1

Today's game at Arkansas has more connections than Google Fiber. It starts with A&T reserve guard Jordan Martin. His father is Arkansas assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Chuck Martin.

2

The connections then move to the sidelines and involves cheesesteaks. A&T head coach Monté Ross and Arkansas special assistant to the head coach Bruiser Flint are both Philadelphia natives and good friends.

3

The two crossed paths as head coaching rivals in the mid 2000's when Flint served as the head coach at Drexel University and Ross was the head man at the University of Delaware. Ross went against Flint during their time in the CAA.

4

A&T also have two Arkansas natives on their roster, and they happen to be their top two leading scorers in Landon Glasper and Ryan Forrest. In fact, Glasper's old high Fayetteville, is located a few feet from the University of Arkansas.

5

On the court, the Aggies are trying to snap a seven-game losing streak. The Aggies have not won since losing 6-foot-9 center Will Felton to a possible season-ending knee injury on Nov. 25 at Buffalo. The Aggies have a minus-5.6 rebounding margin in his absence.

N.C. A&T STATE UNIVERSITY POINTS OF PRIDE

- ▶ North Carolina A&T is the largest historically black college or university (HBCU) in America, boasting nearly 14,000 students enrolled.
- ▶ A&T boasts two Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famers in Al Attles, an NBA veteran, the second black coach ever to win an NBA title (1975), and a longtime NBA executive with the Warriors organization.
- ▶ The other Naismith Hall of Famer is Hugh Evans, a 28-year NBA veteran referee tallying over 1,900 regular-season games, 170 playoff games, 35 NBA Finals games and four NBA All-Star Games.
- ▶ According to the U.S. Department of Education, A&T is the No. 1 producer of black undergraduates in engineering and agriculture and of master's in mathematics and statistics.
- ▶ One of A&T's most prominent alums is civil rights leader and Baptist minister Rev. Jesse Jackson Sr. Jackson ran for President of the United States in 1984 and '88.
- ▶ Four A&T students, David Richmond, Franklin McCain Sr., Jabrill Khazan (born Ezell Blair Jr.) and Joseph McNeil, are credited with sparking the modern civil rights movement. The four students started a series of sit-ins on February 1, 1960, primarily at the Woolworth store in downtown Greensboro, NC, to protest the store's racial segregation policy.
- ▶ In recent years, the Aggies have produced NFL All-Pro Tarik Cohen, Olympic gold medalist and two-time NCAA 400-meter outdoor champion Randolph Ross, Jr., Olympic gold medalist and 4x400-meter indoor and outdoor champion Trevor Stewart and NCAA Women's Track Indoor Athlete of the Year Kayla White.

0 G Kyle Duke

6-4 • 185 • Sr. • Toronto, Canada

BREAKDOWN: Duke returns for his senior in Aggieland ... He has mainly been a backup throughout his career, providing the Aggies with a defensive-minded guard ... Last season Duke averaged 5.7 points and 2.2 rebounds per game ... He also totaled 43 assists and 20 steals ... Duke started nine games for the Aggies in 2023-24 ... He is a two-time member of Team Canada ... Won a gold medal for Team Ontario 15U at the Canadian National Championships in 2018. **2024-25 Season:** He has not played this season.



1 F Ryan Forrest (Northwestern State Transfer)

6-4 • 190 • So. • Marion, Ark.

BREAKDOWN: Forrest signed with the Memphis Tigers coming out of Marion High School ... He decommitted from Memphis during the summer of 2023 ... He eventually signed to play with Northwestern State, where he played 10 games and made seven starts ... He averaged 11.8 points and 2.1 rebounds ... Forrest decided to transfer to A&T on April 9, 2024 ... **2024-25 Season:** Forrest missed the first game of the season against Cheyney with an injury ... He has played every game since, including making nine starts in the 11 games he has played ... Had just four points against Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, marking the first time he failed to score in double figures as an Aggie.



2 G Qua Brown

6-4 • 200 • R-Fr. • Covington, Ga.

BREAKDOWN: Brown was signed by the staff previous to Ross. He came to A&T with an Achilles injury sustained in high school. The Aggies hope to have him back this season as he still tries to recover. **2024-25 Season:** He has not played this season.



3 G Camian Shell (Coffeyville CC Transfer)

5-10 • 170 • Jr. • Winston-Salem, N.C.

