OPENING TIP

- Oklahoma and Arkansas will compete in the third Crimson & Cardinal Classic on Saturday, Dec. 9 at BOK Center in Tulsa, Okla. The Sooners and Razorbacks have split the two previous meetings. OU won the opening game in 2021 and Arkansas evened the tally in 2022.
- » Oklahoma is ranked 14th (games through 12/6) overall and fourth in the Big 12 in the NET. Eight Big 12 teams are in the top 50. Arkansas is 112th overall and 11th in the SEC.
- The Sooners are one of five NCAA DI programs with their football and men's basketball teams in their respective AP Top-25 Polls (12/4). OU is joined by Arizona, Texas, Tennessee and James Madison.
- » Oklahoma is one of 13 teams that have remained undefeated to start the 2023-24 season. Oklahoma is joined by fellow Big 12 members Baylor, Houston, BYU, Cincinnati and TCU.
- » The Sooners earned their first victory in the BIG EAST-Big 12 Battle on Tuesday, Dec. 5, beating Providence 72-51 at Lloyd Noble Center. OU had lost its four previous Battle meetings. Against the Friars, junior Javian McCollum tallied a team-high 19 points and added seven rebunds. Sophomore Milos Uzan recorded his first double-double in the Crimson and Cream, finishing with 17 points and 12 rebounds.
- » Oklahoma improved to 8-0 with its victory over Providence marking the first season since the 2015-16 Final Four campaign OU remained perfect through the first eight games. In the previous 20 seasons, the Sooners have won their first eight games three times (2008-09, 2015-16 & 2023-24). OU finished the 2008-09 campaign 30-6 and advanced to the Elite Eight. The Sooners reached their fifth Final Four in 2015-16, finishing with a 29-7 mark overall.
- » With OU's victory against the Friars, Porter Moser achieved his first 8-0 start as a head coach. During the 2017-18 Final Four campaign at Loyola-Chicago, Moser guided the Ramblers to a 7-0 mark before dropping its first game of the season at Boise State.
- » Oklahoma returned to the Field House on Thursday, Nov. 30 and topped Arkansas-Pine Bluff 107-86, earning the first regular season victory in McCasland since the 2012-13 slate. OU set a men's basketball student attendance record against the Golden Lions, packing 3,124 students into the Field House. Sophomore **Otega Oweh** matched his career high with 20 points on 9-for-11 shooting.
- » OU won the 2023 Rady Children's Invitational with a 72-70 victory over then-No. 23/RV USC. Oweh's last-second tip-in sealed Oklahoma's victory and tournament championship. McCollum was named tournament MVP and averaged 16.0 points, 3.0 assists and 1.5 rebounds per outing. McCollum and Oweh were selected to the all-tournament team. Oweh tallied 14.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per contest. The Sooners opened the two-day, two-game tournament in San Diego with a 79-67 victory over lowa.
- **» McCollum** ranks 11th among NCAA DI active career leaders in free throw percentage (88.0%). In 59 career games, McCollum has made 146 free throws in 166 attempts.
- » Under **Porter Moser**, Oklahoma is 9-2 in non-conference neutral site games, including victories over USC and lowa in 2023-24 and wins over Nebraska, Seton Hall, Ole Miss and Florida in 2022-23. OU's two losses were to Utah State in the 2021 Myrtle Beach Invitational Championship game and Arkansas in the 2022 Crimson & Cardinal Classic.
- » Since the start of the 2018-19 season, OU is 12-2 against SEC teams, including a perfect 3-0 mark in 2018-19, 2-0 in 2019-20 and 2-0 in 2020-21. Oklahoma's 93-69 victory against then-No. 2/2 Alabama in 2023 was the Sooners' first win over an AP top-two team since OU knocked off No. 1 Kansas in the 2002 Big 12 Tournament. The 24-point victory margin was the largest in program history against an AP top-five team and it was the third-largest victory margin by an unranked team against an AP top-two team.

