- No. 10 (1,517) on all-time scoring list at Arkansas, most recently surpassing 1,500 points
- Two away from breaking games started (129) record
- Career active SEC leaders: 1st in assists (325), 2nd in steals (199), 3rd in points & 12th in rebounds (445)
- SEC Preseason Second Team selection

SNAPSHOT:

- Registered 16 points (5-of-9) & two boards vs. UCA
- Fifth in FT% (.857) & 11th in assists in SEC
- Her 10 free throws vs. ULM is tied for the most by an SEC player this year
- No. 17 in career assists with 268 (No. 4 in SEC)
- Tabbed the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year

SNAPSHOT:

- Named SEC Freshman of the Week
- Coming off 17 points vs. UCA
- Delivered 34 points at Arkansas State
- Leading the SEC in scoring, second in the NCAA among players with 5+ games
- McDonald's All-American and No. 11 recruit in class

SNAPSHOT:

- Registered season-high 17 points w/ six boards vs. UCA
- Leads SEC in defensive rebounds (10.2) & second in rebounds (12.2), which is third & 12th in NCAA
- Pulled down 21 rebounds vs. ULM, which was a sophomore record and one shy of tying overall school record
- SEC All-Freshman Team & five-time FOW last year

SNAPSHOT:

- Coming off three straight double-digit scoring games, including 14 points, eight boards & three steals vs. UCA
- Leads team in 3-pointers (8) & 3PT% (.471)
- No. 13 in rebounds (7.8) & defensive rebounds (5.8) in the SEC
- Last year was her first off an ACL injury

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

■ Arkansas is 5-0 for the second consecutive year and third time in the last five years. **Mike Neighbors** has had three of his teams start a season 5-0, which matches a school record with **Gary Blair** and **Tom Collen**

■ Arkansas played three straight in-state opponents and got the job done in each of those games, including an 81-67 win over Central Arkansas on Monday's Native American Heritage Month Appreciation game for the Hogs

■ The Hogs are one of five schools left in the SEC to start the year undefeated

■ With the win over UCA, Arkansas extended its record vs. in-state opponents (since 2019-20 when the ban of playing other in-state schools was lifted) to 15-0

■ The Hogs are set to play in the Elevance Health Fort Myers Tip-Off against a lineup of Power 6 opponents. Arkansas will play Wisconsin on Friday and Marquette or Boston College on Saturday in the Shell Division

■ The Hogs will look to keep its undefeated record intact and come back home with two wins to start 7-0 for the second straight year

■ Arkansas won the Paradise Jam in the Virgin Islands last season and will seek back-to-back years with tournament titles during Thanksgiving

■ Leading the team in scoring in each of the first five games (including ties), **Taliah Scott** has been a force for the Hogs, pacing the team and SEC in scoring with 24.6 points per game, which is second in NCAA w/ 5+ games played. She is coming off being named SEC Freshman of the Week

■ **Saylor Poffenbarger** is one of the best rebounders in the country, pacing the team with 12.2 per game. She pulled down a career-high 21 rebounds, which was one shy of tying the individual game record vs. ULM. Those 21 rebounds is tied for the most by an NCAA player this season, and she leads the league in defensive rebounds (10.2) and is second in rebounds (12.2). Her defensive boards/game is third and rebounds/game is 12th in the country

■ **Samara Spencer** has a team's most assists with 18. She is the leading returning scorer from last year, having averaged 14.4 points per game and paced the team with 154 assists. Her 268 career assists is tied for No. 17 on the all-time career list at Arkansas and is at 968 points, needing just 32 more to be the No. 33rd member of the 1,000-point club at Arkansas

■ After missing last season, **Sasha Goforth** has not missed a beat, logging a team's best 12 blocks, including 3+ in three games. Her 78 blocks is the sixth most among active players in the league

■ **Makayla Daniels** and **Poffenbarger** are tied for a team's most steals with seven a piece

■ The Hogs were picked to finish sixth and seventh in the SEC Preseason Media and Coaches Poll, respectively

