LAST TIME OUT

The UIC women's basketball team's secondhalf resurgence led to a 81-65 victory against UTEP on day one of the West Palm Beach Classic

Senior forward Danyel Middleton led the Flames with 16 points, five rebounds and four assists. Graduate student guard Dais'Ja Trotter netted 13 points and grabbed six rebounds. Junior forward Makiyah Williams also scored 13 points, while senior center Tara Green contributed 12 points off the bench.

SCOUTING ARKANSAS

The Razorbacks have split their last six games since winning their first six games this season. Their biggest win of the season came Nov. 30 against No. 15 Florida State, a 71-58 victory in the ACC-SEC Challenge.

Arkansas leads the SEC with 9.7 made threepointers per game, connecting on 32% of its shots from beyond the arc.

Freshman Taliah Scott has made her mark offensively in her first season, topping the SEC in points per game (22.7).

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the first time the Flames and the Razorbacks have met on the hardwood.

POWER FIVE HEIGHTS

If the Flames walk away victorious against the Razorbacks Thursday morning, this will be the program's first win against a power five opponent since 2007. UIC's last power five victory came against Northwestern at home, when the Flames defeated the Wildcats 53-45.

This could also be the first victory for the Flames against an opponent from the SEC since their 59-51 win against Mississippi State back on Nov. 27, 1985.

FINDING THE OPEN TEAMMATE

The Flames remain the most efficient team in the Missouri Valley Conference, leading the conference in assists per game (18.89).

Senior guard Kristian Young has a conferenceleading 3.4 assist/turnover ratio, ranking 11th in the nation

After a five-assist performance in the win against Chicago State, Young has tallied

348 assists in her career, ranking seventh in program history.

In her first season at UIC, junior Sandra Frau-Garcia (Pego, Spain/Casper College) ranks second in The Valley with 5.1 assists per game.

STEALS OF FIRE

The Flames rank 18th in the nation and second in the MVC with 11.89 steals per game.

Four UIC players rank among the top 20 in The Valley in steals: Rimmer (4th/2.2 spg.), Frau-Garcia (5th/2.1), senior forward Danyel Middleton (12th/1.8) and Young (17th/1.7).

UIC has collected double-digit steals in six games this season, including 15 steals in last week's victory over Chicago State.

PRESEASON HONORS

McCloud was named to the 2023-24 Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Second Team.

McCloud is the Flames' top returning scorer and rebounder (12.2 ppg., 6.6 rpg.). The Peoria, III. native ranked 17th in the conference in scoring and 11th in rebounding during the 2022-23 season.

In March 2023, McCloud achieved a significant milestone by surpassing 1,000 career points against Murray State. Currently, she is 19th in UIC history in career scoring with 1,072 points. She scored in double figures in 25 games last season, and tallied three double-doubles.

BUIDING MOMENTUM

UIC is coming off a memorable 2022-23 season that saw the Flames post 19 wins and earn a berth in the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), the third postseason appearance in program history. It marked the greatest win improvement in MVC history and the secondlargest turnaround in the nation last year.

FAMILIAR FACES AND NEW TALENT

UIC is looking to carry momentum from last year's playoff berth into this season, with seven players returning, led by starting seniors McCloud (12.2 ppg., 6.2 rpg.) and Kristian Young (6.2 ppg., 5.0 rpg.).

The Flames will also have eight newcomers this year, including Chicago natives Krystyna Ellew, Rimmer and Williams.