The Sooners improved to 8-0 for the first time since the 2015-16 season. Junior **Javian McCollum** led the Sooners with 19 points on 7-for-16 shooting and added seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. Sophomore **Milos Uzan** recorded his first double-double in the Crimson and Cream, finishing with 17 points and 12 rebounds. Senior **Sam Godwin** added 12 points and sophomore **Otega Oweh** tallied 13.

>> The Sooners entered the break up 35-31. Providence captured the lead for less than a minute in the second frame before the Oklahoma defense clamped down, holding the Friars to 20 second-half points. OU won the rebounding battle, pulling down 40 boards to Providence's 23. The Sooners recorded 16 second chance points compared to the Friars' two.

SOPHOMORE SEASON

» Otega Oweh appeared in 28 games and made nine starts in 2022-23, tallying 134 points, 59 rebounds and 33 steals. In eight games this season, Oweh has recorded 123 points, 36 rebounds and 17 steals. The Newark, N.J., product has buried seven 3-pointers, improving on the one made triple last season. Oweh has recorded seven 10-plus point games this season, eclipsing his double-digit point game tally from 2022-23.

» Oklahoma holds a 70-25 record at Lloyd Noble Center since 2017. The Sooners have won 82.8% (603-125) of their games at LNC since the building opened in 1975. OU's winning percentage at Lloyd Noble Center is second in the Big 12 only to Kansas' 87.9% at Allen Fieldhouse (850-117).

>> Under Porter Moser, Oklahoma is 27-2 when shooting 50% or greater from the field. OU shot 56.0% in the 2023-24 season opener against Central Michigan, 55.2% against Texas State, 50.0% against USC and 57.1% against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. The Sooners were 9-1 in 2022-23 and 14-1 in 2021-22. Oklahoma won the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational last season and shot 50% or greater in each of the three contests against Nebraska. Seton Hall and Ole Miss.

2024 BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

» Oklahoma will compete in the 2024 Battle 4 Atlantis Nov. 27-29, 2024. The Sooners are joined by Arizona, Creighton, Davidson, Gonzaga, Indiana, Louisville and West Virginia. The 12-game, three-day tournament is played in the Imperial Arena, a grand ballroom transformed into a unique basketball venue.

2023-24 PRESEASON POLL

» Oklahoma was selected 12th out of 14 teams in the 2023-24 Big 12 Preseason Poll. The Sooners were ahead of conference newcomers BYU and UCF, who were selected 13th and 14th, respectively.

» Milos Uzan, Otega Oweh, Sam Godwin, Yaya Keita, Luke Northweather and Jake Moser compile the group of returners from the 2022-23 squad. Uzan appeared in all 32 games and made 24 starts. Oweh started nine games last season and appeared in 28 contests. Godwin, who joined the Sooners as a preferred walk-on, appeared in all 32 games and earned a scholarship following the conclusion of last season. Keita appeared in two games before a season-ending injury and Northweather redshirted.

>> Uzan was named to the 2022-23 Big 12 All-Freshmen Team, marking the second OU selection in as many seasons. In conference action, the Las Vegas product averaged 9.5 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.8 assists per contest. Uzan shot 44.6% (66-148) from the field, 38.6% (22-57) from deep and 73.9% (17-23) from the free throw line. Oweh appeared in 15 Big 12 contests and started eight, averaging 6.8 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.4 steals per outing. Godwin made appearances in all conference contests, adding 5.1 points, 3.3 rebounds and 0.7 blocks per game.

2023-24 STAFF ADDITIONS

» Armon Gates (assistant coach), **Clayton Custer** (assistant coach), **Brock Morris** (director of player personnel and assistant coach) and **Paul Jesperson** (director of player development and assistant coach) are new additions to the 2023-24 coaching staff. The four new staffers joined assistant coach **Ryan Humphrey**, who is in his second season on the sidelines in Norman after six seasons at Notre Dame.