■ Fifth-year **Daniels** was selected on the All-SEC Preseason Second Team, as chosen by the league's coaches. She is averaging 10.8 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. Her 1,517 career points is the No. 10 most points scored by an Arkansas WBB player in school history

■ **Daniels** is one start away from tying the all-time record for career starts with 128 and two off from breaking the record with 129 (will break it if she starts in both games of the tournament). She has started in every game she has appeared in during her collegiate career

■ Arkansas is one of two schools in the SEC to have finished in the top 50 in NET/RPI rankings in the past four years (South Carolina the other) and one of three in the SEC to qualify for the past five consecutive postseason tournaments (SC and Tennessee the others, including 2020 when the tournament was cancelled due to COVID-19)

■ Coach **Neighbors** returns three starters from the 2022-23 team, seven total returners, while bringing in the No. 17 ranked recruiting class, according to ESPN

■ **Scott** comes to Fayetteville as a five-star prospect, No. 11 in the country, logging 36.2 points, 9.2 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 3.0 steals per game during her senior year of high school. Fellow freshman **Jenna Lawrence** was a four-star recruit, No. 61 recruit in the country, out of Farmington High School down the road, who won the 2023 4A Girls State Championship. **Maryn Archer** was a January enrollee and three-star player out of Kansas, while JUCO transfer **Carly Keats** and Spanish National Team member **Cristina Sanchez Cerqueira** make up one of the most talented recruiting classes Arkansas has seen

SCOUTING WISCONSIN ABOUT THE BADGERS

■ Wisconsin is 3-1 to start the season, most recently falling to a tough Kansas State team, 75-57 on the road

■ The Badgers went 11-20 last season, 6-12 in the Big Ten, which was 10th in the league

■ Wisconsin finished the season at the Big Ten Tournament with a 57-55 loss to Purdue in the first round

■ **Serah Williams** leads the Badgers in scoring with 14.5 points per game and rebounds with 8.0 per game along with a team-high 10 blocks in four games. She was a Big Ten All-Freshman Team choice

■ **Ronnie Porter** paces the team with 18 assists and 17 steals

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

■ **Marisa Moseley** is in her third season at the helm in Madison, Wisconsin

■ **Moseley** came to UW after a successful stint as Boston University's head coach, being named 2019 Patriot Coach of the Year. She was on five national championship teams as an assistant

SERIES HISTORY OF WISCONSIN VS. ARKANSAS

- Arkansas is 3–0 vs. Wisconsin in the all-time series
- The last time these two teams played was in back-to-back years in 2018 (W, 69–68 in Nashville) and 2019 (W, 68–64 in Nassau, Bahamas)
- **Makayla Daniels** played in that win in 2019, registering four points and two steals

SCOUTING MARQUETTE**ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES**

- Marquette has begun the year 4–0, including with a 71–67 win over No. 23 Illinois
- The team was picked to finish third in the BIG EAST with 79 points. Marquette finished 21–11, 13–7 in the league last season, losing in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to South Florida, 67–65
- The Golden Eagles are led by **Jordan King**, who is the only player in the country with more consecutive starts in games she has been available in than **Makayla Daniels** with 128. **King** averages 17.0 points per game and was a Preseason All-BIG EAST First Team selection after averaging 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game last year
- **Frannie Hottinger** leads on the boards with 8.3 rebounds per game, while **Rose Nkumu** has a team's most 21 assists and eight steals
- **Liz Karlen** was a Preseason All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention choice after averaging 11.4 points and 7.4 rebounds per game last year

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

- **Megan Duffy** is in her fifth season at Marquette, closing in on the 100 wins mark in Milwaukee. During her tenure, the Golden Eagles have made three postseason appearances, and a pair of runner-up finishes in the regular season and conference tournament
- **Duffy** arrived in Milwaukee from Miami (OH), where she led the RedHawks to two Postseason WNITs

SERIES HISTORY OF MARQUETTE VS. ARKANSAS

- Arkansas has the 1–0 edge in the series with the only other meeting being on Dec. 30, 2007 in Hanover, New Hampshire. The Hogs won, 71–69

