• Carolina looks to bounce back from its first loss of the season when it plays Arkansas in the third place game in the Bad Boy Mowers Battle 4 Atlantis Friday at 1 p.m.

• The Tar Heels are 4-1 after an 83-81 overtime loss to Villanova on Thursday. The Razorbacks are 4-2 with a home loss to UNCG and an 84-79 loss to Memphis on Thanksgiving.

• This is the first game this season in which both teams are ranked in the AP poll. UNC entered the week No. 14 and the Razorbacks are No. 20.

• RJ Davis scored 23 and Harrison Ingram had 20, but Eric Dixon led the Villanova with 34 points and 10 rebounds, the Wildcats made 32 of 36 free throws and three of UNC's top six players fouled out of the game.

• Cormac Ryan added 18 for the Tar Heels, including a three-pointer with 33 seconds to play to tie the game at 68, but injured an ankle in the final seconds in overtime. His status for Friday's game is unknown at this time.

• UNC dropped to 4-3 all-time on Thanksgiving.

• The Tar Heels made nine three-pointers – four by Ingram, two apiece by Davis and Ryan and one by Elliot Cadeau. UNC has made 21 threes in the first two games in the Bahamas.

• Carolina has not allowed a fastbreak point in the two games in the Bahamas.

• UNC is playing in the Battle 4 Atlantis for the

third time. The loss to Villanova dropped UNC's record in the Battle 4 Atlantis to 5-3.

It was Carolina's first overtime loss since a four-overtime game vs. Alabama on Thanksgiving weekend last season in Portland, Ore.
Armando Bacot had 18 rebounds against the Wildcats, the 12th time in his career he grabbed 18 or more in a game. He has 1,401 rebounds in his career, including 499 on the offensive glass, both all-time UNC records.

• Bacot is averaging 4.6 offensive rebounds per game this season, ahead of his school record marks of 4.19 (in 2022-23) and 4.18 (2021-22) the last two seasons.

UNC-ARKANSAS

• The Tar Heels are 7-3 all-time against Arkansas. The last meeting was 11/24/2017 in Portland, Ore., in PK 80, an 87-68 Tar Heel victory. Luke Maye had 28 points, 16 rebounds and five assists in the win.

• The previous six times UNC played Arkansas were in NCAA Tournament games from 1990-2017. Carolina won four of those six NCAA Tournament, including 1993 and 2017 when the Tar Heels went on to win NCAA titles.

• The Arkansas game is the first of back-toback games for UNC against SEC teams. The Tar Heels host Tennessee November 29 in the first ACC-SEC Challenge.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: Carolina head coach Hubert Davis will conduct a postgame press conference in the media workroom. UNC players will be available for interviews in the team dining room just off the home tunnel. Interviews with the visiting team at the Smith Center will be handled on a per-game basis. The visiting team may use the press room for an interview with the head coach, but it may choose to do so via Zoom or make its coach and players available for questions outside their locker room.

NON-GAMEDAY INTERVIEWS: Throughout the season, Davis and players will be available a day or two before select games. The schedule of these ses-

sions will be updated throughout the season in UNC's media game notes. Interview requests should be made through the athletic communications office. The Tar Heels made 10 of their first 17 three-point attempts, shot 61.1% from the floor in the first half and led 65-26 after 20 minutes.
Carolina had 23 assists on 43 field goals. All five starters and seven total players had multiple

assists, led by Armando Bacot and Elliot Cadeau, who each had four.RJ Davis made five of his first six three-point

attempts and scored 20 of his game-high 22 points in the first half.

• Davis was one of seven Tar Heels to score in double figures.

• Bacot (11/10) and freshman Zayden High (10 points, 11 rebounds, three blocks) had double-doubles.

• Harrison Ingram had 16 points, nine rebounds, three assists and three blocks.

• Creighton Lebo scored 11 points and had two assists in the final seven minutes.

• Cormac Ryan sprained his ankle late in the first half and did not return.

• Seth Trimble (lower body) and Jae'Lyn Withers (upper body) did not play.

• The Tar Heel defense held the Falcons to 26.6% shooting from the floor.

• Carolina out-scored the Falcons, 26-0, in sec-

ond-chance points and 25-0 on the break.

