama, seven of Arkansas' starters were all underclassmen: Robyn Herron (freshman - LHP), Lauren Camenzind (freshman - catcher), Atalyia Rijo (freshman - short), Rylee Cloud (freshman - second), Raigan Kramer (sophomore - left field), Reagan Johnson (freshman - center) and Kacie Hoffmann (sophomore - right field). Three arms in Arkansas' pitching staff are also freshmen: LHP Robyn Herron, LHP Hannah Camenzind and RHP Nikki McGaffin.

### Deifel Becomes Program's All-Time Wins Leader

Head coach Courtney Deifel became the program's all-time wins leader on Saturday, Feb. 18 when Arkansas defeated No. 22 Louisiana 7-6. Deifel bested former Razorback head coach Carrie Dever-Boaz's (1997-2004) 244 career wins at helm.

### All Eyes on the Razorbacks

It comes to no surprise that Bogle Park is regarded as one of the premier college softball stadiums and atmospheres in the nation as it hosted the highest attended Regional and Super Regional in the NCAA in 2022. Arkansas finished the 2022 season third in cumulative attendance (66,247) and fourth in average attendance (1,948) at home. Nine of the 10 highest attended games in Bogle Park history were played in 2022. Bogle Park also sold out nine times in 2022. The 2022 Fayetteville Super Regional matchup between Arkansas and Texas at Bogle Park was the most-viewed NCAA Regional or Super Regional on record across ESPN networks and averaged 1.02 million viewers and a 0.53 rating. March 4's number of 2,929 at the Woo Pig Classic is the 10th largest attendance in program history. Arkansas ranks second in the nation in attendance this season (43,447).

Arkansas' 109 homers also tie for the second-most by an SEC team in a single season while also being the most by a league team since 2011. 12 different Razorbacks homered, led by NFCA First Team All-Americans Linnie Malkin (22), Danielle Gibson (20) and Hannah Gammill (18). Arkansas has homered 34 times in six weeks into the 2023 campaign.

- The Hogs are a consensus Top 20 team five weeks into the season, checking in at No. 12 in the USA Today/NFCA poll and No. 17 in ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25. Arkansas sits at No. 17 in DISoftball, No. 11 in Extra Inning Softball and No. 16 in Softball America's polls, respectively.

**Strike 'Em Out**

Behind the arms of Robyn Herron (14), Chenise Delce (2), Hannah Camenzind (2) and Nikki McGaffin (1), Arkansas posted the third-most single-game strikeouts in DI softball this season after ringing up 19 batters vs. Drake on Feb. 24. Arkansas trails Illinois' 21 strikeouts vs. Fordham on Feb. 11 and Utah State's 20 punchouts vs. Cal State Bakersfield on Feb. 11.

**Delce Back for 2023**

SEC Pitcher of the Year Chenise Delce is back for her final collegiate season, pitching to a 19-3 record with three saves and a team-best 2.12 ERA over 151.2 innings pitched. She struck out 188 hitters compared to just 35 walks issued. Putting together one of the most decorated seasons ever by a Razorback spinner and earning the program's second straight SEC Pitcher of the Year accolade, Delce collected an abundance of honors, including NFCA Second Team All-American, SEC Tournament MVP, All-SEC First Team, NFCA All-South Region First Team, Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week and Softball America Third Team All-American. The righthander notched 11 wins and two saves against opponents ranked inside ESPN.com/USA Softball's Top 25. Her 8.70 strikeouts per 7.0/IP rank second in single-season program history.

**Delce, Gammill Named Preseason All-SEC**

Redshirt senior Chenise Delce and junior Hannah Gammill have been named preseason All-SEC by the league's coaches. The duo has also been selected to preseason All-America teams by Softball America (Gammill - First Team, Delce - Second Team). Delce is coming off a stellar 2022 season earning SEC Pitcher of the Year along with NFCA Second Team All-America and All-SEC honors. She became the second consecutive Arkansas pitcher to capture SEC Pitcher of the Year status. She went 19-3 last season with three saves and a team-best 2.12 ERA, 188 strikeouts, 14 complete games and five shutouts. Gammill slugged her way through the 2022 season, slashing .374/.781/.513 with 18 home runs and 51 RBIs to pick up NFCA First Team All-America honors, becoming the youngest Razorback in program history to be named a First Team All-American. She also added All-SEC First Team and SEC All-Defensive Team accolades to her sophomore campaign that helped Arkansas to its second straight Southeastern Conference title in 2022.

**The Portal Delivers**

Arkansas dipped into the transfer portal this offseason and came away with three athletes who are expected to contribute this season: Kristina Foreman, Cylie Halvorson and Tymber Riley.

