NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The SEC leads the nation with seven teams advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Eight SEC teams were among the field of 64 teams competing for the 42nd NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship.
- The eight selections were second-most among all conferences.
- Six of the SEC's teams were seeded and hosted their first round game.
- The six seeded teams are the most among all conferences.
- Over the last seven years, the SEC has earned 52 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of more than seven per year – with all 14 member institutions making at least two appearances during that span.
- The SEC has had at least one team in the NCAA Quarterfinals in each of the last eight years.
- Eight different schools have made NCAA Round of 16 appearances over the last nine years.
- #6 Alabama** – 6th appearance ... 3rd consecutive ... 6-5-0 (.545) all-time record.
- #2 Arkansas** – 10th appearance ... 8th consecutive ... 13-6-4 (.652) all-time record.
- #4 Georgia** – 11th appearance ... 2nd consecutive ... 8-10-1 (.447) all-time record.
- LSU** – 9th appearance ... 3rd consecutive ... 3-8-2 (.308) all-time record.
- #6 Mississippi State** – 3rd appearance ... 2nd consecutive ... 2-2-0 (.500) all-time record.
- #7 South Carolina** – 17th appearance ... 11th consecutive ... 24-15-3 (.607) all-time record.
- Tennessee** – 15th appearance ... 5th appearance in 8 years ... 17-12-3 (.578) all-time.
- #8 Texas A&M** – 28th appearance ... Played in 28 of last 29 tournaments ... 40-24-9 (.610) all-time.

NEWS & NOTES

- The SEC is the No. 1 ranked conference in the NCAA RPI.
- The SEC is the only conference in the nation to have all of its members ranked in the Top 125 of the RPI.
- Five SEC teams are receiving mention in the October 31 United Soccer Coaches poll: South Carolina 13th, Mississippi State 21st, and Alabama 25th. Georgia is among the teams receiving votes.
- Arkansas secured its fourth SEC Championship in school history. Each of those four titles have come in the last four seasons.
- Six different teams – Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, South Carolina, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC regular season titles in the last 12 seasons.
- Georgia won its first SEC Tournament title with a 1-0 win over Arkansas in the championship game.
- Eight different teams – Auburn, Florida, Georgia, LSU, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC Tournament championships since 2011.
- Arkansas was the preseason favorite to win the 2023 Southeastern Conference women's soccer title in voting by the league's 14 head coaches. Alabama, South Carolina, Georgia, and Texas A&M rounded out the top five.
- The SEC returns 50 percent (14 of 28) of the players that earned first or second team All-SEC honors last season. Six first team selections return for the 2023 campaign. Included in the group of returners are 2022 third team All-Americans Anna Podojil (Arkansas) and Felicia Knox (Alabama).
- At least twenty-six regular season matches will be televised to a national television audience this year on SEC Network and ESPNU. Additionally, more than 100 matches will be available digitally on SEC Network+.
- The SEC had a record-tying teams selected to participate in the 2022 NCAA Tournament. Seven of those teams earned national seeds.
- Over the last six years, the SEC has earned 44 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of more than seven per year – with all 14 member institutions mak-

ing at least two appearances during that span. Eight different SEC teams have advanced to the Round of 16 since 2013 and the league has placed teams in the NCAA quarterfinals in each of the last nine seasons.

- Alabama won the 2022 SEC Championship with a 10-0-0 league record. South Carolina earned its third SEC Tournament championship with a 1-0 win over Alabama in Pensacola, Fla.
- The SEC's balance has been shown in league play as six different teams – Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, South Carolina, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC regular season titles in the last 12 seasons. Also, seven different teams – Auburn, Florida, LSU, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC Tournament championships since 2011.
- In 2022, Alabama's Wes Hart was named SEC Coach of the Year honor; Riley Mattingly Parker was voted SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year and SEC Forward of the Year; Alabama's Felicia Knox was selected as SEC Midfielder of the Year; Alabama's Reyna Reyes was voted SEC Defender of the Year; Ole Miss's Ashley Orkus was picked as the SEC Goalkeeper of the Year; and Alabama's Giana Paul was awarded SEC Freshman of the Year.
- Seven SEC players earned All-America honors from the United Soccer Coaches, including first team selections Mattingly-Parker and Reyes. South Carolina's Jylissa Harris earned second team honors while Knox, Georgia's Abby Boyan, Tennessee's Taylor Huff, and Arkansas's Anna Podojil were third team picks.
- SEC's players have garnered 73 All-America awards from the United Soccer Coaches since 2011. SEC players have earned 18 first team All-America honors during that time and three have earned multiple first team honors (South Carolina's Sabrina D'Angelo in 2013 and 2014; South Carolina's Savannah McCaskill in 2016 and 2017; and South Carolina's Fisk in 2018 and 2019).
- A record 48 SEC players earned CSC Academic All-District honors this past season.

