TROJAN TIDBITS

- Scott Cross is in his sixth season at the helm for Troy men's basketball, and his 18th as a Division I men's basketball head coach. While at Troy he has put together a 82-76 record, which included three straight seasons of 20 or more wins. In each of those three seasons, he has also led the Trojans to 10 or more conference wins.
- On Monday, Troy opened its season with a dominating 84-74 win over Toledo in the MAC-SBC Challenge at Trojan Arena. It was Troy's second-largest margin of victory over a Division I opponent to open its season in its DI era. Troy defeated Quinnipiac by 11 in 2005.
- The Trojans followed up their opening win with a 78-61 win on the road against New Orleans. **Jackson Fields** recorded his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Troy didn't win a road game until Dec. 30 last season (at Coastal Carolina).
- Jackson Fields was named the Sun Belt Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Tuesday after he recorded his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. He is the first Trojan to recieve the honor since Jordan Varnado on Jan. 21, 2019.
- The Trojans are returning 100 total starts from last season from seven different players. Troy also returned 262 total games played between 10 players.
- Myles Rigsby and Tayton Conerway each earned preseason Sun Belt honors following a strong 2023-24. Rigsby, who was named the Sun Belt Freshman of the Year in 2024, was named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team. Conerway, who was named the Sun Belt Sixth Man of the Year, was named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team. It's the second consecutive season that Troy has had multiple preseason all-conference selections after Muhammad and Eugene each earned the honor prior to last season.
- Jackson Fields, who started 27 of the 28 games he appeared in last season, and Kameryn Mitchell are the longest tenured Trojans as the pair enter their third season under head coach Scott Cross. All other players are either entering their second year in the program or are new to this year's team.
- Troy did not lose or add a single player to the NCAA Transfer Portal. The only non-freshman addition to this year's team is JUCO transfer **Cobi Campbell**, who is out indefinitely with an injury.

BY THE NUMBERS

Troy was selected third in the Sun Belt Men's Basketball Preseason Coaches Poll, and also received one first place vote. It's Troy's highest preseason selection since 2017-18, where it was also picked third.

Troy returned12 players from the 2023-24 season, including the reigning SBC Freshman of the Year Myles Rigsby and the Sixth Man of the Year Tayton Conerway. Both earned preseason SBC recognition.

Troy has won 20 regular season games in each of the last three seasons, and is the only team in

the Sun Belt Conference to achieve that mark. Troy finished 2023-24 with a 20-13 record.

2024-25 GENERAL INFORMATION

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

- The Trojans opened their 2024-25 season with a resounding 84-74 win over Toledo on Monday night in the first game of the MAC-SBC Challenge.
- Five Trojans scored in double-figures, as Troy shot a scorching 52.2 percent from the field. Tayton Conerway and Myles Rigsby led the way with 12 points each, while Randarius Jones, Jackson Fields and Theo Seng each added 10 points.
- Troy's defense dominated Toledo, holding the Rockets to 40.6 percent shooting and 17.6 percent from 3-point range.
- Nine of the 11 players who checked into the game recorded at least six points.
- It was Troy's largest margin of victory over a Division I opponent to open its season since 2005.

BATTLE IN THE BAYOU

- The Trojans won their road opener 78-61 over New Orleans last Saturday.
- Jackson Fields recorded the first double-double of his career with a personal best 15 points and 10 rebounds.
- Four Trojans finished the night in double-figures, and Troy held the Privateers offense to 36.9 percent from the field

SWEET HOME ALABAMA

- Troy finished the 2023-24 season 15-2 (8-1 SBC) at home, which was its most home wins since they moved into Trojan Arena, and the most since the 1967-68 season (15).
- Under Scott Cross Troy is 50-21 at home, and 95-76 overall in Trojan Arena. Troy opened the 2024-25 season with a home against Toledo.

TROJANS IN THE RANKINGS

- Troy is receiving votes in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll to open the 2024-25 season.
- In the KenPom Ratings, Troy sits 117, which is second in the Sun Belt behind Arkansas State (112).
- In Bart Torvik's rankings, Troy opens the season at 108, second in the Sun Belt behind Arkansas State (102).
- The Trojans finished the 2023-24 season ranked No. 137 in the Net Rankings, third in the Sun Belt.

A GAUNTLET NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- The Trojans have one of the toughest non-conference slates in not just the Sun Belt, but the country, as it will go against two nationally ranked preseason teams and two teams that made the NCAA Tournament last season.
- Troy will head to No. 18 Arkansas, to take on a new-look Razorbacks team led by hall of fame coach John Calipari.
- The Trojans than head to the Pacific Northwest to take on Oregon, who made it to the round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament last season.
- The final non-conference road game of 2024 will see the Trojans head to No. 8 Houston.

