KEEP AN EYE ON IT

Illinois women's basketball returned 93.4% of its scoring from the 2022-23 season and is believed to be the second-highest percentage across NCAA WBB. That mark breaks down to 2,251 of 2,410 points returning for the Illini. Among those returners are all five starters and 10 total players from last season.

The Illini added four newcomers - two freshmen and two transfers - into the mix this season.

GAME NOTES

OPENING TIP

The 50th season of Illinois women's basketball continues this week with the West Palm Beach Classic. UI will face Arkansas (12/20) and UTEP (12/21) from Keiser University in Florida.

Mike Koon will call the action for the Illini on the Busey Bank Illini Sports Network (1400 AM / 93.9 FM). Streaming, audio, and stats links are also available at FightingIllini.com.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- Arkansas sits at 9-3 on this season heading into Wednesday's contest.
- Arkansas went 24-13 last season, advancing to the Great Eight of the WNIT
- UTEP is 4-6 heading into West Palm Beach Classic action and faces UIC on Wednesday.
- UTEP went 20-12 last season & played in the WNIT.

ALL-TIME SERIES INFO

Wednesday's game marks the third all-time meeting against Arkansas, and the first to be played in a neutral setting. Illinois leads the series 2-0 with a win on both teams' home courts in 1996 and 1997.

Thursday's tilt against UTEP will be the first meeting between the sides.

BIG TEN PLAY BEGINS

Illinois played its Big Ten opener at home for the first time since the 2019-20 campaign. The Illini were in search of their first win in a conference opener since the 2016-17 season, when the Orange and Blue defeated Iowa, 70-65, on Dec. 28, 2016, to begin the BIG slate.

COACH GREEN FACES HER ALMA MATER

For the first time in her career as both an assistant and head coach, Shauna Green (the former Shauna Geronzin), coached against her alma mater, Canisius, on Sunday, Nov. 26. The Illini took down the Golden Griffins, 90-58.

Wearing No. 34 for the Griffs from 1998-2002, Green scored 2,012 career points, the most of any men's or women's player - a record which still stands. She also became the program's all-time leading rebounder with 910 boards - a mark that now ranks second. Green was Named 1999 MAAC Rookie of the Year and was also voted 2002 Canisius Female Athlete of the Year. She was a four-time All-MAAC selection and three-time All-MAAC First-Team honoree. She was enshrined into the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame in 2012.

CITI SHAMROCK CLASSIC IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

The Fighting Illini faced off against No. 16/14 Notre Dame from the nation's capital on Saturday, Nov. 18, in the second-annual Citi Shamrock Classic. Action from Entertainment & Sports Arena - home of the Washington Mystics. The Irish won the outing 79-68. The game was televised live on NBC and streamed on Peacock. The nationally televised game marked Illinois women's basketball's first-ever game aired on NBC or Peacock.

In addition Saturday's highly anticipated matchup on the court, Friday featured a women's leadership luncheon, offering both teams an opportunity to hear from a select group of the most powerful women in business and sports. Additionally, both teams participated in a community service initiative presented by Gatorade, which included a visit to the National Museum of African

American History and Culture.

FIELD TRIP DAY 2023

- Illinois hosted its annual Field Trip Day on Nov. 15, 2023, when the Illini took on Saint Peter's.
- Attendance was called at 11,563 - the 4th largest crowd in program history and top mark since 2/20/00.
- The first of the "we want 100" chant from the students started in the third quarter. With 56 seconds left in the game, Shay Bollin hit a jumper to push the Illini into triple digits for the 103-33 victory.
- The 70-point margin of victory is the third-largest in program history.
- The Illini moved 6-1 in Field Trip Day games.

EXHIBITION EXPOSITION

No. 23 Illinois began the second year of the Shauna Green era in Champaign with a resounding 121-60 victory over Truman State in the team's lone exhibition game of the 2023-24 campaign. Green used the pre-season game to give playing time to all 14 players, while 12 different scorers registered at least one point in the blowout victory, including eight Illini in double figures.

Illinois is 2-0 in exhibitions since Green's arrival.

PEEBLES CLIMBS CAREER GAMES ALL-TIME LIST

Jada Peebles is the longest tenured Illini on the squad, playing all five of her collegiate season at Illinois. As of Dec. 19, 2023, Peebles has appeared in 118 games, which sits just outside Illinois' top-15.

