■ No. 10 (1,542) on all-time scoring list at Arkansas, needing 16 to be highest scoring PG in school history

■ Career active SEC leaders: 1st in assists (334), 2nd in steals (202), 3rd in points & 12th in rebounds (458)

■ SEC Preseason Second Team selection

■ Needs 11 more points for 1,000

■ SEC All-Freshman Team & five-time FOW last year

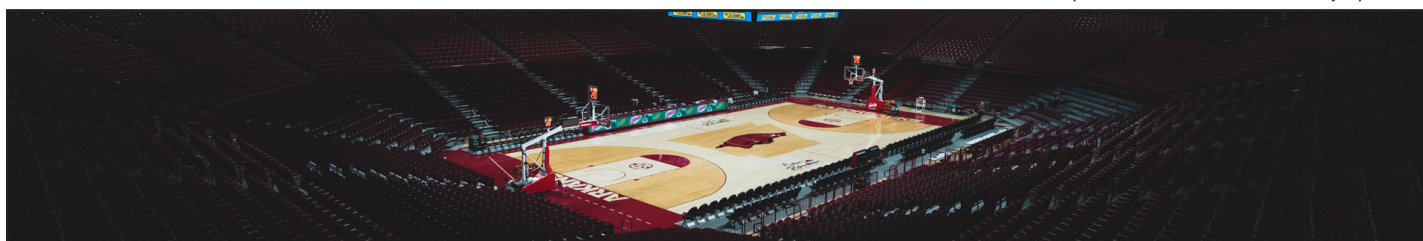
### SNAPSHOT:

■ Was on a three-game double-digit scoring streak

■ No. 9 in defensive rebounds (5.43), as well as 12 in rebounds & blocks (1.29) in the SEC

■ Last year was her first off an ACL injury



## 2023-24 NOTES

### NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

■ Arkansas started the season 6-0 for the second consecutive year, 11th time in school history, before losing to Marquette in the Elevance Health Fort Myers Tip-Off Shell Division Championship game. The Hogs went 1-1 in the tournament to start the year 6-1

■ The Hogs are in the most daunting part of their non-conference schedule, beginning with the SEC/ACC Challenge game at No. 15 Florida State on Thursday and ending with playing host to No. 2 UCLA on Sunday afternoon

■ The SEC/ACC Challenge is in its first year, as the Hogs have drawn No. 15 Florida State, who finished last year fifth in the ACC and earned their 10th consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament

■ In the **Mike Neighbors** era at Arkansas, the program has picked up seven big, ranked wins over AP ranked opponents, including six in the top 16. Arkansas will have the opportunity to increase that total for Coach **Neighbors** to seven win a victory on the road in Tallahassee

■ Improving to 7-1 would become the second-best start for Coach **Neighbors** during his time at Arkansas

■ The Hogs leading scorer since the first game of the season has been **Taliah Scott**. She leads the SEC with 23.1 points per game along with a league's most free throw makes (42) and free throw attempts (48). Her scoring average is the ninth best in the country, while her point total of 162 is the third best. She is fourth in free throw makes, eighth in field goal attempts (123), ninth in free throw attempts and 13th in field goals made (55) in the NCAA

■ **Saylor Poffenbarger** continues to show how she is one of the best rebounders in the country. She is leading the team in rebounding with 11.14 per game, which is also first in the SEC and 12th in the country. Her 9.14 defensive boards per game is also pacing the SEC and is third in the NCAA. She has logged four games with 10+ rebounds, including 21 in the season-opening game vs. ULM. **Poffenbarger** also has 10 blocks

■ **Samara Spencer** has a team's most assists with 23. Her 273 career assists is No. 17 on the all-time career list at Arkansas. She is up to 989 points, needing just 11 more to be the No. 33rd member of the 1,000-point club at Arkansas, and being able to potentially accomplish that milestone in her home state

■ **Makayla Daniels** and **Poffenbarger** are tied for a team's most steals with 10 a piece

■ The Hogs were picked to finish sixth and seventh in the SEC Preseason Media and Coaches Poll, respectively

■ **Daniels** was selected on the All-SEC Preseason Second Team, as chosen by the league's coaches. She is averaging 11.3 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. Her 1,542 career points is the No. 10 most points scored by an Arkansas WBB player in school history

■ Additionally, **Daniels** broke the school record for career starts with 129 on Saturday vs. Marquette. She has started in every game she has appeared in since her freshman year

■ Arkansas is one of two schools in the SEC to have finished in the top 50 in NET/RPI rankings in the past four years (South Carolina the other) and one of three in the SEC to qualify for the past five consecutive postseason tournaments (SC and Tennessee the others, including 2020 when the tournament was cancelled due to COVID-19)

■ Coach **Neighbors** returns three starters from the 2022-23 team, seven total returners, while bringing in the No. 17 ranked recruiting class, according to ESPN

■ **Scott** comes to Fayetteville as a five-star prospect, No. 11 in the country, logging 36.2 points, 9.2 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 3.0 steals per game during her senior year of high school. Fellow freshman **Jenna Lawrence** was a four-star recruit, No. 61 recruit in the country, out of Farmington High School down the road, who won the 2023 4A Girls State Championship.

