- No. 10 (1,495) on all-time scoring list at Arkansas
- Career active SEC leaders: 1st in assists (316), 2nd in steals (194), 3rd in points & 12th in rebounds (433)
- SEC Preseason Second Team selection

- Solid in Murray State game w/ 11 points, five rebounds and seven assists in 38 minutes
- Her 10 free throws vs. ULM is tied for the most by an SEC player this year
- Moved to No. 19 in career assists with 259
- Tabbed the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year

SNAPSHOT:

- Followed up impressive debut with 25 points vs. Murray State
- Her 29 points vs. ULM was the most by a freshman in their Arkansas debut
- Leading the SEC in scoring
- McDonald's All-American and No. 11 recruit in class

SNAPSHOT:

- Logged double-double w/ 10 points, 12 rebounds, three assists, three steals & three blocks vs. Murray State, leads SEC in rebounds (16.5 RPG)
- Pulled down 21 rebounds vs. ULM, which was a sophomore record and one shy of tying overall school record
- SEC All-Freshman Team & five-time FOW last year

SNAPSHOT:

- Tallied three points, eight rebounds and one block vs. Murray State



2023-24 NOTES

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

■ Arkansas welcomed a crowd of 11,026 to Bud Walton Arena on Friday, which was recorded as the fourth best attendance in BWA history for a women's game, and best since 2003

■ The Hogs hosted the largest Elementary Day in the event's 12th year, as over 50 schools and 7,000+ kids were in attendance

■ In the Elementary Day game, Arkansas prevailed in the 82-79 win despite having a 24-point lead early in the third quarter

■ Arkansas has started the season 2-0 for the 12th straight year, looking to say undefeated and commence the year 3-0 for the second consecutive year and fourth in the last five years

■ This year marks the third straight year Arkansas is playing all other DI schools in the state. Since the revival of in-state matchups in 2019-20 (Hogs just played Little Rock that year), Arkansas is 12-0 vs. in-state opponents

■ **Taliah Scott** has started her collegiate debut on a high note, scoring 29 in the game vs. ULM (most scored by a freshman in their Arkansas debut) and 25 vs. Murray State. Her 27.0 PPG leads the SEC and is fifth in the country

■ As one of the best rebounders in the country, **Saylor Poffenbarger** pulled down a career-high 21 rebounds, which was one shy of tying the individual game record vs. ULM. The 21 rebounds is tied for the most by an NCAA player this year. Those 21 rebounds is the most by an NCAA player this season, while her 16.5 rebounds per game leads the SEC

■ The Hogs were picked to finish sixth and seventh in the SEC Preseason Media and Coaches Poll, respectively

■ Fifth-year **Makayla Daniels** was selected on the All-SEC Preseason Second Team, as chosen by the league's coaches. She is averaging 16.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game, and her 1,495 career points is the No. 10 most points scored by an Arkansas WBB player in school history

■ **Samara Spencer** is the leading returning scorer from last year, having averaged 14.4 points per game and pacing the team with 154 assists. She has gotten off to another strong start, coming off a well-rounded 11 points, five rebounds and seven assists vs. Murray State. Her 259 career assists moved up to No. 19 on the all-time career list

■ After two games, **Sasha Goforth** leads the team in blocks with six, logging three in back-to-back games to open the season. She is fourth in the SEC in blocks/game and her 72 career blocks at Arkansas is the sixth most among active players in the SEC

■ Arkansas is one of two schools in the SEC to have finished in the top 50 in NET/RPI rankings in the past four years (South Carolina the other) and one of three in the SEC to qualify for the past five consecutive postseason tournaments (SC and Tennessee the others, including 2020 when the tournament was cancelled due to COVID-19)

■ Coach **Neighbors** returns three starters from the 2022-23 team, seven total returners, while bringing in the No. 17 ranked recruiting class, according to ESPN

■ **Scott** comes to Fayetteville as a five-star prospect, No. 11 in the country, logging 36.2 points, 9.2 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 3.0 steals per game during her senior year of high school. Fellow freshman **Jenna Lawrence** was a four-star recruit, No. 61 recruit in the country, out of Farmington High School down the road, who won the 2023 4A Girls State Championship.

