MUSSELMAN AT A GLANCE

- Was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has 31 years of coaching experience including eight years as a collegiate head coach and 14 as a professional head coach.
- **In his first eight years as a collegiate head coach, has won at least 20 games each season (24, 28, 29, 20, 25, 28 and 22), advanced to all seven postseasons played (including six straight NCAA tournaments) and reached four NCAA Sweet 16's**, including a Elite 8 appearances with the Hogs in both 2021 and '22.
- At Arkansas, produced four "one-and-dones," three first-round draft picks - including two lottery picks, and six NBA draft picks. Overall, had at least one player drafted in five years straight: **Cody Martin** (2nd Rd, pick 36); **Isaiah Joe** (2nd Rd, pick 49); **Moses Moody** (1st Rd, pick 14); **Jaylin Williams** (2nd Rd, pick 34); **Anthony Black** (1st Rd, pick 6); **Nick Smith Jr.** (1st Rd, pick 27) and **Jordan Walsh** (2nd Rd, pick 38). Also, free agents **Caleb Martin**, **Mason Jones** and **Stanley Umude** have made NBA rosters.
- Defeated AP #1 Auburn on Gonzaga in 2022 and #1 NCAA seed Kansas n 2023.
- Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined pro winning percentage of .626 (553-330).
- Played collegiately at the University of San Diego and helped the Toreros to NCAA Tournament berths in 1984 and 1987. He was recipient of the program's Bugelli Leadership Award as a senior.
- Is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman, who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Has two sons, Michael and Matthew, and he and Danyelle have a daughter, Mariah.
- Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

MUSSELMAN DID YOU KNOWS

- Named General Manager of CBA's Rapid City Thrillers at age of 22. The next year, became head coach of the Thrillers at he age of 23, the youngest coach in CBA history.
- From 1990-1997, had 26 players called up to the NBA, the highest number in the league during that span.
- Is the only person in CBA history to coach in five league All-Star Games (1990, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1997)
- The first coach in professional basketball history to win 100 games by the age of 28.
- At the age of 37, named head coach of the Golden State Warriors and was the youngest head coach ever hired by an NBA team at the time.
- He and his father, Bill, were first father-son combination to both become head coaches in NBA history.
- In 2003, was runner-up to Gregg Popovich for NBA Coach of the Year Award voting (231 points, including 26 first-place votes).
- Is the CBA's third all-time winningest coach (270-122 in seven seasons) and the most successful coach (54-3 in two seasons) in the history of the United States Basketball League.
- Led CBA in scoring (116.7 ppg) in 192-93 and was 2nd in NBA in scoring (102.4 ppg) in 2002-03.
- Only needed 130 games to win his 100th game as a collegiate head coach. He was the 27th-fastest coach in NCAA history to reach 100 wins but was the ninth-fastest since 1970.
- In his first season at Arkansas (2020), the Razorbacks led the NCAA in 3-point field goal percentage defense while Arkansas led the NCAA in both free throws made and attempted in 2022.

Razorbacks Coming Off 3rd Straight Sweet 16

- For the third consecutive season, Arkansas reached the NCAA Sweet 16, including a pair of Elite 8 finishes.
- Arkansas, Houston, Gonzaga and UCLA are the only four schools to reach the Sweet 16 in each of the last three years.
- It was the Hogs 14th Sweet 16.
- It was the first time Arkansas has made three straight Sweet 16 appearances since earning three straight in 1994 (national champion), 1995 (national runner-up) and 1996 (Sweet 16).
- Arkansas' eight wins in the NCAA Tournament over the past three seasons were more NCAA wins than the program had experienced in the previous 25 seasons combined (7 dating back to 1996).