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE**ABOUT THE EAGLES**

- Boston College is coming into the Fort Myers Tip-Off with a 3–2 mark, coming off a 71–56 road win at Providence
- The Eagles were picked to finish 13th in the ACC after a 16–17 season, 5–13 mark in the ACC to finish in 10th. BC beat 14th-seed Georgia Tech, 62–57 in the first round before losing to sixth-seed Miami, 84–69
- **Teya Sidberry** paces BC with 14.6 points per game and 7.0 rebounds per game
- **Kaylah Ivey** has a team's most 21 assists and **Dontavia Waggoner** has the most steals with 18

ABOUT THE HEAD COACH

- **Joanna Bernabei-McNamee** is in her sixth season in Boston, where she has had two 20-win seasons
- **Bernabei-McNamee** came to BC from Albany, where she led the team to an NCAA Tournament and Postseason WNIT appearance. She has also been the head coach at Pikeville, where she took the 2015–16 team to the NAIA DI Final Four, and West Virginia Wesleyan

SERIES HISTORY OF BOSTON COLLEGE VS. ARKANSAS

- Arkansas is 3–0 in the all-time series against BC
- These two teams have not faced off since 2001, when Arkansas defeated BC, 76–60, on the road in Boston

LAST TIME OUT

- Arkansas picked up its third straight in-state win this season with an 81–67 victory over Central Arkansas, marking the fourth time the Hogs have reached the 80-point mark in scoring this season
- All five starters reached double digits in scoring
- **Taliah Scott** and **Saylor Poffenbarger** led the team in scoring with 17 points apiece. **Poffenbarger** did so behind 6-of-10 shooting, 3-of-4 from 3-point with six rebounds and two steals, while **Scott** had four rebounds and three assists as well
- **Samara Spencer** enjoyed a great game with 16 points off 5-of-9 shooting from the field and 4-of-4 from the line
- **Maryam Dauda** added 14 points off 3-of-6 from 3-point with a team-leading eight rebounds and three steals. **Makayla Daniels** reached 11 points with four assists and two steals
- Arkansas had 20 points off turnovers and 14 off second-chance opportunities

AN ARKANSAS WIN MEANS...

- Starting the season 6-0 and/or 7-0 for the second consecutive year
- Be one of the few teams left in the SEC to start the year undefeated
- Win a Thanksgiving tournament on back-to-back years
- Keeping perfect series records against all potential opponents in the tournament

RETURN OF THE MAK

■ Granted a fifth-year of eligibility due to COVID-19, **Makayla Daniels** is making the most of it and finishing what she started at Arkansas

■ Scrappy player, creates for herself and teammates and an incredibly underrated defender who can hold a team's leading guard to well below their scoring average

■ Coming off 11 points, three boards, four assists and two steals vs. UCA. Also drew seven fouls in that game

■ Tied for team's most steals with seven

■ Surpassed 1,500 career points in the game at Arkansas State. She is No. 10 on the all-time scoring list at Arkansas, needing 41 more points to become the highest scoring point guard in Arkansas history

■ With two starts in this tournament, **Daniels** will break the school record for career starts with 129

■ Has the opportunity to move up further among several career statistical categories in the record book at Arkansas. Sits seventh in 3-pointers made (186), 3-pointers attempted (540) and free throws made (373), ninth in free throws attempted (478), 10th in 3-point percentage (.344) and free throw percentage (.780), as well as 12th in assists (325)

■ SEC statistical rankings: sixth in minutes/game (30.59)

■ Owns most assists, second most steals (199), third most points and 12th most rebounds (445) among active players in the SEC

■ Named All-SEC Preseason Second Team twice in a row, including at the beginning of this 2023-24 season

■ Paced the team with 56 steals last season and was third in scoring with 13.2 points/game