- **»** Custer returns to the Sooners after a brief stint as an assistant coach at his alma mater Loyola Chicago. The Overland Park, Kan., native spent two seasons as the director of video operations and player development at OU from 2021-23 and one season on Moser's staff at Loyola as director of player development in 2020-21.
- **>>** Before joining the Sooners, Gates was an assistant at Oregon under Dana Altman for the 2022-23 season. The Ducks finished 21-15 and were one of the final eight teams in the NIT. The Chicago native also made stops at Nebraska (2019-22), Northwestern (2013-18), Loyola-Chicago (2011-13), TCU (2010-11) and at his alma mater, Kent State (2008-10).
- **»** Morris and Jesperson joined the Sooners after the NCAA increased the number of men's and women's basketball assistant coaches by two. Prior to joining the Sooners, Morris spent one season as an Ole Miss assistant coach. He also made stops at Louisiana (2019-22 & 2010-13), Daytona State College (2018-19), South Alabama (2015-18) and College of Southern Idaho (2013-15). Jesperson joined the Sooners after three seasons with the Atlanta Hawks, serving as player development coach for two seasons from 2021-23 and assistant video coordinator during the 2020-21 campaign.

» Oklahoma finished the 2022-23 campaign ranked in the top 100 in four NCAA Division I categories. OU was 47th in 3-point percentage defense (31.2%), 94th in field goal percentage (45.8%), 94th in effective field goal percentage (52.4%) and 95th in scoring defense (67.5 PPG).

REPLACING PRODUCTION

» The Sooners return 24.6% of their scoring, 23.9% of their rebounding and 27.5% of their assists from last season. OU welcomes back one starter from last season (Milos Uzan) and will need to replace the production of Grant Sherfield, Tanner Groves, Jalen Hill and Jacob Groves. Sherfield pursued a professional basketball career, T. Groves exhausted his eligibility, and Hill and J. Groves transferred to UNLV and Virginia, respectively. T. Groves led the Sooners in defensive rebounds (192) and rebounds per game (7.2). Sherfield tallied a team-high 15.9 points and 3.3 assists per outing.

BIG 12 HIGHLIGHTS

The 2023-24 season will be the last campaign in the Big 12 for the Sooners. In 27 years on the hardwood, Oklahoma has amassed a 250-205 (.549) mark in conference competition. The Sooners have had 11 players receive 14 first-team all-conference honors. Hollis Price (2003), Blake Griffin (2009) and Buddy Hield (2015, 2016) were named Big 12 Player of the Year. Willie Warren (2009) and Trae Young (2018) were named Big 12 Freshman of the Year, while Corey Brewer (1997), Ebi Ere (2002), Taj Gray (2005), Michael Neal (2006) and TaShawn Thomas (2015) were selected as Big 12 Newcomer of the Year.

2024 SIGNING CLASS

- **» Dayton Forsythe**, a 6-foot-2 combo guard, is a three-star prospect by 0n3, 247Sports, ESPN and Rivals. The Dale, 0kla., product attended Dale High School and is the No. 1 recruit in Oklahoma by 0n3 and 247Sports. Forsythe was named the 2023 Tulsa World's State Boys Basketball Player of the Year, becoming the first junior to win the award since former Oklahoma standout Trae Young earned the honor after his 2015-16 campaign at Norman North. The Oklahoma Basketball Coaches Association tabbed him as the 2023 2A Player of the Year and 2022 Region Player of the Year. He also garnered 2022 Tulsa Word All-State first-team honors as a sophomore.
- » Forsythe led Dale to back-to-back Oklahoma Class 2A State Championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. Dale remained unbeaten during the 2022-23 slate, finishing the season 32-0 and capping the year with a 78-52 triumph over Oklahoma Christian Academy. Forsythe recorded 29 points, eight rebounds and six assists. In the 2023 Tournament of Champions, Forsythe propelled Dale to the tournament crown and earned MVP honors, averaging 25.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists over three games. During his junior campaign, Forsythe averaged 17.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.0 blocks per contest. He shot 53% from the field, 40% from three and 81% from the free throw line. In the 2021-22 Class 2A title game, Forsythe tallied 37 points, eight rebounds and four assists, helping Dale win its first boy's championship in program history. The Pirates finished the season 29-2.
- **>>** In 25 games for Team Griffin in the Nike EYBL, he averaged 12.0 points, 3.2 rebounds and 3.2 assists per outing. Forsythe shot 39% (89-229) from the field, 35% (35-101) from three and 84% (85-101) from the free throw line.
- **>> Kuol Atak**, a 6-foot-9 forward, is a four-star prospect by On3 and ESPN and a three-star by 247Sports and Rivals. The Haltom City, Texas, product is ranked No. 70 nationally by On3, No. 113 by 247Sports and 127 by Rivals. He is the No. 3 prospect in Texas and No. 11 power forward by On3.
- During the 2022-23 campaign, Atak averaged 22.5 points, 5.1 rebounds, 1.6 blocks and 1.2 steals per outing. He shot 45% (223-499) from the field, 39% (92-237) from three and 89% (136-153) from the line. Atak was named to the Texas District 4 6A first team and earned team MVP honors for Haltom High School. As a sophomore, he averaged 9.8 points, 4.7 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.3 assists per contest and was named Haltom's offensive player of the year. Atak earned Texas District 3 6A first-team honors in 2021-22 and honorable mention accolades in 2020-21. He competed on the NY2LA Association AAU circuit for 3D Empire and was named the top prospect at the U16 level. Atok averaged 31.0 points per outing in four games of the 2022 Mays Fall Classic.