GAME 1: @UNC 86, RADFORD 70

• Carolina improved to 102-12 overall in season openers.

• Carolina has won 19 straight season openers since losing to Santa Clara in Oakland (without starting point guard Raymond Felton) in 2004-05.

• The 86 points were the most by UNC in a season opener since defeating Northern Iowa, 86-69, in the first game in 2017-18.

• The Tar Heels' five starters (Armando Bacot, Cormac Ryan, Harrison Ingram, RJ Davis and Paxson Wojcik) entered the game with 416 combined college starts.

• Carolina improved to 464-86 in the Smith Center, including 224-18 against non-ACC opponents.

• It was Carolina's 24th straight victory when shooting over 50% from the field. The Tar Heels shot 52.5%.

• It was Carolina's 13th straight victory against a non-ACC opponent in the Smith Center.

• Bacot led Carolina with 25 points. It was his 100th double-digit scoring game, his 27th game scoring 20 or more points and his 38th game as UNC's leading scorer.

• He passed Joel Berry II for 13th in UNC career scoring.

Bacot led Carolina with 13 rebounds. It was

his 100th game as Carolina's leading rebounder.
Bacot had five offensive rebounds, moving within two of passing Tyler Hansbrough for the most offensive rebounds at UNC (Hansbrough has 482).

• Bacot recorded the 69th double-double of his UNC career, extending his school record.

• Bacot passed Larry Miller (452) for eighth in free throws made by a Tar Heel. He was 5 for 6 from the line and has made 453 in his career.

• Bacot made 10 of 16 field goals. It was the 10th time in his career he made 10 or more field goals in a game.

Carolina's newcomers (five transfers and two freshmen) combined for 39 points, led by 13 by Cormac Ryan and 12 by Harrison Ingram.
Elliot Cadeau led the Heels with six assists. It is the most assists by a freshman in a Carolina debut since Bobby Frasor recorded seven against Gardner-Webb in the 2005-06 season opener.
Four Tar Heels scored in double figures. It

was Bacot's 100th game in double figures and the 72nd for Davis, 58th for Ryan and 38th for Ingram.

• Sophomore Jalen Washington scored eight points. He topped that figure only one time in 20 games last season.

• Carolina held Radford below 45% (42.4%), out-rebounded the Highlanders, 37-34, and scored more points off turnovers (14-11). The Tar Heels were undefeated in 12 games last

season when they hit those benchmarks.
The Tar Heels made their first five three-point attempts and finished the game 7 for 20. Four different starters made threes for UNC, led by Ryan's three. He made three or more eight times last season while playing for Notre Dame.
Carolina had six turnovers in the first 10

minutes of play and eight in the first half but committed only three in the second half. • Carolina's 46 points were its most in the

first half since scoring 48 against The Citadel on 12/13/22. That was the only time Carolina scored more than 46 first-half points a year ago. • Carolina shot 55.2% from the field in the first half, its best first-half shooting performance in a season opener since shooting 74.2% in the first half against Oakland in 2013.

• Hubert Davis won his 50th game as head coach of the Tar Heels (50-23).

GAME 2: @UNC 90, LEHIGH 68

It was the first time Carolina scored 90 points since defeating Clemson, 91-71, on 2/11/23.
With 22 points, Bacot passed Bobby Lewis and Marcus Paige for 11th in UNC career scoring.

• Bacot (22 points) scored 20 or more points for the 28th time in his career, while Davis (22) scored 20 for the 13th time.

• It was the eighth time Davis and Bacot each scored at least 20 points in the same game. Carolina improved to 8-0 when they both score 20 or more.

• Bacot grabbed six offensive rebounds to pass Tyler Hansbrough for the most in UNC history. Bacot has 487 in 134 games, while Hansbrough had 482 in 142 games.

• Bacot now holds the UNC record for offensive rebounds per game at 3.63. Antawn Jamison is second at 3.62 per game.

• It was Bacot's third career 20/20 game. Bacot did it twice in 2021-22, when he had 29 points/22 rebounds against Virginia and 20 points/22 rebounds vs. in the NCAA East Regional final Saint Peter's.