BREAKDOWN: Shell is in his second season with the Aggies ... Last season, he became one of the best point guards in the CAA and became known for his ability to take care of the basketball ... Shell ranked fifth in the CAA in assist-to-turnover ratio and third in total assists (127) ... He posted 127 assists to only 56 turnovers in 2023-24 ... Shell started and played in all of A&T's 31 games last season ... **2024-25 Season:** The clear floor leader for A&T, who rarely leaves the game ... Has played more than 30 minutes in 14 of the last 16 games he has played for A&T ... In one of those games, he left early with an injury ... Had 10 points and four assists, marking the first time he has scored in double figures in two games.



4 G Bryan Ogletree (South Plains Collge)

6-4 • 190 • Jr. • Hampton, Ga.

BREAKDOWN: Ogletree spent the 2023-24 season at South Plains College, where he averaged 6.3 points and 2.4 rebounds per game ... He also shot 39.8 percent from 3-point range and 47 percent from the floor ... He also shot 79.2 percent from the free throw line ... As a freshman, at South Plains, he averaged 2.4 points ... **2024-25 Season:** He made his A&T debut on Nov. 4, posting 17 points on 3-for-6 shooting from 3-point range ... He also had three steals ... Followed that performance by playing 18 minutes at Wake Forest and scoring two points and grabbing five rebounds ... Has not played a game since due to a hand injury but his return is imminent.



5 G Jahnathan Lamothe (University of Maryland)

6-4 • 192 • So. • Baltimore, Md.

BREAKDOWN: Lamothe came to the University of Maryland as a big-time scorer coming out of St. Frances Academy ... Was chosen to play in the prestigious 50th Annual Hoop Culture Capital Classic in April 2023 where he was team captain of the Capital All-Stars ... Senior season in 2022-23 was highlighted by a St. Francis Academy record 57-point performance including 16 three-pointers, also a school record ... He played 16 games for the Terps, averaging 0.8 points and 1.2 rebounds ... **2024-25 Season:** Lamothe has scored in double figures in four straight games ... Had a streak of two straight doubles-doubles snapped against Coastal Carolina on Tuesday.



7 G Landon Glasper (Coffeyville CC Transfer)

6-2 • 170 • Jr. • Fayetteville, Ark.

BREAKDOWN: Glasper will get looks this season. He was brought in to score in bunches for the Aggies. He averaged 13.9 points on 38.9 percent shooting at Coffeyville Community College last season ... During his first season in Aggieland, he averaged 20.9 points per game, securing the best scoring average for an Aggie since the 1992-93 season. He earned first-team All-CAA honors after the season despite missing seven games with an injury. He was also a preseason first-team all-conference selection. **2024-25 Season:** For the first time in his collegiate career at A&T, Glasper failed to make a start when he come off the bench against Liberty last Saturday... Glasper had started all 34 games he played in before Saturday ... He has scored in double figures in 34 straight games ... Had a season-high 29 points against Coastal on Tuesday.

10 G Uchenna Kellman-Nicholes

6-5 • 180 • So. • Orlando, Fla.

BREAKDOWN: Kellman-Nicholes is an excellent shooter with a high basketball IQ. He understands defensive concepts, and is great at help-side defense. He has an understanding of the college game that most freshmen don't have. He is a confident shooter and plays the game the right way... Last season he averaged 4.9 points and 2.5 rebounds while playing 30 games with 14 starts ... As a senior at Seminole High School, he averaged 15.2 points per game. **2024-25 Season:** He has not played this season.



11 G Jordan Martin

6-1 • 190 • Jr. • Columbia, S.C.

BREAKDOWN: Martin is another walk-on looking to make an impact as a shooter. He has played in one game this season. He played in one game during the 2023-24 season. **2024-25 Season:** He played nine minutes against Cheyney on Nov. 4, grabbing a rebound and dishing out two assists ... He also played late in the game at Virginia Tech on Dec. 12.



13 C Jason Murphy

6-9 • 245 • Sr. • Owings Mills, Md.

BREAKDOWN: Murphy had to miss a lot of time last season because he was not initially eligible over the Aggies first eight games and he missed three additionally games with an injury ... Once he entered the Aggies lineup last season, he added immediate help with his size ... Averaged 6.4 points and 6.1 rebounds last season after starting 18 of the 20 games he played ... Averaged 15.9 points and 8.8 rebounds during the 2022-23 season at Frostburg State. He was a four-time letterman at St. Frances Academy. **2024-25 Season:** Murphy's playing time has been sporadic this season after he was a starter last season ... He has played in six of the Aggies 11 games this season with zero starts ... He made 18 starts last season ... He has not played in the Aggies last two games.



