Top-25 Hogs

- Under head coach Courtney Deifel, the Hogs have been ranked 83 times in the USA Today/NFCA Poll. Prior to her tenure, Arkansas was ranked just one time in program history (2013).
- The Hogs have been ranked in the USA Today/NFCA Poll in 77 of its last 78 releases, dating back to week seven of the 2018 campaign.
- Arkansas has received a vote in the last 96 releases of the USA Today/NFCA Poll, the longest streak in program history.
- The Razorbacks Week 1 rankings (No. 4) during the 2023 season match the highest in-season rankings in program history.

Another Milestone for Deifel

- Head coach Courtney Deifel hit 300 career wins on April 24.
- Deifel has 303 career wins.
- Deifel became the program's all-time wins leader on Saturday, Feb. 18, when Arkansas defeated No. 22 Louisiana, 7-6. Deifel bested former Razorback skipper Carrie Dever-Boaz's (1997-2004) 244 career wins at helm.

Postseason History

- Arkansas is making its 12th NCAA Tournament Appearance. It's the sixth appearance under head coach Courtney Deifel.
- Arkansas has made six consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances - every season it has been held since 2017.
- Prior to Deifel's arrival, the program had made just six NCAA Tournament appearances.
- For the fourth time in history, Arkansas is hosting a regional.
- All four of the program's top-16 overall seeds have come under Deifel: 2018 (#13), 2021 (#6), 2022 (#4) and 2023 (#11).
- The Hogs drew a top-16 seed for the third season in a row.
- 16 of 25 Razorbacks have played in an NCAA Tournament.

Matchup History

- Arkansas and Harvard meet for just the second time in history and the first since the 2014 season. In their lone matchup, the Razorbacks defeated the Crimson 9-4 in Fort Myers, Fla., on Feb. 23, 2014.
- The Razorbacks are 5-3 all-time vs. the Oregon Ducks, winning the last two matchups. Arkansas took down the Ducks, 6-2 & 9-3, in the 2022 Fayetteville Regional.
- Arkansas head coach Courtney Deifel and Oregon head coach Melyssa Lombardi are quite familiar with one another, having worked with each other at the University of Oklahoma. Deifel was a graduate assistant at Oklahoma in 2008-09 while Lombardi was serving as associate head coach.
- It'll be the third time Deifel and Lombardi face each other while at the helm of their respective schools.
- Arkansas and Notre Dame are 3-3 vs. one another. It'll be the first time since 2017 the two teams square off against each other.

Rooo Pig Sooi

Redshirt junior Rylin "Roo" Hedgecock is blasting her way into the Arkansas record books. Ranking second in the SEC and sixth nationally in home runs with 20, Hedgecock is closing in on Arkansas history as well. Her 20 homers tie for third-most in single-season program history. Her 58 RBI are the third-most in single-season program history.

20-Fun

Rylin Hedgecock is one of four Razorbacks to hit 20+ home runs in a single season, joining Braxton Burnside (25 HR in 2021), Linnie Malkin (22 HR in 2022) and Danielle Gibson (20 HR in 2022).

She's Just a Freshman

- Freshman LHP Robyn Herron ranks second in the conference (leads all SEC freshmen pitchers) and eighth nationally in strikeouts per seven innings, averaging 10.3.
- Herron is the first Razorback freshman pitcher since Mary Haff in 2018 to throw multiple complete-game shutouts and amass multiple double-digit strikeout performances.

Road HaWWWWWWWWWWWgS

It's hard to win on the road in the SEC. Under skipper Courtney Deifel, Arkansas has found a formula that resulted in 11 consecutive SEC road series wins. Arkansas dropped its first SEC road series since 2020 against Missouri.

Planting (National) Seeds

Prior to Deifel's arrival, the Arkansas Razorback softball program NEVER received a national seed at an NCAA Tournament. Since her inaugural season in 2016, the Deifel and Hogs have constructed four national seeds - No. 13 in 2018, No. 6 in 2021, No. 4 in 2022 and No. 11 in 2023.

