WBB Faces Boston College in Fort Meyers Tip-Off Friday

Will Be First Meeting Between the Two Teams

The Marquette University women's basketball team opens play at the Fort Myers Tip-Off on Friday, Nov. 25 when they face Boston College. Tipoff from Suncoast Credit Union Arena is at 3:30 p.m. CT.

The Golden Eagles (4-0, 0-0 BIG EAST) are coming off a 96-36 win against Saint Peter's on Sunday. Five Golden Eagles scored in double figures as MU shot a season-best 57.4 percent from the field and 56 percent from three.

Sunday's win over Saint Peter's was the second-largest margin of victory in the Megan Duffy era (60). The Golden Eagles beat Alcorn State in the 2021-22 season opener, 96-35. The Golden Eagles held Saint Peter's to just 23.4 percent shooting, the lowest opponent field goal percentage in the Megan Duffy era.

MU is 5-2 in holiday tournaments under Megan Duffy. Last season at the Battle 4 Atlantis, Marquette beat then No. 3 Texas in the first round for the highest ranked win in program history. Rose Nkumu had a careerhigh 16 points in the win along with four steals.

The Golden Eagles beat Gonzaga in the second round before losing to then No. 20 UCLA in the championship. Jordan King was named to the all-tournament team after averaging 16 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 2.3 assists.

Boston College (3-2, 0-0 ACC) is coming off a 71-56 win at Providence on Sunday. Friday's matchup will be the first meeting between Marquette and Boston College.

The winner of Friday's contest will take on the victor of Arkansas and Wisconsin on Nov. 25 at 4 p.m. CT, while the other two teams will play in the third-place game at 6:30 p.m. CT.

Friday's game will be streamed on FSWBucs. com.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

- Boston College (3-2, 0-0 ACC) is coming off a 71-56 win at Providence on Sunday.
- Teya Sidberry leads the team averaging 14.6 points and seven rebounds per game.
- Sidberry had a career-high 22 points in the win at Providence and has scored in double-digits in four of five games this season.
- BC returned four of its top six leading scorers from last season.
- The Eagles were picked to finish 13th in the ACC preseason poll.

ALL-TIME SERIES AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- Friday's matchup will be the first meeting between Marquette and Boston College.
- Last matchup against an ACC opponent came in the first round of the 2021 NCAA Tournament, with MU losing to Virginia Tech 70-63 on March 21, 2022.
- MU is 33-76 all-time against ACC opponents.

STARTING FIVE

- Marquette is 32-11 against non-conference opponents under Megan Duffy.
- In her fifth season at the helm of Marquette women's basketball, Coach Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in MU history, going 91-37 (.711) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play.
- The Golden Eagles returned three starters and six letterwinners from last season, who accounted for just under 60 percent of the scoring.
- As a team, the Golden Eagles were picked third in the preseason poll by the conference coaches. Marquette has finished the regular season better than their preseason pick three out of the last four seasons.
- At 17.2 points per game in league play, Jordan King is the BIG EAST's top returning scorer from 2022-23.

KING NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST TEAM

- Senior Jordan King was named unanimous preseason All-BIG EAST after averaging 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game. She led the Golden Eagles in minutes played, three-point percentage, points, assists, and steals per game. At 17.2 points per game in league play, King is the BIG EAST's top returning scorer from 2022-23.
- The Rockton, Illinois, native has started in all 128 games during her collegiate career, averaging 32.3 minutes per contest. King ranked top ten in the BIG EAST in five statistical categories last season: scoring (8th, 15.9), assists (5th, 4.0), steals (5th, 2.0), assist/TO ratio (9th, 1.3), and minutes played (8th, 34.3).

KING ON CHERYL MILLER AWARD WATCH LIST

• Jordan King was named one of 20 student-athletes nationwide selected to the 2024 Cheryl Miller Award Preseason Watch List, given annually to the best small forward in the nation.

