GAME NOTES

- » The Razorbacks scored on all 10 of their drives during the game which is also the most recorded consecutive drives with a touchdown in program history. The previous consecutive high of six was set during a 63-13 win over New Mexico State on Sept. 4, 2004.
- » RB Ja'Quinden Jackson finished the first half with eight carries for 101 yards (12.6 avg) and two touchdowns, logging his sixth career 100-yard rushing game and his fourth career multi-rushing touchdown performance.
- » QB Taylen Green completed 16-of-23 passes (70%) for 229 yards and two touchdowns, and rushed six times for 88 yards (14.7 ypc) and two touchdowns. Green is just the third Arkansas quarterback since 1997 to pass for multiple touchdowns and rush for multiple scores in a game. It marked the fourth time in Green's career that he registered multiple passing and rushing touchdowns in the same game.
- » The Razorbacks registered their first shutout since Oct. 20, 2018 when they shutout Tulsa 23-0 in Fayetteville.
- » The Hogs' 70 points were the most in a season opener since a 100-0 win over Missouri State in 1911. The 70-0 victory was the 103rd season-opening win in program history. Arkansas is now 103-24-4 all-time in season openers and have won three consecutive season openers.
- » WR Isaac TeSlaa has caught at least one pass in 26 consecutive games dating back to Nov. 13, 2021, while at Hillsdale College.
- » For the second consecutive season, Arkansas scored on its opening drive, this time courtesy of an eight-yard Ja'Quinden Jackson touchdown rush to cap an eight-play 66-yard drive that took 2:46 off the clock.
- » The Razorbacks' 28 points in the first quarter were the most in the first quarter of a game since they scored 35 during a 73-7 win over Nicholls on Sept. 6, 2014.
- » With the win, the Razorbacks improved to 154-62-4 all-time at War Memorial Stadium, including a 3-0 mark in the Pittman era.
- » OL E'Marion Harris, OL Keyshawn Blackstock and OL Addison Nichols all made their first career starts offensively. Defensively Nico Davillier and TJ Metcalf made their first career starts.
- » RB Braylen Russell scored his first collegiate touchdown on a nine-yard rush with 6:13 left in the third quarter.
- » The Razorbacks improved to 9-3 all-time in games televised on ESPNU since the channels inception in 2005.
- » The Razorbacks now hold an all-time record of 6-2 in games played in August, including a 6-1 mark in designated home games.
- » Arkansas is the only team over the past 25 seasons to have recorded a 70+ point shutout while converting every single third-down attempt in a game.

Sam Pittman, Arkansas Head Coach

Opening Statement:

I appreciate the crowd here in Little Rock. We played 83 guys and brought 92 which I thought was really good. We have to tackle better. We missed too many tackles. We cleaned up the penalties in the second half we had five in the first half and came back with one in the second half which was good. We cleaned up the crossing route in the second half that they hit on us before in the second quarter. We have to get better with limiting penalties on special teams. It is hard to shut somebody out. I thought our defense did a great job with that. The ones, twos and threes that came in all played extremely hard and wanted to keep that shutout intact. To score all 10 times we get the ball was really good. I was pleased with all of our quarterbacks when Malachi (Singleton) came in. KJ (Jackson) got the last series. It was the right thing to do to go to 10-minute quarters in the second half but we wanted to play KJ a little bit more if it got to that situation. We all saw what he is capable of doing and Ramsey made all those extra points which was good. After we talk to you, we will move on to Oklahoma State.

On his assessment of Taylen's performance:

We feel like he would play somewhat like he played. We knew he was fast, but we just had not seen it live. The breakout play down the sideline was a difficult play to make. He threw the ball well and was able to run the offense. Credit to the receivers for making good catches.