RUN IT BACK

- In the era of the transfer portal, the Trojans did not a lose a single player from its 2023-24 squad to another Division I men's basketball team.
- Troy had four departures from last season's team, which was highlighted by the loss of the Trojans starting backcourt made up of Christyon Eugene and Aamer Muhammad, both of whom graduated following the season.
- The Trojans return 12 players to the 2024-25 team, which includes 10 players who played in a game for Troy last season.
- Among the 10 players who appeared in a game, seven of those players combined for 100 total starts from last season. In total those 10 players appeared in 262 total games.

LOYALTY RUN DEEPS IN TROY

- Jackson Fields and Kameryn Mitchell enter their third year in the Cardinal and Black, and are the longest tenured Trojans on this year's team.
- Jackson Fields has appeared in 61 games over his two seasons at Troy, and he started 27 of the 28 games he appeared in last season. He leads the team in career DI starts with 27.

WELCOME TO THE WIREGRASS

- The Trojans rounded out their 2024-25 roster by adding five players to the team this offseason, including five freshman and one junior college transfer.
- The four freshman include Austin Cross, Jackson Porch, Evan Griffin and Cooper Campbell.
- Cobi Campbell is Troy's lone non-freshman addition, as he played his freshman and sophomore year at North Idaho College. Campbell is out indefinitely with an injury.

THE BROTHERS

- Troy has two sets of brothers on the 2024-25 team.
- Marcus Rigsby Jr., and Myles Rigsby, and Cobi Campbell and Cooper Campbell.

THE FAMILY BUSINESS

- Head Coach Scott Cross will coach his son Austin for the first time in his lifetime, as Austin joined the 2024-25 team this summer.
- The Troians are one of 17 Division I men's basketball teams to have a son playing for their father this season. The others include, UNC Greensboro, Saint Louis, West Virginia, Nebraska, Akron, Chicago State, Charlotte, Rice, Lehigh, Northern Iowa, St. Thomas, Arizona State, Wisconsin, Dayton and Utah.

A YOUNG SUPERSTAR

- Myles Rigsby is coming off one of the best freshman campaigns in program history, a season that resulted in him being named the Sun Belt Freshman of the Year after averaging 11.3 points on 44.1 percent shooting from the field, 41.1 percent from distance and 82.4 percent from the line.
- Rigsby scored in double figures in 17 games, and had 20 or more points in five games.
- He scored a career-high 22 points in Troy's win over Kent State in the second game of the MAC-SBC Challenge game at Trojan Arena.
- He one of the Trojans best defenders, and had a career-high five steals in Troy's road win over Louisiana. He finished second on the team in steals with 49, which was also good for sixth in the Sun Belt Conference.
- His strong freshman campaign earned him a spot on the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team entering the 2024-25 season.

THE SPARK PLUG

- Tayton Conerway was Troy's top spark plug last season coming off the bench, as he averaged 11.8 points – second on the team – on 47.5 percent from the field, 32.9 percent from distance and 70.9 percent from the free throw line.
- His strong offensive play earned him the honor of being named the Sun Belt Sixth Man of the Year. He was the first Trojan to earn the honor.
- Under his lead, the Trojan's bench averaged 29.50 points per game, which led the Sun Belt and was 14th in the country.
- He was also one of the most lethal ball thief's in the country last season, as he swiped 66 steals on the season. That total was good for first in the Sun Belt and 39th nationally. It was also the sixth-most steals in a single season in Troy's DI history.
- He led a Troy defense that finished the season averaging 10.3 steals per game, which was the most in the SBC and second in the country.

TROY'S IRON MAN

- A staple of last year's starting lineup, Jackson Fields has appeared in 61 of 65 games over the last two seasons. In 2023-24, Fields played in 28 of 32 games, and started 27 of those.
- Fields leads all players on the team in career Division I starts.
- Playing at the center position last season, Fields averaged 6.5 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game in 22.9 minutes of action.
- Fields was Troy's best paint defender last season, as he led the team in blocks with 1.3. He had a career-high five blocks in Troy's road loss to South Alabama.
- He was also third on the team with 1.2 steals per game, and had a career-high five steals against Grambling State.