15 G Jalal McKie

6-5 • 195 • So. • Atlanta, Ga.

BREAKDOWN: McKie has the ability to shoot the basketball with confidence. He is a zone buster for the Aggies with his perimeter game. Last season, McKie averaged 8.3 points and 3.0 rebounds per game ... He also shot 31.5 percent from 3-point range. ... He played in 31 games with 12 starts. **2024-25 Season:** McKie is typically a valuable member for the Aggies coming off the bench ... However, he has not scored in four of the Aggies past five games despite playing more than 15 minutes in all but one of those games ... Did have eight points as a starter against Liberty on Dec. 14.



16 Nikolaos Chitikoudis

6-9 • 215 • So. • East Thessalonki, Greece

BREAKDOWN: Chitikoudis took the American game slowly last season. But once he found his rhythm, he became one of Ross's most effective players ... Chitikoudis has an inside/outside game that makes him tough to defend ... Last season, he averaged 7.1 points and 5.3 rebounds per game ... He also had 39 blocks in 28 games played ... Chitikoudis started 19 games for the Aggies, shooting 48 percent from the field. **2024-25 Season:** Has become a starter since the injury to Will Felton on Nov. 25 ... In those six games, he is starting to develop into one of the Aggies most valuable players ... He recorded his second double-double of the season when he posted 13 points and 10 rebounds against Coastal on Tuesday ... He is also ranks 18th in the nation in total blocks.



20 G Chanler Montgomery

6-3 • 172 • Fr. • Blacksburg, Va.

BREAKDOWN: Montgomery has a point guard mentality and should add some depth to the Aggies. **2024-25 Season:** Montgomery played four minutes in A&T's opener against Cheyney on Nov. 4 and scored his first two collegiate points on a layup ... Also played late at Virginia Tech on Dec. 12.



31 C Efstratios Kalliontzis

6-11 • 225 • R-Fr. • Mitilini, Greece

BREAKDOWN: Brings tons of international talent to A&T's roster ... Averaged 21.0 points, 12.0 rebounds in the Greek U18 league. He signed with LaSalle initially before transferring to A&T. **2024-25 Season:** Has played in the Aggies opener against Cheyney on Nov. 4 before not playing at Wake Forest ... He did play at George Washington, but missed games against The Citadel and Morgan State ... He has played in the Aggies last six games, making starts against UNC Greensboro and Liberty.

BREAKDOWN: Reese is a local player who played at Greensboro Day School ... He did not play in a game last season. **2024-25 Season:** He played in the Aggies opener and scored the first two points of his career on Nov. 4 ... Also played late at Virginia Tech on Dec. 12.



34 C Will Felton (Arizona State Transfer)

6-9 • 260 • R-So. • Raleigh, N.C.

BREAKDOWN: Felton was expected to be a major force in the paint for the Aggies both offensively and defensively two years ago and last season. Unfortunately for two straight seasons a preseason ACL injury stopped those plans for the Aggies and left a huge absence in the paint. Felton's absence was felt especially when it comes to rebounding. Felton was ranked a three-star recruit by Rivals and ESPN receiving numerous college offers from Appalachian State, High Point, UNC Wilmington, Mercer and Miami among others. He decided to attend Arizona State, where he did not see any action for the Wildcats ... But he is back this season, where he looks to contribute to A&T. **2024-25 Season:** In his first game in three years, Will Felton had 17 points and 12 rebounds against Cheyney on Nov. 4. Felton sustained a knee injury at Buffalo on Nov. 25 and has not played since.

ALMA MATER: WINSTON-SALEM STATE '92



North Carolina A&T Director of Athletics Earl M. Hilton III announced the appointment of Monté Ross as the new head men's basketball coach on April 10, 2023. Ross became the 14th head coach in the history of the A&T men's basketball program.

A native of Philadelphia, Pa., Ross has spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach with the Temple Owls. Before landing with the Owls, Ross spent 10 seasons (2006-16) as the head coach for the Coastal Athletic Association (CAA) Delaware Blue Hens.

"This is an exciting time in North Carolina A&T Athletics, and coach Ross adds to that excitement," said Hilton. "Coach Ross brings a decade of head coaching experience in the CAA, where he was tasked with building a program. He had some outstanding seasons for the Delaware men's basketball program, and we think that translates well for us at North Carolina A&T as we strive to win championships in

the CAA. We hired the best person to lead and mentor our young men on and off the court."

