HOGS PLACE 10th AT SEC ... AGAIN ... WHICH ISN'T BAD (NECESSARILY)

- Arkansas had its share of struggles in 2023 and needed to post a top 10 finish at the SEC Championship to satisfy the NCAA's .500 Rule. Well, Arkansas did just that, placing 10th to finish the year with a 60-59-2 record.
- Even though Arkansas finished 10th, the Razorbacks' 54-hole total of 843 is the program's third-best score at the Championship. Other positives included:
 - Arkansas led the field by playing the par 5's at 10-under (4.67 avg.).
 - Arkansas' 192 pars tied for second-best in the field.
 - Mateo Fernandez de Oliveira led the field with 43 pars.f
- Arkansas finished 10th in last year's SEC Championship as well. However, the Razorbacks placed fourth in the NCAA Regional and went on to finish 9th at the NCAA Championship.

PERICO POSTED 2ND SEC TOP 10; TAKES TEAM SCORING LEAD

- Julian Perico shot 68-72-66 to tie for 6th at the 2023 SEC Championship. In fact, he jumped 21 spots on the final day thanks to his 66.
- Perico shot 66 in his first-ever round at the SEC Championship (2019) and shot 66 in his final round (2023).
- He placed among the SEC top 10 twice. First, thanks to 66 start in 2019, Perico finished 8th at the 2019 SEC's and, thanks to his final 66, tied for 6th in 2023.
- With his performance at the SEC Championship, Perico regained the team scoring lead at 70.94 with previous leader Mateo Fernandez de Oliveira dropping to 71.10.
- Perico also leads the tea, with four top-10 finishes, nine rounds in the 60's and 19 rounds at par or better.

A PERFECT MATCH ... WELL ALMOST PERFECT

- In addition to its success in match-play competition versus SEC competition, the Razorbacks have thrived in other match play situations.
- Arkansas is 3-0 in match play this season, posting a combined 14-1-0 record.
 - Beat Kentucky 5-0-0 in the SEC Fall Match Play
 - Beat Missouri 5-0-0 in the Blessings Medal Match 1
 - Beat Central Arkansas 4-1-0 in the Blessing Medal Match 2
- Arkansas won the 2021 SEC FALL MATCH PLAY
 - Beat Mississippi State 3-2
 - Beat Ole Miss 3-1-1
 - Beat LSU 3-2
 - Beat Vanderbilt 3-2
- In the 2022 SEC Fall Match Play, the format was different and Arkansas finished 12th of 14 in the stroke play but swept Kentucky, 5-0-0, in the one round of match play.

MATEO WINS LAAC; MAKES MASTERS AND PGA TOUR DEBUTS

- After a runner-up finish at the 2022 Latin America Amateur Championship, Mateo Fernandez de Oliveira bounced back to a dominant win at the 2023 LAAC.
- With the win, Fernandez de Oliveira earned an exemption to the 2023 Masters and he will play in the 2023 Open Championship and 2023 U.S. Open. He additionally received an invitation to play on the PGA TOUR April 27 at the Mexico Open at Vidanta.
- He shattered the LAAC scoring record as he fired rounds of 68-67-63-67 for a record score of 265 (-23). The previous low 72-hole total was 273 (-13) in 2018 and the previous low score in relation to par was -14 (274) in 2019.
- At the 2023 Masters, Fernandez de Oliveira missed the cut shooting 76-75 (+7).
- At the Mexico Open at Vidanta, he shot 71-71 (E) but missed the cut.