KARLEN TABBED PRESEASON HONORABLE MENTION ALL-BIG EAST

• Liza Karlen is coming off a junior season where she averaged 11.4 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game, all career bests. The St. Paul, Minnesota native, started in all but one of her 25 games played and her 7.4 rebounds a contest led the team and was ninth in the BIG EAST.

DOWN GOES ILLINOIS

- Marquette got its first ranked win of the season after beating then No. 23 Illinois, 71-67, on Nov. 11.
- It was the fifth ranked win in the Megan Duffy era at Marquette, and first since beating then No. 4 UConn, 59-52, on Feb. 8, 2023 at the Al McGuire Center.

KARLEN NAMED BIG EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Liza Karlen was named BIG EAST Conference Player of the Week in the first weekly honors of the season on Nov. 13.
- Scored a game-high 22 points on 11-of-16 shooting in the win over No. 23 Illinois.
- Scored 10 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for her 14th career double-double against UT Martin in the season opener.

NATIONAL HONORS FOR KARLEN

- Liza Karlen was named a U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Player of the Week after her performances against UT Martin and then No. 23 Illinois first week of the season. The rest of the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Players of the Week included Caitlin Clark (Iowa), Kamilla Cardoso (South Carolina), Saniya Rivers (NC State), and Kiki Iriafen (Stanford).
- Karlen also was named to the March Madness "Starting Five" for Week 1 that included Cardoso, Rivers, Delanie Crawford (Tulsa) and Savannah Wheeler (Middle Tennessee).

WEEKLY HONOR ROLL FOR KENZIE

- Mackenzie Hare was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor roll for the first time this Monday.
- Hare had a game-high 22 points at IUPUI and 19 points against Saint Peter's.
- The sophomore shot 63.6 percent from the floor and 71.4 percent from three (10-of-14) during the week.
- Hare is 10th in the nation and second in the BIG EAST in three-pointers per game (3.75).

MOVING UP THE RANKS

- Jordan King moved into the top-15 on the Marquette all-time scoring list after her 19-point game against Illinois and 14-point outing at IUPUI.
- The senior has 1,441 career points to rank 15th all-time, and is 147 points away from being in the top-10.

NATIONAL RANKS

- Marquette is second in the BIG EAST and 33rd nationally in FG percentage defense (31.3 percent).
- The Golden Eagles are first in the BIG EAST and 43rd nationally in rebounding margin (+11.0) and are averaging 36.5 rebounds per game.
- MU is first in the BIG EAST and ninth in the nation in three-point percentage (44.2 percent).
- MU is first in the BIG EAST and 14th in the nation in scoring margin (+32.8).
- MU is second in the BIG EAST and 23rd in the nation in free throw percentage (79.7 percent).

MOVING THE BALL

- Marquette is first in the BIG EAST and 9th in the nation in assists per game (21.8).
- The Golden Eagles have recorded 20 or more assists in three of four games this season. MU hit that mark eight times all of last season.

HOT SHOOTING START

- Marquette is first in the BIG EAST and 6th in the nation in shooting percentage (52.9 percent) through the first four games.
- The Golden Eagles have shot 50 percent or better in all four games this season (51.7 percent vs UT Martin, 50 percent vs Illinois, 52.2 percent at IUPUI, 57.4 percent vs Saint Peter's) for the first time in the Megan Duffy era.
- Marquette shot 50 percent or better as a team three times all of last season.
- Marquette was 10th in the nation in combined shooting percentage (54.6 percent) last week in the wins at IUPUI and Saint Peter's.
- MU is the only team in the BIG EAST to have multiple players shooting over 50 percent from three-point range (Jordan King, 57.1 percent and Mackenzie Hare, 55.6 percent).

Fifth Year | Davton, Ohio | Notre Dame, '06



The 2022-23 campaign marked the fourth at Marquette University for Megan Duffy, who was named the sixth head coach in program history in April 2019.

Through four seasons at the helm of Marquette women's basketball, Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in Marquette women's basketball history, going 87-37 (.702) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play. During Duffy's tenure, the Golden Eagles have made three postseason appearances, and have earned a pair of runner-up finishes in both the regular season and conference tournament.