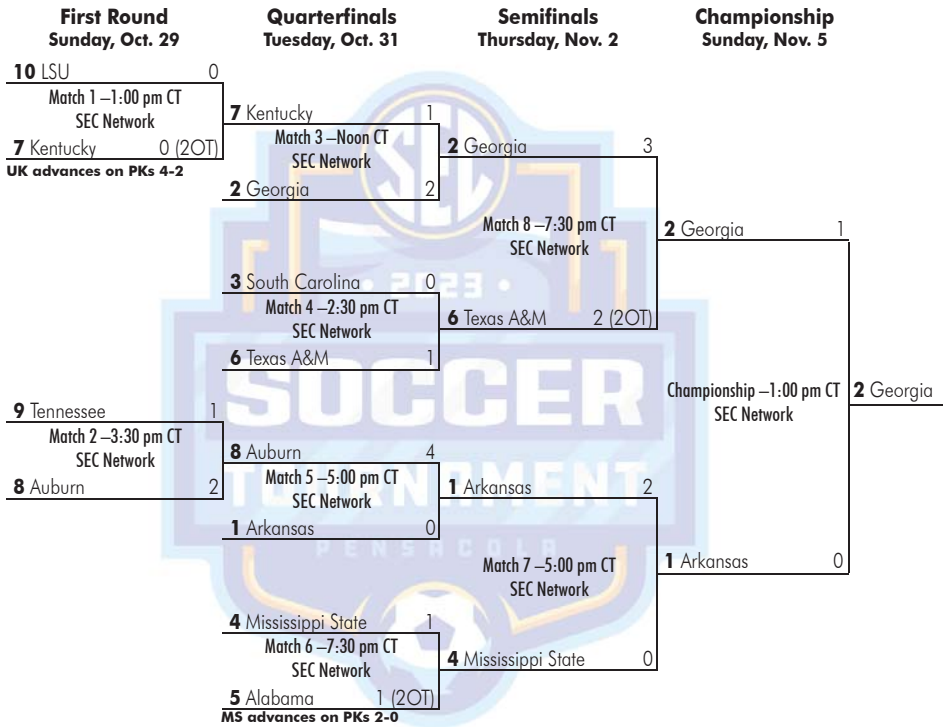

There shall be a single-elimination tournament of the top ten teams played at the conclusion of the regular season schedule. The tournament champion shall be the Conference representative to the NCAA championship.

The top ten teams with the highest point total, regardless of divisions, will participate in the tournament, with the two division champions serving as the top two seeds. The following point system is utilized to determine regular season standings and seeding for the tournament: a win counts as three points, a tie as one, and a loss as zero points. If a game(s) is cancelled, neither team will receive a point and the standings will be determined by average points per game.

Tie-Breaker Procedures

The tournament will be seeded 1-14 based on the point system implemented to determine regular season standings. The two division champions shall be the top two seeds. If teams are tied, the following procedures, in order as follows, will be used to break the tie:

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Head-to-head competition between the tied teams.
- B. Points earned versus common opponents.
- C. Goal differential versus common opponents.
- D. Goals scored versus common opponents.
- E. Won-Lost record of the two teams versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- F. Goal differential versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- G. Goals scored versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- H. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** The following procedure will be used until the tie is broken. If at any time this tie breaker results in only two remaining tied teams, then the two-team tiebreaker will be used beginning with Subsection A in that procedure and continuing from that point:

A. If all teams have played one another, then most points earned in those matches only.

B. If all teams have not played, but one team has defeated all teams in the tie break, then that team breaks the tie and shall be placed highest. Remaining teams will continue with the tie break procedure.

C. If all teams have not played one another and a team does not have all wins over the tied teams, then use Subsection B in the two-team tie break procedures and continue through the two team tie-break procedures until ties between all teams are broken (except Subsection H will read "if three or more teams are still tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw").