Cook is one of nine Big Ten representatives to earn a spot on the preseason list this season. She's also the second athlete in Illinois program history named to the prestigious watch list, joining Jenna Smith from the 2009-10 season.

COOK LANDS ON LIEBERMAN AWARD WATCHLIST

For the first time in Illinois program history, a Fighting Illini player was named to the Nancy Lieberman Top-20 Preseason Watch List as Makira Cook was announced as an honoree on Oct. 16. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) have given the award annually since 2000 to the top point guard in the NCAA.

A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates. To be considered, candidates must exhibit the floor leadership, play-making, and ball-handling skills of Class of 1996 Hall-of-Famer Nancy Lieberman.

COOK NAMED TO NAISMITH POTY WATCHLIST

Preseason accolades continue to roll in for Illinois women's basketball senior Makira Cook, as the point guard has been named to the 50-player 2023-24 Jersey Mike's Naismith Women's Player of the Year Watch List. Cook is the third Fighting Illini player in program history to land on the Naismith preseason list. She joins Tauja Catchings and Susan Blausner, who were both selected to the list ahead of the 1999-2000 season.

RETURNING SCORING

Illinois women's basketball returned 93.4% of its scoring from the 2022-23 season, which is believed to be the second-highest percentage across NCAA WBB. That breaks down to 2,251 of 2,410 points returning for the Illini. In those returners are all five starters from last season and 10 total players.

This season, 10 different Illini have scored double digits.

NCAA COACHING LIMIT INCREASE

With the NCAA's coaching limit increase going into effect on July 1, Emily Durr and Jenna Giacone were elevated to assistant coaches on Shauna Green's Illinois women's basketball staff. Durr adds on-court coaching duties in addition to her director of recruiting operations responsibilities, while Giacone adds on-court coaching duties on top of her director of scouting and player development role in year two on Green's Illini staff.

Both Durr and Giacone followed Green from her previous stop at Dayton. Durr served one season as an administrative associate with the Flyers, while Giacone played six seasons under Green at UD.

HAVE A NIGHT, GENESIS BRYANT

For the second time in as many seasons, Genesis Bryant delivered a career-high night in the Illini's season-opening game. This season, Bryant scored 32 points on 75% shooting to go along with four rebounds and four assists. She shot 10-for-11 from 2, 2-for-5 from 3 (12-for-16), and 6-for-7 from the free-throw line. She was the first Illini to record at least 30 points in a game since Makira Cook scored 33 points at Indiana on Dec. 4, 2022.

Bryant's Game Score of 26.8 was the top mark in NCAA WBB on Nov. 7. "Game score" is a metric giving a measurement of a player's productivity for a single game.

BRYANT GOES FOR 30, AGAIN

In the Illini's 79-68 loss to No. 16/14 Notre Dame from the nation's capital, Genesis Bryant put on a show on the biggest stage, scoring 31 points. The output marked Bryant's second 30-point game of the season and her career. Bryant is the first Illini to have multiple 30-point games in a season since 2010-11 when Karisma Penn did so as a sophomore.

ILLINI RETURN TO THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

For the first time since 2003, Illinois went dancing after earning a berth in the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament. The NCAA Tournament appearance marked the ninth in program history, while Illinois is 8-9 all-time across its 17 tournament games.

ILLINOIS ATHLETICS IN ELITE COMPANY

Last season, Illinois was selected for both the men's and women's NCAA basketball tournaments in the same year as the football team qualified for a bowl game. The Fighting Illini were one of only 14 teams nationally to achieve the feat in 2022-23, and one of only four Big Ten teams along with Iowa, Maryland, and Purdue.

The other schools to appear in both NCAA basketball tournaments and a bowl game were Alabama, Baylor, Connecticut, Duke, Mississippi State, North Carolina State, UCLA, USC, Tennessee, and Texas.

It was the first time Illinois has achieved the feat since 1999-2000 and the third time overall with the first occurring in 1985-86.

RETURN TO THE RANKINGS

For the first time since Nov. 27, 2000, Illinois Women's Basketball was ranked in the Associated Press (AP) Top-25 Rankings on Jan. 9, 2023. After 8,072 days, the Fighting Illini returned to the AP Poll at No. 24. Throughout the 2022-23 campaign, Illinois appeared in the AP poll four times.