Additionally, Deifel and the Hogs have made the NCAA Tournament every year it has been held since 2017. Prior to Deifel taking helm in Fayetteville, the program had only made six NCAA appearances. Deifel currently has six at Arkansas.

The Standard

Arkansas is the only SEC team to record a top-four conference finish in each of the last three seasons. Arkansas won the SEC in 2021 and 2022 and finished fourth this season.

Leading Things Off

Freshman center fielder Reagan Johnson was named a top-25 finalist for Tucci/NFCA National

Freshman of the Year on April 28. Johnson is one of four SEC freshmen selected to the prestigious list. Johnson was also selected as Second Team All-SEC last week.

- Johnson ranks second in the SEC in hits with 73. Johnson paces all SEC freshmen in base knocks as well.
- On a national scale, Johnson's 73 hits rank second amongst freshmen and 15th overall.
- The Karnes City, Texas, native has been dynamic for the Razorbacks so far this season. Johnson was named SEC Freshman of the Week on April 25 after leading Arkansas to a 4-1 week that included a road series win at No. 20 Kentucky.
- Electrifying at the leadoff position, Johnson sports a team-leading .374 batting aver-

age and paces the Hogs in hits (73), runs scored (43), stolen bases (17) and triples (4). Johnson also boasts a .411 on-base percentage with 20 RBI.

- Helping Arkansas capture a doubleheader sweep for a series win vs. Kentucky to earn SEC Freshman of the Week, Johnson went 7-for-9 with three runs scored and two RBI. Johnson recorded a base hit in six straight plate appearances before lining out to short in game two.
- Johnson ties for the third-most single-season hits in program history.
- Johnson leads Arkansas with 22 multi-hit outings this season. She's the first Razorback freshman to be named an NFCA Freshman of the Year finalist since Mary Haff in 2018. With four triples this season, Johnson is one triple shy from tying the program's single-season record of five.

Rylin's Big Bat

Redshirt junior Rylin Hedgecock has quickly blossomed into a star.

- Hedgecock sits second in the conference and sixth nationally in home runs with 20.
- Hedgecock slugged a career high three home runs vs. Kentucky in game two last on April 22. She also matched her career high in RBI with seven.
- Delivered a two-run home run in the series finale vs. Tennessee, helping Arkansas clinch a 2-0 rubber match win.
- Hedgecock homered in each of her first three plate appearances vs. Kentucky in game two.
- Hedgecock has three multi-home run games this season, including two vs. ranked SEC opponents (Florida & Kentucky).
- Her 57 RBI this season sits second in the conference and eighth nationally.
- She paces Arkansas in home runs (20), RBI (58), total bases (119), slugging percentage (.773) and on-base percentage (.451).

Home Sweet Home

It comes to no surprise that Bogle Park is regarded as one of the premier college softball stadiums and atmospheres in the nation as it hosted the highest attended Regional and Super Regional in the NCAA in 2022.

- Arkansas finished the 2022 season third in cumulative attendance (66,247) and fourth in average attendance (1,948) at home.
- The 2022 Fayetteville Super Regional matchup between Arkansas and Texas at Bogle Park was the most-viewed NCAA Regional or Super Regional on record across ESPN networks and averaged 1.02 million viewers and a 0.53 rating.
- This season, Arkansas ranks second in the nation in attendance (85,580) and second in average attendance (2,853).
- The Razorbacks set a weekend attendance record vs. Tennessee (9,595) this season.
- Nine of the program's top-10 attendance figures have happened in either 2022 or 2023.
- Each of the program's top-10 highest attended games have occurred during head coach Courtney Deifel's tenure.
- Bogle Park hosted the highest attended SEC Tournament last week: 16,937

The Standard

Arkansas is the only SEC team to record a top-four conference finish in each of the last three seasons. Arkansas won the SEC in 2021 and 2022 and finished fourth this season.