A 1992 graduate of Winston-Salem State, Ross played for legendary head coach Clarence "Big House" Gaines from 1988-92. After spending 13 seasons as an assistant coach at various Division I programs, Ross became the Blue Hens' coach in 2006.

In his sixth season at Delaware, he led the Blue Hens to an 18-14 record overall and a 12-6 mark in the CAA. The Blue Hens appeared in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) before going 19-14 the following season, finishing second in the CAA with a 13-5 mark. He followed the second-place finish with one of the best seasons in Blue Hens program history. They posted a 25-10 record, winning the CAA regular-season title with a 14-2 record and the tournament championship.

In advancing to the NCAA tournament, it marked just the fifth NCAA tournament appearance in program history and the first since 1999. For his efforts, Ross earned CAA Coach of the Year. The National Sportscasters and

Sportswriters Association honored him with the Clarence "Big House" Gaines Division I Coach of the Year award. In addition, he earned the National Association of Basketball Coaches UPS District 10 Coach of the Year award. He posted 132 wins at Delaware, the second most in program history.

Ross also had tremendous success at Saint Joseph's as an assistant coach for 10 seasons (1996-06). In 2003-04, the Hawks went 27-0 during the regular season and rose to No. 1 in the nation before ending their season with a 30-2 record after a loss in the Elite Eight. Saint Joseph's made it to the postseason seven times during Ross' tenure there, including four NCAA appearances.

Ross has also had assistant positions at Drexel (1994-96) and Lehigh (1993-94). He was on the staff that saw Drexel win its first-ever NCAA tournament game with an upset win over Memphis in 1996.

Ross and his wife, Michelle, relocated to Greensboro. They have two children, Justin Monté and Lauren Noelle.

LAST TIME OUT (COASTAL CAROLINA)

Timely stops and timely made shots did not go in North Carolina A&T's favor in the clutch Tuesday night at Corbett Sports Center. As a result, the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers earned a 73-68 non-conference men's basketball win.

Junior Landon Glasper scored a season-high 29 points and tied a career-high with eight rebounds, but the Aggies lost their seventh straight to fall to 3-9 overall. Nikolaos Chitikoudis recorded his second double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds. It marked the third straight game an Aggie has secured a double-double.

The Chanticleers improved to 6-5 and defeated the Aggies for the first time in five tries after shooting 5-for-6 from the field over the game's final 5 1/2 minutes.

A&T had trouble making shots in the first half, shooting 29 percent. Plus, they gave up an open jump shot at the buzzer to RaSheed Jones to give Coastal a 37-27 halftime lead.

Glasper got hot coming out of the break, scoring nine of the Aggies first 11 points to cut Coastal's lead to 46-42 with 13:19 remaining in the game. Over the next seven minutes, the Aggies got the deficit down to one, 55-54, on a pull-up jumper by junior Camian Shell.

Chitikoudis then briefly gave the Aggies the lead as he caught the reflection from a blocked shot and scored on a layup with 5 1/2 minutes remaining. That would be the last lead of the game for the Aggies. The Chanticleers scored the next four points before a Glasper three tied the game at 59-59 with 3:09 to play.

Coastal responded with a 7-0 run with five points from Jones, including an enormous 3-pointer with 1:13 to play to give the Chanticleers a 66-59 advantage. Jones led the Chanticleers with 20 points and six rebounds on 7-for-12 shooting.

A&T shot 47 percent in the second half, but Coastal shot 50 percent to counter. Coastal also outscored A&T 36-20 in the paint.

Jahnathan Lamothe and Shell had 10 points apiece for A&T.

"We wanted to make him work everything he got," Ross said about Jones. "I thought we did a great job in the first half. In the second half, he got going. He made a tough shot that we defended pretty good, but he got free for a layup that put them up one. Then he made a big three from the top."

- ▶ Despite John Calipari's lengthy and legendary career, this will mark the first time he has faced the Aggies despite previous stops at UMass, Memphis, and the University of Kentucky.
- ▶ Ryan Forrest scored four points against Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, marking the first time in his 11-game A&T career that he failed to score in double figures.
- ▶ Saturday will mark the first meeting between the Razorbacks and the Aggies in 14 years. The first time they played occurred in the 1994 NCAA tournament, where the Aggies entered the tournament as the No. 16 seed and battled the top-ranked Razorbacks in a competitive game before Arkansas pulled away and eventually won the national championship.
- ▶ A&T has struggled in the area of depth this season after some circumstances have left them without some key players. Bryson Ogletree who had 17 points in A&T's opener, has not played since the second game of the season with an injured hand. However, Ogletree has started to practice. Meanwhile, a huge blow is the loss of center Will Felton. The Aggies have gone 7 or 8 deep since those losses.
- ▶ The Aggies hope to get their defensive fire back. During their current seven-game losing streak. Opponents are shooting 45.4 percent from the floor during the Aggies seven-game slide. Teams are shooting 58 percent against A&T from 2-point range.