For the first time since the 1999-2000 campaign, Illinois women's basketball was ranked in the Associated Press Preseason Poll, coming in at No. 23 to begin head coach Shauna Green's second season at the helm.

The 2023-24 season marks the fourth time in program history that Illinois has appeared in the AP Preseason Poll. Prior to this year, the Illini had appeared ahead of the 1997-98 (No. 7), 1998-99 (No. 25), and 1999-2000 (No. 12) campaigns – all under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz.

The Fighting Illini program has appeared in 68 AP Polls total across 10 different seasons now. Shauna Green joins Theresa Greutz, Laura Golden and Jane Schroeder as Illini coaches to lead a ranked Illinois squad. Green was the lone coach to achieve a Top-25 ranking in her first year leading the program.

HOME ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

Across its 15 home games during the 2022-23 season, Illinois Women's Basketball saw 52,295 fans fill the State Farm Center en route to a 12-3 record. That total attendance ranked 5th in program history and made Shauna Green the only head coach to bring in 50,000 or more fans in her first season with the Illini.

In Illinois' season - and home - opener, the attendance of 2,680 marked the largest ticketed season-opening crowd at State Farm Center since 2000 (3,954). Through seven home games, Illinois has a combined attendance of 31,370 for an average of 4,481 a game.

FIRST SEASONS AT A NEW SCHOOL

Shauna Green quickly took Illinois women's basketball out to a refreshing start and has sustained that success better than anyone. Green was one of 38 head coaches in their first season at a new school last season. The Illinois squad was one of just 10 programs under a new coach last season to have secured 20 or more wins and one of seven to make the NCAA Tournament.

THE ILLINI TURNAROUND

Illinois secured the biggest one-year Big Ten win improvement in program history last season, finishing with 10 more conference wins (11) during the 2022-23 campaign than the Illini had during the 2021-22 season (1). This ties the best one-year Big Ten win improvement in Big Ten Conference history. Illinois won 15 more games (22) than the 2021-22 total of seven. The one-year overall improvement set a new program record, and was the third-largest improvement in Big Ten history.

BRYANT'S TRIPLE-DOUBLE LEADS TO BIG HONORS

- Following just the second start of her collegiate career (Dec. 21, 2022), Illinois junior transfer Genesis Bryant turned in a triple-double performance, etching her name in the record books and earning herself Co-Big Ten Player of the Week honors.
- Bryant's award marked the first Player of the Week award by the Illini women's basketball program since the 2013-14 campaign.
- Bryant's triple-double line read 20 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds - which also marked the first double-double of her career.
- Bryant became only the sixth player in Big Ten history to score 20 points in a points/rebounds/assists triple-double, and third since 2009-10 (four by Iowa's Caitlin Clark last year; one by Michigan State's Tori Jankoska in 2016-17).

THE SHAUNA GREEN COACHING TREE

- Shauna Green's first trio of assistant coaches at Illinois were no strangers to her or each other. Green, Calamity McEntire, DeAntoine Beasley and Ryan Gensler were on the Dayton Women's Basketball staff together for four seasons from 2017-21. With those four coaches leading from the sidelines, the Flyers posted a 79-34 overall record across four seasons.
- Green, Beasley and Gensler stuck together for the 2021-22 campaign at Dayton, while McEntire headed to Texas to be an assistant coach with the Longhorns.
- Together, Green, McEntire, Beasley and Gensler finished a combined 101-42 between Dayton and Illinois. The 100th win together came in the regular-season finale at Rutgers.
- On March 29, 2023, Ryan Gensler was announced as the head coach of the Akron women's basketball program.
- With the departure of Gensler, Green hired Britney Anderson after her time at Stanford (2020-23), Virginia Tech (2015-20), and Radford (2013-15).

UBBEN UPGRADE

Construction on the \$40 million renovation and expansion of the Ubben Basketball Complex has been completed with the Illinois programs back in their state-of-the-art facility. The project added approximately 40,000 square feet to the existing structure, while remodeling large portions of the existing building. Two new half courts were added to both the men's and women's gym space, giving the two programs additional areas to work on development while not disrupting full-court action. The project included a new two-story strength and conditioning addition, significantly increased the size of the locker rooms and players lounges, and included a state-of-the-art sports medicine area featuring hydrotherapy and sports science spaces. New coaches' office spaces and a grand entry lobby also were included in the project.