Marquette had an outstanding season in 2022-23, a campaign which was topped off by a trip to the NCAA tournament. The season was highlighted by the two highest-ranked wins in program history, as the Golden Eagles took down then No. 3 Texas and then No. 4 UConn during the regular season. The team went 21-11 overall with a 13-7 mark in BIG EAST play, and made it to the BIG EAST Tournament semifinal round for the seventh-straight season.

Duffy led the development of Jordan King and Chloe Marotta, the first Marquette duo to each land a spot on the All-BIG EAST First Team in the same season program history. Additionally, Duffy helped Emily La Chapell and Mackenzie Hare

each earn recognition as members of the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, the first duo to do so at Marquette since Natisha Hiedeman and Allazia Blockton in 2015-16.

As a team, the Golden Eagles boasted one of the nation's top defenses and most efficient offenses. Marquette led the BIG EAST in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 58.2 points per game, and dominated the glass with a +3.9 rebounding margin and 38.4 boards per contest. The team averaged 16.5 assists with just 13.5 turnovers per game to post an outstanding 1.22 assist/turnover ratio on the year.

The 2021-22 season was highlighted by a run to the WNIT Sweet 16 and the seventh-best win total in program history (23). The Golden Eagles posted a 23-11 overall record, including a 15-3 mark at the Al McGuire Center, a program record for home wins in a season. After earning a bye in the first round of the BIG EAST tournament as the 5-seed, Marquette used a historic offensive performance in a 105-85 win over DePaul in the quarterfinal round to advance to its sixth-straight tournament semifinal appearance.

The Golden Eagles made history during the 2020-21 season, winning 14 of their 18 BIG EAST games, including a school-record 11 true wins in road games. Thirteen of MU's 19 wins came away from home, including a decisive 85-71 victory over then-No. 24 DePaul at Wintrust Arena that helped the team lock up an NCAA tournament bid. After winning BIG EAST tournament games against Providence and Creighton, MU advanced to the BIG EAST tournament championship game for the fifth consecutive season. UConn and Maryland are the only other high major teams to make five straight conference tournament title games from 2017-21.

Duffy was named the sixth head coach in Marquette women's basketball history on April 10, 2019. She inherited a team that went 27-8 (15-3 BIG EAST) in 2018-19 that fell in the Round of 32 in the NCAA tournament to Texas A&M. 78-76.

Despite these losses, Duffy made an immediate impact on the program, directing a team selected to finish ninth in the preseason poll to a second-place effort in the BIG EAST and an appearance in the league tournament championship game. The roster featured a pair of all-league performers in Selena Lott and Camryn Taylor and the program was poised for participation in the NCAA tournament.

The Dayton, Ohio, native has translated her extensive playing career, which included All-America selections (finalist for national player of the year awards), USA Basketball participation (Gold medalist) and professional experience in the WNBA (Minnesota and New York) and overseas, into immediate success in the coaching ranks.

Duffy arrived at Marquette after leading Miami (Ohio) to a pair of Women's National Invitation Tournament appearances during her two-year tenure with the program.

Under Duffy's tutelage, Miami produced two all-conference performers, while the team's successes carried into the classroom as well. Miami had a program-high eight student-athletes tabbed Academic All-MAC and the RedHawks were named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Honor Roll in 2018 after earning the sixth-best team grade-point average in the nation among all Division I schools.

Prior to her time in Oxford, Duffy owns stops at BIG EAST school St. John's (2009-12, assistant coach), George Washington (2012-14, associate head coach) and Michigan (2014-17, assistant coach). She helped lead each of the three programs to the postseason (seven total appearances).

Duffy was a four-year letterwinner at Notre Dame (2002-06), helping the Irish to four-straight NCAA appearances and two Sweet 16 berths. She is one of four players in school history to total at least 1,000 points, 500 assists and 200 steals. She was an Associated Press and Kodak All-America honorable mention in 2005 and 2006, while being a finalist for both the John Wooden Award and Nancy Lieberman Award in her final season.

Duffy graduated from Notre Dame in 2006 with a double degree in psychology and computer applications. She is married to Kevin Hoyng.