Maryn Archer was a January enrollee and three-star player out of Kansas, while JUCO transfer **Carly Keats** and Spanish National Team member **Cristina Sanchez Cerqueira** make up one of the most talented recruiting classes Arkansas has seen

STORYLINES

■ After the 40+-year ban on Arkansas schools being able to play one another in the regular season, Tuesday's game marks the fifth straight year the Hogs will play Little Rock

■ The Hogs are 12-0 vs. in-state opponents since 2019-20

■ Arkansas is entering this year's matchup vs. Little Rock with a 5-0 edge over the Trojans

■ Head coach **Mike Neighbors** and Little Rock coach **Joe Foley** are good friends and fierce competitors on the golf course

■ Through two games **Taliah Scott** is the SEC's leading scorer and sixth highest scorer in the NCAA among players who have played in 2+ games

■ **Saylor Poffenbarger's** 33 rebounds through two games is the most in the country with her 21 pulled down vs. ULM being tied for the most pulled down by a player in the country thus far

SCOUTING LITTLE ROCK ABOUT THE TROJANS

■ The Trojans have one of the toughest schedules among Mid-Major programs, and have started the season 0-2, most recently coming off a 77-39 loss vs. Kansas State

■ Little Rock has SEC opponents Alabama, Ole Miss and Auburn also on its schedule

■ LR was projected to finish second in the Ohio Valley Conference with five first-place votes

■ The Trojans finished last year 21-11, 17-1 in the OVC to win the regular season title. Little Rock lost to Tennessee Tech in the OVC Tournament Championship, 54-46, but played in the Postseason WNIT to fall to SMU, 68-42

■ **Tia Harvey** and **Faith Lee** earned spots on the Preseason All-OVC Team. Last season, **Harvey** averaged 9.7 points per game, while **Lee** tallied 8.3 points per game

■ On this year's Little Rock team, **Lee** leads the team with 18.5 points per game, **Camryn James** and **Trinity Hudson** lead the team in rebounds with 6.0 per game, while **Jayla Brooks** has a team's most seven assists and four steals

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

■ **Joe Foley** holds an impressive 854-308 career record through 37 years as a head coach, which is the third most wins among active DI coaches. This marks his 21st year at Little Rock, where he holds a 398-227 mark

■ **Foley** is a five-time conference Coach of the Year and has led the program to a 20-win season for 11 of the last 14 years and outright Sun Belt Conference West Division winners in 10 of last 13 years (five NCAA berths)

■ Graduated from Central Arkansas in 1979

SERIES HISTORY OF LITTLE ROCK VS. ARKANSAS

■ Arkansas is 5-0 in the all-time series vs. the Trojans

■ This marks the fifth straight year Arkansas and Little Rock will square off

■ Arkansas is 1-0 in Fayetteville, as this game is just the second of the series played in Bud Walton Arena

■ The first game of the series was in 1977, and it took until 2019 to bring back the series

■ In the last game vs. Little Rock, played at the Jack Stephens Center, Arkansas defeated the Trojans, 93-49, behind a season-high 62.5 field goal percentage. **Makayla Daniels** logged 12 points and four assists, **Samara Spencer** logged 11 points, seven rebounds and six assists and **Saylor Poffenbarger** had nine points and nine boards

LAST TIME OUT

■ Arkansas earned another hard-fought victory on Friday, as the Hogs defeated Murray State, 82-79, despite being ahead by 24 points early in the third quarter

■ The Hogs welcomed a crowd of 11,026, which went down as the fourth best attendance in Bud Walton Arena history. Arkansas hosted over 50 local-area schools with 7,000+ students as a part of Arkansas' 12th Elementary Day

■ **Taliah Scott** guided the Hogs in scoring for the second straight game with 25 points and three rebounds

■ **Makayla Daniels** was instrumental in great ball handling at the end of the game, tallying 15 points and six rebounds in the win

■ **Samara Spencer** stuffed the stat sheet with 11 points, five boards and seven assists in 38 minutes played

■ **Saylor Poffenbarger** recorded her first double-double of the season, fifth in her career, with 10 points and 12 rebounds, along with three assists, three steals and three blocks

■ **Sasha Goforth** registered nine points and three blocks, her second straight game with 3+ blocks

■ Arkansas delivered 44 points in the paint compared to MSU's 28, as well as 20 fast break points vs. the Racers' 14

AN ARKANSAS WIN MEANS...