• It was Bacot's 23rd career game with 15 or rebounds and seventh with 20 or more. Billy Cunningham is the only player in UNC history with more 20-rebound games (12 from 1962-65).

• Bacot recorded a double-double in the first half (12 pts/12 reb). Bacot was the last Tar Heel to achieve a double-double in a half, recording 10 points and 12 rebounds in the first half against Boston College on 1/17/23.

• Carolina improved to 2-0 against Lehigh. Their only other matchup was a 62-58 Carolina victory in Woollen Gym on 1/2/1941.

GAME 3: @UNC 77, UC RIVERSIDE

• Carolina allowed 52 points, the fewest since Saint Peter's scored 49 in the 2022 NCAA Elite Eight in Philadelphia.

• Bacot scored a game-high 21 points. The fifthyear grad student passed Walter Davis for 10th all-time in UNC history. He made his second three-pointer and first since at Boston College on 1/2/22.

• Bacot scored more than 20 points for the 29th time in his career and for the third straight game. Carolina improved to 24-5 when Bacot scores 20 or more points.

• It marked the third time Bacot scored over 20 points in three or more straight games. He had a five-game streak in 2022-23 and a three-game streak in 2021-22.

• Washington scored 11 points, his second career game in double figures (13 at Virginia on 1/10/23). He made his first two career three-pointers and set career highs in offensive rebounds (3) and blocks (2).

• Trimble tied his career high with 11 points. He scored 11 vs. Wake Forest on 1/4/23. It was the second time he has scored in double figures.

• Withers had a career-high three blocks.

- Cadeau scored a season-high eight points.
 Carolina's bench scored a season-high 34
- points (18 and 24 in the previous two games). • Davis's field goal with 17:01 remaining in the second half ended a 7:50 period without a field goal for Carolina dating back to the final 4:51 of

the first half.
Carolina started the second half on a 19-0 run as UC Riverside did not score until 10:33 remaining in the second half. Carolina also had a 17-0 run in the first half.

• Carolina was out-rebounded, 38-37. It was the first time Carolina was out-rebounded in a win since beating Syracuse on 1/24/23.

• It was Carolina's 15th straight win against non-ACC opponents in the Smith Center.

• It was the fourth time in the last 30-plus seasons UNC wore blue uniforms at home: vs. Duke on February 8, 2020; vs. UNCW on 12/31/2013; and vs. UConn on 12/6/1991, in the ACC/Big East Challenge.

GAME 4: UNC 91, NORTHERN IOWA 69 BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS FIRST ROUND

• Carolina scored a season-high 91 points, including 56 in the second half (most in a half through four games).

• Carolina trailed at the half for the first time this season but began the second half on a 32-6 run to go from six points behind to leading by 20 with 11:24 to play.

Carolina improved to 5-2 all-time in the Battle 4 Atlantis. The 91 points were the most by the Tar Heels in the Bahamas in seven games.
Carolina trailed several times in the first half by eight points. The largest deficit in its first three games was three points. UNI led 10-2 at the first TV timeout and 39-31 with 1:17 to play in the half.

• Carolina trailed 41-35 at halftime, the first

time this season an opponent led at the half.

three-pointers, including a career-high four by Ingram and three by both Davis and Ryan.
UNC was 3 of 13 from three-point range in the first half and nine of 13 in the second. It was UNC's best three-point percentage in a half (.692) since shooting 75% (9 of 12) in the first half against Florida State on 2/12/22.

The Tar Heels made all nine of their second-half threes in the first 11:03 of the half.
Carolina made its first change in the starting lineup this season as Trimble made his third career start. He previously started against Notre Dame and at Virginia last season. Wojcik had started the first three games.

• Withers started the second half in place of Trimble.

• Six Tar Heels scored in double figures for the first time since 2/6/2021 at Duke.

• Ingram led UNC with a game-high 16 points. Ingram also had a game-high 10 rebounds for his first double-double as a Tar Heel and sixth of his career.

• Ingram made a career-high four three-pointers. He had made three seven times over his first two seasons at Stanford. He made one three in the first half and three in the first seven minutes in the second half.