BATTLE OF THE BALL, BOARDS & PAINT

Head Coach Shauna Green has emphasized the importance of the battle of the ball (turnovers), boards (rebounds) and paint (points in paint) to the new-look Illini squad. Stats below are listed as ILLINOIS/OPPONENT.

Illinois Women's Basketball first-year head coach Shauna Green led one of the biggest turnarounds in college athletics, and did so at an astounding pace.

Green and her team have reinvigorated both the program and the Illinois fan base, making the Fighting Illini one of the most attractive prospects for long-overdue postseason play.

- Green only had her complete 13-player roster together since the end of summer when international players arrived after playing for national teams.
- Despite the program not being ranked since the 2000-01 season, Green needed just 10 weeks of play to produce a ranked Illini squad.
- Illinois secured the first top-25 win of Green's career over No. 12/10 Iowa on New Year's Day, a 90-86 victory.
- The average attendance for Illinois women's basketball home games tripled to nearly 3,500 fans per contest since 2021-22
- Illinois made major improvements on both ends of the court, resulting in an 10.1 scoring margin this season - ranking 43rd in the nation.

Shauna Green was named the 10th head coach of the Fighting Illini women's basketball program history on Monday, March 21, 2022.

Year one at Illinois saw Green lead the program to new heights both on and off the court. The Illini finished 22-10 (11-7 B1G) and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 20 seasons. Illinois found itself ranked in the AP Top 25 for the first time since 2000 and would appear in four polls, ranking as high as No. 21. Green is the only Illini head coach to have a team ranked in their first season at UI.

Green was one of 10 WBCA NCAA Division I National Coach of the Year finalists in 2022-23. Throughout the season, Green was tabbed ESPN Coach of the Week (Dec. 19, 2022), Just Women's Sports' Midseason NCAA Coach of the Year Frontrunner (Jan. 13, 2023), and was listed on the Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Late Season Watch List (Feb. 15, 2023).

Across its 15 home games during the 2022-23 season, Illinois Women's Basketball saw 52,295 fans fill the State Farm Center en route to a 12-3 record. That total attendance ranks fifth in program history and makes Green the only head coach to bring in 50,000 or more fans in her first season with the Illini.

With five returners from the 2021-22 Illinois squad that posted a 7-20 record, Green delivered the largest turnaround in program history and one of the top all-time in Big Ten history. The 15-win improvement from last season's 7-20 campaign set a new best turnaround in program history and ranks third best in Big Ten history. In league play, Illinois tallied 10 more wins than the 2021-22 mark (1-13), the best turnaround in program history, which tied for the best all-time in the Big Ten.

Green arrived at Illinois following six successful seasons as the head coach at the University of Dayton, where her teams captured five Atlantic 10 regular season championships and qualified each year of her tenure for postseason play, including four appearances in the NCAA Tournament. During the 2021-22 season, the three-time Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year led the Flyers to the Atlantic 10 championship and an opening round victory in the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season with a final record of 26-6.

Green took over the Illini program after compiling a record of 127-50 (.718) with the Flyers, and 156-75 (.675) overall, which includes two seasons at Loras College. Previously, Green was an assistant coach at Dayton. She also had assistant coaching stints at Northwestern University and Providence College.

A native of Clinton, Iowa, Green began her coaching career as a head coach at Loras College in Dubuque, Iowa, in 2006 and 2007, where she compiled a record of 29-25. Green gained Big Ten experience in 2016 as an assistant at Northwestern prior to being named head coach at Dayton before the 2016-17 season, where she had been an assistant coach from 2013-15. The Flyers advanced to the NCAA Tournament all three years Green was an assistant, including a memorable run to the 2015 NCAA Elite Eight. She also served as an assistant at Providence College from 2008-12 before her move to Dayton.

A 2002 graduate of Canisius College, Green received a degree in business marketing. While at Canisius, the former Shauna Geronzin became one of the greatest basketball players in Griffins' history. A four-time letterwinner from 1998-2002, Green earned All-Conference honors each year, including three times being selected First-Team All-Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. She is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 2,012 points, and she remains second in career rebounding. Green was the Canisius Female Athlete of the Year in 2002 and, in 2012, was inducted into the Canisius College Sports Hall of Fame.

Green later earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in athletic administration from Loras. She and her husband, Andy, have one son, Matteo.