WHAT HAS HAPPENED SINCE WE DEPARTED

The North Carolina A&T men's basketball program's final year in the MEAC was a memorable, considering it was during the COVID pandemic in 2020-21 and the Aggies could not complete the tournament because it was determined by the conference that a member of the staff tested positive for COVID.

The Aggies then turned their attention to the Big South Conference under head coach Will Jones. During A&T's first season in the Big South Conference, the Aggies went 6-10. After starting conference play 3-0, the Aggies lost their final four conference games of the regular season to enter the Big South tournament as the No. 9 seed. A&T defeated Radford in the first round before losing to No. 1 seed Longwood in the quarterfinals in Charlotte, N.C.

The following year, the Aggies enter the Coastal Athletic Association (CAA) conference under interim head coach Phillip Shumpert and posted an 8-10 mark. The Aggies entered the tournament as the No. 7 seed and lost to Stony Brook in the first round. In their first season under Ross a year ago, the Aggies went 5-13 in the CAA and lost to No. 13 seed William & Mary in the 12 vs. 13 matchup. The Aggies are 19-33 in conference play since leaving the MEAC and are 1-3 in conference tournament play.

ROSS BRINGS STABILITY TO AGGIE BASKETBALL

A&T has had an unusually high number of coaches in the past 11 years. A&T has had six different men on the bench in that span. Jerry Eaves left the Aggies in 2012 after going 12-20. Five-time MEAC tournament champion Cy Alexander replaced him. He won his sixth MEAC title in 2013 as he led the Aggies to the conference championship title over Morgan State. He also led the Aggies to their first-ever NCAA tournament win, a 73-72 triumph over Liberty. Alexander retired during the 2015-16 season, and the Aggies replaced him with his assistant Jay Joyner. Joyner finished the season 5-5. Joyner went on to have two 20-win seasons before leaving during the 2019-20 season and was replaced by his assistant Will Jones. Jones finished the season 14-5, led the Aggies to the No. 2 seed in the MEAC tournament, and had a first-round win over Howard before COVID canceled the tournament. Jones led the Aggies to a MEAC Southern Division title the following year before leading the Aggies into the Big South Conference. Jones departed before the 2022-23 season and was replaced by his assistant Phillip Shumpert on an interim basis.

The Aggies have now turned to Montè Ross to get the Aggies over the top and into contention in the CAA conference. Ross is a CAA veteran who coached at the University of Delaware for 10 seasons. He went 7-24 in his first season with A&T but already has three wins this season before the calendar has turned to January.

One of his friends is one of the world's most prominent sports personalities in, ESPN commentator Stephen A. Smith. The other is one of the country's most recognizable college basketball coaches and personalities in, University of South Carolina head women's basketball coach Dawn Staley.

Smith, the host of ESPN's highly-rated First Take show, was teammates with Ross at Winston-Salem State University in the early '90s under legendary coach Clarence "Big House" Gaines. Smith visited Ross at Corbett Sports Center on Dec. 12, 2023, as the Aggies faced their archrival North Carolina Central.

Meanwhile, Staley and Ross grew up together in Philadelphia, with Ross often marveling at how well Staley competed against the guys. Staley has become a college basketball star at the University of Virginia, a 6-time WNBA All-Star, a gold medalist at the Olympics, and a two-time NCAA champion as a head coach.

WEEKLY SUPERLATIVES

INJURY FILLED

Injuries derailed a promising start in Coastal Athletic Association (CAA) play for the North Carolina A&T men's basketball team last season. Glasper was the leading cause of worry from an injury standpoint a year ago. Four of A&T's five conference wins came in January when the Aggies started league play 4-2 thanks to a three-game winning streak that included wins over Hampton, Northeastern, and William & Mary. But on an unlucky night in Newark, Del., against the Delaware Blue Hens, Glasper sustained a leg injury that caused him to miss seven CAA games.