■ Logged 27 double-digit scoring games with 12 4+ assists contests in 2022-23

■ Was No. 1 on Sportscenter for her buzzer beater against Vanderbilt

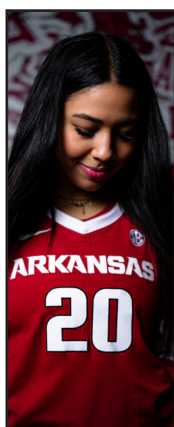

MIKE NEIGHBORS

Seventh Season | Career Record: 223-118 (11) | Arkansas Record: 125-77 (7)

Arkansas women's basketball has been transformed into a nationally recognized program in just six short years thanks to head coach Mike Neighbors. During his time back home at his alma mater, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best six-year period of sustained success in program history with 120 wins and five postseason qualifications in that time. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers - Neighbors has accumulated 218 wins during his 10 seasons as a head coach, the most of any Power 5 head coaches in 10 or fewer seasons, as well as one of only two NCAA Division I Head Coaches.

Entering his seventh season on the bench for Arkansas, the program is coming off its fifth consecutive winning season, four straight postseason appearance (would be five had the 2020 NCAA Tournament had not been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as Arkansas was a lock to make the Big Dance) and third 20+ win season in the Neighbors' era.

In 2022-23, the Hogs started out the season 13-0, which was tied for the second-best start in program history. Going into Mid-December, the Hogs were ranked as high as No. 17 in the AP Poll. The Hogs won another SEC Tournament game in comeback fashion versus Missouri to make it to the quarterfinals and hold the best winning percentage in the SEC Tournament among all coaches in Arkansas history with an 8-6 record. Continuing into postseason, Arkansas became the automatic bid out of the SEC to the Postseason WNIT, making it to the Great 8, while being able to host three of its four games at Bud Walton Arena. Neighbors led the Hogs to two All-SEC selections, including Second Team choice Erynn Barnum, who was also on the Midseason Top 10 List for the Katrina McClain Award, as well as All-Freshman selection Saylor Poffenbarger, who broke a school record for five SEC Freshman of the Week accolades. The Hogs finished the season with 24 wins, which tied for the most in the Neighbors' era and matches the fourth most in a single season in program history. Additionally, four players averaged double digits in scoring, the most in the Southeastern Conference.

Prior to Arkansas, Neighbors guided Washington to four seasons of unprecedented success, highlighted by the 2016 NCAA Final Four and two NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. Neighbors was an assistant for the Huskies prior to this promotion and also has had stops at Xavier, Tulsa, Colorado and Arkansas as an assistant.

A native of Greenwood, Arkansas, Neighbors received his associate degree at the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith and his bachelor's degree from the University of Arkansas in 1993. Neighbors is married to Jayci Stone. He has four children, a daughter, Abby and three sons, Alec, Bowen and Barrett, as well as a granddaughter, Emzey.

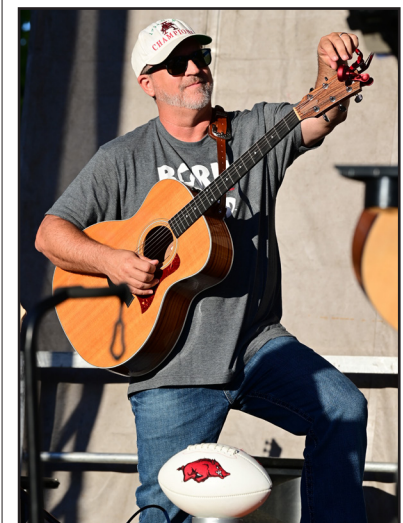

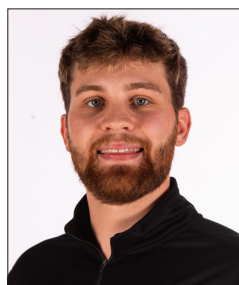

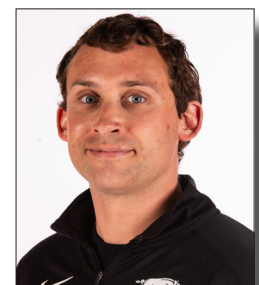