3rd Straight Year Versus #1

- For the third straight year, Arkansas faced a #1 seed in the NCAA Tourney.
- ^ 2021: Lost to #1 seed Baylor in the Elite 8.
- ^ 2022: Beat #1 seed Gonzaga in the Sweet 16.
- ^ 2023: Beat #1 seed Kansas in the 2nd round.
- The last program to beat #1 seeds in back to back years was Butler in 2010 and '11. Ironically, Butler, like Arkansas in 2023, was a #8 seed in 2011.
- Arkansas is the fourth team EVER to defeat the #1 seed in their region in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments (CBSSportsCBB), joining Duke (1988-90); UCLA (2006-07) and Butler (2010-11).
- Last year, Arkansas became the first team to ever beat an AP #1 team in the regular season (vs Auburn on Feb 8) and defeat the AP #1 (overall #1 seed Gonzaga) in the NCAA Tournament (ESPN Stats). Also, no men's college basketball team had beaten two different No. 1 teams from the AP poll in the same season since 1992-93 when Georgia Tech beat Duke and North Carolina in the same season (both were regular-season games).

Ranked 21st in the final coaches poll

- With its Sweet 16 finish, Arkansas was in the Coaches final top 25 for a third straight year the Razorbacks finished the year ranked among the coaches top 25, placing 21st.
- (NOTE: Arkansas was not in the final AP poll. The AP final poll occurs prior to the NCAA Tournament and the Coaches final poll occurs after the NCAA Tournament.)
- LAST THREE YEARS IN FINAL COACHES POLL:

- The last time Arkansas finished in the coaches final top 25 in three straight seasons was 1994 (#1), 1995 (#2) and 1996 (18th).

Three Hogs Drafted; Council Signs 2-Way

- **Anthony Black** (#6 overall to the Orlando Magic) and teammate **Nick Smith Jr.** (#27 overall to the Charlotte Hornets) were the first Razorbacks taken

in the first round of the same NBA Draft since 1992. In the second round, Arkansas had **Jordan Walsh** go with the 38th overall pick by the Boston Celtics.

- Arkansas had three players selected in the 2023 NBA Draft, the most since 1992 (4), just the fourth time as many as three went in the same year with 1982 (3) and 1979 (2) and the 10th time more than one Razorback was picked in the same draft.
- The trio became the 42nd, 43rd and 44th Razorbacks to be selected in the NBA Draft.
- Immediately after the draft, **Ricky Council IV** signed a two-way contract with the Philadelphia 76ers.
- **Black** ties Joe Kleine (#6 overall to the Sacramento Kings in 1985) as the second-highest Razorback to be picked. Sidney Moncrief (#5 overall to the Milwaukee Bucks in 1979) is the highest Razorback to be drafted.
- Black is the seventh Razorback to be a Lottery Pick (instituted in 1985) and the second in the Eric Musselman era, joining Moses Moody (#14 overall by Golden State Warriors) in 2021.
- **Black and Smith** joined the 1992 trio of Todd Day (8th overall), Oliver Miller (22nd overall) and Lee Mayberry (23rd overall) as the only Razorback teammates to be drafted in the first round in the same year.
- **Black, Smith and Walsh** are the second, third and fourth one-and-dones in Razorback history. All four Razorback one-and-dones have come under head coach Eric Musselman as Moses Moody was the first one-and-done in 2021.
- This marks the fifth-straight year at least one Razorback has been taken in the NBA Draft, joining Daniel Gafford (2019), Isaiah Joe (2020), Moses Moody (2021) and Jaylin Williams (2022).

- For the second straight year, the Arkansas men's basketball program will play in a preseason charity exhibition game that features two top 25 teams. The Razorbacks, a top 20 selection in the early polls, will host Purdue, generally tabbed among the nation's top three teams this summer, on Oct. 28 (Saturday) at Bud Walton Arena. Tipoff is set for 3 pm.
- Arkansas and Purdue have only met on two previous occasions with each team winning once and both coming on neutral courts. The first meeting was on Dec. 28, 1938, and the Boilermakers won, 57-51, in the Sugar Bowl Classic (New Orleans, La.). The last meeting was in 1983 when the Razorbacks defeated Purdue, 78-68, in the second round of the NCAA Tournament (Tampa, Fla.).