Coach Duffy led Marquette to a 24-8 (13-5 BIG EAST) season in her first year at Marquette in 2019-20. She was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year and had the Golden Eagles on the cusp of their fourth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance.

Justine Raterman Associate Head Coach Dayton (2010)

- Entering her fifth season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Serves as recruiting coordinator for the Golden Eagles and excels in post player development.
- In 2021-22, Raterman helped her post players take their games to another level. Lauren Van Kleunen earned First Team All-BIG EAST honors, leading the squad in scoring (13.7), while also averaging 6.4 rebounds per contest and shooting a team-best 57.8 percent from the floor. She also helped Liza Karlen to make enormous improvement during her sophomore season.
- Before coming to MU, Raterman served as an assistant for the Miami Redhawks in the 2018-2019 campaign.
- A former standout player at Dayton, Raterman graduated in 2012 after leading Dayton to three NCAA tournament berths and one WNIT appearance. She is the Flyers' second all-time leading scorer and all-time leading rebounder of the modern era with 1,832 points and 915 rebounds.



Khadijah Rushdan Assistant Coach Rutgers (2012)

- Entering her first season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Comes to Marquette after spending the past five seasons as an assistant coach at North Florida.
- Primary duties include player development, scouting and recruiting at Marquette.
- While at North Florida, Rushdan helped develop forward Jazz Bond into the program's first-ever WNBA draft pick.
- Spent one season as an assistant coach at LaSalle and three seasons as an assistant coach at St. Elizabeth High School in Wilmington, Delaware. She was also a member of the coaching staff at the 2022 US Olympic Women's Basketball U16 Trials.
- After a strong collegiate career at Rutgers, she was selected as the 15th overall pick in the 2012 WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks. She spent one season there before playing professionally in Israel in 2012-13.
- As a guard at Rutgers from 2007-12, Rushdan helped her team to NCAA tournament appearances all five seasons, including an Elite Eight in 2007-08 and a Sweet 16 appearance in 2008-09.



Kayla Kleifgen Assistant Coach Eckerd (2015)

- Entering her first season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Comes to Marquette after spending the past seven seasons at Northern Kentucky.
- Primary duties include recruiting, player development of guards, and scouting.
- Spent six seasons as the recruiting coordinator at Northern Kentucky and was promoted to associate head coach for the 2022-23 season.
- While at Northern Kentucky, Kleifgen helped lead the Norse to their first-ever 20-win season at the Division I level in 2019-20. In 2021-22, she assisted the team en route to a 21-8 record, the program's best Division I record.
- Prior to NKU, Kelifgen spent one year at Kentucky as the team's staff support associate.
- As a player, Kleifgen was a four-year player at Eckerd College. She tied Eckerd's career mark by appearing in 110 games over her career and left Eckerd as only the third player in program history to finish with over 700 points and 400 assists.



Jonathan Tsipis Advisor for Scouting and Analytics North Carolina (1996)

- Entering his second season with the Marquette women's basketball program as an advisor for scouting and analytics in 2023-24 after joining the team in September of 2022.
- At Marquette, his roles will include advanced scouting, analytics of team and opponents, working closely with the coaching staff on game plans, and video breakdown.
- Has over 25 years of coaching experience, including nine years as a head coach at the Division I level at Wisconsin and George Washington.
- At Wisconsin, he coached players to eight all-Big Ten honors during his five seasons at the helm and coached the Badgers to their best finish in nearly a decade in 2018-19.
- While at George Washington, Tsipis helped turn the Colonials into a national power. Taking over a program that went 11-18 the year prior to his arrival, GW went 92-38 through four seasons with Tsipis at the helm. In his final two seasons there, the team had a 55-11 record with A-10 titles and NCAA Tournament appearances each year.
- From 2012-14, Tsipis and Duffy worked side-by-side at George Washington as head coach and associate head coach, respectively, a relationship which began during Duffy's playing days at Notre Dame, where Tsipsis an assistant for Muffett McGraw from 2003-2012.