THE LOCAL KID

- Growing up just an hour south of Troy in Dothan, Ala., was sophomore forward Thomas Dowd, who is coming off an impressive freshman campaign.
- The 6-8 guard played 22.4 minutes per game and started in 17 of his 31 appearances.
- He averaged 6.3 points, and was third on the team in 3-pointers per game at 1.1.
- In just the third game of his career, Dowd went on the road at Oregon State and scored a career-high 22 points, which included a buzz-beating 3-pointer to send the game to
- Dowd led the Trojans in rebounds with 168 5.4 per game.
- He had his first double-double of his career when he pulled down a career-high 13 boards at home against Marshall to pair with his 12 points. Recorded his second one against Old Dominion (11 points, 11 rebounds).

THE POINT GUARD

- Marcus Rigsby Jr., is expected to start at the point guard position on Monday night against Toledo after serving as the backup to Aamer Muhammad last season.
- He played in 28 games for an average of 11.9 minutes.
- ullet He scored a career-high 15 points against Reinhardt, and finished the year averaging 4.1 points on 38.1 percent shooting from the field.

THEO "BIG BIRD" SENG

- Theo Seng, a product of Davis, California, started 15 games last season, as he and Thomas Dowd had similar roles
- He recorded 10 or more points in four games last season, including a career-best 14

points against Reinhardt.

- He finished the season averaging 4.9 points per game while making 40.3 percent of his shots from the field.
- He is the only player on the Troy team that has played for another Division I institution at some point in his career (Sacramento State).

- One of the toughest players on the team, Randarius Jones was a key member of the bench last season on both offense and defense.
- He appeared in 31 games for 12.4 minutes, and averaged 4.3 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- He scored a career-high 15 points against SUNO on 7-9 of shooting in 10 minutes of action.
- He was Troy's most efficient shooter last season, knocking down 60.9 percent of his shots.

THE DISTRIBUTOR

- One of the best passers on the team last season, Victor Valdes is primed for a bigger role this season.
- The sophomore forward/guard combo hails from Monterrey, Mexico, and is Troy's lone international player on the team.
- He appeared in 31 games, starting 12 of them, for an average of 15.7 minutes per game.
- He recorded 4.3 points on 45.2 percent shooting, including 38.8 percent from distance. He scored a career-high 16 points in front of a national television audience against Arkansas
- Despite being 6-7, Valdes saw time at the point guard spot, and head coach Scott Cross has compared his skill set and play style to that of Dallas Mavericks star Luka Doncic.

THE REDSHIRTS

- Jerrell Bellamy (R-Jr.) and Kerrington Kiel (R-Fr.) redshirted last season, and are expected to be important contributors for the Trojans this season.
- Kiel, a native of Birmingham, Ala., is a lengthy forward who will add to the defensive side of the ball, while also bringing a strong jumper and 3-point game on the offensive side.
- \bullet Bellamy, a native of Phenix City, Ala., is a 6-9 forward who can score at all three levels and is an excellent rebounder. He will join Dowd, Fields, Seng and Jones as a key paint defender this

THE RED MAMBAS

- Brothers Cooper and Cobi Campbell, who go by the nickname "The Red Mambas", are new additions to the team this season.
- · Cooper comes to Troy after playing at Phhoenix Prep in Arizona, and is an elite shooter of the basketball. He was named to the Second-Team All-UAA in the summer of 2023 after
- averaging 20 points and six assists per game while shooting 42 percent from 3-point distance. • Cobi spent his freshman and sophomore seasons at North Idaho College, where he was an
- elite scorer like his brother. During the 2022-23 campaign, he averaged 16.9 points on 54.3 percent shooting. In 2023-24, he had 11.3 points on 43.5 percent shooting.
- Cobi is out indefinitely with an injury.

A LETHAL SHOOTER OFF THE BENCH

- While he only saw limited time off the bench last season, Braydon Whitaker made the most of it.
- The guard from Slocomb, Ala., appeared in 11 games last season, making 11 of his 20 shots while draining 41.7 percent of this 3-point attempts. He had a career-high nine points against Reinhardt on 4-7 shooting.

THE FRESHMAN

- Austin Cross, Jackson Porch and Evan Griffin are the three other freshman joining Cooper Campbell on this year's team
- All three guys are from Alabama, and are expected to be key contributors for the Trojans in the years to come.

TAKE THE STAIRS

- A mantra that head coach Scott Cross has used for the past decade, "Take The Stairs" has become the slogan for Troy men's basketball since Cross was hired in 2019.
- The saying comes from the mentality that the team never takes shortcuts, and always does things the tough way. Why take the elevator when you can take the stairs?