Hogs vs Duke in Inaugural SEC/ACC Challenge

- In what will be a rematch of the 2022 NCAA Elite 8 and the 1994 National Championship, Arkansas will host Duke as part of the inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge. The game will be played Nov. 29 (Wednesday) and tipoff is set for 8:15 pm (CT). Television network designations will be announced at a later date.
- Arkansas and Duke have met on four previous occasions - all on neutral courts and in all four both teams were nationally ranked. The series is tied, 2-2.
- The last time the Razorbacks and Blue Devils met was the 2022 NCAA Elite 8 in San Francisco, a game Duke won 78-69. Prior to that, Arkansas defeated Duke, 76-72, to win the 1994 NCAA Championship in Charlotte.
- The first meeting between the schools was in the 1990 NCAA Final Four. The Blue Devils won that initial match-up, 97-83. Eight months later (Nov. 21, 1990), Arkansas beat Duke, 98-88, at New York's Madison Square Garden in the Preseason NIT semifinals.

• In the previous nine years, Arkansas participated in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge. The Razorbacks were 4-5 in those games, going 4-0 in Bud Walton Arena.

Razorbacks Return to Tulsa

- Arkansas will have its own SEC/Big 12 Challenge when the Razorbacks play the third game of the neutral-site series versus the Oklahoma Sooners – dubbed the Crimson and Cardinal Classic – on Dec. 9 at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Okla.
- The Sooners won the in meeting, 88-66, and Arkansas prevailed last season, 88-78.
- The overall Arkansas and Oklahoma series includes 30 games dating back to the 1938-39 season. Arkansas owns a 17-13 advantage in the series, including a 6-1 record when the teams play on a neutral court. The teams' only meetings in Tulsa have come as part of this recent series.

- For the second straight year, and just the third time since the Razorbacks joined the SEC (1991-92), Arkansas and **Kentucky** will meet in a home-and-home series. The teams split the series last season, each winning on the road. The only other time came in 2013-14 when Arkansas swept Kentucky with a pair of overtime victories.
- Arkansas and **Alabama** will only be meeting once, and the game will be played in Tuscaloosa. The previous two times the teams only met once (2020 and 2022), those games were also played in Tuscaloosa.
- Arkansas and **Missouri** will be playing a home-and-home series for the 12th consecutive year. The streak coincides with the number of years since the Tigers joined the SEC (2012-13). Arkansas leads the all-time series with Missouri, 33-27, and leads 14-8 since Mizzou joined the SEC.
- Arkansas and **LSU** have met for a home-and-home series in all but two seasons since the Razorbacks joined the SEC (1991-92). The Razorbacks and Tigers only met once in 2013 (at Baton Rouge) and just once in 2015 (in Fayetteville). Arkansas leads the Tigers 38-30 since the Razorbacks joined the SEC and has won seven of the last 11 versus LSU.
- Arkansas and **Texas A&M** will be scheduled to play a home-and-home series for the 10th time in the now 12 years since the Aggies joined the conference. While Arkansas leads the all-time series with the Aggies, 106-60, the advantage is just 11-10 since A&M joined the SEC. The home teams have dominated the series over the last 12 seasons as Arkansas is 9-1 versus the Aggies at home and Texas A&M is 7-2 versus the Razorbacks in College Station.
- Arkansas will host **Georgia** in a home-and-home series for the first time since 2014 and just the third time ever. The only other time it happened was in 2006. However, the teams have played multiple times in a season nine other times as the programs have squared off nine times in the SEC Tournament. That makes the Bulldogs the second-most common opponent at the SEC Tournament behind Kentucky (10 meetings).
- For the fourth straight year, long-time rivals Arkansas and **Ole Miss** will only play once. The longest streak Arkansas currently has of playing an SEC opponent just once in the regular season is versus Florida. This year will mark the seventh-straight year the Razorbacks and Gators are scheduled to meet just once.
- Arkansas will host **Tennessee** this year. The schedule has favored the Volunteers of late. Since 2014, Arkansas has played in Knoxville nine times and, including this season, Tennessee will be coming to Fayetteville for just the sixth time.