- Graduate infielder Kristina Foreman joins the Razorbacks from Duke. Foreman was a staple in the Blue Devil's lineup over the last four years, starting 165 games in her career. An All-ACC selection in 2022, she started all 48 games she played in and hit .398 with 15 home runs and a Duke single-season program record 56 RBIs. The Tampa product had one of the best games of
- Junior infielder Cylie Halvorson joins the Hogs from South Dakota State where she was named Summit League Player of the Year in 2021 after averaging .352 at the plate and shattering the school's home run record with 19. In 2022, Halvorson started 54 games while hitting .311 with 19 home runs, 55 hits, 46 RBIs and 40 runs scored.
- Graduate utility Tymber Riley, an Arkansas native, joins the Razorbacks from DII Arkansas Tech where she was one of the best players in program history. Riley, who also participated in volleyball at Arkansas Tech, was named GAC Female Athlete of the Year and GAC Player of the Year in softball in 2022. Riley led the GAC conference in batting average (.432), on-base percentage (.529), slugging percentage (.840), home runs (15), hits (73), runs scored (58), doubles (22) and total bases (142).
- Coach Deifel has made splashes in the portal over recent years. Notable transfers Deifel has picked up include Chenise Delce, Callie Turner, Danielle Gibson, KB Sides, Taylor Ellsworth and Braxton Burnside.

**An All-American Duo**

Arkansas is one of three DI softball programs to return multiple 2022 NFCA All-Americans. Hannah Gammill was named an NFCA First Team All-American and Chenise Delce was tabbed a Second Team All-American after sensational 2022 campaigns.

**Homegrown Hogs**

Arkansas' 2023 roster features seven Arkansans - the most of any state. Madi Conklin (Ft. Smith), Hannah Gammill (Beebe), Kaitlyn Howard (East End), Cally Kildow (Gravette), Chelsi Passage (Greenwood), Tymber Riley (Bentonville) and Ally Sockey (Greenwood) all hail from the Natural State.

**Deifel Era Continues**

Following a pair of historic seasons, including back-to-back Southeastern Conference (SEC) regular season championships and a 2022 SEC Softball Tournament title, Coach Courtney Deifel signed a new employment agreement in August that could keep her in the third base coaching box at Bogle Park through 2030.

**Field of the Year**

Bogle Park, home of the Arkansas Razorback softball team, was recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) as the 2022 Netting Professionals/NFCA DI Field of the Year in October. The playing surface is tended by a crew led by Austin Freeman.

**Back-to-Back Coach of the Year**

Back-to-back SEC Coach of the Year Courtney Deifel returns for her eighth season at the helm. In seven seasons in Fayetteville, Deifel has orchestrated the Razorbacks' return to postseason play and guided the program to two SEC regular season championships, one SEC Tournament MVP and five NCAA Tournament appearances, which includes five consecutive berths from 2017-22. The Hogs have qualified for the national tournament every year it has been held since 2017. Deifel led the program to its first NCAA Tournament Super Regional appearances in 2018, 2021 and 2022. Since her first season in 2016, the Razorbacks have been ranked 71 times in the NFCA Coaches' Poll after being previously ranked only once in program history. Nine of the program's 10 NFCA All-American nods and 78 Easton/NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete awards have been accumulated under Deifel.

**Just a Kid from Beebe**

Hailing from Beebe, Ark., First Team All-American Hannah Gammill returns to Razorback lineup for her junior season in 2023. Gammill became the Young Hog in program history to garner NFCA First Team All-American honors after doing so in 2022. Gammill started all 59 games at third and slashed .374/.781/.513 with 18 homers, 58 hits, 51 RBIs and 50 runs, which also earned her spots on the All-SEC First Team and All-SEC Defensive Team. Gammill ranked seventh in the SEC and third on the team in home runs with 18, which ties for fourth-most in single-season program history. A rock at the hot corner, Gammill compiled a .964 fielding percentage on 140 total chances and committed just one error during SEC play. Gammill's .781 slugging percentage ranks fourth in Arkansas' single-season history while her .513 on-base percentage ranks fifth in single-season program history. Her 51 RBIs tied for sixth-most in single-season program history while her 121 total bases ranked seventh in single-season program history. The slugger posted 15 multi-hit games, including four games with three hits, and registered 16 games with multiple RBIs. In addition, Gammill was hit by pitches a program-record 20 times last season.

**Razor-Back-to-Back**

- Winning the SEC regular season crown in 2021 and 2022, Arkansas added the program's first tournament title in 2022 after downing the Missouri Tigers, 4-0, in Gainesville, Fla. The Razorbacks were the only power five program last season to win their conference's regular season and tournament championships.
- Arkansas is one of four SEC program's to win back-to-back regular season crowns, joining Alabama, Florida and LSU. After winning the league's regular season in 2021, Arkansas became the first team not named Florida or Alabama to win the conference's regular season title since Tennessee did in 2007.
- The Hogs posted a 2022 48-11 overall record, recording the most single-season wins in program history.
- In the 2022 NCAA Tournament, Arkansas achieved the program's highest overall seed (No. 4) and swept the Fayetteville Regional before hosting the program's second consecutive Super Regional and garnering the program's first victory in Super Regionals while taking down the Texas Longhorns, 7-1, in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional.