The Big 4-0

- Two wins at the Fayetteville Regional will give Arkansas 40 wins on the season. It would be the third straight season with 40+ wins for the Hogs.
- Under head coach Courtney Deifel, Arkansas currently has three 40-win seasons. Prior to Deifel, the program only had two 40-win seasons.

Bogle Bombers

Arkansas has blasted 35 home runs at Bogle Park compared to 13 by opponents this season (48 total between Arkansas and opponents).

#ProHogs

After being selected No. 9 overall in 2023 WPF Draft, Chenise Delce became the third Hog under head coach Courtney Deifel to be drafted by a professional softball league. In the past two seasons, three Razorbacks have been drafted. Two-time NFCA All-American Danielle Gibson was picked in the 2022 Athlete's Unlimited Draft last spring. Former Hog Taylor Ellsworth was selected in the 2022 WPF Draft by the USSSA Pride. Ellsworth also plays professionally in Japan with Shokki Softball.

Against Ranked Foes

Arkansas is 12-10 against ranked competition. The Razorbacks are 7-5 at home vs. ranked foes.

Top Hogs

- The Hogs are a consensus top-15 team, checking in at No. 13 in the USA Today/NFCA poll and No. 13 in ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25.

All Roads Lead Home for Delce

Redshirt senior RHP Chenise Delce was picked No. 9 overall in the 2023 Women's Professional Fastpitch (WPF) draft by the Oklahoma City Spark on April 17 at The Yale Theatre in Oklahoma City. Delce was also selected in the Athletes Unlimited Draft on Monday night.

- The reigning SEC Pitcher of the Year was the first selection of the third round in the WPF Draft. Delce is the third Razorback in program history to be drafted to a professional softball league, joining former Hogs Taylor Ellsworth and Danielle Gibson. Ellsworth (USSSA Pride) is currently on a WPF roster. Gibson was selected in the Athlete's Unlimited draft last spring.
- This season, Delce has recorded a 1.86 ERA and 20-9 mark.
- Her 20 wins this season rank third in the conference.
- She ranks fourth in the SEC in strikeouts with 183.

6 Razorbacks Tabbed All-SEC

Arkansas garnered six All-Southeastern Conference selections, the league announced Friday. For the second straight year, redshirt senior RHP Chenise Delce was named First Team All-SEC while five others earned their first All-SEC honors. Fifth-year senior Kristina Foreman, redshirt junior Rylin Hedgecock, junior Cylie Halvorson and freshmen Hannah Camenzind and Reagan Johnson were all recognized as second-team honorees. Camenzind and Johnson are the first Razorback freshmen to claim all-conference honors since Mary Haff was named Second Team All-SEC in 2018.

The Portal Delivers

Arkansas dipped into the transfer portal this offseason and came away with three athletes who are expected to contribute this season: Kristina Foreman, Cylie Halvorson and Tymber Riley.

- Graduate infielder Kristina Foreman joins the Razorbacks from Duke. Foreman was a staple in the Blue Devil's lineup over the last four years, starting 165 games in her career. An All-ACC selection in 2022, she started all 48 games she played in and hit .398 with 15 home runs and a Duke single-season program record 56 RBIs. The Tampa product had one of the best games of
- Junior infielder Cylie Halvorson joins the Hogs from South Dakota State where she was named Summit League Player of the Year in 2021 after averaging .352 at the plate and shattering the school's home run record with 19. In 2022, Halvorson started 54 games while hitting .311 with 19 home runs, 55 hits, 46 RBIs and 40 runs scored.
- Graduate utility Tymber Riley, an Arkansas native, joins the Razorbacks from DII Arkansas Tech where she was one of the best players in program history. Riley, who also participated in volleyball at Arkansas Tech, was named GAC Female Athlete of the Year and GAC Player of the Year in softball in 2022. Riley led the GAC conference in batting average (.432), on-base percentage (.529), slugging percentage (.840), home runs (15), hits (73), runs scored (58), doubles (22) and total bases (142).
- Coach Deifel has made splashes in the portal over recent years. Notable transfers Deifel has picked up include Chenise Delce, Callie Turner, Danielle Gibson, KB Sides, Taylor Ellsworth and Braxton Burnside.