In addition to Glasper missing time, forward Jeremy Robinson sustained a season-ending injury in February. Starting forward Nikolaos Chitikoudis missed time with injuries and starting center Jason Murphy did not play in the Aggies' final three games of the season. All of that is behind A&T and second-year head coach Monté Ross as the 2024-25 season approaches. Glasper, Chitikoudis, and Murphy are back.

Before the season even started, 6-9 center Will Felton sustained a season-ending knee injury during an exhibition game at Corbett Sports Center. Felton had missed the previous season because of a knee injury. But the Aggies had an impressive offseason where they signed some talented transfers.

THE TALENTED TRANSFERS

North Carolina A&T men's basketball has retooled, adding significant depth during the offseason to offset such an occurrence as the 2024-25 season approaches. Hoping to avoid getting controlled by the injury bug in 2024-25, the Aggies added some talented pieces, starting with transfer guard Ryan Forrest (6-4, 190, Marion, Ark.). Forrest played 11 games last season for Northwestern State, averaging 11.8 points on 38.5 percent shooting. Forrest missed the Aggies first game against Cheney, but he has played and scored in double figures in each game since, leading the Aggies in scoring at 20.2 points per game. Forrest committed to the University of Memphis coming out of high school.

University of Maryland transfer Jahnathan Lamothe is also an excellent addition to the team. Lamothe played 16 games for the Terrapins last season after becoming a standout at St. Frances Academy, where he once scored 57 points. Lamothe made his A&T debut on Nov. 4 and scored a collegiate career-best 27 points. Ross added a little more height with the addition of 6-11 LaSalle transfer Efstratios Kalliontzis. A 6-10 center/forward, Kalliontzis has extensive international experience and played for the Greek U18 National Team at the FIBA U18 European Championships in 2022 and 2023. This past summer, he averaged 4.3 points over three games, including seven points and three rebounds in an 88-83 win over Italy. Kalliontzis did not play a game for LaSalle.

Bryant Ogletree is a talented junior college transfer out of South Plains College. Ogletree averaged 6.3 points and 2.4 rebounds in 32 games played last season at South Plains College.

GLASPER EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

Junior guard Landon Glasper was a unanimous first-team preseason selection. His backcourt mate, junior point guard Cam Shell, earned honorable mention preseason all-conference honors. Glasper averaged 20.9 points per game in his first season as an Aggie after transferring from Coffeyville Community College. It marked A&T's highest scoring average since Jamain Williams averaged 21.4 points per game during the 1992-93 season. A&T's scoring machine scored 30 or more points four times last season.

Glasper has also earned a spot on the Bracketeer's Non-Power Conference All-American Watch List for men's basketball. The 2025 Bracketeer.Org Non-Power Conference Player of the Year will be announced in the final week of March 2025. Bracketeer's All-American Watch List for the Non-Power Conferences recognizes the college basketball season's most outstanding players regardless of position.

We are excited to find more ways to honor the 22 conferences that do not get nearly enough attention in D1 Basketball. The list contains players from all 22 eligible conferences. A midseason watch list will be released in early January or before. The Final All-American Awards will be given in late March.

Shell, who played at Coffeyville CC with Glasper, had an outstanding first year as an Aggie, becoming Ross's coach on the floor. He started all 31 games he played in last season, averaging 12.3 points, 4.1 assists, and 1.3 steals per game.

WILL FELTON HAS TRIUMPHANT RETURN

After two years of rehabbing from two serious knee injuries, Felton finally made his way to a college basketball court and made the best of his first opportunity. Felton had a double-double by halftime in his collegiate debut, finishing with 17 points and 12 rebounds on 6-for-6 shooting. He split his rebounding evenly, posting six offensive and six defensive boards.

Felton had 11 points and 10 rebounds by halftime, and the Aggies held a 55-24 lead going into the locker room. Standing as the fiercest force on the court is a far cry from where Felton has spent the previous two seasons. Before the start of the 2022-23 season, after Felton transferred from Arizona State, he sustained a season-ending injury in a preseason exhibition game.

After a successful rehab, Felton found himself back on the Corbett Sports Center basketball court in another preseason exhibition game before the 2023-24 season started. As he played his way toward a double-double performance, Felton again sustained a severe knee injury that forced him to miss the season. But his long-awaited A&T debut was worth it for the big man who always seems to have a big smile. His first official action as an Aggie in a regular-season game was not as a rebounder or scorer. He dished off a nice pass to a cutting Jalal McKie to give the Aggies a 2-0 lead.