■ Going 3-0 in Arkansas' first three games for the second straight year, fourth in the last five years

■ Extending Arkansas' home-winning streak to seven, which stretches back from last year (starting with Arkansas' 78-65 win over Texas A&M on Feb. 26, 2022)

■ Elevating to 13-0 in games played vs. in-state opponents since 2019

■ Extending Arkansas' all-time series record vs. LR to 6-0

RETURN OF THE MAK

■ Granted a fifth-year of eligibility due to COVID-19, **Makayla Daniels** is making the most of it and finishing what she started at Arkansas

■ She has started the year averaging 16.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game, coming off 15 points and 6.0 boards vs. Murray State

■ Began her fifth season with 17 points off an efficient 7-for-11 shooting from the field, 3-of-5 from beyond the arc vs. ULM. Made some huge shots down the stretch and came up with big defensive stops, finishing with two steals and no turnovers

■ Scrappy player, creates for herself and teammates and an incredibly underrated defender who can hold a team's leading guard well below their scoring average

■ Sits at No. 10 on the all-time scoring list at Arkansas with 1,495 points, which is the second most among Hog point guards. She needs 63 more

points to surpass **C'eira Ricketts** to be the highest scoring point guard in Arkansas WBB history

■ Has the opportunity to move up further among several career statistical categories in the record book at Arkansas. Sits third in games started (124), seventh in 3-pointers made (184), 3-pointers attempted (529) and free throws made (368), ninth in free throw percentage (.785), free throws attempted (469) and 3-point percentage (.346), as well as 13th in assists (316)

■ **Daniels** has started in every game she has appeared in since her freshman year with 124 total starts. Out of players across the country who have also started in every game they have appeared in throughout their collegiate career, she has the second most starts among NCAA DI players

■ SEC statistical rankings: eighth in minutes played/game (31.97) and 3-pointers/game (2.0), as well as 12th in scoring (16.0) and field goal percentage (.565)

■ Owns most assists, second most steals (194), third most points and 12th most rebounds (433) among active players in SEC

■ Named All-SEC Preseason Second Team twice in a row, including at the beginning of this 2023-24 season

■ Averaged 11.3 points per game off 13-of-24 shooting and led the way with seven steals through three games during the Europe trip

■ Paced the team with 56 steals last season and was third in scoring with 13.2 points/game

■ Logged 27 double-digit scoring games with 12 4+ assists contests in 2022-23

■ Was No. 1 on Sportscenter for her buzzer beater against Vanderbilt in game where she finished with 16 points

KEEPING IT 100

→ **Makayla Daniels** is one of 15 players in collegiate women's basketball to start in all games they have appeared in with a minimum 100 contests

→ No. 2 for most starts among active players

SUNSHINE STATE STUD

■ South Florida product **Samara Spencer** made an impact on the Hogs the moment she stepped foot on campus, being named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year and averaged 14.4 points per game and tallied 154 total assists as a sophomore

■ **Spencer** is coming off 11 points, five rebounds and seven assists while playing over 38 minutes vs. Murray State

■ Started the season with 16 points, 10-of-12 from the free throw line, with eight rebounds against ULM in the season opener

WHAT'S HE SAYIN'?

Trying to figure out what Coach Neighbors is saying on the bench? Don't worry – he has a language all his own.

Coach Neighbors plays Positionless Basketball. Instead of having guards, forwards and centers, he has Rabbits, Rackers, Locks and Dragons.



Rabbits run the floor and look to score quickly with a layup.



Rackers bring the ball up the floor, and are trying to get to the rack.