TROJANS IN THE PROS

- Both Christyon Eugene and Aamer Muhammad signed professional deals this summer after graduating from Troy.
- Eugene is playing with CS Rapid București in Romania. The club is located in the country's capital of Bucharest, and finished sixth in the league last season.
- Muhammad is playing with BC Barsy Atyrau in Kazakhstan. The club has appeared in the Kazakhstan Basketball Championship Finals in 12 of the last 13 seasons and has been the runner-up in the last eight seasons.

2024 SUN BELT PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- The Trojans were selected to finish third in the Sun Belt Preseason Coaches Poll, and even received one first-place vote.
- It's the highest Troy has been selected to open the season since the 2017 poll, when Sun Belt coaches also picked Troy third with one first-place vote.





HEAD COACH SCOTT CROSS

A consistent winner over 27 years in the coaching profession, Scott Cross enters his sixth season as the head coach at Troy in 2024-25, his 18th overall season as a collegiate head coach. In five seasons, Cross has built the Troy program into one of the perennial leaders in the Sun Belt as the Trojans enter the upcoming campaign as the only league program with back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons and the only Sun Belt program with 10-plus league wins in three consecutive seasons.

The 2023-24 season saw Troy win 20 regular season games for the third consecutive season, as well winning double-digit conference games for the third straight year. The Trojans are the only team in the Sun Belt to achieve that mark. The Trojans finished the regular season third in the Sun Belt, which is the highest they have finished during Cross' tenure. Troy was picked eighth in the coaches preseason poll. Troy played three nationally televised games and forced Oregon State into a double overtime showdown in Corvallis, Ore.


Troy racked up postseason honors as Christyon Eugene – who eclipsed the 1,000 career-point mark in the final regular season – was named All-Sun Belt First Team. Myles Rigsby was named the Sun Belt Freshman of the Year and Tayton Conerway was named the Sun Belt Sixth Man of the Year. In addition, graduating seniors Eugene and Aamer Muhammad each signed professional deals in the summer of 2024.

Despite losing five of his top six scorers, including the top three, from the 2021-22 team, Cross led the Trojans to a 20-13 overall record in 2022-23, including an 11-7 Sun Belt record and berth in the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals. The non-conference slate saw the Trojans knock off Florida State, 79-72, in Tallahassee; Troy's first victory over a major-conference opponent since 2012 and first against an ACC opponent since a 1981 victory over Georgia Tech. Troy also led national-runner up San Diego State by eight points midway through the second half of a 5-point loss to the Aztecs, one year after Cross and the Trojans defeated another Final Four program in Florida Atlantic on its home court. Zay Williams earned All-Sun Belt and all-district distinction after he finished one rebound shy of becoming Troy's all-time leader in the category.

Cross led Troy to its first 20-win season in five years and back to the postseason in 2021-22 as the Trojans finished 20-12 overall and a 10-6 mark in the Sun Belt. The Trojans returned to the postseason for the first time since its 2016 NCAA Tournament run with an appearance in the College Basketball Invitational. Troy finished with the third-most Sun Belt wins and advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament semifinals despite

being picked to finish last in the league during the preseason.

The 20-win season was just Troy's fourth since 2000, and the Cross-led Trojans won eight road games, the most by the program since the 2009-10 season. Troy was also well represented on the Sun Belt postseason awards lists, with Efe Odigie earning the league's Newcomer of the Year award and Duke Deen taking home Freshman of the Year honors. Odigie also earned all-district second team honors and All-Sun Belt First Team distinction.



Two Trojans hit the professional circuit following their careers under Cross' guidance this past summer as his first class of recruits for Troy in Khalyl Waters and Nick Stampley both signed professional contracts to play in Finland in the Korisliigaleague.

Troy has shattered Trojan Arena box-office records in Cross' first four seasons, including new single-season records in each of the last two seasons, with 3,036 fans in 2022-23 and 2,758 in 2021-22. Additionally, four of Troy's top-10 highest-attended games have come in the last two seasons.

Cross preceded his current run at Troy with a brief stint as an assistant coach at TCU under Jamie Dixon in 2018-19.

Cross helped lead the Horned Frogs to the Big 12 quarterfinals and a No. 1 seed in the 2019 NIT in his one year. TCU finished the season with 23 wins, the second most in program history, and Cross helped develop current Memphis Grizzles' star Desmond Bane.

The bulk of Cross' coaching career came at his alma mater UT Arlington where he presided over the most successful era of men's basketball in UTA history with five postseason appearances and five 20-win seasons.

He inherited a program that averaged 10 wins per season and made just one postseason appearance in its 47-year history and transformed the Mavericks into a premier program at the mid-major level. In addition to leading UTA to an average of 19 wins per season, he also chaired the top four seasons in program history plus signed and developed the first player in UTA history to be selected in the first two rounds of the NBA Draft when Kevin Hervey was selected with the 57th pick of the 2018 Draft.