An All-American Duo

Arkansas is one of three DI softball programs to return multiple 2022 NFCA All-Americans. Hannah Gammill was named an NFCA First Team All-American and Chenise Delce was tabbed a Second Team All-American after sensational 2022 campaigns.

Homegrown Hogs

Arkansas' 2023 roster features seven Arkansans - the most of any state. Madi Conklin (Ft. Smith), Hannah Gammill (Beebe), Kaitlyn Howard (East End), Cally Kildow (Gravette), Chelsi Possage (Greenwood), Tymber Riley (Bentonville) and Ally Sockey (Greenwood) all hail from the Natural State.

Deifel Era Continues

Following a pair of historic seasons, including back-to-back Southeastern Conference (SEC) regular season championships and a 2022 SEC Softball Tournament title, Coach Courtney Deifel signed a new employment agreement in August that could keep her in the third base coaching box at Bogle Park through 2030.

Field of the Year

Bogle Park, home of the Arkansas Razorback softball team, was recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) as the 2022 Netting Professionals/NFCA DI Field of the Year in October. The playing surface is tended by a crew led by Austin Freeman.



Back-to-Back Coach of the Year

Back-to-back SEC Coach of the Year Courtney Deifel returns for her eighth season at the helm. In seven seasons in Fayetteville, Deifel has orchestrated the Razorbacks' return to postseason play and guided the program to two SEC regular season championships, one SEC Tournament crown and five NCAA Tournament appearances, which includes five consecutive berths from 2017-22. The Hogs have qualified for the national tournament every year it has been held since 2017. Deifel led the program to its first NCAA Tournament Super Regional appearances in 2018, 2021 and 2022. Since her first season in 2016, the Razorbacks have been ranked 71 times in the NFCA Coaches' Poll after being previously ranked only once in program history. Nine of the program's 10 NFCA All-American nods and 78 Easton/NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete awards have been accumulated under Deifel.

Just a Kid from Beebe

Hailing from Beebe, Ark., First Team All-American Hannah Gammill returns to Razorback lineup for her junior season in 2023. Gammill became the Young Hog in program history to garner NFCA First Team All-American honors after doing so in 2022. Gammill started all 59 games at third and slashed .374/.781/.513 with 18 homers, 58 hits, 51 RBIs and 50 runs, which also earned her spots on the All-SEC First Team and All-SEC Defensive Team. Gammill ranked seventh in the SEC and third on the team in home runs with 18, which ties for fourth-most in single-season program history. A rock at the hot corner, Gammill compiled a .964 fielding percentage on 140 total chances and committed just one error during SEC play. Gammill's .781 slugging percentage ranks fourth in Arkansas' single-season history while her .513 on-base percentage ranks fifth in single-season program history. Her 51 RBIs tied for sixth-most in single-season program history while her 121 total bases ranked seventh in single-season program history. The slugger posted 15 multi-hit games, including four games with three hits, and registered 16 games with multiple RBIs. In addition, Gammill was hit by pitches a program-record 20 times last season.

Razor-Back-to-Back

- Winning the SEC regular season crown in 2021 and 2022, Arkansas added the program's first tournament title in 2022 after downing the Missouri Tigers, 4-0, in Gainesville, Fla. The Razorbacks were the only power five program last season to win their conference's regular season and tournament championships.
- Arkansas is one of four SEC program's to win back-to-back regular season crowns, joining Alabama, Florida and LSU. After winning the league's regular season in 2021, Arkansas became the first team not named Florida or Alabama to win the conference's regular season title since Tennessee did in 2007.
- The Hogs posted a 2022 48-11 overall record, recording the most single-season wins in program history.
- In the 2022 NCAA Tournament, Arkansas achieved the program's highest overall seed (No. 4) and swept the Fayetteville Regional before hosting the program's second consecutive Super Regional and garnering the program's first victory in Super Regionals while taking down the Texas Longhorns, 7-1, in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional.