Locks, generally good three-point shooters, are trying to win the race to the corners.



The Dragon is the last player down the court, dragging behind the others.

■ One of the fastest on the court (easily beating her defenders to the rack), gets to the free throw line frequently and catches fire from beyond the arc

■ SEC statistical rankings: fourth in minutes/game (34.32), eighth in free throw makes (11), and assists/game (4.5), ninth in defensive rebounds/game (6.0) & 10th in assists/game (4.5)

■ Her 10 free throws made is tied for the most by a player in the league thus far

■ Cracked top 20 all-time in career assists at Arkansas with 259

■ Among active SEC players, fourth in career assists (259) and ninth in career scoring (937, needing 63 points for 1,000)

■ In Europe, averaged 6.3 points per game and tallied six steals and a team-leading 13 assists through three games

■ Finished her sophomore campaign with 27 double-digit scoring games, eight 20-point performances, two double-doubles in points and assists and had 13 games with 5+ assists

■ Logged a career-high 32 points vs. Oral Roberts, shooting 10-of-17 from the field with a career-high six 3-pointers last season

SHE'S POFFEN OFF!

■ **Saylor Poffenbarger** is a big guard who can be placed at all five positions on offense and defense if needed. One of the best defenders in the league and is a great rebounder

■ Coming off her fifth career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds vs. Murray State. Also logged three assists, three steals and three blocks in the win

■ Had a career-high 21 rebounds vs. ULM, which was the second most in a single game in school history (one off from tying record)

■ SEC statistical rankings: first in rebounding (16.5), defensive rebounds/game (14.5) and minutes/game (34.9) and sixth in blocks/game (2.0)

MIKE NEIGHBORS

Seventh Season | Career Record: 220-118 (11) | Arkansas Record: 122-77 (7)

Arkansas women's basketball has been transformed into a nationally recognized program in just six short years thanks to head coach Mike Neighbors. During his time back home at his alma mater, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best six-year period of sustained success in program history with 120 wins and five postseason qualifications in that time. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers - Neighbors has accumulated 218 wins during his 10 seasons as a head coach, the most of any Power 5 head coaches in 10 or fewer seasons, as well as one of only two NCAA Division I Head Coaches.

Entering his seventh season on the bench for Arkansas, the program is coming off its fifth consecutive winning season, four straight postseason appearance (would be five had the 2020 NCAA Tournament had not been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as Arkansas was a lock to make the Big Dance) and third 20+ win season in the Neighbors' era.

In 2022-23, the Hogs started out the season 13-0, which was tied for the second-best start in program history. Going into Mid-December, the Hogs were ranked as high as No. 17 in the AP Poll. The Hogs won another SEC Tournament game in comeback fashion versus Missouri to make it to the quarterfinals and hold the best winning percentage in the SEC Tournament among all coaches in Arkansas history with an 8-6 record. Continuing into postseason, Arkansas became the automatic bid out of the SEC to the Postseason WNIT, making it to the Great 8, while being able to host three of its four games at Bud Walton Arena. Neighbors led the Hogs to two All-SEC selections, including Second Team choice Erynn Barnum, who was also on the Midseason Top 10 List for the Katrina McClain Award, as well as All-Freshman selection Saylor Poffenbarger, who broke a school record for five SEC Freshman of the Week accolades. The Hogs finished the season with 24 wins, which tied for the most in a single season in program history. Additionally, four players averaged double digits in scoring, the most in the Southeastern Conference.

Prior to Arkansas, Neighbors guided Washington to four seasons of unprecedented success, highlighted by the 2016 NCAA Final Four and two NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. Neighbors was an assistant for the Huskies prior to this promotion and also has had stops at Xavier, Tulsa, Colorado and Arkansas as an assistant.

A native of Greenwood, Arkansas, Neighbors received his associate degree at the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith and his bachelor's degree from the University of Arkansas in 1993. Neighbors is married to Jayci Stone. He has four children, a daughter, Abby and three sons, Alec, Bowen and Barrett, as well as a granddaughter, Emzey.