**Maryn Archer** was a January enrollee and three-star player out of Kansas, while JUCO transfer **Carly Keats** and Spanish National Team member **Cristina Sanchez Cerqueira** make up one of the most talented recruiting classes Arkansas has seen

### SCOUTING FLORIDA STATE

#### ABOUT THE SEMINOLES

■ FSU is coming into the week ranked No. 15, holding a 5-1 record on the season

■ The Seminoles picked up a 92-91 win over Tennessee, but lost its first game vs. Stanford at the Ball Dawgs Classic last week, 100-88

■ Last season, the Seminoles were 23-10, 12-6 in the ACC to finish fifth in the league. The team was the No. 7 seed in the Iowa City Regional, losing to SEC's Georgia, 66-54

■ The Seminoles were picked to finish fifth in the ACC, while two players were chosen on the Blue Ribbon Panel Preseason All-ACC Team. The 2023 WBCA National Freshman of the Year in **Ta'Niya Latson** and the reigning ACC Most Improved Player **Makayla Timpson** were selected. **Latson** averaged 21.3 points per game along with 90 assists and 51 steals, while **Timpson** logged 13.2 points per game, 8.8 rebounds per game, 69 blocks and 35 steals, all last season

**SERIES HISTORY OF FLORIDA STATE VS. ARKANSAS**

■ Arkansas and Florida State have played each other just once, as Arkansas defeated the Seminoles 55-52 in overtime at the WBI Tip Off Classic in Daytona Beach, Florida on Nov. 13, 2011

**LAST TIME OUT**

■ Arkansas went 1-1 at the Elevance Health Fort Myers Tip-Off, beating Wisconsin, 65-62, to advance to the Shell Division Championship game before losing to Marquette, who is now ranked No. 23 in the AP Poll, 74-58

■ In the win over Wisconsin, **Makayla Daniels** led the Hogs with 22 points, eight rebounds and three assists, while **Taliah Scott** followed with 18 points

■ **Maryam Dauda** enjoyed a career-high 11 rebounds with three assists, three blocks and two steals vs. the Badgers, while **Saylor Poffenbarger** had 10 boards and three steals in the game

■ The Hogs overcame a 10-point deficit to Wisconsin to win the game

■ Against Marquette, **Scott** led with 21 points and **Poffenbarger** followed with 13 points, seven rebounds and two blocks

■ **Daniels** came up with a season-high six assists vs. the Golden Eagles, while picking up her 129th career start to break the record at Arkansas

■ On the Fort Myers Tip-Off All-Tournament Team, **Daniels** represented the Hogs, having averaged 12.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game in those two contests

**RETURN OF THE MAK**

■ Granted a fifth-year of eligibility due to COVID-19, **Makayla Daniels** is making the most of it and finishing what she started at Arkansas

■ Scrappy player, creates for herself and teammates and an incredibly underrated defender who can hold a team's leading guard to well below their scoring average

■ Named to Fort Myers Tip-Off All-Tournament Team, having logged a game-high 22 points off five 3-pointers with eight rebounds, three assists and two steals vs. Wisconsin, as well as three points, five boards and a season-high six assists vs. Marquette

■ Broke the school record for career starts at the Fort Myers Tip-Off, now with 129 under her belt, while starting in every game since freshman year, being just one of 14 in the country to start in all games available for with 100+ starts

■ Leads the team with 13 3-pointers and is tied for the team's most steals with 10

■ Surpassed 1,500 career points in the game at Arkansas State. She is No. 10 on the all-time scoring list at Arkansas, needing 16 more points to become the highest scoring point guard in Arkansas history (**C'eira Ricketts** in the No. 9 slot at 1,557)

■ Arkansas records: holds games started record (129), sixth in games played (129), seventh in 3-pointers made (192), 3-pointers attempted (552), free throws made (376) and minutes (3688), ninth in free throws attempted (484) and 3-point percentage (.348), as well as 12th in assists (334)

■ SEC statistical rankings: fifth in minutes/game (31.44) and 10th in 3-pointers/game (1.86)



- Owns most assists, second most steals (202), third most points and 12th most rebounds (458) among active players in the SEC
- Named All-SEC Preseason Second Team twice in a row, including at the beginning of this 2023-24 season
- Paced the team with 56 steals last season and was third in scoring with 13.2 points/game
- Logged 27 double-digit scoring games with 12 4+ assists contests in 2022-23
- Was No. 1 on Sportscenter for her buzzer beater against Vanderbilt