Among UTA's postseason appearances under Cross was a quarterfinal appearance in the 2017 NIT. The historic 2017 season produced the program's first-ever Sun Belt Conference regular season title.

Throughout the course of just more than a decade, Cross guided the Mavericks to postseason tournament appearances with trips to the NCAA Tournament (2008), NIT (2012 & 2017) and CIT (2013, 2016). In addition, UT Arlington won the Southland Tournament Championship in 2008 and the 2012 regular season Southland Conference

Cross was named 2012 Southland Conference Coach of the Year, 2012 NABC District 23 Coach of the Year and was a 2012 finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year. Cross' efforts on and off the court were recognized once again in 2016 when he was announced a finalist for the 2016 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award.

In 2017, he earned Sun Belt and NABC District Coach of the Year honors after leading the Mavericks to a program-record 27 wins. Cross, who has coached 19 players to professional contracts, was named a Prosser Award finalist for the second time and earned finalist honors from the Hugh Durham Award. The Mavs defeated Texas for the first time in school history, marking UTA's first win over an AP top-25 team in program history. UTA went on to win NIT games at BYU and against Akron and posted two of the largest UTA basketball crowds in College Park Center history.

The 2016 squad helped put UTA basketball on the Division I men's basketball map. Crowned the best rebounding team in the nation and ranked in the top 10 in four team categories, UTA knocked off national powers Ohio State and Memphis on the road en route to its best start in school history (14-3).

Cross was named the head coach of his alma mater in 2006 after serving as an assistant for the previous eight seasons. In his second season, he led the Mavericks to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history. During that season, the Mavericks were ranked for the first time in the collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25, reaching a high of No. 14 in Dec. 2007.

From the end of the 2007 season throughout the 2008 season, Cross led the Mavericks to a school-record 17 consecutive home wins. In UTA's final season in the Southland (2011-12), the Mavs set a school record with 16 straight victories, which included their first 15 league games. UTA went on to finish the season 24-9 and advance to the NIT.

A three-year letter winner at UT Arlington from 1995-98, Cross gained a reputation as both a fierce competitor on the court and a scholar-athlete off the floor. Cross appeared in 82 games for UTA as a player, including 58 in the starting lineup. As a senior, Cross averaged 11.9 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game while converting a team-high 41.5 percent of his 3-point shots, second best in the Southland Conference.

In the classroom, Cross set the standard for UT Arlington basketball. He was a twotime GTE/College Sports Information Director of America Basketball Academic All-American, earning third-team as a junior and second-team honors as a senior. Cross graduated with a perfect 4.0 grade-point-average in marketing.

Cross is married to the former Jennifer Harris, and the couple has three sons, Austin, Cody and Tyler. Austin joined the Troy men's basketball team as a freshman for the 2024-25 season.

NEW CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT BRACKET

While the league will continue to take all 14 members to the Sun Belt Men's and Women's Basketball Championships and will maintain its seven-day tournament format, rest days will be eliminated from the postseason events.

In an effort to prioritize the value of the 18-game conference regular-season, the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds will now receive byes to the tournament semifinals. The No. 3 and No. 4 seeds will maintain byes to the tournament quarterfinals, which had previously been given to the top four seeds.

With the elimination of rest days, higher-seeded teams will no longer face a lower-seeded team coming off a rest day.

"The new Sun Belt Basketball Championship brackets will reward our top seeds for their accomplishments during the regular season, ensuring they receive the advantage they've earned for their on-court performance," said Sun Belt Conference Commissioner Keith Gill.

Women's basketball tournament games will be contested during the morning sessions each day, with games tipping off primarily at 11:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Men's basketball tournament games will be played during the evening sessions, with games scheduled primarily at 5:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

SUN BELT NATIONALLY TELEVISED GAMES

Four Sun Belt league matchups will be part of the wildcard appearances during 2025 portion of the schedule. The wildcard windows are Thursday, January 23 (9 p.m. ET / 8 p.m. CT, ESPN2), Wednesday, February 5 (9 p.m. ET / 8 p.m. CT, ESPNU), Saturday, February 15 (8 p.m. ET / 7 p.m. CT, ESPN2/ESPNU), and Friday, February 28 (9 p.m. ET / 8 p.m. CT, ESPN2/ESPNU). Game selections will be determined at a later date.

All games that are televised on an ESPN network will also be available on the ESPN App. In addition, every men's basketball conference game and home non-conference game within the Sun Belt will air on ESPN+.