• Ryan was scoreless in the first half (0-5 FG, 0-3 3FG) but hit his first three attempts in the first 3:53 of the second half to help give UNC a 51-42 lead. Ryan, who made three 3FGs in the opener vs. Radford, had missed 11 consecutive three-point attempts before making three straight to begin the second half.

• Ryan's 15 points were his season high as a Tar Heel. Ryan also matched his previous career high with three blocked shots, all in the first half.

• Withers made his first three of the season and had a season-high five points by halftime. He finished with a season-high 11 points, his 31st career game in double figures.

• Cadeau was 5 for 9 from the floor and scored a season-high 15 points.

• Carolina forced 17 turnovers for the second game in a row and scored a season-high 25 points off UNI's 17 turnovers. It was the most points off turnovers since scoring 32 in a home win over Wake Forest early last January.

• Carolina made 27 free throws and 26 field goals. The Tar Heels had season highs in free throws made (27) and attempts (31) and shot a season-best 87.1% from the stripe.

The Tar Heels had 14 assists on 26 field goals.
UNI shot 60% from the floor in the first half (15 of 25), the first time an opponent shot 60% in a half since NC State shot 64.5% in the second half on 2/19/23.

• The Tar Heels then held UNI to 32.1% from the floor and made 50% from the floor in the second half.

GAME 5: VILLANOVA 83, UNC 81 (OT) BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS SEMIFINAL

• It was Carolina's first overtime game of the season and first since beating Ohio State in New York on 12/17/2022.

• Davis (23) and Ingram (20) led UNC in scoring, both with season highs. It was the 14th 20-point game of Davis's career and the third for Ingram. Both of Ingram's previous 20-point efforts came while playing for Stanford.

• Davis, Ingram and Ryan (18) combined to score 61 of UNC's 81 points.

• Ingram made a career-high four three-pointers

for the second consecutive game. Prior to the UNI game he had made three 3FGs seven times. Yesterday, he was 4 for 6 from behind the arc; today he made 4 of 5.

Ingram fouled out with 3:44 to play in regulation (the first time in 70 games in his career he fouled out). He was one of three Tar Heels to foul out (also Withers with 3:08 left in the second half and Cadeau with 4:08 to play in overtime).
Carolina was whistled for a season-high 30 fouls, most since committing 33 at Louisville on 1/31/2015.

• Villanova was 32 for 36 from the free throw line, the most made and attempted free throws by an opponent since Wake Forest was 33 for 42 last season in Winston-Salem. The Wildcats were 11 for 13 from the line in the first half, 12 of 13 in the second and 9 of 10 in overtime.

• Villanova's free throw percentage (.889) was the third-highest ever by an opponent with 36 or more attempts and sixth-best for 30 or more attempts.

Davis passed Danny Green and Ty Lawson for 43rd in UNC history with 1,383 points. Luke Maye and Kris Lang are tied for 41st with 1,392.
Cadeau had a game-high five assists (has eight assists and zero turnovers in the two games in the Bahamas) and led UNC in plus-minus for the first time season at +14. Cormac Ryan was next at +7.

Bacot had a game-high and season-high 18 rebounds. It was his 24th career game with 15 or more rebounds and 12th with 18 or more.
Bacot raised his rebounding total to 1,401 and offensive rebounds total to 499, extending both UNC records.

Carolina is 68-61 all-time in overtime games, including 4-2 under head coach Hubert Davis.
Withers made his first start as a Tar Heel. He made 64 starts over the previous three seasons at Louisville, including 29 of 32 games in 2022-23.

• Eric Dixon led Villanova with 34 points and 10 boards. The 34 points were the most by an opponent since Wake Forest's Tyree Appleby scored 35 on 2/7/23 in Winston-Salem.

• Carolina fell to 5-3 all-time in the Battle 4 Atlantis, including 0-2 in semifinal games (lost to Michigan in the 2019 semifinal).

• Carolina led by nine points in each half. The Tar Heels led, 34-32, at the half, the first time UNC has lost when leading at the half since 1/10/23 when it led Virginia, 29-27, in Charlottesville.

• Carolina is 11-6 all-time against Villanova. This was the first time the teams have played since the 2016 NCAA championship game, which Villanova won, 77-74.