## SUNSHINE STATE STUD

- South Florida product **Samara Spencer** made an impact for the Hogs the moment she stepped foot on campus
- One of the fastest on the court by easily beating her defenders to the rack, gets to the free throw line frequently and catches fire from beyond the arc
- Needs 11 more points to become the 33rd member of the 1,000-point club at Arkansas, while having the opportunity to reach the milestone in her home state
- **Spencer** logged 13 points, six rebounds and two steals vs. Wisconsin and eight points with three dimes against Marquette at the Fort Myers Tip-Off
- Her 10 free throws made in the season opening game vs. ULM is tied for the second most by a player in the league thus far
- Leads the team in assists (23)
- SEC statistical rankings: sixth in minutes/game (30.94), seventh in free throws made (25), ninth in free throw attempts (48), 10th in free throw percentage (.781), 14th in assists/game (3.29) & 15th in assist/turnover ratio (1.35)
- No. 17 on the career all-time assists charts at Arkansas with 273
- Among active SEC players, fourth in career assists and ninth in career scoring (989)
- Finished her sophomore campaign with 27 double-digit scoring games, eight 20-point performances, two double-doubles in points and assists and had 13 games with 5+ assists

Trying to figure out what Coach Neighbors is saying on the bench? Don't worry – he has a language all his own.

Coach Neighbors plays Positionless Basketball. Instead of having guards, forwards and centers, he has Rabbits, Rackers, Locks and Dragons.



Rabbits run the floor and look to score quickly with a layup.



Rackers bring the ball up the floor, and are trying to get to the rack.



Locks, generally good three-point shooters, are trying to win the race to the corners.



The Dragon is the last player down the court, dragging behind the others.

- Logged a career-high 32 points vs. Oral Roberts, shooting 10-of-17 from the field with a career-high six 3-pointers last season
- Named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year

## SHE'S POFFEN OFF!

- **Saylor Poffenbarger** is a big guard who can be placed at all five positions on offense and defense if needed. One of the best defenders in the league and is a great rebounder

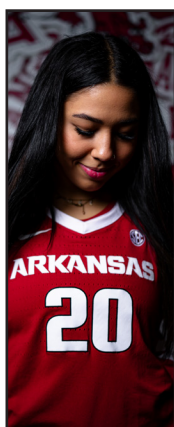

# MIKE NEIGHBORS

Seventh Season | Career Record: 224-119 (11) | Arkansas Record: 126-78 (7)

Arkansas women's basketball has been transformed into a nationally recognized program in just six short years thanks to head coach Mike Neighbors. During his time back home at his alma mater, Neighbors has guided his Hogs to the best six-year period of sustained success in program history with 120 wins and five postseason qualifications in that time. The proof of his success, and the success of his system, lies in the numbers - Neighbors has accumulated 218 wins during his 10 seasons as a head coach, the most of any Power 5 head coaches in 10 or fewer seasons, as well as one of only two NCAA Division I Head Coaches.

Entering his seventh season on the bench for Arkansas, the program is coming off its fifth consecutive winning season, four straight postseason appearance (would be five had the 2020 NCAA Tournament had not been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as Arkansas was a lock to make the Big Dance) and third 20+ win season in the Neighbors' era.

In 2022-23, the Hogs started out the season 13-0, which was tied for the second-best start in program history. Going into Mid-December, the Hogs were ranked as high as No. 17 in the AP Poll. The Hogs won another SEC Tournament game in comeback fashion versus Missouri to make it to the quarterfinals and hold the best winning percentage in the SEC Tournament among all coaches in Arkansas history with an 8-6 record. Continuing into postseason, Arkansas became the automatic bid out of the SEC to the Postseason WNIT, making it to the Great 8, while being able to host three of its four games at Bud Walton Arena. Neighbors led the Hogs to two All-SEC selections, including Second Team choice Erynn Barnum, who was also on the Midseason Top 10 List for the Katrina McClain Award, as well as All-Freshman selection Saylor Poffenbarger, who broke a school record for five SEC Freshman of the Week accolades. The Hogs finished the season with 24 wins, which tied for the most in the Neighbors' era and matches the fourth most in a single season in program history. Additionally, four players averaged double digits in scoring, the most in the Southeastern Conference.

Prior to Arkansas, Neighbors guided Washington to four seasons of unprecedented success, highlighted by the 2016 NCAA Final Four and two NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. Neighbors was an assistant for the Huskies prior to this promotion and also has had stops at Xavier, Tulsa, Colorado and Arkansas as an assistant.

A native of Greenwood, Arkansas, Neighbors received his associate degree at the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith and his bachelor's degree from the University of Arkansas in 1993. Neighbors is married to Jayci Stone. He has four children, a daughter, Abby and three sons, Alec, Bowen and Barrett, as well as a granddaughter, Emzey.