AGGIES MOURN THE LOSS OF A LEGEND

The North Carolina A&T Intercollegiate Department of Athletics and the North Carolina A&T State University family are mourning the loss of one of its most well-known, legendary, and celebrated figures, Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer and A&T legend Al Attles.

As a tribute to Attles, the Aggies will wear a patch on their upper right side of their home white jerseys of Attles' No. 22 that he wore while playing for the Aggies in the mid 1950's to the early 1960's on the east side of Greensboro. Attles is one of only three A&T student-athletes to have their numbers retired joining, Pro Football Hall of Famer Elvin Bethea and College Baseball Hall of Famer Al Holland.

The Golden State Warriors, an NBA organization he spent more than six decades with as a player, general manager, coach, and team ambassador, announced his passing on August 21. He died in his San Francisco Bay Area home surrounded by family. Attles, a native of Newark, New Jersey, played for legendary North Carolina A&T head men's basketball coach Cal Irvin from 1956-60, graduating in 1960 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and history. He led the Aggies to consecutive Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) titles in 1958 and '59.

In 1960, Attles was drafted by the Philadelphia Warriors and played for 11 seasons with the team in Philadelphia and then in San Francisco, now known as Golden State. Starting in 1980, he held numerous roles in the franchise, including coach from 1970-83. He led the organization to an NBA Championship in 1975, becoming only the second African American coach to win a title. He is one of five Warriors to have his number retired.

On February 7, 2015, Attles became the first player in the history of A&T athletics to have his number officially retired. His number 22 jersey hangs from the rafters of Corbett Sports Center. On Friday, September 6, 2019, Attles and 11 other honorees were enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. It is home to more than three hundred inductees and more than 40,000 square feet of basketball history.

NATIONAL CHAMPION COMES TO A&T

Ricky Moore brings championship experience as a player and a coach. After an 11-year professional basketball career that included stops in Austria, Ukraine, Sweden, Turkey, and Germany, and domestic

stops in the Continental Basketball Association (CBA) and the NBA Developmental League (NBDL), Moore started his coaching career at Dartmouth College in 2010 before coming back to UConn to help the Huskies win a national title in 2011. Before starting his professional basketball career, Moore co-captained UConn's national championship team in 1999, the program's first in school history. During his four seasons (1995-99) in Storrs, Conn., the Huskies went 114-24 overall and 55-17 in the Big East. Moore made the Final Four and West Regional all-tournament teams, and Basketball News Magazine named him national defensive player of the year in 1999. He also made UConn's all-century team in 2001.

NAISMITH HALL OF FAMERS FROM A&T

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame accepted another North Carolina A&T Aggie into its hallowed doors in Hugh Evans in 2022. Evans, a 2002 inductee into the North Carolina A&T Sports Hall of Fame, played men's basketball for the Aggies from 1959-63 under legendary head coach Cal Irvin. He scored 585 points in 72 games.

The Aggies went 63-22 (.741) during Evans' time in AggieLand. After graduating from A&T, Evans served as an NBA Official for 28 consecutive years (1973-2001), tallying over 1,900 regular-season games, 170 playoff games, 35 NBA Finals games and four NBA All-Star Games.

Evans will join fellow Aggie Al Attles in the Naismith Hall. Attles played at A&T from 1956-60. Attles played with the Philadelphia/Golden State Warriors (1960-71) before becoming one of the first African American coaches in NBA history. In 1975, he became the second African American coach in NBA history to win an NBA title.

A&T's ONE TRUE FRESHMAN

Chanler Montgomery attended Blacksburg High School in Blacksburg, Virginia. Montgomery played basketball and football while at Blacksburg, but basketball was where he truly excelled. His dedication to the game and leadership made him a standout athlete in his class. While at Blacksburg High School, Chanler Montgomery put up impressive statistics. He averaged 18.5 points, 7.2 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game. His scoring ability and playmaking skills were notable. Montgomery also shot 40 percent from 3-point range. Montgomery's talent did not go unnoticed, and he received several accolades throughout his high school career. He was named to the All-Region First Team and secured a spot in the All-State Tournament.

THE COFFEYVILLE CONNECTION

The Aggies starting backcourt came together in this way. North Carolina A&T hired Monté Ross on April 10, 2023. Ross needed a point guard after the transfer to N.C. State by Kam Woods. He went to nearby Winston-Salem, N.C., and signed 5-foot-10 guard Camian "Cam" Shell out of Coffeyville. Shell provided the Aggies with a floor leader and someone who could score from the perimeter. Shell averaged 7.3 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 3.9 assists while shooting 42 percent from the floor, 45 percent from 3-point range, and 83 percent from the free throw line last season at Coffeyville.