FROM LAST SEASON

- » Oklahoma had the third highest NET strength of schedule in 2022-23 and was only behind conference foes Kansas and Iowa State. The Sooners played 20 quadrant one games and finished 13-2 in games against quadrant 2-4 competition, including a 6-1 mark in quadrant two.
- **>>** The Sooners finished the 2022-23 season 70th in the NET. All 10 Big 12 teams were ranked in the top 70 and seven were ranked in the top 30. The conference had an average NET ranking of 30.2.
- » Oklahoma earned four AP Top-25 victories in 2022-23, including wins over No. 2 Alabama, No. 12 Kansas State, No. 22 TCU and No. 23 lowa State. Oklahoma's 93-69 victory against then-No. 2/2 Alabama was the Sooners' first win over an AP top-two team since the Sooners knocked off No. 1 Kansas in the 2002 Big 12 Tournament. The 24-point victory margin was the largest in program history against an AP top-five team and it was the third-largest victory margin by an unranked team against an AP top-two team.
- **» Milos Uzan** was selected to the 2023 Big 12 All-Freshman Team and averaged 9.5 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.8 assists per outing in 18 Big 12 games. Uzan's selection marked the second consecutive season the Sooners had an all-freshman team honoree. Uzan finished conference action third in points per outing and second in assists per contest.

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser enters his third season leading the Sooners in 2023-24. Moser, who is the 15th coach in program history, was hired April 3, 2021.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Forward Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sherfield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and a postseason berth in his first season with the Crimson and Cream in 2021-22. The 19-year Division I head coach amassed five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition and the Sooners received a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament. Oklahoma earned a victory over Missouri State in the opening round of the NIT.

Four Sooners earned 2021-22 All-Big 12 honorable mention honors and one was selected to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was named a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and selected to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Prior to his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, 571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the CBI title in 2017 and qualifying for the NIT in 2019. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mentions All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC, Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins and posted the most wins in a single season in school history during the 2017-18 season (32)

His most successful season at Lovola occurred during the 2017-18 season. Moser led the Ramblers to the Final Four - Lovola's first appearance since winning the NCAA Championship in

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed ever to advance to the Final Four, earning wins over Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year and was selected as the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year

The 2017-18 squad ranked second in the nation in fewest personal fouls per game (13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg). During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer became the first player in Loyola history to be named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America honors. Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his third year working with Moser, starting his first season as assistant coach in 2023-24 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 - tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside of major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola, Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in the 2020-21 season. As an eight seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championiship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 327-275 (.543) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season prior to his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories prior to his tenure, but Moser turned the program around in just one season to finish with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011.

He then returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach prior to the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife. Megan, have four children - Jordan, a member of OU's women's baskethall team, Jake, a member of the Sooners' men's baskethall team, and Max and Ben.