But Ross needed a top-notch scorer after the Aggies lost more than 90 percent of their offense from the previous season, thanks to the transfer portal and exhausting eligibility. That led to Shell telling Ross, "I know a guy." Shell told Ross about his backcourt mate at Coffeyville, Landon Gasper. Shell told Ross that Gasper is available and ready to visit North Carolina A&T.

After Gasper visited the university, Ross told him he would give him a couple of days to decide. However, Gasper decided on the spot, telling the first-year A&T head coach he was ready to sign with the Aggies program. Gasper's signing gave the Aggies a scorer, a good defender, and someone to build the program around. Gasper averaged 13.9 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 1.9 assists at Coffeyville while shooting 45 percent from the floor, 38 percent from 3-point range, and 81 percent from the line.

The duo was fabulous during their first season in Aggieland. Shell played all 31 of A&T's games, leading the team in assists per game (4.1) and finishing second in points per game (12.3). He and Gasper were the only two Aggies to average double figures last season. Meanwhile, Gasper ran into some injury issues but still led the Aggies in scoring (20.9), earning first-team All-CAA honors at season's end. Before this season, the Coffeyville backcourt was rewarded for their efforts in 2023-24. CAA head coaches voted Gasper a unanimous first-team All-CAA preseason selection. Head coaches voted Shell as an honorable mention preseason All-CAA.

PLAYERS RECRUITING PLAYERS

The Aggies needed another scorer to help prolific scorer Landon Gasper. Therefore, Gasper helped himself and the program by convincing his longtime friend and fellow Arkansasian Ryan Forrest to sign with the North Carolina A&T Aggies. Originally from West Memphis, Ark., Forrest spent his freshman, sophomore, and junior seasons at Marion High School. Forrest helped lead the Marion Patriots to the Class 5A state title during the 2021-22 season. As a senior, Forrest averaged 20.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, and 3.1 assists per game, helping lead Marion High School to a 26-8 record and an appearance in the Class 5A state final.

The cousin of Memphis Tigers assistant coach Shawan Forrest, he was the No. 37 shooting guard in the country and the No. 8 player in Arkansas. As a 3-star athlete coming out of high school, he committed to Memphis before re-opening his recruitment and choosing Northwestern State. He played only 10 games with Northwestern State, averaging 12.0 points per game before entering the transfer portal.

After returning to A&T after entering the transfer portal, Gasper reached out to his friend to see if he would be interested in A&T. With the Aggies needing another reliable scorer, Forrest believed A&T would be the best fit and signed with the Aggies.

EUROPEAN CONNECTION

In addition to two Arkansasians and two Coffeyville Junior College alumni, the Aggies also have two team members from Greece. Last season, Nikolaos Chitikoudis affectionately earned the nickname "Greek Freak" playing off of the NBA's version, Giannis Antetokounmpo, another Greek native. It was also a play on Chitikoudis's East Thessaloniki, Greece hometown. Chitikoudis averaged 7.1 points and 5.3 rebounds and led the team in blocked shots at 1.39 per game. With their connection to Chitikoudis, the Aggies reached out to 6-foot-11 Efstratios Kalliontzis from Mitilini, Greece.

The two decided to reconnect after Kalliontzis left LaSalle. Two years ago in the Greek U18 league, he averaged 21 points and 12 rebounds per contest. He is playing high school in the United States at The Hoosac School in New York. Stratos is an international player will give A&T another frontcourt option and his international experience will help with his adjustment to college basketball.

GETTING OLDER

A year ago, the Aggies came into the season as the eighth youngest team in the nation. A&T featured seven freshmen and five sophomores last season, and sometimes it showed. The Aggies struggled against older, more mature teams in a season where the Aggies went 7-24. Therefore, the Aggies decided to get older quickly. Four of A&T's 12 freshmen or sophomores left the team.

The Aggies replaced those players with Division I transfers such as Ryan Forrest from Northwestern State, Jahanathan Lamothe from the University of Maryland, and Efstratios Kalliontzis from LaSalle. The Aggies also brought in junior college transfer Bryson Ogletree. With players such as sophomores Jalal McKie and Uchenna Kellman-Nicholes with a year of experience, the Aggies had room for only one freshman in walk-on Chanler Montgomery.

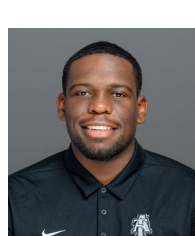
